## Louisiana Culinary Institute provides world class instruction

Louisiana is known for its cuisine. There are very few places in the world that can match the array of foods, both traditional and exotic, that the Pelican State has to offer.

Traditional beef and poultry foods are complemented by delicacies like crawfish and alligator. Other seafood, like shrimp, blue point crabs, oysters, red snapper, flounder and redfish, allow the chef ample opportunities for creativity in the kitchen.

But before a chef can become creative in the kitchen, he/she must first learn the basics of cooking. Some learn from relatives who want to pass on their cooking secrets to the next generation. Those home-kitchen cooks are usually content to provide a good, nutritious meal for their families. Other would-be chefs aspire to own their own restaurants and catering services and many of them choose to learn the culinary arts from the Louisiana Culinary Institute in Baton Rouge.


The cooking world has exploded. There are TV networks (the Food Channel) devoted to nothing but food. Cooking shows (Naked Chef, Giada at Home, Iron Chef, Paula's Home Cooking) are watched religiously

by the faithful. Celebrity chefs (Wolfgang Puck, Rachel Ray, Anthony Bourdain) have made millions because of their skill and popularity. Louisiana also has its own share of world famous chefs (Emeril Lagasse, Paul Prudhomme, John Besh).

Charlie Ruffolo, the public affairs coordinator of the Louisiana Culinary Institute, believes Louisiana has a natural advantage over other states when it comes to the culinary arts and it shows in their enrollment. A full 30 percent of the student body is from out of state.

"The students that travel from out of state are coming here for one reason and that's to learn about Louisiana cuisine," Ruffolo said. "People from around the country know about the reputation of Louisiana food and our students definitely want to get a good education in Creole flavors.

"One of our greatest successes is when a student from out of state graduates from LCI, then returns to *See Culinary, continued on page 6*

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## LDAF, Jeff Davis Parish, grain farmers enter into lease agreement

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D. V.M., leased 2.4 acres of the state-owned Lacassine Industrial Park to the South Louisiana Rail Facility and Jeff Davis Parish in a signing ceremony March 23 at the Jeff Davis Parish Police Jury office.

The South Louisiana Rail Facility (SLRF) is a limited liability company (LLC) comprised of 156 individual farmers and landowners from Jeff Davis, Acadia, St. Landry, Vermilion, Allen, Calcasieu, Cameron, Evangeline and St. Mary parishes. The SLRF will begin construction of four 40,000-bushel grain tanks in July. The plant is expected to begin operation by the fall of 2011. The facility will take advantage of high-speed rail loading technology that will allow area grain farmers access to new markets.

“My office, the legislature, police jury, area farmers and businessmen and the Jeff Davis Economic Development office have been working on this rural economic development project very diligently for more than a year,” Strain said. “The new grain facility’s ability to load many rail cars at once will allow these area growers to compete in markets in Mexico and Central America that were previously unavailable.”

Jeff Davis Parish Police Jury President Donald Woods said the parish was very pleased to get the funding put together quickly.

“The Jeff Davis Police Jury has been happy to work on this project which will add jobs to our local economy and be a positive economic boost for our farm community,” Woods said.

Chris Krielow, the president of the

South Louisiana Rail Facility, said the grain facility will take advantage of existing infrastructure at Lacassine Industrial Park.

“There are two miles of rail spurs and that will give us access to hundreds of railcars,” Krielow said. “More trains means cheaper transportation costs.”

Senator Dan “Blade” Morrish and Representative John Guinn, both of Jennings, helped to procure \$1.8 million in capital outlay money to partially fund the project. An additional \$780,000 of funding was raised by the SLRF. The Police Jury has applied for a \$200,000 Community Development Block Grant and an additional \$200,000 grant from the United States Department of Agriculture for the grain plant.

“It’s never easy to get \$1.8 million from the legislature, but when you

have a group of committed farmers who dug inside their own pockets, that makes a whole lot of difference in Baton Rouge,” Morrish said. “That makes it a much easier project.”

“It took the efforts of a lot of farmers and other people to put this together,” Guinn said. “I think this will be a project we’ll all be proud of 20 years down the road.”

“It’s unheard of to get \$1.8 million in capital investment from the legislature in one session, but we did it,” said Marion Fox, director of the Jeff Davis Parish Economic Development and Tourist Commission. “It was because of the investment from nine parishes.”

Woods and Police Jurors Mark Pousson and Bill Wild, both of Welsh, served on the parish committee that helped negotiate the lease with the Louisiana

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

their home city and goes to work in a restaurant. They possess a worldly culinary experience that few have."

The Louisiana Culinary Institute is a state-of-the-art teaching kitchen. The 28,500 square-foot facility boasts a large full-service restaurant kitchen, a project kitchen, a bakery demonstration laboratory, three demonstration labs, an amphitheater with a residential kitchen, a restaurant dining room and a media center.

The faculty is comprised of eight fully accredited chefs and one food service instructor. Combined, the staff has more than 125 years of culinary and food service experience. The teacher-student ratio is 15-1.

