Strain: Guest worker policy must be reformed

H-2B guest worker wages increase by 32 percent average across the board

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said crawfish plants that employ temporary guest workers as crawfish peelers could be forced to pay hourly wages that are on average 32 percent higher than last year under a new wage calculation methodology adopted by the United States Department of Labor (DOL).

Strain said the proposed change would affect any Louisiana industry that employs workers through the federal H-2B labor program.

The H-2B Visa Program is a default United States worker program that permits American business to fill unfilled seasonal job vacancies with H-2B foreign visa workers so businesses can avoid closures due to lack of seasonal workers.

Shrimp, crab and other food service industries as well as candy manufacturers, sugarcane, forestry, equine, construction and hotel businesses employ seasonal workers through the H-2B program. These seasonal employees are typi-

cally paid the prevailing wage for the type of job performed in the geographical area in which they are hired.

Strain said a March 23 LSU AgCenter report estimated that the new DOL wage methodology increased H-2B seasonal worker wages by an average of 32 percent, which means labor costs will rise from \$13 million to \$19.5 million in one year. The estimated reduction in economic activity resulting from the proposed wage increase is \$40 to \$60 million per year.

"Louisiana shellfish industries are under constant pressure from overseas competition where wages are much lower than American rates," Strain said. "Louisiana created the crawfish tail meat industry. Now it's practically extinct. It has put United States businesses that rely on H-2B labor at a severe disadvantage.

"It is unfair to employers who need the workers to process Louisiana seafood and work in other industries to have this signifi-

cantly higher wage increase imposed on them. What business could absorb a 32 percent wage increase at the stroke of a pen?"

Strain said the national guest worker policy must be revamped.

"Employers across the nation who use H-2B labor demand a streamlined process that will allow producers to pay foreign guest workers a fair wage to fill job vacancies that aren't being taken by American workers," Strain said.

Strain said the H-2B provision of the DOL rules allow U.S. employers to bring in foreign nationals for work if employers can establish that the need for workers is temporary and/or seasonal. American employers must also demonstrate that there are not enough American workers who are available and willing to do the work.

The number of H-2B guest workers allowed in the United States is capped at 66,000 per year. A variety of Louisiana industries brought in 3,145 H-2B workers in 2011.

"Year in and year out, crawfish, shrimp, and crab processors and other food processors establish the need for temporary workers because they are never able to fill the jobs locally," Strain said.

Strain said he has proposed a plan that would lower process costs to bring guest labor into the U.S. by pre-processing foreign workers for a five-year period.

"Ninety percent of guest workers brought into the country come year after year to work in our crawfish plants, sugar mills and hospitality industries, many times for the same employers," Strain said. "We need to implement a pre-processing system that will be good for five years. If guest workers have already worked in the U.S. and have done a good job and have no criminal record in our country and in their own country, then our seafood and agricultural employers should have a more streamlined application system to bring those workers into the U.S. to work without unnecessary delays and expense."

LDAF train with National Guard in cattle location

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said livestock experts with the Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF), LSU AgCenter and Louisiana Cattlemen's Association drilled with the Louisiana National Guard March 31- April 1 in airborne rapid damage assessment techniques at locations in the Bonnet Carre Spillway and Hackberry.

Strain said the training will help in search and rescue operations after the initial onslaught of an emergency is over.

"Livestock are sometimes displaced by a storm and wander onto highways and other high ground areas and can present hazards for

search and rescue operations," Strain said. "We practiced integrated search and rescue protocol that included locating livestock and relaying the information from local emergency operation centers (EOCs) to the state and federal EOCs for quick assessment and allocation of resources."

"While search and rescue needs are determined, our personnel can also determine what resources can be allocated to humanely help stranded livestock with water and food until the emergency event is over."

Strain said the LDAF mobile command vehicle was positioned at the location and served as a communication center between the

Bonnet Carre and the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparation in Baton Rouge.

A demonstration of the LDAF emergency refueling system was also featured during the two day event.

LDAF personnel work closely the LSU AgCenter and Louisiana Cattlemen's Association to protect agricultural interests in the aftermaths of hurricanes and other disasters.

"This hands-on opportunity for local Extension agents to practice air reconnaissance and livestock rescue operations was extremely valuable," said Paul Coreil, Vice Chancellor and Director of the

LSU AgCenter Extension Service. "All of us on the state's hurricane recovery team will be better prepared to respond efficiently and effectively - saving lives and protecting agricultural assets - when the next storm strikes."

"The Louisiana Cattlemen's Association is committed to being a full partner in any emergency recovery effort related to helping our fellow cattlemen help distressed livestock," said Robert Joyner, Executive Vice President of the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association. "We learned a lot from the Guardsmen and they learned a lot from us."

Whole Roast Gulf Coast Lamb - part 1

For the lamb stuffing:	1 onion, diced
2 pounds lamb shoulder or shanks	3 cloves garlic, sliced
Salt	2 tomatoes, peeled and diced or 1
Freshly ground black pepper	cut canned diced tomatoes
1 tsp. dried thyme	1 sprig fresh rosemary
1 tsp. crushed red pepper flakes	2 cups basic chicken stock
2 tbsps. extra-virgin olive oil	

For the lamb stuffing, season the lamb shoulder or shanks with salt, pepper, thyme, and pepper flakes. Heat the olive oil in a large heavy pot over high heat and sear the lamb on all sides until browned all over. Add the onions to the pot, reduce the heat to moderate, and cook, stirring occasionally, until the onions are brown, about 10 minutes. Add the garlic, tomatoes, rosemary, and Chicken Stock, increase the heat to medium-high and cook until the stock comes to a boil. Reduce the heat to low, cover, and cook until the meat is fork tender and falling off the bone, about 1 1/2 hours. Transfer the meat from the broth to a platter (set the broth aside for later); season with salt and pepper. Set the meat aside and let cool to room temperature.

