

## Nothing Says Spring Like Louisiana Strawberries

Tangipahoa Parish strawberry grower Heather Robertson said she would prefer for Louisiana's weather to be completely dry from now until June.

She and her husband, Dale, cultivate about 15 acres of strawberries annually at Johndale's Farm, their family farm in Ponchatoula.

"We had a lot of rainy weather over the Mardi Gras weekend," Robertson said.

That's an understatement.

Tangipahoa Parish averages a little over six inches of rainfall for the month of March. More than ten inches of rain fell on Robertson's strawberry patch during Mardi Gras.

"We irrigate so we're not that concerned about rain," Robertson said.

Johndale's Farm grows the Festival Plug, Festival Root and Camino Real varieties, plants known for large berry production, but Louisiana is damp and strawberries are prone to crown rot if the field is not properly treated. Crown rot is easily controlled by the regular application of fungicide, but as Robertson pointed out, "You can't spray when it's raining."

Robertson said her pickers had to "strip" the fields after the Mardi Gras downpour. Stripping, in strawberry grower parlance, means picking and discarding all fungus damaged berries. That's hard on the bottom line because March is the month when berry production picks up and prices go down.

Louisiana strawberry farmers plant their crop as early as Thanksgiving. If the winter is mild, they can reap the benefits of high prices in late January and February.

February in Tangipahoa wasn't exactly mild, Robertson said.

Commercial strawberry farmers like the Robertson's expect cold weather and most growers use crop "blankets" to cover their rows.

"We kept the covers over the plants this winter for the most part," Robertson said. The temperature under the blankets can be ten degrees warmer. The blankets also tend to promote fungus-growing conditions.

Despite the adversity from rain and cold, Robertson predicts a good harvest.

"This year has been crazy," Robertson said. "The cold was bad for so many days in a row and then all the rain. Still, it looks like it's going to be a good year. I think the cold is over and the plants are loaded."

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain said the new Louisiana strawberry labeling rule will make it easier for consumers to identify Louisiana strawberries in the supermarket.

"Consumers will be helping our Louisiana strawberry farmers every time they buy a pack of strawberries marked as a product of Louisiana," Strain said. "Consumers are also concerned about food safety and it's always good to know where the food we eat was grown."

The state's 89 strawberry growers planted 397 acres of strawberries in 2009. The gross farm value of the 2009 crop was \$17.4 million and yielded 870,425 flats.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## New conservation program to aid Louisiana coastal prairie

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the state of Louisiana have entered into a new Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP) agreement to improve water quality in the Louisiana coastal prairie region. The agreement, called LA CREP II, will include portions of Acadia, Allen, Calcasieu, Evangeline, Jefferson Davis, St. Landry and Vermilion parishes.

“The agreement will reduce agricultural non-point source pollution to water bodies in the region by establishing more areas of native grasses, shallow water habitats for wildlife and the restoration of rare and declining habitat,” Strain said. “The program has the potential to increase Louisiana’s native coastal

prairie acreage to more than 2,500 acres, a 500 percent gain.”

The program is a partnership of USDA’s Farm Service Agency (FSA), the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry’s Office of Soil and Water Conservation, Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, and private organizations such as Ducks Unlimited and the Nature Conservancy. Through this valuable partnership, participants will be offered incentives for the installation of needed conservation practices.

LA CREP II seeks to enroll 15,050 acres located in the watersheds of the Mermentau River Basin area in the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). Landowners can voluntarily offer eligible cropland in the seven parishes within the watershed for a

contract period of 14 to 15 years. By implementing the program, the state seeks to improve water quality and establish, preserve and/or enhance wildlife habitat leading to an increased population and diversity of birds, mammals and aquatic organisms.

Over the course of the contract period, the partners will provide LA CREP II participants incentive payments and cost-share assistance for installing approved conservation practices. Also provided are annual rental payments plus incentive payments of 50 percent of the base CRP contract annual rental rate for the life of the contract. The state of Louisiana and its private partners will contribute at least 20 percent of the overall costs of implementing LA CREP II, including making a one-time up front

Best Management Practice (BMP) payment of \$61.10 per qualified acre and will provide additional cost-share assistance above the established 50 percent federal cost share. The state also will pay all costs associated with the LA CREP II annual water quality monitoring program and provide additional technical assistance, where resources are available, to develop and implement conservation plans. The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality will assist in water quality monitoring.

Sign-up for LA CREP II begins March 14 and will continue until enrollment goals are attained and/or as long as there is statutory authority for such CRP enrollment.

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

## STRAWBERRY DISHES

### Strawberries 'N Cream Cooler

1 pkg. low cal. whipped topping mix	6 pkts. artificial sweetener
1/2 cup skim milk	8 ice cubes
1/2 tsp. strawberry extract	8 fresh strawberries
3 cups quartered strawberries	6 dashes bitters
2 cups club soda	1 tsp. lemon juice

Prepare whipped cream according to package directions, substituting milk for water and strawberry extract for vanilla extract. Puree strawberries in food processor or blender. Add club soda, sweetener, bitters, lemon juice, ice cubes and 4 tablespoons whipped topping. Blend on high until smooth and creamy. Serve in tall glasses with a generous dollop of whipped topping. Garnish with 2 fresh strawberries.

### Strawberries and Cream Bread

1 3/4 cups all purpose flour	2 eggs, room temperature
1/2 tsp. baking powder	1/2 cup dairy sour cream, room temperature
1/4 tsp. baking soda	1 tsp. vanilla extract
1/2 tsp. salt	1 cup coarsely chopped fresh strawberries
1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon	3/4 cup toasted chopped walnuts
1/2 cup butter, room temp.	
3/4 cup sugar	

Grease an 8 x 4 inch loaf pan; set aside. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl, combine flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt and cinnamon; set aside. In a small bowl of electric mixer, cream butter. Gradually add sugar; beat 1 minute or until light and airy. Beat in eggs one at a time. Beat in sour cream and vanilla. Stir into flour mixture only until dry ingredients are moistened. Fold in strawberries and nuts. Turn into prepared pan; smooth top. Bake 60 to 65 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Let stand in pan 10 minutes. Turn out onto a rack to cool. Makes 1 loaf.