Louisiana Culinary Institute, while located in Louisiana, doesn't limit itself to Louisiana cooking styles.

"We teach them everything from how to make a roux to rolling sushi," said instruc-

tor Chef Jeremy Coco. "We're teaching as many food cultures as possible."

The school's director, Chef David Tiner of Prairieville, has a well-rounded experience in the culinary arts. He has worked in bed and breakfast, fine dining and high volume kitchens.

"We try to teach our students that the learning never stops as long as they remain teachable," Tiner said.

Part of the learning experience means putting their students in scenarios where they must serve the public. A restaurant classroom within the LCI's building on Airline Highway provides a good learning atmosphere but it is a controlled environment. Students are assigned to work as servers and in the kitchen in the dining room on a daily basis to plan and serve a meal to their fellow students.

"It's one thing to serve a meal in a controlled setting and another thing to apply the knowledge in a restaurant setting," Coco said. "Once you get outside in the real world, all those controls can go right out the window."

To get some experience in a real world setting, six Louisiana Culinary Institute students volunteered when Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain asked for help with the food service for the March celebration of Ag Day at the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Baton Rouge headquarters. More than 300 visitors were expected.

Six LCI students, under the supervision of Tiner and Chef Chris Nicosia, prepared a shrimp fettuccine dish for the event. The students, Malonna Peters, Cory Berthelot, Logan Alfred, Michele Pope, Debra Chesser and Suzanne Badeaux also prepared the crab dip, and a lavish fruit and vegetable display and assisted other volunteers with their food items.

"I was extremely pleased with the quality of the food and the professionalism of the Louisiana Culinary Institute students," Strain said.

Teaching their students to be professional is what Louisiana Culinary Institute is all about, Ruffolo said.

"We teach them how to cook but the educational experience we try to impart is so much more than just cooking," Ruffolo said. "We try to teach teamwork, strategy, the best use of resources and how to overcome and deal with adversity. It is imperative that students are exposed to real life situation that happen not only in the kitchen but in everyday business. Our goal is to have a well-rounded graduate that can make a positive and immediate impact towards their career of choice."

Ruffolo said Louisiana Culinary Institute has plans to expand and include an evening program for baking and pastry specialties.

James there too. They all used to come to that little bitty joint.”

Johnny would often throw parties at the barn and inevitably, someone would break out a guitar and begin playing music.

“There was always music,” Johnny said. “We took two boards and laid them across the top pipes to make a stage.”

Local rock bands would sometimes play at these parties and everyone always seemed to mention how great the acoustics were in the sale arena.

When a proposed highway project threatened to take the old barn, Johnny and his wife, Kathy, took action. They listed the building on the National Register of Historic Places in 1997. So the building had a modicum of protection. Now what?

“Johnny had his saddle repair business in the barn,” Kathy said. And that was the total use of the barn. The back stockyard pens, the scale, the old slaughterhouse were dormant.

Because Kathy was a jewelry maker and designed pieces using alligator teeth and Johnny had a reputation for making bull whips, the pair were often written about in

travel magazines. In those articles, they talked about the sale barn, always mentioning the arena’s great acoustics.

Eventually, a call came from the booking agent for a French music group called Opus 37. The agent had read about Richard Sale Barn and thought it was a great venue for the 37-voice *a capella* choir that was touring through Louisiana. Kathy booked the group for April 6, 1999.

“I told Johnny, ‘You wanted it. I booked them. You better build a stage,’” Kathy said.

That first concert was a tremendous success. In 2006, the first event of the newly created *Le Bayou Legendaire* Concert Series took place with a performance by Michael Juan Nunez at the old auction barn. Now in its fifth season, the family friendly venue has featured concerts by Baton Rouge bluesman Henry Gray, Cajun great Hadley Castille and the Nouveau String Band.

Two more concerts remain on the spring series schedule, guitarist Sam Broussard, April 16, and Lisa Sings Peggy Lee on May 21.

### Chicken Italiano

2 large whole boneless chicken breasts, cut in three pieces	½ tsp. dried basil
¾ tsp. salt	2 bay leaves
¼ tsp. black pepper	1 (26 oz) jar meatless spaghetti sauce
¼ tsp. dried oregano	

Place chicken in bottom of slow cooker & sprinkle seasonings over chicken. Pour sauce over seasoned meat, stirring to be sure chicken is completely covered. Cover & cook on low for 6 hours on high for 3 ½-4 hours. Serve over pasta. Makes 6 servings. Cooked in a 4-qt. slow cooker.

### Beef Brisket

1 cup ketchup	½ tsp. black pepper
¼ cup grape jelly	1 (3-3 ½ lb.) fresh beef brisket, cut in half
1 package dry onion soup	

Combine ketchup, jelly, onion soup & pepper, mix well. Place half of the beef in slow cooker and cover with half of sauce. Add remaining beef and cover with remaining sauce. Cover & cook on low for 8-10 hours or until meat is tender. Slice & serve with sauce.

