

Research station evaluates new ornamental plants

The LSU AgCenter works actively to evaluate new ornamental plants for the landscape industry in Louisiana. This includes plants that may even eventually make their way into home gardens around the state. Much of this work is done at the AgCenter Hammond Research Station.

Efforts in 2012 include new research with roses. One new rose group being evaluated is a collection from Biltmore Home and Gardens. The most popular of these is expected to be Loretta Lynn. These are low-maintenance landscape roses for the South.

The station is working with Jim Mills at K and M Nursery in Buckatunna, Miss., on the landscape performance of different mini-flora roses. The mini-floras are a new class of roses – crosses between miniature roses and floribunda roses. The plant growth characteristics and flower size mostly resemble a smaller-growing floribunda.

Also in the trial garden are the Southern Living Plant Collection's new landscape shrub roses – Majesty and All A Flutter.

The sun garden plant evaluation area has new plants that will be available in 2013. These are trialed in landscape settings to see how they will perform in Louisiana prior to general introduction next spring. Researchers are excited about the new Cheyenne Spirit purple cone-flower – this will be an All-America Selections winner in 2013.

In addition, next year will see a new addition to the Louisiana Super Plant BabyWing begonias – a bronze-foliaged, white-flowered variety. And a new cousin of the popular Senorita Rosalita cleome will be Senorita Blanca cleome.

New perennials that have been performing well include the Atomic series of veronicas. These plants are not widely known to most Louisiana gardeners. Previously, Sunny Borde Blue has been the most well-known and planted variety in Louisiana.

The Lyrical series of salvia nemorosa shows lots of appeal. Most of the perennial salvia species, such as nemorosa, are good landscape performers and are drought-tolerant. The new Lighthouse series of annual salvias are available in red and purple and look to be a great improvement over what has been available in the past.

Copper plants are worthy of increased use. The LSU AgCenter will be adding the Tiki Series of copper plants from Plug Connection to our plantings later this summer. This will bring our collection to more than 30 varieties. Great plants with potential, the Tiki series includes Lava Flow, Tropical Typhoon, Island Sunrise, Firestorm, Peach Whirl, Tahitian Halo, Jungle Cloak and Tropical Tempest. Copper plants are normally available at garden centers late spring through late summer.

Early to midfall is a great time to add perennials to the landscape.

New varieties and series of annual flowers coming in 2013 are in evaluation trials. They include a new dwarf series of angelonias called the Serenitas. These are smaller-growing forms of Louisiana Super Plant Serena angelonias.

Strain supports House Ag Committee Farm Bill draft

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., praised Chairman Frank Lucas of Oklahoma and Ranking Member Collin Peterson of Minnesota for crafting a bipartisan Farm Bill that works for Louisiana farmers and ranchers.

"I commend the House Agriculture Committee for recognizing that Southern agriculture is unique and farm policy must be tailored to benefit all agricultural commodities throughout the country," Strain said.

Strain recently met with the state's Congressional delegation and House Agriculture

Committee and staff members in Washington, D.C. to discuss the Farm Bill.

"We brought our concerns to the table and worked on solutions that make sense for Louisiana farmers," Strain said. "The proposed legislation now creates a balanced approach for both Louisiana producers and the entire Southern region."

Strain said the draft includes key provisions for rice and other commodities that provide a proper safety net for Louisiana farmers and producers throughout the South.

"While direct payments may

now be a thing of the past, the proposed legislation provides effective and fair policies to enable Louisiana farmers and ranchers to continue to supply us with safe and affordable food and fiber."

The bill seeks to reform, streamline and consolidate numerous programs, and reduce the federal deficit by \$35 billion. The proposed legislation creates two risk-based management tools only intended when a producer suffers a significant loss.

The bill also includes an extension of the U.S. Sugar Program, which is vital to Louisiana sugar-

cane growers, and it creates a new risk management program called the Stacked Income Protection Plan or STAX, for cotton producers. It also expands the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition program to benefit not only low-income seniors but also provide low-income families access to fresh fruits and vegetables through coupons that can be exchanged for eligible foods at farmers markets.

