

## St. Martin Parish veterinarian has deep roots in Cajun community

Regardless of age, most small town Louisiana veterinarians probably think of themselves simply as "old country doctors."

The wise, white-haired veterinarian who was around when they invented veterinary medicine, the Doc who knows exactly what's wrong with Bossy or Flicka or Queenie or Arnold is an enduring image.

St. Martin Parish veterinarian Louis Huval, originally of Cecilia, and practicing in Breaux Bridge since 1964, really is an old country doctor.

At 70 and counting, there's not much that Doc Huval hasn't seen or done in veterinary medicine.

He's like any other small town animal doctor. He treats small and large animals, loves his horses and cattle and is well-liked in the community.

Still, he's had a different outlook on life ever since he came out of rural Cecilia and went to Texas A.M. vet school.

Perhaps it was his early adherence to a physical fitness regimen before it became cool to pump iron.

"I brought the first set of weights into St. Martin Parish," Huval says. "That was in 1955."

He worked out in Alvin Roy's gym in Baton Rouge. Roy trained LSU greats Billy Cannon and Johnny Robinson.

The barrel-chested veterinarian still works out at the local health club in Breaux Bridge. He has his own key to the gym and hits the weights daily at 4:00 a.m.

He doesn't want to brag but he holds the gym record for pushups. How many is that, Doc?

"I stopped at 150," he said.

Huval also keeps his veterinary skills sharp and attends all the continuing education courses he can

find, but to keep his intellect on the cutting edge, he and the other senior medical professionals in Breaux Bridge banded together to form a book club. The group gets together once a week to discuss their readings, which is strictly non-fiction.

"We're reading *JFK vs. LBJ vs. Nixon* right now," Huval said. "It's mostly history but one of the doctors will cheat and read a novel every now and then."

A French speaker, Doc Huval calls everyone "sugar" or "cher." His Cajun French origins set him apart from most veterinarians and he imparted those French values into his 14 children.

14 children? Yes, Doc Louis Huval and wife, Irma Gene, raised 14 children at their Mills Avenue home and veterinary hospital.

There's Michelle, Kevin, Chad, Ben, Stacey, Brazos, Luke, Zach, Jebb, Alicia Merle, Karla, Stephanie, Callen and Jody. The oldest is in her late 40s; the youngest 21. They all have college degrees, (several have advanced professional degrees) and Doc is understandably proud of his children.

He has enough children to have a basketball and baseball team but more importantly, a Cajun music band.


At last spring's Breaux Bridge Crawfish Festival, there weren't many bands on the bandstand without a Huval family member included in the group.

And they even have their own band, the Huval Family Band. "They all play three or four musical instruments," Huval said. "At the next Festival de Musique Acadienne the kids will play. It's going to be good."

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Strain: EEE confirmed in two parishes

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said two additional cases of Eastern equine encephalitis (EEE) were confirmed in Iberville Parish and is urging horse owners to vaccinate their horses.

The first state EEE case, in Rapides Parish, was reported in mid-June and resulted in the horse's death.

Strain said the Louisiana Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory in Baton Rouge identified EEE, also known as sleeping sickness, as the

cause of death.

"There is no cure for Eastern equine encephalitis, but this is a very preventable disease. Unfortunately, many times horse owners wait until it's too late," Strain said. "All horse owners should keep their equine vaccinations up to date and consult a veterinarian if their horses are displaying any symptoms."

Symptoms include depression, lack of coordination and walking in circles. An infected horse eventually collapses to the ground.

Equine owners with horses displaying any of these symptoms should contact their local veterinarian. Any suspected equine neuro-encephalitis cases should be reported upon suspicion of disease symptoms even if blood is not drawn.

State Veterinarian Henry Moreau said Eastern equine encephalitis has a mortality rate of 90 percent. The disease causes encephalitis, or swelling of the brain, in both horses and humans. Humans and horses contract the

disease from a mosquito that has bitten an infected bird.

Horses that have not been vaccinated should have two vaccine doses administered about two weeks apart. Once the initial vaccination has been given, an annual booster is sufficient to maintain immunity.

The Department of Agriculture and Forestry is working with local veterinarians, horse owner groups, health officials and local mosquito abatement programs to monitor the spread of the disease.

# Louisiana Farm and Agribusiness grant and loan program information

Louisiana Farm and Agribusiness Recovery Grant and Loan Program funds are available to eligible Louisiana farmers and agribusinesses who suffered damages from hurricanes Gustav and Ike.

The application period for the program is July 13 through August 21. Completed applications must be post-marked or hand delivered and date stamped to an LDAF district office no later than 5 p.m., August 21.

The Farm Recovery Program is designed to help farmers and ranchers affected by the 2008 hurricanes with their 2009 production costs through a 20 percent grant and 80 percent low-interest loan process.

