Farmers helping farmers

Raising cattle in South Louisiana is hard enough but a beginner cattlemen has no chance at being successful unless he has help. Meet Danny Uriegas's cattle cabal.

Most folks in the cattle business today were born to it. Their parents or grandparents raised cattle, and they took an interest in continuing the tradition.

Then there's 39-year-old Danny Uriegas of Lafayette.

"When I was a kid growing up in a trailer park in Abbeville, I helped the landlord, Mr. Jim LaCour, with

to help a green wanna-be cattleman took time.

"I found folks who were willing to sell me ten white cows when I was looking for two black cows," Uriegas said. "And it was hard to find people who would take time to meet me at a certain time and place."

Uriegas, a Mexican-American,

takes a lot of work."

Work is what Uriegas does best. He went to the sale barns and noted which animals drew top prices. He asked questions. He listened and he continued to study. Finally, he found a some Lafayette Parish cattlemen that he trusted, and more importantly, who trusted him.

his cattle," Uriegas said. "I said when I grew up I wanted to have cattle."

Two years ago Uriegas figured he finally had the wherewithal to become a cattlemen so he went to the public library to learn about raising a herd.

"Did you know the public library has maybe five books about raising cattle?" Uriegas said. "And they aren't all at the same library branch."

Uriegas studied and took notes from all the literature he could find, but he quickly discovered that all the books in the world couldn't teach him how to raise cattle in South Louisiana.

He searched for mentors, but finding people willing to take time

didn't get to be the manager of the Angco Disposal and Landfill by being impatient.

Uriegas' informal cattle cabal is comprised of Chris Romero, Mike Broussard, Kirk Martin, and Stan Dutile. With the exception of Romero, who is 37, all of the Uriegas' advisory group are over 50.

All are diversified cattlemen. Dutile is the Lafayette county agent. Martin owns Martin Slaughterhouse and also grows hay. Broussard is in the business of growing and selling hay too, while Romero has a job in retail.

The cattlemen are concerned about the future of farming in Lafayette Parish because of the rapid urban growth that has come to the city. Expansion of Verot School Road, Ambassador Caffery

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Be sure horticulture professionals are licensed

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain advised that Louisiana homeowners should use only licensed landscape horticulturists, arborists and landscape irrigation contractors when doing major landscaping work at their homes or businesses.

"Every spring and summer, so-called yard specialists claiming to be landscaping professionals begin making the rounds in local neighborhoods offering bargain basement deals for yard work," Strain said. "Many have little or no training and their work is often substandard, producing less than desirable outcomes and sometimes downright disasters."

"All arborists, landscape horti-

culturists and landscape irrigation contractors must be licensed by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry," Strain said.

Oversight of these professionals is through the LDAF's Horticulture and Quarantine Programs division.

Strain advised that homeowners ask to see a license issued by LDAF before allowing any work to be done on their property. Homeowners should also ask arborists, landscape horticulturists and landscape irrigation contractors for references before engaging their services and should follow up by checking those references.

Licensed arborists and landscape irrigation contractors must also

have current liability insurance before a license is issued, Strain said.

"Homeowners should ask for copies of the arborist and landscape irrigation contractor's liability insurance," Strain said. "They can then call the contractor's insurance company to verify that the policy is current or they can contact our office."

"These are basic steps homeowners should take to be sure that they are hiring a licensed professional," Strain said.

Strain said licensed professionals are tested by the LDAF to ensure that they have the training necessary to do the work. Arborists and landscape irrigation contractors are

required to attend continuing education training to renew their licenses.

In addition, licensed horticultural professionals are required to display their LDAF license number on their vehicles.

"Every year fly-by-night operators prey on unsuspecting homeowners who are looking for a quick and inexpensive fix for their dead and damaged trees and help in their landscapes," Strain said. "Call our Horticulture and Quarantine Programs division at 225-952-8100 if you have any questions about whether a landscape horticulturist, landscape irrigation contractor or arborist is properly licensed."

Strain said consumers may also





All dairy cattle 20 mos. of age, beef cattle 24 mos. of age, or pasturient or post pasturient animals of any age offered for sale, except for immediate slaughter, must have valid 30-day negative brucellosis test certificate. Contact La. Dept. of Agriculture and Forestry, P.O. Box 1951, Baton Rouge, La. 70821-1951.

