

### **Red Stick Farmers Market** adapts to the new normal

Despite a coronavirus vaccine on the horizon, there is still some uncertainty regarding the pandemic as COVID-19 cases rise across the country. However, farmers markets seem to have given shoppers who do not feel comfortable entering a brick and mortar store an outlet to shop with ease. For Red Stick Farmers Market regular Saundra Wilford, she said that made all the difference in the world to her.

"Being outside definitely makes me feel more comfortable than being in a store. I don't mind being outside even in the rain. I find the food tastier and I trust it more," added Wilford.

As Wilford knows, whether it is the freshest fruits and vegetables including microgreens, seafood and meat, goat milk soap or all natural dog treats, there is always something local to find at the farmers market. And as you prepare that holiday

> meal or look for that perfect locally made gift, the farmers market may be one of the places to consider doing your shopping.

> "It slowed down some at the start of the pandemic but we managed to stay steady," said Ponchatoula, La. farmer Eric Morrow, But despite the global pandemic and the many hurricanes that have impacted the state, Morrow is grateful the farmers markets stayed open and for the business he's maintained.

> "It's different. We all wear masks. People don't touch stuff like they used to," added Morrow who said he misses the personal interaction he once had with his customers.

> "We actually picked up some customers early on because they found out we had a drive-through," said Copper Alvarez, executive director for Big River Economic and Agricultural Development Alliance (BREADA). BREADA has since discontinued the drivethrough at the market, but Alvarez

said working with the Louisiana Department of Health to manage safety guidelines such as eliminating food sampling, touching, requiring masks to be worn, having sanitizer available and social distancing was beneficial to keeping the customers coming back.

The downside for us was that on Saturdays when we would normally have 50-60 farmers selling at the market, we would average around 35 because many of our farmers are at what is considered a vulnerable age. So, BREADA lost income from that, "The positive is that we were able to stay open. Once you close down a market, you lose your customers," added Alvarez.

Meanwhile, for some farmers who primarily sold to restaurants and were hit hard when the restaurants shut down during the pandemic, the farmers market allowed them to somewhat stay

"The worst part of it was we were at full production before Covid hit. We needed to expand and were trying to expand and then we got hit and had to start all over again," said gourmet mushroom farmer Cyrus Long of St. Francisville, La.

Long and his wife, Maggie, said before the pandemic, they sold their different varieties of mushrooms to approximately 50 restaurants and grocery stores and to caterers for special events. But according to them, 90-percent of their business was restaurants. They also laid off their five employees when it was clear things would not be back to normal soon.

'We lost a lot of product because we were not selling it," said Cyrus. "We wound up giving a lot of it away."

### Deadline Nearing for Additional Coronavirus Assistance for Ag Producers

Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding Louisiana farmers and ranchers that the deadline to apply for coronavirus assistance is nearing its December 11, 2020 deadline.

"That deadline is about a month away and will be here before you know it. And with the holidays coming up, people get even busier and distracted. If you have not applied, I urge you to contact your local Farm Service Agency (FSA) office as soon as you can," said Strain.

The FSA is reportedly urging all producers, particularly nursery and specialty crop producers who have not applied, to do so as soon as possible.

"It's been a difficult year for all commodities and for ag producers to be aware of all of the programs available to them. Eligibility is different for each program and we think nurseries and specialty crop producers just aren't aware that they could be eligible for assistance under CFAP 2," said FSA State Executive Director Craig McCain.

According to the LSU AgCenter, the total value of the nursery industry in Louisiana was \$171.02 million in 2018. Specialty crops were valued at \$203.35 million in 2018.

In May, through the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP), the USDA announced up to \$16 billion in direct payments to America's farmers and ranchers who suffered losses during the pandemic. In September, the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) expanded the Coronavirus

Food Assistance Program (CFAP 2) and dedicated an additional \$14 billion to agricultural producers.

If eligible, CFAP provides direct relief to producers who faced market disruptions, price declines and additional marketing costs due to COVID-19. The funds are available through the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) Charter Act and CARES ACT to support row crops, livestock, specialty crops, dairy, aquaculture and many additional commodities.

Producers can apply for CFAP 2 through their local Farm Service Agency (FSA) offices. All eligible commodities, payment rates, and calculations can be found on farmers. gov/cfap. Additional information can be found at farmers.gov/coronavirus.



### **SLAP YA MAMA SPICED BROOKIES**

### **Ingredients:**

- 1 tablespoon canola oil
- 1 teaspoon butter (unsalted)
- 2 cups semisweet chocolate chunks
- 2 large eggs, whisked
- 34 cup light brown sugar
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- ½ cup all-purpose flour
- ½ teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon Slap Ya Mama Hot Blend Seasoning
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon

#### **Instructions:**

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Convert a stainless-steel bowl into a double boiler and melt oil, butter, chocolate and Slap Ya Mama Hot Blend Seasoning in bowl. Set aside and let mixture cool. ### APPLE AND BACON WRAPPED PORK LOIN

### **Ingredients:**

- 1-3 4 pound boneless Pork Loin, cleaned and trimmed
- ounces apple juice
- ½ cup wild Louisiana honey
- 3 tablespoons coarse ground mustard (Creole style)
- 6-8 slices thick cut bacon
- 1 large Vidalia onion, diced
- 2 Granny Smith apples, cored, peeled, and cut into 1 inch cubes
- 1 tablespoon garlic, finely chopped
- 3 tablespoon cold water
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 1½ teaspoons salt
- 1½ teaspoon black pepper
- 1 teaspoon thyme
- 1 teaspoon marjoram
- 1 tablespoon red pepper flakes
- ½ cup olive oil