The Agribusiness Recovery Program provides low-interest loans for

agribusinesses like aerial applicators, cotton gins and elevators.

The funds will be administered through the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's Louisiana Agricultural Finance Authority office (LAFA).

More than 76 percent of the cotton, 73 percent of the sweet potato crop and 10 percent of sugarcane were lost due to the storms, Strain said. Other commodities suffered significant losses as well.

The two programs are funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through community development block grants (CDBG).

The funds are divided between eight disaster relief regions based on the

agricultural losses from the 2008 hurricanes.



## LDAF accepting pre-orders for seedlings

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry is taking pre-orders for its superior tree seedlings grown at the state nurseries in DeRidder, Columbia and Monroe.

The tree seedlings will be sold through next spring's seedling harvesting process, also called lifting, on a first-come, first-served basis while supplies last.

A variety of pine and hardwood species are available, including loblolly, slash, and longleaf pines, and baldcypress, twelve species of oak, and more than a dozen other species of hardwoods.

For the first time ever, the state nurseries will have containerized longleaf pine for \$200 per thousand. Advanced generation loblolly seedlings are also available at \$42 per thousand bare-root seedlings.

Specialty packets include an arboretum packet with 50 assorted and labeled seedlings. This packet includes 16 to 25 different species of trees and shrubs and costs \$30 per packet. Another packet is the wildlife packet for \$20. It is comprised of 25 assorted and labeled seedlings with a minimum of five species for wildlife habitat improvement. The species in the wildlife packet are crabapple, sweet pecan, white oak, sawtooth oak and water oak.

The state nurseries offer 37 species of hardwoods and nine of pine. Inventory for the 2009-2010 plant-

ing season is expected to number about three million hardwoods and 24 million pines. LDAF began accepting applications on July 1, 2009.

Seedlings will be available for pickup on December 15 through March 1.

## Italian-Style Zucchini Bake

½ lb. lean ground beef	4 eggs, beaten
1 cup chopped onions	¾ cup milk
1 clove garlic, crushed	1 can (15 ounce.) tomato sauce
1 lb. zucchini, sliced	½ teaspoon each basil, oregano,
3 cup cooked rice	and seasoned pepper
1 cup grated Monterey Jack cheese (4 ounce)	Salt, pepper, and Garlic salt to taste

Cook beef, onions, add garlic until meat loses its red color. Add zucchini, cover, and cook 3 or 4 minutes. Remove from heat. Stir in rice and Monterey Jack cheese; mix well. Combine eggs, milk, salt, and pepper. Stir into rice mixture. Turn into a greased shallow 2 quart casserole. Bake at 350F for 30 minutes or until set. Meanwhile, blend tomato sauce and seasonings. Simmer about 5 minutes. Cut zucchini mixture into squares and serve with tomato sauce. Sprinkle with parmesan cheese, if desired. Serves six.

## Hot Kale

2 bunches red kale	¼ cup pecan oil
1 shallot pod, chopped fine	1 teaspoon red pepper flakes
2 garlic toes, minced	Salt and pepper to taste

Wash kale thoroughly, remove the toughest stems and tear into bite size pieces. Heat oil in pan on medium heat, add shallots and cook soften. Add garlic, but do not let brown. Push garlic and onion to the sides of the pan and add kale. Wilt kale and add red pepper, salt and black pepper. Serve warm, when kale has reduced.

Slice squash and cook in salted water until tender. Drain well, and mash with a fork. Sauté onions, bell pepper, and chestnuts in butter; combine with squash. Fold in cheese, mayonnaise, sugar and beaten egg. Season to taste. Pour into greased casserole dish; top with breadcrumbs and dust with paprika. Bake at 350 degrees about 30 minutes or until browned.

# EIA meeting a success

State veterinarians from Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas and Louisiana met at Louisiana Tech University in Ruston to examine current equine infectious anemia (EIA) testing procedures and methods to improve them.

The meeting took place on June 22-23, 2009 at Reese Hall on the La. Tech campus.

The veterinarians also discussed ways to target the untested equine population and re-define terminologies used in key animal health documents.

Louisiana State Veterinarian Henry Moreau hosted the meeting.

Chuck Issel, D.V.M., from the Gluck Equine Research Center, Lexington, Ky., and Tim Cordes, D.V.M., Senior USDA Staff Veterinarian for equine programs and national coordinator for equine diseases, listened as the gathered veterinarians related problems associated with equine testing within the four state area.

Issel and Cordes also suggested adopting a new program of three-tiered testing methods and a meeting schedule so regional veterinarians could stay up-to-date with the latest EIA regulations,

research and programs.

