## *North House Home and Gardens*

To say North House Home and Gardens is a labor of love would be an understatement. "When we purchased the five acre cow pasture in Bush, La. in 1985, the plan was to come here to do some fishing and woodworking," said owner Dr. James Briggs.

Briggs and co-owner David Bourgeois started from scratch. "First came the pond and then the driveway. Then we added some crepe myrtles. Once we started building, we've never really stopped for the last 25-plus years," said Briggs.

Briggs, a general dentist by profession who specialized in working on medically compromised patients in nursing homes, built a smaller home on the land at first. Then he added a barn, conservatory, workshop, guest house, chapel, cottage, guest cottage and a stable to the property.

By 2005, the North House itself had evolved into a stately three-story custom built Georgian estate surrounded by several gardens inspired by Long Vue House and Gardens in New Orleans and also by Briggs' travels.

"At this point, I thought it was important to know how to plant, what to plant and how to recognize disease. That's when I signed up to take the master gardener class through the LSU AgCenter," said Briggs. "I learned a lot, earned my master gardener certification and made a lot of friends."

North House is named for its location - north of New Orleans where their other home is located. Today, the grounds consist of 25-30,000 trees, plants, shrubs and bulbs. It takes 1.2-1.5 million of gallons of water a month to keep everything green and Briggs, Bourgeois and groundskeeper Charlie Powell spend about 50 hours a week maintaining its beautiful, lush and perfectly manicured grounds.

"I spend a lot of time here," said Briggs as he walked into the chapel on the grounds. While the quaint chapel can be used for weddings, it is also where Briggs comes to be in solitude and to worship. "The altar is from Germany and was built in the late 1800s. The

# LOUISIANA AGRICULTURE & FORESTRY TODAY

## Coronavirus Food Assistance Program

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the announcement of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP) will provide relief to farmers, ranchers, and consumers in response to the COVID-19 crisis.

The USDA plans to provide \$16 billion in direct support for losses where agricultural producers have been impacted. "I urge Louisiana ag producers to document and maintain detailed records of all financial losses as a result of this crisis," said Strain.

The USDA will also partner with regional and local distributors, whose workforce has been significantly impacted by the closure of many restaurants, hotels, and other food service

entities, to purchase \$3 billion in fresh produce, dairy, and meat. Distributors and wholesalers will then provide a pre-approved box of fresh produce, dairy, and meat products to food banks, community and faith based organizations, and other non-profits serving Americans in need.

"In addition to feeding the people of Louisiana and the rest of America, the direct purchase of fresh produce, dairy and meat for food banks and other organizations will bolster and grow the economy, especially those sectors hardest hit by restaurant and food entity closures as well as the loss of workers in processing facilities," added Strain.

Strain was recently appointed by Governor John Bel Edwards to serve

as co-chair of the critical food and agriculture sector on the Resilient Louisiana Task Force. Strain is also in weekly contact with the USDA discussing keeping the American food supply chain intact, safe and secure.

CFAP will use the funding and authorities provided in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES), the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA), and other USDA existing authorities.

Further details regarding eligibility, rates, and other implementation will be released at a later date.



# Gnats becoming problematic

One of the small pleasures people are trying to enjoy during this COVID-19 crisis is the spring weather. An influx of gnats is making it increasingly more difficult to even do this.

These pests are known by several different names, including turkey gnats or buffalo gnats. They are members of the black fly family and usually start to show up in early spring.

Boyd Causey lives in West Feliciana Parish, and he is battling an infestation for the second consecutive year.

"I finally bought netting to wear to keep them out of my face," Causey said. "Last year, we were able to sit underneath the carport to avoid them somewhat. This year, there is no safe place."

Another factor adding to people's misery is the gnats are active throughout the day, unlike mosquitoes that are most active early in the morning and near dusk.

While their bites can be annoying, the gnats are not a major pathogen transmitter to humans as compared with mosquitoes, according to LSU AgCenter medical entomologist

Kristen Healy.

"Turkey gnat bites are really irritating to people," Healy said. "Our biggest concern is simuliotoxicosis in birds."

This condition can be a concern for people who own poultry. In 2010, more than 200 birds died in 17 parishes across the state. Experts blamed the deaths on strikes from black flies.

There have been documented cases where the gnat infestation was so intense that it caused asphyxiation in livestock.

Sebe Brown, an LSU AgCenter entomologist at Dean Lee Research and Extension Center in Alexandria, said black flies tend to avoid enclosed or roofed areas such as carports and barns. Eluding them in open areas is nearly impossible, however.

"Products that have either DEET or Picaridin can provide a limited amount of protection from gnats," Brown said of popular insect repellents. "They are very good for mosquitoes. There's just no silver bullet for gnats."

Some people have used products containing naturally-derived

ingredients such as citrus or vanilla, which may contain some repellent properties. Brown said no scientific research supports these types of products offering protection from the biting pests.

Adult populations exist for about a month, hatched from eggs laid the previous spring. Female gnats lay between 100 and 600 eggs.

Like mosquitoes, adult gnats feed on blood. Some gnat species will swarm around livestock and people, cutting the skin of their host and feeding on the blood, Brown said.

For livestock, repellent products containing permethrin or insecticidal ear tags, smoldering fires, such as hay bales, that produce dense smoke and providing shelters may reduce exposure to the gnats.

Permethrin or any pyrethroid-class products should not be used on cats, Brown said.

While not many people are looking forward to the dog days of summer, heat will provide relief from gnats. Once daytime high temperatures consistently stay above 80 degrees, the interaction with gnats will diminish.

wood carved angels are from France circa 1776. I salvaged these original canvas paintings from a church in Philadelphia, Pa.," said Briggs. Most of the chapel contents are from the 15th to the 19th centuries.

Briggs enjoys sharing his labor of love with the public. He often hosts garden club luncheons on the grounds. North House Home and Gardens is also available for other special events ranging from weddings to special dinners to graduation and birthday celebrations. "I can't tell you the number of people who use the gardens to take their bridal or even graduation pictures," he added.

The property is also a certified agritourism destination through the LSU AgCenter and people can tour the grounds by appointment. Depending on the time of year, visitors will find colorful splashes of hydrangeas, impatiens, caladiums to petunias and snap dragons. A walk around the grounds will also bring you to the conservatory where there is a permanent exhibit of plants and a fruit and vegetable garden where Briggs grows beans, rosemary, tomatoes and even watermelon.

Peacocks, ducks and geese also roam the grounds.

But a visit to the workshop is where you will find Briggs latest projects - custom beehives. "I have my own bees that are housed in a beehive I built in the replica of a chapel," said Briggs. "These are fully functional beehives - just dressed up. Every queen needs a grand home," he added. While he builds and sells them on special order, he has a collection of beehives he has built inspired by his travels - a Georgia mansion, North Fork Church in Virginia, Mallard House in Williamsburg, Va., and Smyth Barn in Pennsylvania. Briggs said he's considering adding birdhouses to the collection.
