Hurricane Season Ahead Are You Prepared?

Hurricane season began on June 1 and Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M., is urging everyone to have a plan in place for their property, pets and/or livestock in the event a storm threatens.

“As we continue to work

to stay healthy and protect our families from the COVID-19, we must also remember that hurricane season is upon us. It’s time to get ready for the possibility of severe weather over the next several months,” said Strain. “This is the time

to prepare your property so if you need trees cut, it is recommended you use a licensed arborist. This protects you because they are trained and must maintain liability insurance.

Refer to the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) website or LDAF Business App for mobile devices to verify the current license status of an arborist.”

As for animals, livestock owners should identify an area on their property that is least likely to flood and where the animals can be moved when severe weather threatens the area. During an evacuation, it is important to leave early and have a place to go that allows livestock and or family pets.

Tips on preparing livestock trailers:

- Check tire pressure

- and rubber for wear
- Test brake and running lights
- Inspect the overall condition of the trailer

Important livestock items to take during an evacuation:

- Health records (especially proof of EIA testing for horses)
- Food
- Special medications
- Bridles or leads

Important pet items to take during an evacuation:

- Health records
- Food and food bowls
- Special medications
- Pet carriers
- Collars/leashes

Proper identification for livestock that are evacuated is crucial during a natural disaster.

By law, the LDAF is designated by the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act to assist in evacuating

and sheltering household pets for evacuated citizens going to shelters during declared emergencies. The LDAF now has two mobile pet shelters to assist in keeping family pets in close proximity to their owners when an evacuation is necessary. Those pet trailers and LDAF employees are ready to be mobilized, if necessary.

The LDAF also provides fuel for emergency vehicles, hospitals, nursing homes, shelters and other emergency operations that require fuel. The LDAF is prepared to move forward on this, if necessary.

Livestock Theft in Avoyelles Parish

Baton Rouge, La. (May 28, 2020) - The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Brand Commission arrested a Rapides Parish man accused of stealing four head of cattle and one horse from a public livestock barn in Avoyelles Parish.

According to investigators, 48 year old Joel Dunn, 125 Town & Country Road, Alexandria, La., allegedly purchased the five head of livestock on October 2 and October 9 of 2019, and left the market without making

proper payment.

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "State law protects our livestock markets from persons not complying with proper payment for livestock. When the suspect did not return the livestock he did not pay for, it became a crime. As always, our brand investigators take these criminal acts seriously."

The stolen livestock is valued at approximately \$2,000. At this time, the livestock have not been recovered.

Dunn is charged with two counts of theft of livestock for each date in which the crimes were allegedly committed.

Dunn was located and booked in Vermilion Parish. He was then transported by Brand Commission inspectors to Avoyelles Parish where he was also booked.

The Livestock Brand Commission was assisted in this investigation by the Abbeville Police Department and the Vermillion Parish Sheriff's Department.

CREOLE SHRIMP OVER CHEESE GRITS

Submitted by Darlene Carter, LDAF, Office of Forestry

Ingredients:

Shrimp

- 1 pound large Louisiana shrimp, peeled and deveined (with tails on)
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 lemons, halved and juiced (reserve halves)
- 4 tablespoons creole seasoning
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cups butter, melted

Grits

- 4 cups water
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup quick cooking grits, uncooked
- 1 cup cheddar cheese, shredded
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup parmesan cheese, shredded
- 2 tablespoons butter
- Ground black pepper, to taste

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a large bowl, toss shrimp evenly with olive oil, lemon juice, lemon halves, and seasoning. Spread shrimp in shallow baking dish. Pour melted butter over all. Bake for 20 to 25 minutes. After 20 minutes, check shrimp for doneness. Do not overcook. Bring water and salt to a boil in 3-quart saucepan. Whisk in grits. Reduce heat to medium-low; cook for 5-6 minutes or until tender. Remove from heat. Stir in cheddar cheese, parmesan cheese, and butter. Sprinkle with pepper to taste. Serve shrimp over grits.



CAJUN BLAST PORK SPARE RIBS



can do," Faust said. "If you don't have a good roof on your cage and water is getting in all the time, it will become a slop hole of bacteria."

Two of the most common chicken diseases that can spread from bird to bird and even destroy a flock are avian influenza and virulent Newcastle disease. Even though proper sanitation goes a long way in preventing disease, you can do something else first.

"The National Poultry Improvement Program certifies qualified poultry breeders to have chicks, hatching eggs or mature stock that are free of disease," Timmerman said. "If you buy these NPIP birds, you'll know they've already been vaccinated against diseases."

People are also at risk of getting diseases like salmonella from handling poultry if they don't use proper sanitation.

"You always want to wash your hands after handling your birds. And don't kiss them or touch your face to them," Timmerman said.

The United States Department of Agriculture recommends these safe cleaning tips for poultry:

- Regularly remove used litter, manure and other debris.

- Remove chickens from houses when "wet" cleaning all surfaces. Work from top to bottom and back to front. Rinse carefully with water.