Attention: Bull sellers and buyers. All non-virgin bulls and bulls older than 24 months for sale in Louisiana must have a current negative trichomoniasis test from an accredited veterinarian before they may be sold. Virgin bulls must have a breeder's certification of virgin status signed by the breeder, the breeder's agent or an accredited veterinarian.  1/2 cup celery, chopped (can substitute celery salt)
 1 carrot, chopped (optional)

Cube or chop potatoes and onions. Cover with water and cook until potatoes are done. Add soups, milk and cheese. Cook until cheese has melted and the soup is very creamy. Stir well to prevent burning. Season to your taste with salt and pepper. (Optional: A little Greek seasoning can be added as well as vegetables of your choice.)

 1 large can crushed pineapple, drained
 3 pints fresh strawberries
 1/2 cup bananas, sliced

2 pkgs. vanilla instant pudding mix
 3 1/2 cups milk
 1 can sweetened condensed milk
 1 (12 oz.) carton Cool Whip
 1 (16 oz.) carton Cool Whip

Prepare yellow cake mix as directed on package. Bake on cookie sheet or jelly roll pan. Let cake cool. Slice strawberries and sprinkle with 1/2 cup sugar, set aside. Tear cake into small pieces. Parkway and Interstate 49 have all put pressure on land that used to be in row crops or pasture.

"If you have to drive your equipment on the four-lane to get to a field, it's just not worth it," Broussard said.

What were once farm roads are now narrow subdivision streets with 90 degree turns that are not very accommodating to tractors, combines and hay balers.

"Developers build subdivisions next to farmland with no buffers between the subdivisions and farmland," Broussard said. "Then they expect the farmer to build the buffer."

When cattlemen and other producers find land that may be suitable for agricultural endeavors can be found, landowners want top dollar for pasture that has no water, existing fences or shade.

"Black cows need the shade," Uriegas said.

The group thinks that the general public is so removed from agricultural traditions that they lack a basic understanding of how their food gets to market.

"Most people don't know where their meat comes from," Martin said.

However, Martin said there are still plenty of folks who want to know where their beef is raised and that's what keeps his slaughterhouse in business.

"They want grass fed beef and they'll order a side (of beef) for their freezer," he said.

Though Lafayette Parish is dominated by the oil and gas industry, Dutile noted that agriculture is still a major economic factor.

"Lafayette is slowly pushing agriculture out because of urban growth," Dutile said. "But the parishes that are contiguous to Lafayette are all large agricultural producers. It means that agriculture is still the driving force around Lafayette."

Despite the barriers, Uriegas started Double U Farm two years ago and is now



the proud owner of twenty head of Angus and Beefmaster cattle. His herd is spread out on three small pastures in the Carencro-Cankton area.

Once Uriegas put cattle in the plots, he found that his neighbors were willing to lend a hand.

Uriegas pointed to a small red barn at the fence line.

"My neighbor said, 'My daddy built this barn years ago but no one has used it. I'd love for you to use it, Danny. I see you bring your feed every day. Put your feed in my barn. My daddy would be happy someone is using the barn,'" Uriegas said.

Another neighbor gives Uriegas access to his water supply.

Uriegas speculates that the neighbors who help him want to be connected to agriculture in some form and are grateful for the opportunity. They also tend to be of an older generation.

The barn owner said, "You don't have to pay me nothing, *cher*," Uriegas said.

Uriegas said his cattle advisors have kept him from making stupid mistakes.

"I call Mike Broussard the cow whisperer," Uriegas said. "He introduced me to other cattle producers and helped me pick my bull."

Broussard introduced Uriegas to the "premier Angus breeder" in the state, Uriegas said.

It's essential for young people who want to get in the cattle business (or farming, for that matter) to be mentored by an experienced hand like Broussard, Uriegas said.

With only 20 cows, Uriegas knows that he's not going to make money, but he hopes to have a herd of 100 in the years to come.

But ever since Uriegas helped his trailer park landlord with his cows, he knew he wanted to be a cattleman and drive a John Deere tractor.

"Amongst cattle producers, it's the ultimate compliment to be known as someone who took care of his animals," Uriegas said. "I want to be the person that cattle producers buy their replacement heifers from."
