## Horse economics

There may be no better time to buy a horse from Red Benoit Stable than now.

"Horse people kept breeding horses," Benoit said. "We've outbred ourselves."

With an oversupply of horses on the market and tough economic conditions, Benoit said one of his well-trained animals that would normally go for \$5,000 will sell for considerably less.

Benoit doesn't necessarily blame the times. No, he is looking squarely at the nature of the horse industry to find the problems and the solutions.

"The people involved in the horse business, including me, were prospering and breeding more and more horses," Benoit said. "But we weren't getting more customers."

The simple rule of economics, supply and demand, is occurring, Benoit said.

"The business is regulating itself and it's done it before," he said. "Over the last few years we've overbred with too many mediocre horses. Now, the American Quarter Horse Association reported there were 200 fewer mares bred last year."

And Benoit says the quality of horses is better now because of the market shake-out.

Benoit said oversupply is the biggest culprit but allowed that other pressures on the horse market is

stalling the business. The same issues – urban sprawl, land price pressure, rising input costs, environmental concerns- that affects the overall agricultural sector affects the Louisiana horse industry.

Benoit's farm, on Old Military Road just north of Covington, was in the heart of St. Tammany Parish's cattle and horse farming area.

He pointed down the narrow two-lane road. "This used to be all farms," Benoit said. "Now it's suburbia. It's changed. Old Military Road was cattle country and for a while, we were big in horse breeding."

Despite the demographic shift, Benoit adapted his operation.

He used to breed horses for the area ranchers. Now he's breeding horses for the urbanites who moved to Covington.

"Encroaching suburbia has helped me in a way," Benoit said. "It's good and bad. We give a lot more riding lessons."

John Westra, an LSU AgCenter associate professor specializing in environmental and production economics, said Louisiana's equine industry is still very strong. Valued at \$579 million, the equine business is the fourth largest agricultural industry in the state. *See horse economics, continued on page 20*

## Statewide outdoor burn ban lifted

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the statewide ban on outdoor burning has been lifted but cautioned residents in forested areas to continue reducing the fire risk around their homes.

"The state had some rain but these damp conditions could change very quickly," Strain said. "And in reality, our wildfire season is typically from Dec. 1 through April 15."

Strain recommended several steps homeowners can take to reduce the

risk of wildfire damage to their property.

-Keep wild vegetation near homes trimmed and at least 30 feet away from the house and other structures by using weedeaters, lawnmowers, chainsaws and other mechanized equipment.

-Make sure that all machinery is equipped with proper spark arrestors.

-Refuel your equipment in areas void of vegetation.

-Practice extra caution when fire

danger is high.

-Remove all leaves or pine needles that are within 30 feet of a structure.

-Thin tree stands and brush to eliminate continuous vegetation that can promote wildfire spread.

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) fire protection statistics show that 525 wildfires burned more than 6,704 acres of wildland during the month of October. In Oct. 2009, only eight wildfires were detected and suppressed by LDAF firefighting

crews.

Strain said the LDAF is responsible for wildfire detection and suppression of 18.9 million acres of wildland, including valuable commercial timber resources, yet receives wildfire detection and suppression funding from landowners for only 53 percent of the protected area.

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

# Enjoy great sweet potato dishes from the Louisiana Sweet Potato Commission

### *Ham & Sweet Potato Pot Pie with Pecan Crust*

1 cup chopped onion	1 cup skim milk
2 cups cubed sweet potatoes	2 cups cubed cooked ham
2 cups canned chicken broth, divided	1 9-inch refrigerated pie crust
1/2 cup all purpose flour	1/2 cup finely chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large pot coated with nonstick cooking spray, sauté the onion over a medium high heat for 5 minutes. Add fresh\* sweet potatoes and 2/3 cup chicken broth. Bring mixture to a boil and simmer over medium heat for 10 to 15 minutes or until sweet potatoes are tender. (If using canned yams, add them and 2/3 cup chicken broth to sautéed onions; heat thoroughly.) Add flour, stirring and gradually add milk stirring until well combines. Add ham, bring to a boil and then transfer mixture to a 9x9-inch baking dish coated with nonstick cooking spray. If mixture is too thick, add more broth or milk. Unfold crust and sprinkle pecans on one side, fold, and roll with rolling pin pressing pecans into crust. Spread pecan crust on top of mixture and bake for 30 minutes or until crust is brown.