Black-Eyed Peas and Rice

2 1/2 cups black-eyed peas, frozen	1 tbsp. apple cider vinegar
2 tbsps. soybean oil	1 tsp. sugar
1 medium white onion, diced	1/4 tsp. red pepper flakes
2 garlic cloves, minced	3 cups cooked long grained rice
2 cups tomatoes, ripe peeled diced	1/4 cup parsley, minced
1 tsp. thyme leaves	Salt and pepper to taste

In a large stockpot or Dutch oven, combine peas, 1 teaspoon salt and enough water to cover. Simmer peas over medium low heat until tender, about 20 minutes. Drain peas and set aside. Heat Dutch oven over medium heat and add the oil and onion. Cook and stir the onion unit tender about 5 minutes. Add the garlic and continue to cook another minute. Add the tomatoes, thyme, vinegar, sugar and red pepper flakes. Cook another 15 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add the black-eyed peas and continue to cook for 15 more minutes. Stir in the cooked rice and parsley. Season with salt and freshly ground pepper to taste.

Whole Roast Gulf Coast Lamb - part 2

For the leg of lamb:	4 cloves garlic, sliced
5 lb. deboned and butterflied leg of lamb	2 branches fresh rosemary, divided into small sprigs
Salt and freshly ground black pepper	

For the leg of lamb, preheat the oven to 400 degrees. Lay out the leg of lamb, skin side down, on a cutting board and season with salt and pepper. Remove the cooled slow-cooked meat from the bones and arrange it in the center of the boneless leg of lamb (parallel to the short sides). Discard the bones. Beginning with a short side, roll the lamb around the slow-cooked meat, jelly-roll fashion, and tie it securely with kitchen string. Using a paring knife, make small incisions in the tied-up roast. Stuff a slice of garlic or a sprig of rosemary into each incision and season the roast with salt and pepper. Put the lamb into a roasting pan and roast until the internal temperature is 130 degrees, 30-40 minutes. Remove from the oven and let rest 15 minutes. While the lamb rests, reduce the broth of the slow-cooked meat by half over medium-high heat. Strain and serve it over slices of the stuffed leg of lamb.

Catfish and Shrimp La Fitte

2 eggs	1/2 tsp. chopped garlic
1 cup milk	12 3x1/4 inch strips of ham
2 cups all-purpose flour	1 tbsps. dry vermouth
2 tps. salt	1/2 cup heavy cream
1 tps. cayenne pepper	1 tbsp. chopped green onions
4 U.S. Farm-Raised Catfish fillets	1 tsp. lemon juice
Vegetable oil for deep frying	Salt (to taste)
3 tbsps. butter, melted	Dash of cayenne pepper
12 shrimp, shelled and deveined	Parsley sprigs and lemon wedges

Beat eggs and milk in a shallow dish. Mix flour, salt and cayenne pepper in another shallow dish or on a piece of wax paper. Dredge catfish fillets in flour mixture, then in egg mixture and again in flour. Set aside on a wax-paper lined baking sheet. Pour oil into a deep fryer or a large, deep skillet and heat to 360°F on a deep-frying thermometer. Place fillets, two at a time, in hot oil and fry for 2 to 3 minutes on each side, or until golden brown and fish flakes easily when tested with a fork. Place on paper towels to drain. While catfish are frying prepare the sauce. Heat 1 tablespoon of the melted butter in a large skillet over medium heat. Add shrimp and sauté until light pink on both sides; do not overcook. Stir in garlic, ham strips and vermouth. Mix in cream, half of the green onion, lemon juice, salt and cayenne pepper; cook for 1 to 2 minutes to reduce cream. Remove from the heat and whisk in remaining 2 tablespoons melted butter. Place a catfish fillet on each serving plate and top with three shrimp pieces. Arrange ham strips to fill in gaps between shrimp. Spoon sauce onto catfish, and sprinkle with remaining green onion. Garnish with lemon wedges and parsley sprigs and serve.

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Louisiana youth to explore state's wetlands

Students across Louisiana will be engaged in wetlands-related activities during Youth Wetlands Week, which runs April 22-27. Activities will revolve around learning the vital role wetlands play in offering recreational and economic opportunities along with their ecological value such as protection from hurricanes and their ability to improve water quality.

Youth Wetlands Week is organized by the LSU AgCenter's 4-H Youth Development department. Ashley Mullens, Youth Wetlands program director, said activities are planned across the state based on a curriculum developed by the department with input from Louisiana science teachers.

"We provide an extensive curriculum that offers teachers a choice of lessons based on their access to a wetlands area. Some of the lessons can be conducted

on a large-scale if a teacher has a major wetlands area nearby, and some can be performed on a small stream or even a



water garden on the grounds of the school," Mullens said.

The curriculum is provided free to teachers and is distributed through the LSU AgCenter's parish extension offices.

In northeast Louisiana, Mullens said students will have a special opportunity to participate in the Louisiana Wetlands Exploratory Days at the Tensas River National Wildlife Refuge near Tallulah. Starting on April 24, for four consecutive days, students visiting the refuge will conduct tree plantings, identify macro invertebrates and learn how animals have adapted to live in wetland areas.

"This year we decided to select an area of the state to coordinate our state office personnel with local agents and experience different lessons in a large wetlands location.

The Tensas refuge is an excellent site for this," Mullens said. She also said that plans are to select a different part of the state for next year's exploratory days. Funding for the Youth Wetlands program is provided by the Louisiana Office of Coastal Protection.