### White Cake with Strawberries

Vegetable cooking spray	1 tsp. vanilla extract
3/4 cup + 2 tbsps. sifted cake flour	3 egg whites
1/2 cup superfine sugar	1/2 tsp. cream of tartar
1 tsp. baking powder	1 cup sliced 1 fresh strawberries
1/4 cup vegetable oil	1/4 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips
1/4 cup water	1 whole strawberry

Coat a 10 inch flan pan with cooking spray; set aside. Combine flour, sugar, and baking powder in a medium bowl; make a well in center of mixture. Combine oil, water, and vanilla; add to dry ingredients, stirring well. Set aside. Beat egg whites (at room temperature) at high speed of an electric mixer until frothy; add cream of tartar and beat until stiff peaks form. Fold egg white mixture into flour mixture. Pour batter into prepared pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 18-20 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pan 10 minutes; remove from pan, and cool completely on a wire rack. Arrange strawberries over the cake and set aside. Place chocolate morsels in a heavy-duty zip-top plastic bag; seal bag. Submerge bag in boiling water until chocolate melts. Snip a tiny hole in the end of bag, using scissors. Drizzle chocolate over strawberries.

### Herb Punch with Strawberries

1 gal. white wine	1/2 cup rose geranium leaves
1/2 cup each of lemon balm and sage	2 quarts strawberries
1 cup mint	1/2 cup honey
1/4 cup rosemary	1 bottle champagne

Place wine and herbs in a crock. Allow to set at room temperature overnight. Chill berries. Add berries and honey and bottle of champagne. Chill until very cold. Serve in small punch cups with edible flowers of the season floating on top.



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# Keithville youth named Humane Teen of the Year

Daniel McFarland, an 18-year-old high school senior from Keithville, was named the 2011 "Humane Teen of the Year" by the Humane Society.

For Daniel, watching a news story about the chimpanzee sanctuary in his hometown of Keithville in Caddo Parish was an eye-opening experience.

Daniel, then 14 years old,

learned that Chimp Haven is a permanent home for chimpanzees who have been retired from medical research or the entertainment industry, or who are no longer wanted as pets. He also learned that chimpanzees are humankind's closest genetic relative.

Before long, Daniel was a regular volunteer at Chimp Haven,

and he soon realized he could do even more to help the sanctuary and chimpanzees. He developed a program and found creative ways to spread awareness about the needs of Chimp Haven.

His efforts have included creating "Chimp Change" donation buckets to raise money for Chimp Haven, developing a "Chimp Challenge" activity booklet for

elementary students, encouraging legislators to support the Great Ape Protection Act, and organizing a supply drive with more than 50 4-H clubs to collect items for the sanctuary.

"Through hard work and persistence, my project continues to help maintain the welfare of chimps," says Daniel, now 18. "Every time I visit, it is such a great feeling to witness the chimpanzees happy and content in their natural environment."

Daniel tells us about one special chimp named Henry: "I will never forget when he came to the facility two years ago. He had lived in a small cage in a dark garage for 15 years. He lived on only cola, candy, and cigarettes. All of his teeth had fallen out and his gums were bleeding. Now, when you see him, he is a happy, active, and very healthy chimpanzee. He loves for you to interact with him."

Henry and other chimpanzees like him provide all the motivation Daniel needs to continue his work. He determinedly writes to his federal lawmakers in Congress to encourage them to support the Great Ape Protection Act.

If passed, the law would phase out the use of chimpanzees in

invasive research, retire all federally owned chimpanzees to sanctuaries, and permanently end the breeding of federally owned chimpanzees. The 111th Congress ended with the strong bipartisan support of over 160 co-sponsors. "It will be reintroduced in the 112th Congress in 2011," says Daniel. "There is still a lot of work to be done to get this bill passed."

Daniel has had the pleasure of speaking to hundreds of visitors who come to the sanctuary. He also talks to children about the importance of ensuring the health and welfare of chimpanzees.

"Throughout the years, I have witnessed attitudes changing when people learn that hundreds of these chimpanzees are not even used for research but are just locked up in research labs until they die," Daniel tells us.

His plans for the future include expanding his work with local farmers who donate produce for the sanctuary and setting up food donation bins at the local grocery stores.

"I have learned that one person can make a difference," says Daniel. "Through my programs, I can change the outlook of how my community and my peers value the survival of the chimpanzees."

## Learn to scout for insects, diseases in crop fields

Farmers can learn specifics about how to efficiently check for insect pests and diseases affecting their crops by watching a series of scouting videos now available on LSU AgCenter's website, [www.LSUAgCenter.com](http://www.LSUAgCenter.com).

The videos focus on key insect and disease issues in Louisiana's rice, soybean, cotton and citrus crops, according to Natalie Hummel, LSU AgCenter entomologist.

The videos address the proper techniques and tools farmers and crop consultants should use when scouting fields for the presence of major insect pests, Hummel said.

"The comments we've received have been extremely positive. The crop consultants that viewed the videos said the information is useful. We've received requests for more topics and crops



such as wheat and sugar," Hummel said.

The videos feature entomologists, plant pathologists and state extension specialists for soybeans, feed grains and cotton. The lengths of the videos range from approximately one to seven minutes.

Hummel said more videos are being produced. Topics that will be featured include weed problems in grain crops, harvest aids in soybeans and issues concerning defoliating cotton.
