



LDWF and United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) recently released back into the wild two birds rescued from oil impacted marshes along the Louisiana coast. One least bittern and a single cattle egret, treated at the Fort Jackson rehabilitation facility in Buras, were released at Sherburne Wildlife Management Area (WMA) on the northern edge of the Atchafalaya Basin.

As of June 8, 579 birds had been processed through the wildlife rehabilitation triage center set up at Fort Jackson in Buras. 225 birds were dead before their arrival at the center. Thirty-six birds have been treated and released. Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry shipped 3,000 animal crates in May to the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF) in response to the Deepwater Horizon oil spill.

The crates were delivered to the Fort Jackson rehabilitation center in Buras for use by the LDWF to house shorebirds, migratory birds and various marsh mammals impacted by the oil spill.

LDWF biologists, along with biologists from federal and contracted recovery specialists, are making daily trips into oil impacted marshland areas to recover

er distressed wildlife.

"The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry stands ready to assist in the oil spill response in any way," Strain said.

The crates, used for pet evacuation during hurricanes Gustav and Ike, were shipped from an animal evacuation facility at Dixon Correctional Institute near Zachary and the Central Louisiana State Hospital in Pineville.

The LDAF continues to monitor the oil spill's movement and its possible effect on Louisiana's agricultural industry.


"Our emergency management team is planning for all contingencies," Strain said.

Senior FMNP coupons mailed first week of June

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said more than \$300,000 worth of Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP) coupon booklets were mailed to qualifying senior citizens the first week of June.

Strain said the coupons give senior citizens an opportunity to buy fresh, locally grown produce and support state agriculture at the same time.

"The Farmers Market Nutrition

Program is a very important program for our senior citizens and state farmers," Strain said. "Seniors citizens who qualified for the program will receive \$24 worth of food coupons to be spent on fresh produce grown by local farmers.

"I set a goal to get the food vouchers in the hands of our senior citizens by the first week of June. June is prime harvest time for a large variety of Louisiana produce and the selection for tomatoes,

blueberries, peppers, squash, beans and melons will be at its peak. June will be one of the best months to redeem the coupons."

Strain said the coupons are set in a booklet of six \$4 coupons and may only be redeemed at approved farmers markets and roadside stands to buy fresh fruits, vegetables, cut herbs and honey approved by the FMNP. The coupons can also be used during the fall harvest season but must be redeemed by

Nov. 30, 2010.

A person must be at least 60 years old and earn less than 185 percent of the poverty level to have qualified for the program. Strain said for a one-person household, the annual income level should be \$20,036 or less. The annual household income in a two-person household should be \$26,955 or less.

Beat the Heat with a Cool Dairy treat

Peach Frozen Yogurt

1 envelope unflavored gelatin 1 ½ cups vanilla low-fat yogurt
1 cup skim milk 2 tsp. vanilla
½ cup sugar 3 cups frozen sliced peaches, pureed
Dash of salt

Sprinkle gelatin over milk in saucepan. Let stand 1 minute. Cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until gelatin dissolves. Remove from heat and add sugar salt, stirring until sugar dissolves. Stir in yogurt, vanilla and peaches. Cover and chill. Pour yogurt mixture into freezer can of a 4 qt. ice cream freezer. Freeze according to manufacturer's instructions. Scoop yogurt into individual dishes. Serve immediately. Makes 7 ½ cups.

Strawberry Frozen Yogurt Squares

1 cup crunchy wheat and barley cereal 1 cup fat-free sweetened condensed milk
3 cups fat-free strawberry yogurt 1 cup light or fat-free whipped topping (optional)
1 (10-ounce) bag frozen unsweetened strawberries (about 2 1/2 cups)

Line an 8x8-inch baking pan with foil. Sprinkle cereal evenly on the bottom of the pan; set aside. Place yogurt, strawberries and condensed milk in a blender; cover and blend until smooth. Pour the mixture over top of cereal, gently smoothing yogurt mixture to edges of pan. Cover with foil (or plastic wrap) and freeze for 8 hours or until firm. Use edges of foil to loosen and remove from pan; let recipe thaw for 5 to 10 minutes. Cut into squares, top with whipped topping, if desired, and serve.

Orange Dreamsicle Milkshake

1 1/2 cups ice 1 vanilla bean, scraped
1/2 cup orange juice 2 tsp. vanilla extract
1/2 cup milk

Blend all the ingredients until smooth. Serve in a chilled glass and enjoy.