### Macaroni & Cheese


2 cups dry macaroni noodles	3 cups milk

### Peach Cobbler

2 lbs. fresh or canned peaches, sliced	½ tsp. ground cinnamon
2/3 cup oats (oatmeal)	¼ tsp. nutmeg
2/3 cup flour	¾ cup softened butter
2/3 cup light brown sugar	

If using canned peaches, drain liquid & place in the slow cooker. In a small bowl combine oats, flour, brown sugar, cinnamon & nutmeg then pour over the peaches. Add the butter and stir until crumbly. Cook for 3 hours on low.

## Richard Sale Barn: The Concert Hall

Abbeville's Richard Sale Barn, a cattle auction house, was built in 1937 by J. Avery Richard. Back then, it was called the Abbeville Commission Company.

Avery Richard used to buy cattle from the rural communities and drive them up to a slaughterhouse in Abbeville. This was a daily routine, said his grandson, Johnny Richard (*pronounced Cajun-style—Reeshard*), because there was no refrigeration.

"He dealt only in gold coins," Richard said.

As young men, Johnny, 61 and his brother Bert, 60, were expected to work in the sale barn pens and herd the cattle through the chutes to the auction pit.

"From the time we were in ninth grade until we were seniors, we never went to school on Tuesday because that was the day of our sale," Johnny Richard said. "We

worked cattle all the time with everybody. That's all we did. It was a family thing and we were in everyone's family."

But the cattle auction market bypassed Abbeville and Richard Sale Barn closed in 1978.

"Gooseneck trailers and I-10 killed this barn," Johnny said. The building lay large-

ly empty for years, but Johnny had an idea for another use for the old building. The unlikely source for the idea came from a hitchhiker who camped at the barn on his way through town.

Amphitheater seating rises up from the wood floor and surrounds the pit. A staircase at the back of the room provided a separate entrance during segregation days.

"The hitchhiker would play music in here," Johnny said. "He had a 12-string guitar. He'd play the guitar down there sitting on the bench. I would pass by the barn and hear him play. It sounded really good."

"I remember that guy," Bert said. "He had a black dog. He'd sleep inside here."

Johnny thought the old barn would make a great music venue.

Johnny and Bert, children of the '60s, developed an appreciation of music by sneaking into the local juke joints.

"I'd go to hear Carol Fran at the Starlight Club in the sticks," Johnny said. "I heard Aretha Franklin, Irma Thomas and Etta See *Sale barn, continued on page 7*

## Commissioner Strain and LDAF celebrate Ag Day 2011

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., unveiled the new "Fresh, Local and Grown Bayou" logo during Ag Day festivities at the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry building in Baton Rouge March 18.

Ag Day honors the men, women and businesses of the farming communities across the state.

The "Fresh, Local and Grown Bayou" logo was designed by Jeffrey Johnson of Clinton, Miss. and will be used to promote statewide "Buy Fresh, Buy Local" marketing efforts.

Johnson, of LSU, won a contest for state college art students and was presented a \$1,000 check for his winning entry.

"The 'Fresh, Local and Grown Bayou' is a clever play on words and will be available to promote our wonderful local food products," Strain said. "We grow so many quality products in Louisiana — strawberries, citrus, crawfish, Creole tomatoes and many others — and the 'Fresh, Local and Grown Bayou' will be another way to let consumers know the food they are buying and eating is grown right here in Louisiana."

Strain said Louisiana has experienced

unprecedented growth and investment in agriculture during the last two years.

"A new \$10 million rice mill will be constructed in Mer Rouge," Strain said. "It's the first rice mill to be built in northeast Louisiana. This underscores how important agriculture is in Louisiana because our rice industry is expanding."

Strain said the Elton Kennedy Rice Mill is the latest agricultural project in a number of recent large economic development projects.



"ConAgra Lamb Weston's \$155 million sweet potato processing plant near Delhi went online just in time for the sweet potato harvest," Strain said. "DG Foods' \$10 million chicken processing plant in Bastrop is in development and a new bio-refinery in Lake Providence will manufacture succinic acid with sorghum and carbon dioxide."

Succinic acid is used in the production of polymers, fibers, detergents and flavors.

"Ag is booming in Louisiana. There has been an unprecedented investment in ag pro-

cessing in the state and Louisiana increased its exports by 15 percent last year with agriculture leading the way."

Strain cited other recent agricultural developments in the state:

- Louis Dreyfus Commodities will invest more than \$100 million in the grain elevator facility at the Port of Greater Baton Rouge.

- a new high-speed rail grain loading facility will be built in the Lacassine Industrial Park.

- Louisiana Sugar Refining's \$190 million sugar mill in Gramercy should begin operations in 2011.

- Point Bio Energy's plant in Port Allen will produce more than 400,000 tons of wood pellets for use as bioenergy.

- Bruce Foods of Iberia Parish expanded in 2010 and created 43 new jobs.

- Zagis USA's cotton spinning mill in Lacassine is the first new cotton mill to be built in Louisiana in decades.

"Agriculture is the basis of all wealth," Strain said. "Investment in value-added agricultural commodities will attract jobs and enable our farmers to compete in a larger market allowing them to realize better margins."