Strain said he looks forward to continuing dialog with both the House Agriculture Committee and our state's Congressional delegation.

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



Strain: USDA streamlines disaster designation process

New USDA rules are expected to fast track assistance Louisiana farmers and ranchers can receive as the result of an agricultural disaster.

"The USDA is making much needed changes to the disaster declaration process," Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said. "In the past, there was so much red tape and bureaucracy it could take weeks or even months after a parish met disaster criteria before a USDA designation would be issued."

The amended rules and procedure include:

- ♦For drought, once a parish is categorized by the U.S. Drought Monitor as experiencing a severe drought for eight consecutive weeks during the growing season, the parish nearly automatically qualifies for a natural disaster

designation.

- ♦Disaster declaration requests no longer must be initiated by a governor or Indian tribal council.

- ♦Reduced the USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) emergency loan interest rate from 3.75 percent to 2.25 percent.

- ♦Annual rental payments by producers on Conservation Reserve Program acres used for emergency haying or grazing will be reduced to 10 percent in 2012 instead of 25 percent.

"This is a step in the right direction," Strain said. "It is important to be able to deliver assistance to farmers and ranchers when they need it the most."

Criteria currently used to trigger a disaster designation remain unchanged.

Individuals not meeting these requirements should contact their local LSU Cooperative Extension Service office to inquire about any upcoming 3-day Prescribed Burn Workshop.

Prescribed burning is a "land

management tool" that may be beneficial for threatened and endangered species, land and brush management, pasture maintenance and fuel-load reduction within timber stands.

Course topics will include, legal aspects with regards to prescribed burning, prescribed burn plan development; fire weather information.

Course participation will be held to 40 students.

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LDAF joins with the EPA in Mississippi River Basin lawsuit

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain announced that the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is intervening in the Gulf Restoration Network, v Jackson lawsuit that seeks to impose strict numeric water quality standards on the entire Mississippi River Basin.

Strain made his comments to the general assembly of the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation's annual conference in New Orleans at the Marriott Hotel June 29.

Strain had previously announced the LDAF intentions regarding the lawsuit at a press conference at the LSU AgCenter's Crowley Rice Research Station in Acadia Parish June 28.

"We are joining the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in a lawsuit to defend the EPA against the Gulf Restoration Network," Strain said. "The Gulf Restoration Network is suing the EPA to force them to set numeric guidelines for nutrient runoff. The Gulf Restoration Network wants to set specific numbers of what can come off your field and into our waterways."

Under the Clean Water Act, states may use either "narrative" or "numeric" standards as a method for determining water quality, Strain said.

Most states in the Mississippi River Basin use narrative standards, such as "no nutrients

at levels that cause a harmful imbalance of aquatic populations."

If the lawsuit is successful, EPA would be forced to override existing state standards with federal water quality standards and to express those standards as specific numeric limits on nutrients.

Strain said he agrees with the EPA that the case is a state's rights issue.

"What is best for Louisiana is for us to look at what our nutrient numbers are and base runoff levels on what is normal for our environment," Strain said. "If we lose this lawsuit it will cost the Louisiana agricultural producer more than \$400 million and outside groups will be dictating to us how much fertilizer we can use. That cannot stand. We are going to fight this vigorously."

In addition to the LDAF joining with the EPA in the lawsuit, Strain said the state departments of Environmental Quality, Natural Resources, Attorney General and Governor's office have intervened in the lawsuit. Also, 16 other national and regional agricultural organizations, including the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation, are participants in the lawsuit.

Strain said farmers and state government must continue to work together to minimize nutrient runoff but the state oppose a "one size fits all" approach.

Strain warns of EEE & WNV threats Advises horse owners to vaccinate

Baton Rouge, LA (July 18, 2012) - An increase in Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) and West Nile Virus (WNV) cases in horses has prompted Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., to warn owners to vaccinate their horses.

