The months of January through May are an exceptionally busy time of year at Clear Creek Stud Farm in Folsom, La.

"We're having a baby," said Michelle LaVoice

as she hangs up her phone. Jumping in her truck, the farm manager raced to the expectant mare. At this point, that baby can come at any moment.

Clear Creek Stud, founded in 1969 by Jack Lohman, is a premier thoroughbred breeding facility and home to many of Louisiana's leading sires. A few of the notable stallions that currently reside at the facility include Star Guitar, Custom for Carlos, Half Ours and Clearly Now. They stand tall and strong. Their personalities vary but they all have one thing in common - distinguished credentials giving them the right to be at Clear Creek Stud.

"We are on watch 24-7 during foaling season which starts the first of January," LaVoice said. "We have day and night watchmen." Foaling occurs relatively quickly, generally from the time their water breaks

until delivery which is about 15-20 minutes. Fortunately, complications are rare. However, a veterinarian, who lives on site, is available to assist when needed.

General Manager Val Murrell said, "The breeding and foaling seasons are always exciting. At Clear Creek, there are probably more people in attendance for a foaling mare than for the birth of a human baby." He added that the extra help is out of an abundance of caution.

Gestation is 11 months and five days. LaVoice explained that each foal turns another year older on January 1. All thoroughbreds have a universal Jan. 1st birthday. That's important because for the rest of its racing career, the horse will be competing with its peers based on their ages. The closer they are born to Jan. 1, the bigger and stronger they are next to their peers who were born later.

Breeders look for good conformation and bloodline when breeding potential racehorses. "It's very important to have a well-balanced horse with lots of muscle to hopefully limit injuries," said LaVoice.

Livestock theft in Tangipahoa Parish

Baton Rouge, La. (January 27, 2020) – A Mississippi man is accused of stealing six head of cattle from a Tangipahoa Parish livestock sale barn.

Twenty-three year old Colson K. Lambert, 55 Argyle Trail, Bogue Chitto, Ms., was arrested by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission

January 24, 2020. Lambert is charged with six counts of theft of livestock.

According to investigators, the LDAF received a complaint from a public livestock market in Tangipahoa Parish that someone illegally removed cattle from the livestock market and took them out of state. Following


an investigation, it was determined Lambert was allegedly in possession of the cattle after leaving the public auction market on January 14, 2020. Investigators were able to link Lambert to the theft through video from security cameras.

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, “Our public livestock markets

provide a legitimate and professional avenue to sell livestock from local producers. Our brand inspectors move swiftly to respond to complaints in an effort to recover stolen property.”

All six head of cattle were recovered by LDAF brand inspectors and have been returned to the sale barn.

Clear Creek Stud sits on 300 acres. At the time of this interview, there were 16 foals on the ground and about 115 more to go.

Murrell, who has worked at Clear Creek Stud for 40 years, is considered an expert in equine reproduction. "I've seen 5,000 horses born here; it is a passion for horses that makes everything work. I've been blessed with a client base and staff that all share an incredible passion for horses, breeding and the racing industry in Louisiana."

LaVoice said the stallion market is the toughest part of the business. "A stallion prospect must be productive early, producing not just winners, but a big percentage of winners and at levels including stakes and hopefully beyond. If this does not occur, they simply move on to another horse. One hears all sorts of statistics about stallion success rate, but it is probably more like one in 20 that are successful," she added.

Folsom, La. has rivaled Louisville, Ky. as horse country, mostly because of the number of horse farms and not necessarily the number of thoroughbreds. At Clear Creek Stud, stud fees range from \$1,500 to \$7,500, but stud

fees can go up to \$300,000 in Kentucky where many high-end stallions are housed.

"We were fortunate to deliver California Chrome's baby here," said Murrell. California Chrome won the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness in 2014. "We have a number of new clients at Clear Creek Stud, mostly from Kentucky and California. Perry Martin, who had an interest in California Chrome, sent 10 mares, eight of which are in foal to California Chrome. Chester Thomas, Kevin Atwood and others, all with high-quality mares, decided to move parts of their operations to Louisiana because of the strong breeders program and associated racing venues," added Murrell. He also credits the state legislature and Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., for recognizing thoroughbred breeders and the racing industry as an important part of the state's economy. Horse racing is a \$1 billion industry.

Once the babies are born, Murrell and staff help raise them, prepare them for sale. "We generally handle two-year olds through the sales or until owners send them on to trainers at the track. We prepare them for the

world of racing if they seem cut out for that," added Murrell.

As for now, the baby watch continues. Maybe you will see one of these Louisiana-bred horses competing one day in the highly anticipated Louisiana Derby at

the New Orleans Fairgrounds or the Kentucky Derby in Louisville, Ky.

In many provinces, U.S. exporters must have a registered agent who provides the necessary marketing support, within the province, to obtain a provincial liquor board listing.

Louisiana Crawfish King Cake

- 1/2 cup chopped onion
1/2 cup chopped red or green bell pepper
1 teaspoon minced garlic
1 cup Louisiana crawfish tails, drained and rinsed
- 1/3 cup chopped green onion
3 tablespoons reduced-fat cream cheese
2 (8-ounce) cans reduced-fat crescent rolls
Mardi Gras Topping (see recipe)

Preheat oven 350 degrees Coat 10-inch round pizza pan lined with foil with nonstick cooking spray. In nonstick skillet coated with nonstick cooking spray, sauté onion, red pepper and garlic until tender. Add crawfish, green onion and cream cheese, stirring until creamy. Remove from heat. Separate crescent rolls at perforations, into 16 slices. Place slices around prepared pan with points in the center. About halfway down from points, press seams together. Spread crawfish mixture on dough in the center where seams have been pressed together. Sprinkle with cheese. Fold dough points over filling, then fold bottom of triangle over points forming circular roll like king cake. Bake 20-25 minutes or until golden brown. Sprinkle with Mardi Gras Topping (see recipe).

Mardi Gras Topping

- 6 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese
Yellow, green, red, and blue food coloring

In three small bowls, divide cheese. In one bowl, add few drops yellow food coloring. In second bowl, add few drops green food coloring. In third bowl, add equal amounts drops of red and blue food coloring (to create purple). Sprinkle cheese over baked king cake. Return to oven 1-2 minutes or until cheese melted.

AgCenter soil workshop, field day set for Feb. 26 in St. Joseph

The LSU AgCenter Northeast Research Station will host a soil health workshop and cover crop field day Feb. 26 in St. Joseph.

Registration will begin 8:30 a.m. followed by the program from 9 until 4 p.m. A sponsored lunch will be provided.

The event will highlight soil health and regenerative agriculture presented by recent LSU graduate Kathleen Bridges.

A field tour of the research station will cover current research on legume seeding rates, nematode suppression with cover crops, tillage and cover crop three-way rotations, and a 12-species cover crop trial looking at broadcast versus drill planting and termination timing.

In a hands-on workshop, farmers will use biomass collected during the field tour to review technology resources available for nutrient analysis.

Other presentations will include soil health dynamics and strategies, economics of best management practices and updates on the Patrick F. Taylor Foundation grant project.

The meeting will conclude with a producer panel and open forum.