#### **Instructions:**

In a large plastic bag, combine ½ cup of apple juice, honey, mustard, garlic salt, black pepper, red pepper flakes, thyme, and marjoram. Add tenderloin and refrigerate for 6-8 hours or overnight. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a large roasting pan add olive oil, apples, and onions. Create a bed for the loin to rest on in the center of the pan. Remove loin from bag and place on the bed of apples and onions. Pour the remaining liquid on top of the loin. Using the bacon, lay each slice over the loin, wrapping it carefully; with one edge against the other. Cover with aluminum foil. \*Jaclyn created this recipe while serving in the US Navy overseas during the holidays.\*



### PECAN PRALINES

### **Ingredients:**

2 cups whole pecans

tablespoons butter 6

 $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups white sugar

3/4 cup brown sugar

cup evaporated milk 1/2

teaspoon vanilla 1

Candy thermometer

#### **Instructions:**

Preheat the oven to 300 degrees F. Place the pecans on a sheet pan and toast for 10 minutes. Remove the pecans and set aside. Line two cookie sheets with parchment paper. In a large saucepan with a heavy bottom over medium heat, add all of the ingredients (including the pecans) and stir. Continue slowly stirring the ingredients as they heat until they are all combined into one syrupy liquid. Resist the urge to scrape the sides of the pan down, as that will add large crystals to your pralines. Stop stirring, and watch the candy thermometer. Once the liquid reaches somewhere between 235 and 240 degrees F, remove it from the heat. Immediately whisk the mixture for about 45 seconds, then let it rest for 2 minutes. Using an ice cream scoop, quickly scoop out 15 - 20 pralines on the cookie sheets. They will be ready to eat as soon as they cool (roughly 10 minutes).



an effort to adapt to the situation, the Long's started making home deliveries, still served some grocery stores, sold at their pop-up markets, and started selling at as many farmers markets they could.

"It's true that what doesn't kill you makes you stronger," said Maggie. Both agree that the few grocery stores, restaurants and the farmers markets helped get them through scary times during the pandemic.

For small nursery owner Mila Berhane of Greenhand Nursery, her business never slowed down. "We survived because there was more demand because people were gardening," she said.

Berhane and her husband, Andeab, grow those "hard to find plants and herbs that are harder to find in the larger nurseries" such as Ethiopian and Siberian kale. She added that they doubled the amount of vegetables and herbs because of the demand. It also forced her to

improve their marketing and they started taking orders online.

Cutrer's Meat Market and Slaughterhouse out of Kentwood, La. had similar experience during the height of the pandemic. Owner Raymond Cutrer said he is grateful none of his employees got sick during the pandemic. "Early on, we were impacted by a lack of supplies, but custom butchering for personal consumption went through the roof for us," said Cutrer.

He added people started stocking up on meats, they started ordering more online and Cutrer's encouraged contactless payment so money would not have to pass hands.

"Obviously, we'd rather that we did not have to go through Covid and feel for people who have lost loved ones. But we also noticed that people who started shopping at the farmers market more became really aware of where their food comes from."

Much like the Long's, Erin Tassin of Grosse Tete said the pandemic was tough on her business, but she, too, learned to adapt. "I had a child at home from school so for awhile, I could not sell." Tassin makes soap out of the goat milk. She said she milks her goats twice a day to use the freshest milk possible in her products.

"When you go through situations like this, you find strength you didn't know you had," said Tassin. She adapted by building her "Farm Life" website to sell online and support her family. While she is back at the farmers markets now, she reminds everyone it's always a good time to support the local farmer or local business.

"This Christmas is a great time to support local businesses. I, myself, am shopping locally more," said Tassin.

So as you prepare your holiday meals or plan to do your holiday gift buying, please consider your local farmers and businesses. As the folks at the Farmers Market will tell you, "We have almost everything you need!"

### **Dates Set for Unwanted Pesticide Pick-Up Program**

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has scheduled two more dates and locations to collect unwanted pesticides from agricultural producers across the state who need assistance disposing of them properly.

The next date for the Unwanted Pesticide Pick-Up Program will be on December 8, 2020 from 7 a.m. until 1 p.m. at Shutt's Seed Service located at 12548 Highway 1, Hamburg, La. 71339. The second date scheduled is December 10, 2020 at Teche Farm Supply located at 2100 Canal St., Jeanerette, La. 70544.

Eligible items include but are not limited to partially full containers of pesticides and pesticide products that are cancelled or expired.

The program will be conducted at various locations in the state on an annual basis. There is no cost to the farmer, and it is completely anonymous for those who wish to participate

"We are happy to continue providing this service to agricultural producers, pesticide applicators or homeowners who need to get rid of old, unused or partial containers of pesticides," said Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M. "This program allows us to help properly dispose of unwanted pesticides and ensure that human health and the environment in Louisiana are protected."

All pesticides will be accepted. Containers will be supplied for transportation to the collection site if old containers are damaged. Inventory sheets, which can be obtained from your local LSU AgCenter office, are recommended to assist in documenting the pesticides being disposed.

Currently in Louisiana, an individual wishing to dispose of pesticide products must contact a licensed contractor for disposal,

which results in a costly fee based on pounds of product(s) submitted for disposal. The LDAF program will not require a fee for the disposal of unwanted pesticides. The cost of the program will be funded through fees associated with pesticide manufacturers' product registrations in Louisiana. All pesticides offered for sale in Louisiana must be registered annually with the LDAF.

The LDAF has retained a licensed contractor for the program. This contractor will assume all responsibility for pesticide products delivered to the designated locations and for disposal.

The program, which started in 2019, schedules dates and locations after the LDAF and LSU AgCenter determine which location will best serve the public.