### *Sweet Potato & Black Bean Burritos*

2 cups thinly sliced red onion	1 (15 ounce) can black beans, drained
2 tsp. sugar	8 (6 inch) flour tortillas
3 cups fresh sweet potatoes (yams) baked and cut into chunks	3 tbsp. light margarine, melted
1/2 tsp. ground cumin	

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Coat large skillet with nonstick cooking spray and heat over medium high heat. Add onion and sugar; sauté 5 minutes or until tender, stirring. Reduce heat to medium and continue cooking for 10 to 15 minutes or until onion is caramelized or deep golden brown. Remove from heat and stir in sweet potatoes, cumin and black beans, mixing gently. Spoon mixture evenly down center of each tortilla. Roll up tortillas jelly roll style and place rolls seam side down in an oblong casserole dish coated with nonstick cooking spray. Drizzle melted margarine over burritos. Cover and bake 10 to 15 minutes or until well heated and crispy on outside.

### *Sweet Potato Bisque*

1 tbsps. butter	2 cups chicken or vegetable broth
1 onion, chopped	1 tsp. dried thyme leaves
3 cups (1/2 inch) chunks fresh sweet potatoes, peeled or 3 (15 oz.) cans sweet potatoes drained	1/8 tsp. cayenne
	1 cup skim milk
	Salt and paper to taste

In large pot, melt butter and sauté onions until tender, about 4 minutes. Add sweet potatoes and chicken broth and bring to boil. Reduce heat and simmer, covered, 15 minutes or until potatoes are tender. Pour mixture into food processor and blend until smooth; return to pot. Add thyme, cayenne and milk and cook over low heat just until heated through. Season to taste.

### *Sweet Potato Casserole with Praline Topping*

3 cups fresh sweet potatoes, cooked and mashed or 2 (15 oz.) cans sweet potatoes, drained and mashed	1/2 cup raisins (optional)
1/4 cup sugar	1 tsp. vanilla
2 tbsp. light margarine	<i>Topping:</i>
1/2 cup egg substitute	1/2 cup brown sugar
	2 tbsp. flour
	2 tbsp. light margarine, melted
	1/4 cup chopped pecans

Whip potatoes while hot. Add remaining ingredients; mix well. Pour into greased casserole dish. Top with topping; bake at 350 degrees for 20-25 minutes.

### *Sweet Potato Bars*

1/2 cup butter	1/2 tsp. salt
1 1/2 cups brown sugar, packed	1/2 tsp. ground allspice
2 eggs	1 lb. sweet potatoes, peeled and shredded (about 2 cups)
1 cup all-purpose flour	2 cups uncooked old-fashioned rolled oats
1 cup whole-wheat flour	2 cups coarsely chopped pecans
2 tsp. baking powder	
2 tsp. ground cinnamon	
1/2 tsp. baking soda	

In large mixer bowl, cream butter and sugar until smooth. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Sift together all-purpose flour, whole-wheat flour, baking powder, cinnamon, baking soda, salt and allspice. With a wooden spoon, stir in dry ingredients, sweet potatoes, oats and nuts. Spread dough in a 9x13x2-inch greased baking pan. Bake at 350 degree for 25 to 30 minutes until lightly browned. Cool completely on wire rack. Cut into 1 1/2 inch bars.