Oklahoma State Veterinarian Becky Brewer said she has been testing the three-tiered program for more than a year and believes that it has been successful. Brewer emphasized that the quick turn around for horse owners during testing and fewer false positives for the tested equine were meeting with favor from horse owners in her state.

Pat Badley, Arkansas State Veterinarian, and Dee Ellis, Texas Assistant State Veterinarian, both said that current language concerning the equine infectious anemia Uniform Methods and Rules should be moved into the Code of Federal Regulations.

Making this change will ensure that testing for EIA, and the subsequent state enforcement, is codified properly Badley and Ellis said.

Plans for future meetings were set, and future topics of discussion will include procedures to establish random checkpoints that will monitor livestock crossing state borders.

The group was also treated to a supper sponsored by the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association.

## Aquaculture grant program underway

Louisiana aquaculture producers with recorded losses associated with high feed inputs during the 2008 calendar year may qualify for financial aid under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry expects to receive \$2.4 million of this allocation and is currently developing procedures to get these funds in the hands of producers.

The application and guidelines are available the LDAF Web site at [www.ldaf.state.la.us](http://www.ldaf.state.la.us). Click on the link entitled 2008 Aquaculture Grant Program.

Federal guidelines for the program require that feed costs for eligible aquaculture species must be 25 percent or more of the total production costs. Eligible species in Louisiana include catfish, turtles, baitfish, tilapia and crawfish.

Producers will be required to

demonstrate that their feed costs are at least 25 percent of the 5-year average.

Producers will need to provide their W-9, 2008 feed tonnage report, certification letter from the feed mill certifying tons purchased in 2008 and the average feed price paid by the aquaculture producer in the 2008 calendar year.

Producers that are not individuals will be required to establish a Dun and Bradstreet universal numbering system (DUNS) or update an existing DUNS number at [www.dnb.com](http://www.dnb.com).

Producers that are not individuals are also required to register with the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) database or update an existing registration with CCR at [www.ccr.gov](http://www.ccr.gov).

# LDAF and LSU AgCenter hit the road to promote agritourism this summer

*Corn mazes, U-pick farms, dude ranches, Christmas tree farms...how do you keep folks safe on the farm? Agritourism roadshows have the answers...*



Agri-tourism businesses, like corn mazes and dairy farm tours, can be profitable for many Louisiana farmers and a way to keep the family farm in the family.

But there are liability risks. How do you keep the many visitors a corn maze attracts safe? How do you keep a class of fourth graders touring a dairy farm from slipping on the floor? More importantly, how does the farmer/entertainment entrepreneur protect himself?

"Agritourism venues like farms, ranches, wineries or vineyards offer a recreational or educational experience based on the agricultural way of life to the general public," Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said. "More and more folks want to visit farms to see where their food comes from and share it with their children, but insurance companies are understandably leery at providing liability coverage to bring large numbers of the general public to working farms."

During the 2008 legislature session, Strain worked with a cross section of agricultural producers, LSU AgCenter experts, restaurateurs and insurance executives to create an agri-tourism task force to address the issue.

The legislation, authored by Representative Andy Anders and Senators Francis Thompson and Mike Walsworth provides that the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry will develop a set of rules and regulations and that the LSU AgCenter will define a "plan of operation" for agritourism ventures and review those plans.

The task force developed a set of guidelines to help the agri-

tourism venue operator identify areas to protect themselves and their customers from injury and problems.

In order to publicize the newly-created guidelines, the LSU AgCenter and the LDAF is presenting an agritourism 'roadshow' this summer to inform the farming public of how best to proceed with their plans to turn their farms into agritainment destinations.

Dora Ann Hatch, LSU AgCenter community rural development agent, and Carrie Castille, special advisor to Commissioner Strain, will conduct the tour and explain how to complete the required plan of operation to be eligible for LDAF certification.

The roadshow is suggested for individuals meeting the following criteria:

- Farmers looking to diversify their business to add supplemental income.
- Farmers seeking new agricultural alternatives to keep present farm workers employed during the off season.
- Educators interested in sharing their knowledge of farm experiences.
- Individuals adding value to products for sale.

A plan of operation is a document that assists with such steps in developing an agritourism venture as assessing your personality, identifying goals, doing a market analysis, evaluating resources, estimating labor needs, identifying safety issues and exploring insurance options.

The LSU AgCenter will forward approved plans to LDAF and LDAF will contact the agritourism professional for a site visit before certifying, Hatch said.

After certification, it is the responsibility of the agritourism professional to continually update his plan as stated in the guidelines.

Strain said agritourism opens another avenue for agriculture and gives any size farm something advantageous to offer citizens of Louisiana. "It's an opportunity for an agricultural producer to get more return for the farmer's investment," he said.