- Apply disinfectant according to label directions. Use disinfectants that the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency indicates are effective against avian influenza and other poultry diseases.

- Leave the enclosure empty until it is completely dry. Wet surfaces can be harmful to poultry.

- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water after you leave the poultry area.

"People might think chickens are noisy and stinky, but as long as you do it properly, they're not," Faust said. "Chickens offer a lot of practical benefits. And because they're really affectionate little animals, they make surprisingly good pets."

Louisiana cotton crop planted; going to be a small

Louisiana's cotton farmers have nearly completed this year's planting, and the crop size has shrunk when compared to earlier estimates.

In early February, estimates had planting intentions for cotton around 230,000 acres, with the possibility it could be as large as a quarter of a million acres. Market conditions and loan availability have lowered that number considerably.

LSU AgCenter cotton specialist Dan Fromme is an eyewitness to just how small the cotton crop has become.

"When you drive the farm-scape, you just don't see 230,000 acres," Fromme said. "I think most would agree with me that we're going to be south of 200,000."

Farmers planted the crop relatively early compared with previous years, which normally bodes well for better yields.

"When you have to plant the last part of May, the first part of June, yields aren't quite as good," Fromme said.

A warm April helped dry the fields and warm the soil for cotton planting, but a cooler May slowed crop development, he said.

Jay Hardwick farms in Tensas Parish, where cotton has traditionally been a major part of the landscape. His cotton crop this year is much smaller than last year's.

"We're about 50% down on our cotton this year," Hardwick said. "It's off and running. We haven't experienced any insect or disease pressure yet, but it's early."

Low cotton prices just do not make it as profitable as some of the other crops, said Hardwick, who has significant acres planted in soybeans and corn.

Dennis Burns, an AgCenter agent for Catahoula, Concordia and Tensas parishes, said cotton acres in his area have taken a big hit.

"Tensas Parish usually has around 40,000 acres in cotton in a typical year," Burns said. "Things changed in January and early February. We're probably around 20,000 acres now."

Justin Dufour, an AgCenter agent for Avoyelles, Grant and Rapides parishes, has had a similar experience with cotton acres.

"It's the most condensed cotton crop I've seen in a while," Dufour said. "It will probably be the smallest one in the past 10 years."

Most farmers switched cotton acres to soybeans because soybeans seemed to stand a better chance of turning a profit, Burns said. But soybean prices are also low and come with the risk that China, the No. 1 buyer of U.S. soybeans, might not be inclined to buy soybeans from the U.S.

"Cotton is a big rotational crop in our area," Burns said.

"People are taking it out of their rotation because of the economics, and that concerns me."

To help increase the likelihood of producing good yields, cotton farmers have planted cotton on some of their better lands. Cotton is one of the more expensive crops to grow, so farmers want to help ensure the crop can succeed.

Preparations, precautions important for safely raising backyard chickens

With extra time at home, many people have begun raising chickens for the first time, while others are considering this rapidly burgeoning hobby. For those contemplating backyard chickens, it's important to consider the materials you will need and how to keep both poultry and people healthy and safe.

"If you're looking for a good egg-producing bird, go for the heavy breeds — like an Australorp, a Buff Orpington or a Barred Rock," said Anna Timmerman, LSU AgCenter extension agent in Greater New Orleans. "Chickens also come in bantam size, too, which is a miniature. But if you're looking for a good egg-producing bird, go for the heavier breeds." Before bringing baby chicks home, you need to set up a brooder area.

"You want good bedding material like pine wood chips in the bottom of the brooder so they don't slip and go lame," Timmerman said. "You also want to get chick-sized feeders and waterers."

Additionally, young birds will need a sack of special chick starter feed, which has more protein than other feeds, grit for grinding their food and a fire-safe ceramic heat lamp that should be set to about 95 degrees.

"If your chicks are bunched up underneath the heat source, it's too cold. And if they're all out towards the edges, it's too hot," said Timmerman, who grew up raising poultry as part of a 4-H project. "If they're all over the place in the brooder, then it's just right."

"In about six weeks, they'll look like full-grown birds," she said.

Susceptibility to extreme temperatures is not the only vulnerability for a chick or a full-grown chicken. Predators like foxes and coyotes are a constant threat, and the best way to prevent harm to your birds is by building a sturdy house that prevents multiple entry points.

"Most people think chicken wire is what you're supposed to use for your building, but the gaps are big enough for predators to stick their paws through or rip it open and get your chickens. So you should use something sturdier with less openings," said Matt Faust, a Baton Rouge resident who has been raising chickens for 10 years. "It's also important to sink concrete blocks under the structure to prevent predators from digging underneath the cages to get in," he said.

"There are pre-fab chicken house kits you can easily put together that have two levels and a good roof," Timmerman said. "You need protection from the rain and the elements, and the cage needs to be sturdy to keep them safe from predators." "As far as the health of the birds, keeping the cage dry and clean is about the best thing you
