## Despite the ongoing pandemic, LDAF Weights and Measures inspections continue

While much of the state is on lockdown because of the Covid-19 pandemic, it's business as usual on a hot but breezy day along the bayou at Chauvin's Seafood in Dulac, La.

"Fortunately, what we do is outside and we are able to maintain safe protocols. We also have a responsibility to help keep the food supply chain going and what better way than to provide fresh, Louisiana seafood," said owner Kimberly Chauvin. Chauvin and her husband, David, have worked in the seafood industry for more than 20 years.

On this day, a team of Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Weights and Measures inspectors are testing the scales to ensure accuracy. "In spite of the coronavirus, we're still out here protecting the consumers," said LDAF Director of Weights and Measures Bobby Fletcher, Ph.D.

We do this for the local grocery or retail store to make sure their pricing system is correct, for taximeters to make sure they measure distance and time properly, the gas station on the corner to make sure their retail motor fuel devices are accurate and in this case, making sure the scales are correct.

While having to follow Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, LDAF inspectors are working to protect the shrimper, the business owner and the consumer. "The scales have to be accurate because the shrimper is paid by how much he/she catches. The business owners need to feel confident they are not over paying. And the consumer, of course, needs to trust they are getting what they pay for, so we make sure that equity prevails in all transactions" added Fletcher.

Three types of scales were tested during the inspection. A hopper scale where the shrimp are initially weighed when the shrimper makes a delivery, a platform scale when the shrimp are separated and a retail scale that is used when consumers purchase shrimp onsite. The LDAF conducts an increasing load test up to the capacity of the scale then a decreasing load test back to zero. "In addition, one of the tests we do is a shift or corner test. That ensures that no matter where the product is placed on the scale, the weight will be the same," said Heavy Duty program Ag Specialist Randy Mobley.

The scales are tested one to two times a year, typically before each harvest season starts. It's a job the LDAF inspectors take seriously. LDAF inspectors are well trained and continue profes-

## Invasive Species Impacting Crops

(July 22, 2020) – A recent report from the LSU AgCenter regarding the apple snail (*Pomacea maculata*) sheds light on this foreign invasive species that is now negatively impacting two Louisiana food staples: crawfish and rice.

The apple snail reportedly first appeared in a canal in Gretna, La. in 2006 and quickly infested ponds, bayous and streams in about 30 parishes. According to the LSU AgCenter, the invasive apple snail has impacted crawfish farms in Vermilion, Acadia and Jefferson Davis parishes and has made its first appearance in rice fields. In March, the invasive mollusks reportedly wiped out a 50-acre field of rice,

marking the first reported case of the snail damaging the crop in Louisiana.

“It is imperative that each of us works diligently to protect Louisiana from these pests.

Pests often find their way into the ecosystem by people releasing aquatic animals and ornamental plants in areas they should not,” said Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. “I urge everyone to be mindful of the damage that can be done when non-native pests and plants are introduced into the environment. Take the giant salvinia, for example. It is an exotic fern from South America that is fast-growing and

has wreaked havoc on lakes and ponds by destroying native plants that provide food for animals and also clogs the waterways.”

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is the lead agency responsible for protecting food and fiber. Multiple agencies including U.S. Customs and Border Protection and the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries and the LSU AgCenter work jointly with the LDAF to keep foreign plant pests and diseases out of fields, forests and waterways.

sional development annually through a state as well as national credentialing process.

If a device is found to be performing outside of its prescribed tolerance range, a device owner has ten days to get it repaired before a red tag is applied. Licensed Service Agencies have the authority to repair these devices, and to place it back into service. Service agencies must notify the LDAF of this action with a Placed in Service Report.

"The seafood industry is huge in Louisiana. When we say 'buy fresh, buy local,' we mean it. You can taste the difference when you buy our local seafood. It is the best in the world. are very important for trade and commerce," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.



It is estimated that every person in Louisiana who is not counted will cost Louisiana approximately \$3,200 or more in lost federal funds.

Due to the covid-19 public health emergency, the United States Bureau of the Census has delayed the start of its follow-up until August 11, 2020.

Again, I urge you to fill out the 2020 federal census when you receive it.

# Orleans youth win One in a Million award

Winning any award is big news. But winning an award for "doing good" is considered one of the ultimate forms of development.

Checking on seniors who are stuck in place due to the pandemic was just the ticket to win the One in a Million award by Orleans Parish 4-H'ers.

Known for the prestigious Jefferson Award, Multiplying Good recently launched the One in a Million campaign to recognize acts of service big and small during these unprecedented times.

LSU AgCenter 4-H agent in Orleans Parish Alisha Okoro found out about the award and decided to nominate the club.

"Our junior leaders have been making weekly phone calls to elderly residents in Orleans Parish during the pandemic as part of a 4-H program called CARES Project — Children Acting Responsibly to Engage Seniors," she said.

"This is a new program within Missouri, Virgin Islands, Jefferson and Orleans parishes 4-H that connects youth with local seniors," she added. "Since we're having to social distance, many of our seniors can no longer receive visits from family and friends."

Okoro and fellow 4-H

agent Derek Landrum realized the separation can be a source of extreme loneliness and depression. They saw an opportunity to help the elderly and help their students learn about the past.

Once the junior leaders make the initial call to introduce themselves, subsequent calls are scripted to engage the seniors about several topics from eating a balanced diet to physical activity.

One of the seniors has provided an education away from school for the 4-H'er who has been assigned to her.

Mary Johnson, one of the seniors participating in the CARES Project, was born in Mississippi and moved to New Orleans as a teen. Johnson likes to talk to the 4-H'er about her more than 20 years of experience as a nurse.

The topic she discussed with one of the junior leaders — eating a balanced diet — has made her more conscious of eating healthier and making better food choices.

"The junior leader, Maya, also enjoys talking to the senior each week," Okoro said. "She has learned a lot from the senior and looks forward to the little piece of advice she receives each

week, such as wearing a mask as recommended, drinking enough water and always doing her best in school."

Through the CARES Project, 4-H junior leaders have directly affected the lives of seniors, along with increasing their communication and leadership skills by

promoting community resilience.

The junior leaders have also made masks for health-care workers in New Orleans as one of their community service projects.

"We are always looking for new projects to keep our students connected and involved," Okoro said.