Tropical Milkshake

1 ripe banana, sliced 1½ cups vanilla ice cream
1 (8 oz.) can crushed pineapple, chilled 1 cup skim milk
1/3 cup frozen orange juice concentrate Shredded coconut, toasted

In blender combine banana, undrained pineapple and orange juice concentrate. Cover and blend until almost smooth. Add ice cream and milk. Cover and blend until smooth. Pour into glasses. Top each serving with toasted coconut. Serve immediately. Serves 4.

Blueberry Malt Milkshake

1 pint vanilla ice cream 1/4 cup malted milk
1/2 cup milk To finish: whipped cream
1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries Blueberries

Place the ice cream, milk, blueberries, and malted milk in a blender. Pulse on low speed until just combined. Divide between 2 glasses. Top with whipped cream and garnish with fresh blueberries.

Strawberry Banana Milkshake

1 (90-oz.) package frozen sweetened sliced strawberries, slightly thawed 1 tsp. lemon juice
1 ripe banana, cut up 1/4 cup nonfat dry milk powder
1 1/2 cups milk

Combine all ingredients in an electric blender. Cover and whirl until smooth and thick. Serve immediately in tall glasses. Makes three 10-oz servings

Proactive cattle producers can prevent bovine trichomoniasis in herds

The organism *Trichomoniasis foetus* is the causative agent of the venereal disease trichomoniasis of cattle. *Trichomoniasis foetus* is a single celled protozoan which must reside in a cow or bull to survive and is transmitted only by breeding. Trichomoniasis should not be confused with trichinellosis, a disease of swine which is caused by a nematode parasite which can potentially be zoonotic or passed between animals and people. Bovine trichomoniasis is not a zoonotic disease.

Trichomoniasis can cause significant economic losses to the producer, to include open cows, repeat breeding, and subsequent longer calving intervals. The producer may also experience smaller calf crops, less uniform crops,

increased culling rates, and increased veterinary expenses.

Bulls infected with trichomoniasis show no symptoms. The organism is found on the penis and inside the sheath and localizes in the smegma (secretions of the penile sheath) and at the end of the urethra. The penis and sheath have crypts or microscopic folds in the tissue that allows the organism to lie protected within the epithelial lining. As the bull ages, these crypts become deeper which allows older bulls to be more susceptible to infection. Bulls infected with *Trichomoniasis foetus* stay infected for life, which is the reason positive bulls are culled and sent to slaughter.

In cows, the organism colonizes in the reproductive tract including the vagina, the uterus, and oviducts. The organism causes an inflammatory process in the uterus which

causes the pregnancy to terminate. However, less than 5% of these cases will show any discharge or obvious abortion. Most commonly, the cow is infected for 50 to 60 days then will clear to breed again if the bull is still available. Occasionally, the cow will abort before day 18 and will clear to cycle on the next cycle, although this is not common. It is also possible but not common that the cow will not abort until 7 to 8 months into gestation. While cows will develop immunity, it is short lived and they can be infected again in subsequent years.

Indications that you may have trichomoniasis in your herd are:

- ◆ An extended calving season
- ◆ Poor pregnancy rates
- ◆ Abortion (not often detected)
- ◆ Pyometra or dead fetuses on ultrasound
- ◆ Cows returning to estrus during breeding season

Transmission of trichomoniasis occurs during natural breeding. Up to 90% of cows bred by an infected bull will become infected. Your herd may become infected through the introduction of an infected female or when non-virgin bulls are purchased, borrowed, leased, co-mingled on common grazing tracts or mixed through downed fences.

Herd diagnosis is usually made by testing bulls---observing the organism in samples taken from the prepuce by an accredited veterinarian. There is no simple blood test or screening for the diagnosis of trichomoniasis.

Treatment-THERE IS NO APPROVED OR EFFECTIVE TREATMENT FOR BOVINE TRICHOMONIASIS IN COWS OR BULLS. Prevention and containment are the only effective methods for management of trichomoniasis:

- ◆ Females-buy only virgin heifers or bred cows and heifers from reliable reputable sources
- ◆ Males-buy or lease only virgin bulls or bulls that test negative
- ◆ Use AI and synchronization programs
- ◆ Maintain good fences
- ◆ Avoid communal grazing
- ◆ Consider vaccination if at high risk

If a herd is infected:

- ◆ Test all herd bulls
- ◆ Cull all open and late calving cows
- ◆ Vaccinate-will not prevent transmission and infection but will limit duration of infection resulting in more term pregnancies.

New rules and regulations are being implemented by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry-Office of Animal Health and Food Safety to help control and prevent the spread of this disease.
