The Certified Program includes Certified Louisiana, Certified Cajun, Certified Creole, Certified Craft Beverage, and Certified Farm to Table. The logo program was established by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry in accordance with RS 3:4721 for the promotion of Louisiana-made, grown, manufactured, or processed products that are aimed

at enhancing and promoting Louisiana's agricultural industry. The logo aids in marketing these products to consumers for farmers, processors, producers, and suppliers alike. With the recognition of the Certified logos, buyers can help support their local homegrown companies.

Why keep it local?

- Every dollar spent on Certified Louisiana products circulates more than five times in your local economy.
- Local businesses generate \$68 of local economic return for ev-

- ery \$100 spent while spending \$100 at a national chain generates only \$43 of local economic return.
- Small businesses, which are almost exclusively locally-owned, employ 54% of Louisiana employees.

### Two men arrested for theft of livestock in St Landry Parish

were arrested on January 19 Brand Commission. During by Livestock Brand Inspectors regarding two separate investigations involving theft of livestock in St. and failed to render proper Landry Parish.

Forty-nine-year-old Ray A. Dunbar, 1744 School Road, Opelousas, La., was arrested in St. Landry Parish on a warrant for theft of livestock in St. Landry Parish following an investigation by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and

the investigation, it was determined that Dunbar received two head of livestock payment to a local livestock market as required by law. The alleged theft occurred on or about Oct. 12, 2021.

Additionally, forty-sixyear-old Carlos J. Allen, 2704 Grand Point Hwy, Breaux Bridge, La. was arrested in St. Martin Parish on a warrant from St. Landry

Baton Rouge - Two men Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Parish following an investigation by the LDAF Livestock Brand Commission. During the investigation, it was determined that Allen received seven head of livestock and failed to render proper payment to a local livestock market as required by law. The alleged theft occurred on or about Sept. 28,

> The acquisition of the livestock and failure to render proper payment is a violation of R.S.14:67.1 (Theft of

Livestock.) LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "The law is specific when dealing with the purchase of livestock. The failure or refusal to pay for livestock acquired is a crime and a violation of the theft of livestock statute."

The Livestock Brand Commission was assisted in this investigation by St. Landry and St. Martin Parish Sheriff's Departments.

At this time, a bond amount has not been set,



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

Whisk together mayonnaise, black pepper, salt, and lemon juice. Place in a refrigerator until time to serve. For tots, fold bacon, cheese, hot sauce, and rice together. Lay 1 inch of rice mixture onto a sheet tray lined with plastic wrap. Cover rice with plastic wrap and place another same size sheet tray with around 2-3 pounds of added weight on top of it. Let press for 2-3 hours in refrigerator or until rice completely cools. Remove rice from refrigerator and uncover. Cut rice into 1 inch by 1 inch cubes and toss in rice flour to coat. Fry in 350 degree F oil until light golden brown. Serve tots with black pepper aioli for dipping. Garnish with sliced scallions.

The Southern University Agricultural Research Center (SUAREC) is able to provide training, technical assistance, and monetary support to Louisiana Produce Growers that are pursuing their first USDA GHP/GAP audit. First priority will be given to growers that have attended a SUAREC GAP Workshop or participate in an upcoming workshop. There are two program options: 1) up to a 75% reimbursement for passing your first USDA GAP Audit, not to exceed \$1000.00 or 2) complete the three tier program with \$1000.00 being the maximum amount awarded to a grower/operation.

#### Tier 1: \$500

In order to qualify for tier one you must attend two one-on-one technical assistance sessions and submit a completed Farm Food Safety Plan. [Must be completed by June 30th]

#### Tier 2: \$250

In order to qualify for tier two you must have completed tier 1 and have a mock audit at your operation conducted by SUAREC.
[Must be completed by June 30th]

#### Tier 3: \$250

In order to qualify for tier three you must have completed tiers 1 & 2 and pass a USDA GAP/GHP audit. [Must be completed by June 30th]

### Roots, Shoots, Fruits & Flowers: **Looking to the Spring**

Roots, Shoots, Fruits & Flowers' reader, Erin, is already looking forward to growing spring vegetables and sent in the question, "How can I stop mildew in cucumbers and squash leaves that stunts their

Dr. Don Ferrin of the LSU AgCenter wrote in a publication, "Downy Mildew of Cucurbits," about treatments. "Disease control relies primarily on the use of fungicides since resistant varieties are available only for cucumbers and some melons (but not watermelons). Fungicides are most effective when they are applied before the onset of disease, and they must be applied repeatedly if environmental conditions are suitable for disease development. Because this pathogen can develop resistance to fungicides quite readily, it is important to follow label instructions regarding their use," said Ferrin.

AHA examined the AgCenter's "Disease Management Guide" for fungicides suitable for mildew con-

dening but should not be mixed with liquid fertilizers. Another caution regarding copper fungicides is to avoid water with a pH less than 6.5 or the copper treatment will be less effective. Finally, copper fungicides can stain masonry and concrete.

Homeowners may be seeing stringy algae growing in their garden ponds this winter. Dr. Greg Lutz, a fisheries and pond specialist with the AgCenter, makes these useful comments, "Filamentous, slimy algae gets started on the pond bottom during the winter months when the water is clear, then grows into big clumps as the water warms up. The unusually cold weather we have been having has caused many ponds to get very clear, and this creates ideal conditions for the filamentous algae as the winter progresses.

The best approach in terms of cost, labor, and effectiveness is to use copper sulfate crystals to limit the growth of the filamentous algae. This product is available at most big feed and seed stores or farm co-ops. Tell your clientele to observe a limit of no more than 5 pounds of crystals per acre, per treatment. The crystals should be sprinkled or broadcast directly onto the clumps of filamentous algae - a little goes a long way. When roughly 5 pounds per acre (that would be 2.5 pounds in a half-acre pond, 10 pounds in a 2-acre pond, etc.) have been applied - even if only 1/4 or 1/3 of the algae in the pond has been treated, no more copper sulfate should be applied. After 8 days another treatment with the same number of crystals can be applied. There is usually little or no fish mortality when people stick to this strategy, but clientele should be made aware that there is always some risk of killing fish when treating aquatic vegetation. Are there more efficient ways of dealing with filamentous algae? In some cases, there probably are, but I have found over the years that it's better to have folks knock this stuff back gradually rather than hit it hard and become upset when they kill some fish."

The AgCenter has a downloadable publication entitled, Management of Recreational and Farm Ponds in Louisiana, and this publication is a handy reference for any landowner with a pond.