"The rain we've been having creates breeding grounds for mosquitoes. If a mosquito bites an infected bird, Eastern Equine Encephalitis or West Nile can be spread to horses, dogs, cats even alligators and, of course, humans," said Strain.

The mosquito-transmitted diseases can cause inflammation or swelling of the brain and spinal cord.

So far this year, the LDAF Office of Veterinary Health is reporting eight WNV and 10 EEE cases in horses with new positive cases trickling in every day.

"Horses are infected the same way humans become infected, by being bit-


ten by infected mosquitoes," said Strain. "We want people to also be mindful of mosquitoes and to take preventative measures to stay safe."

Infected horses may show lethargy, weakness, paralysis or even death.

Prevention includes avoiding mosquitoes, using mosquito repellents that are safe for horses and humans, and vaccination for horses. So far, there is no vaccination approved for people.

Ten cases of WNV have been reported in humans so far this year. "We need to follow the One Health concept in which we battle these deadly diseases together in an effort to keep humans and animals safe," added Strain.

Horse owners should contact their local veterinarian regarding proper vaccination protocols during this time of increased risk.



Diseases, weeds highlight sugarcane field day

ST. GABRIEL, La. – Rust diseases and bermudagrass control highlighted the presentations at the 30th annual sugarcane field day at the LSU AgCenter Sugar Research Station July 18.

"Brown rust has become our biggest problem," said LSU AgCenter plant pathologist Jeff Hoy.

The disease comes in spring and affects sugarcane at a time that it grows most vigorously, said Hoy. He is evaluating new fungicides and studying when and where to best treat for the disease.

"If we can minimize the losses with a good fungicide, we can have a good crop," he said. "The final question for producers is, 'does this stuff pay?'"

Orange rust, a similar sugarcane disease that occurs later in the growing season, has been identified in several fields this year. The disease appears to have come to Louisiana by spores carried in the wind from Florida, where it has been for several years.

So far, the disease has been found on only one variety, Ho 05-961, which only has been planted for seed this year. "You have to know what you're looking for and look hard to find it," Hoy said of discovering an infection in a field.

Fungicides that work on brown

rust also are effective on orange rust, Hoy said.

Bermudagrass is a persistent problem in sugarcane, but weather conditions during the past year have eased the situation this year, said LSU AgCenter weed scientist Jim Griffin.

The sugarcane crop grew rapidly this past spring and shaded out bermudagrass, Griffin said, explaining various alternatives for suppressing bermudagrass at planting.

"We cannot control bermudagrass in sugarcane, we can only suppress it," he said. Several herbicide combinations can be effective in slowing down the growth until the sugarcane crop can out-compete it.

"You get four to six to eight weeks of effectiveness following application, then the herbicides are degraded and don't persist," Griffin said.

He suggested sequential herbicide applications at planting in late summer. The second application helps prevent bermudagrass from re-establishing and helps control other winter weeds.

LSU AgCenter sugarcane breeder Michael Pontif reviewed the sugarcane varieties available to Louisiana growers and pointed out the strengths of each. He was

accompanied by Ed Dufrene with the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Research Service sugarcane research unit in Houma.

It takes about 12 years for variety development, Pontif said.

The next new variety may be in 2014 from USDA, Dufrene said.

Twelve years from crossing to commercialization is typical for sugarcane, said LSU AgCenter sugarcane specialist Kenneth Gravois.

Standing in front of examples of sugarcane plants in various stages of variety development, Gravois explained how wild cane from Asia was introduced into U.S. sugarcane breeding about a century ago. At that time, sugarcane grown in Louisiana began suffering from mosaic and stalk rotting diseases, and new sources of genetic material had to be incorporated into the breeding programs.

"Basic breeding doesn't give you a commercial variety but a variety to put into the crossing program," Gravois said.

Today, sugarcane development includes breeding for varieties to be used as biofuels that can be grown in other climates and not compete with food crops, Gravois said. "Research is the arena for innovation and risk."