### *Sweet Potato Bundt Cake*

1/2 cup sugar	1 1/2 tsp. ground cinnamon
1/2 cup 1/3 less fat margarine	1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg
3 large egg whites	1 tsp. baking powder
1 large egg	1 tsp. baking soda
2 (15-oz.) cans sweet potatoes, drained and mashed	1 1/2 tsp. vanilla
2 cups all-purpose flour	2 tbsp. flaked coconut

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In large bowl, beat together sugar and margarine until blended. Add egg whites and egg, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Mix in sweet potatoes. In another bowl, mix together flour, cinnamon, nutmeg, baking powder and baking soda. Gradually add flour mixture to first mixture, beating well after each addition. Add vanilla. Pour half of batter into a 10-bundt pan coated with nonstick cooking spray and dusted with flour. Sprinkle coconut over batter. Cover with remaining batter. Bake for 50 minutes to 1 hour or until a wooden toothpick inserted in center of cake comes out clean. Cool in pan on wire rack for 10 minutes; invert to serving platter.

## FSA county committee election deadline is Dec. 6

Farm Service Agency (FSA) officials are urging eligible voters to cast their votes in the 2010 FSA county committee elections before the Dec. 6 deadline. Voters should return their ballots to their local FSA office.

County committee members provide input and make important decisions on local administration of new disaster and conservation programs under the 2008 Farm Bill. They are also an important link between the agricultural community and the Department of Agriculture (USDA).

Farmers and ranchers elected to county committees help deliver FSA programs at the local level, applying their knowledge and judgment to make decisions on commodity price support loans and payments; conservation programs; incentive indemnity and disaster payments for some commodities; emergency programs and payment eligibility. FSA committees operate within official regulations designed to carry out federal laws.

To be an eligible voter, farmers and ranchers must participate or cooperate in an FSA program. A

person who is not of legal voting age, but supervises and conducts the farming operations of an entire farm also may be eligible to vote. Agricultural producers in each county submitted candidate nominations during the nomination period, which ended on Aug. 2.

Eligible voters who have not received their ballots can obtain ballots from their local USDA Service Center. Dec. 6, 2010, is the last day for voters to submit ballots in person to local USDA Service Centers. Ballots returned by mail must also be postmarked no later than Dec. 6.

Newly elected committee members and their alternates will take office Jan. 1, 2011.

Nearly 7,900 FSA county committee members serve in the 2,244 FSA offices nationwide. Each committee consists of three to 11 members who serve three-year terms. Approximately one-third of county committee seats are up for election each year. ## Strain helps create national food animal veterinary institute

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said Louisiana will partner with national animal health science leaders to create and develop a plan to train more large animal veterinarians.

The LDAF has teamed with the United State Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA) to create a food animal pilot training program to provide advanced training to animal health professionals.

Missouri Governor Jay Nixon announced the \$500,000 USDA Rural Development Program grant funding for the program Oct. 29 at Missouri Western State University

in St. Joseph, Missouri.

"Rural America is facing a critical shortage in food animal veterinary care," Strain said. "There are many areas in Louisiana and the country that are underserved when it comes to food animal veterinarians. This program will begin the process of addressing America's food animal veterinarian needs."

The program will provide additional training and specialization for animal health professionals who already have gone through primary training programs, including veterinary school or veterinary technician programs.

It is hoped that the pilot program will lead to the establishment of a national food animal veterinary

institute.

Strain said an additional 1,500 large animal veterinarians are needed to address the shortage.

"Large animal veterinarians are vital to a reliable food supply, disease control and animal health," Strain said.

Strain and Missouri Director of Agriculture Jon Hagler developed the concept for a national food animal veterinary institute at the February meeting of the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture.

Strain said Deputy Assistant Commissioner Carrie Castille coordinated the project between the Louisiana and Missouri agriculture departments.



