(01/10/20) Baton Rouge, La. - Six people who completed environmental stewardship training through the Louisiana Master Farmer Program

were recognized Jan. 9 during the Louisiana Association of Conservation Districts annual meeting in Baton Rouge.

They join more than 200

others who have earned the Master Farmer designation since the program, which is led by the LSU AgCenter, launched in 2001.

Participants must attend classes on environmental stewardship and develop plans for implementing conservation practices on their farms. Sessions are taught by experts from the AgCenter, the Louisiana Farm Bureau, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association and the U.S. Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service.

"Conservation is very important to the sustainability of agriculture throughout the world," said Ronnie Levy, Master Farmer Program coordinator. "The Louisiana Master Farmer Program is

leading the nation in helping farms continue to thrive while preserving soil health, water quality and other facets of the environment for future generations."

The latest graduates of the program are Kirk J. Garber, of Rapides Parish; Daniel Hebert, of St. Martin Parish; Glenn Simon, Lucas Simon and Wesley Simon, all of Acadia Parish; and Sonja Vice, of Bossier Parish.

Four previous graduates who logged continuing education hours to renew their certifications also were honored. They are James "Buff" Fontenot, of St. Landry Parish; Patrick N. Hebert and Christian J. Richard, both of Vermilion Parish; and Mike Strain, of St. Tammany Parish.

Strain is the commissioner of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. Also at the ceremony, Franklin Parish farmer Gregory Kincaid received

the Outstanding Master Farmer Award. A 2012 graduate of the program who was recertified in 2018, Kincaid produces corn, soybeans, hay and cattle on land that has been in his family for more than 100 years.

"This land is the anchor that has kept my family in Louisiana all these years," Kincaid said in a nomination application for the award. "We make a living and stay in business. A lot of families haven't been able to do that, and I feel like I'm carrying the torch. The land is still productive after all these years and hopefully it will continue."

Kincaid has worked with the AgCenter, the NRCS and the Northeast Soil and Water Conservation District to try new strategies to reduce soil compaction and erosion, irrigate more efficiently and improve water quality.

Livestock Theft in Tangipahoa Parish

Baton Rouge, La. (January 27, 2020) – A Mississippi man is accused of stealing six head of cattle from a Tangipahoa Parish livestock sale barn.

Twenty-three year old Colson K. Lambert, 55 Argyle Trail, Bogue Chitto, Ms., was arrested by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission January 24, 2020. Lambert is charged with six counts of theft of livestock.

According to investigators, the LDAF received a complaint


from a public livestock market in Tangipahoa Parish that someone illegally removed cattle from the livestock market and took them out of state. Following an investigation, it was determined Lambert was allegedly in possession of the cattle after leaving the public auction market on January 14, 2020. Investigators were able to link Lambert to the theft through video from security cameras.

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said,

“Our public livestock markets provide a legitimate and professional avenue to sell livestock from local producers. Our brand inspectors move swiftly to respond to complaints in an effort to recover stolen property.”

All six head of cattle were recovered by LDAF brand inspectors and have been returned to the sale barn.

The LDAF Livestock Brand Commission was assisted in this investigation by the Tangipahoa Parish Sheriff’s Office.

Guatemala has the largest economy and the largest population at around 17 million people in Central America. The U.S. is Guatemala's largest trading partner, additionally U.S. products have no import tariffs, and all remaining tariffs will be removed within the next few years. Around 31% of consumer-oriented products imported into the country come from the U.S. Guatemalans have adopted much of the U.S. culture, and local food tastes are changing, and more high-value foods are preferred. Most Guatemalans are familiar with and prefer U.S. products to other imported or domestic products, as they are perceived as safer and of higher quality. As with Guatemala, the U.S. has lower import duties and compared to competitors, and with the country's close proximity to the Southern U.S., Southern exporters have an advantage in this market as well.

## Commissioner Strain Praises U.S., China Trade Deal

Jan. 15, 2020 – “Our President, Donald J. Trump has secured a historic and unparalleled phase one trade agreement with China. As a direct result of his leadership, we have achieved substantial progress towards free trade and a level playing field that benefits American agriculture, manufacturing, energy and services. China has agreed to purchase \$40 to \$50 billion a year of American agricultural products. The benefit to our economy is unprecedented,” Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.

“Further, China’s agreement to structural reforms in areas of intellectual property, technology transfer, agriculture, financial services, currency, and foreign exchange will result in long term stability between the world’s two largest economies. This agreement paves the way for phase two which will set the course for trade and economic prosperity for generations to come.”

## USMCA Passage Victory for La. Ag Producers

Jan. 16, 2020 – Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., hailed the passage of the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) by the U.S. Senate as a major victory for Louisiana farmers and ranchers.

“USMCA modernizes the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) by increasing market access and leveling the playing field for American farmers and ranchers.” Strain added, “Louisiana ag producers will see increased market access for rice, cotton and grain. Nationwide, we will see benefits to many other agricultural products including dairy and poultry.”

In total, \$12.7 billion in agriculture and non-agriculture exports from Louisiana went to Canada and Mexico in 2018. Canada and Mexico are also the top two largest importers of American food and agricultural products totaling more than \$39.7 billion in 2018. These exports support more than 325,000 American jobs.

## CDC study shows physical inactivity high among La. adults; LSU AgCenter program addressing problem

(01/16/20) Baton Rouge, La. — Maps released by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention show that Louisiana is one of seven states with the highest prevalence of physical inactivity among adults.

The findings indicate that more than 15% of adults in every state are inactive. That number jumps to 30% or more in Louisiana.

The LSU AgCenter is working to address physical inactivity in the state through the Healthy Communities initiative. Healthy Communities is a community-led process in which the AgCenter assists community partners make changes that promote health and help make the healthy choice the easy choice for community members.

Denise Holston, an AgCenter nutrition specialist and registered dietitian, is leading the program across the state to address nutrition and physical activity in Louisiana.

“We might, for example, help a community work on making existing park facilities more attractive, help make a downtown more walkable or create physical

activity through painted play spaces,” she said. “We know that every community is different, so the type of work that we do is decided by local community members.”

Small adjustments such as adding crosswalks on streets or better lighting on walking paths help to improve access to physical activity opportunities.

With an obesity rate of 35%, and 16 of 64 parishes with obesity rates over 40%, Louisiana residents disproportionately suffer from high rates of chronic diseases such as diabetes, heart disease and stroke. The Healthy Communities project is working to combat obesity by approaching health holistically.

Holston offered tips to help adults get started with more physical activity:

Make an appointment with your doctor to get medical clearance to participate in physical activity.

Make notes of what types of activities you enjoy. Do you prefer to be physically active in groups? Do you prefer to be physically active throughout the day or in the morning or at night?

Start slowly and set small

goals that are SMART — specific, manageable, attainable, relevant and time-specific.

Prioritize. Schedule activity on your calendar just as you would an appointment for your child or a doctor’s appointment.

Still no time to work out? Try incorporating small bouts of physical activity into your day and reducing sedentary activities such as watching TV.

Do things you enjoy. If you do things you enjoy with people you like, it will seem less like a chore, and you will be more likely to stick with it over time.

The CDC study combined four years of data from the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System.

The South had the highest rates of physical inactivity. Besides Louisiana, states with inactivity rates 30% or higher included Alabama, Arkansas, Kentucky, Mississippi, Oklahoma and Tennessee.

In the release of these findings, the CDC reported that inactivity contributes to one in 10 premature deaths in the U.S. and is associated with \$117 billion in annual health care costs.

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