# ConAgra Foods celebrates Lamb Weston grand opening

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., Governor Bobby Jindal, ConAgra CEO Gary Rodkin and other dignitaries helped open the new ConAgra Foods Lamb Weston sweet potato plant in Delhi on Nov. 5. The \$156 million plant is expected to employ 275 and was enticed to Louisiana by up to \$37.4 million in state incentives. Strain said that sweet potato crop insurance will be available for the next planting season and expected to see sweet potato acreage in Louisiana increase. In 2009, 85 farmers planted more than 13,000 acres in sweet potatoes and produced 3.9 million bushels. The gross farm value of the crop was \$85 million.

An estimated 49,000 state residents own horses.

Westra helped compile the 2009 LSU AgSummary statistics and the figures show that the racing industry and its \$118 million in gross farm income is 30 percent of the total industry. That income is derived from only 14,000 horses.

The show or performance industry (15,000 rodeo, roping, cutting, barrel-racing horses) makes up 15 percent or \$101 million of the total value of the horse market.

The majority of value (55 percent, \$179 million, 174,000 horses) in the horse business is recreation.

"A lot of these horse are companion animals," Westra said. "These horse owners use their animals for exercise and trail riding."

The total \$579 million is calculated from estimated value and sale of horses and stud fees, but the economic value to Louisiana is far greater than the dollar amount of sales.

Westra estimated that the average horse owner will spend \$4,000 in feed costs, tack, veterinary bills, farrier fees, stabling and other costs to support his or her horse. That's an additional \$800 million pumped into the Louisiana economy.

Westra said the horse industry, like other

agricultural industries, has a cyclical nature.

"Oversupply happens in any sector," Westra said. "But if you have an animal, you have to maintain it."

And that will keep money flowing and exchanging hands. Still, economics factor into the future horse market. Drought has caused hay prices to ride. Financial speculation in grain has created record high prices for feed.

"If you don't already have a horse, you'll probably be less likely to purchase one," Westra said. "That will affect the horse economy and when you have soft demand, prices will go down for what you can get for the animal."

Benoit has been able to adjust to encroaching suburbia but expanding city life has drastically affected the tradition of the organized trail ride.

Parish and local governments are glad to escort trail riders through towns and on state highways, but many Louisiana municipalities are feeling the financial pinch and want trail ride organizers to pay for services rendered, said horseman Harry Latiolais of Carencro.

Carencro is in the heart of the Louisiana bushtrack country. Nearly every rural family in South Louisiana had a horse at one time and enjoyed quarterhorse racing at a local track.

Those freewheeling track days are gone, Latiolais said, but he wants to preserve the tradition of public trail riding in the shrinking rural areas.

"Sheriff escorts are \$40 an hour and some towns want to charge you \$4,000 to ride through their streets," Latiolais said. "Population has taken over. Where I used to ride horses as a kid are now gated communities. I'd like to see horse owners band together and get our politicians to help preserve our tradition."

Latiolais believes elected officials don't

see both sides of the story.

"They see the bad side of the trail ride," Latiolais said. "Disrespect to private and public property and there is sometimes some animal cruelty."

Latiolais says these issues can be overcome if the trail riding community can band together and create educational opportunities for its followers.

"We need a good organization that can offer seminars to educate people on humane treatment to horses and publicize the recreational and social aspects of trail riding. We need to make trail riding a family tradition again," Latiolais said.

What is the future for the horse industry in Louisiana?

Westra said the prognosis is not all bad. "Competitive and show events are alive and well and the racing sector is a sizable portion of the horse industry," Westra said. "The horse industry is diversified and anytime you have diversity in an industry when there's economic stress, it helps you weather the storm better."

Latiolais is encouraged by the support he has received for the formation of a statewide trail riding association but he knows it will be a long haul to create any kind of political clout.

As for Benoit, he believes he can soldier on because he's been in business for 40 years. He has to. His sole method of earning a living comes from his ability to train a horse to do things it doesn't necessarily want to do.

"I do anything and everything with horses," Benoit said. "We do Western pleasure, reining, cow horses. We breed 'em, break 'em and train 'em."

That's the horse business.
