

## LDAF Isaac response

All eyes were on Hurricane Isaac as it churned in the Gulf of Mexico, hopeful the storm would take a different path – away from our hurricane weary state. By Sunday, Aug. 26, it was clear Isaac was headed our way and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Incident Management Team, along with the rest of south Louisiana, began storm preparations.

The LDAF immediately began staging resources in key areas

and activating emergency contracts ahead of the storm. The agency serves as the lead in emergency response for animals, agriculture and forestry in addition to providing support to other state agencies

for evacuation, sheltering, search and rescue, and recovery.

While barely reaching Category 1 status on the Saffir-Simpson Hurricane Scale, 75-95 mph winds, forecasters predicted Hurricane Isaac's fury would not be the wind but rather its storm surge and heavy rainfall.

Hurricane Isaac began impacting Louisiana Tuesday, Aug. 28 at the Southwest Pass of the Mississippi River. After storm surge pushed water from lakes Pontchartrain and

Maurepas into St. John the Baptist and St. Tammany parishes the LDAF's companion animal response began. The LDAF evacuated pets to shelters in *See Response, continued on page 20*

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Strain urges horse owners to vaccinate

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is strongly advising horse owners to vaccinate their animals for Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) and the West Nile Virus (WNV).

Recent rainfall from Hurricane Isaac could be problematic in the coming weeks.

Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "We were concerned about the increased number of cases even prior to Hurricane

Isaac. Louisiana was not experiencing the drought other areas of the country were dealing with and now with Isaac inundating parts of the state with water, those areas will be a breeding ground for mosquitoes. Remember, horses are infected the same way humans are infected – by being bitten by infected mosquitoes - so everyone needs to take extra precautionary measures at this time."

If a mosquito bites an infected bird, EEE or WNV can be spread

to horses, dogs, cats and humans. The mosquito-transmitted diseases can cause inflammation or swelling of the brain and spinal cord.

As of press time, the LDAF Division of Veterinary Health reported 43 EEE and 28 WNV cases in horses since January 2012. In 2011, there were three cases of EEE and no cases of WNV reported in horses.

Infected horses may show lethargy, weakness, paralysis or

may even die.

So far this year, nine humans have died from WNV.

Prevention includes avoiding mosquitoes, using mosquito repellents that are safe for horses and humans, and for horses, vaccination.

At this time, no vaccination is approved for people.

Horse owners should contact their local veterinarian regarding proper vaccination protocols during this time of increased risk.



The 50 cents state check-off is now a Mandatory Collection as a result of Act 298 passed in the 1995 Louisiana legislature, but producers may request a refund of this amount only, by written request to the Louisiana Beef Industry Council.

The seller is also responsible under the law. The seller may collect and remit the \$1.50 per head in a private treaty transaction. This is the best way to handle purebred sales. To avoid a late payment charge, money must be remitted by the 15th of the month following the sale. Penalties of up to \$5,000 per transaction applies to violators. All sale transactions are subject to audit to insure compliance with the check-off law.

Alexandria and Haughton, when more than 1,400 people were rescued and/or evacuated from Laplace in St. John the Baptist Parish as neighborhoods flooded following torrential rain.

“Our citizens needed assistance and were very grateful when we arrived with pet cages and trucks to ensure their four-legged loved ones would be cared for just like the rest of their family,” Strain said. “I witnessed, first hand, the struggle these flood victims were going through while trying to evacuate. At least we were able to keep their families and pets together.”

In all, nearly 200 pets were evacuated and sheltered.

When levees were overtopped in Plaquemines Parish, LDAF’s agriculture branch began receiving requests for assistance with livestock.

“We coordinated with the Louisiana Air National Guard to air drop round bales of hay for stranded cattle in Plaquemines Parish,” Strain said. “In addition to the hay drops, we brought in a portable corral and water troughs, assisted cattlemen with rounding up stray cattle and provided security.”

Cattle are sensitive to sudden changes in salinity in their diet, Strain added, so feeding protocols were implemented that had been used after hurricanes Katrina and Rita with excellent outcomes.

The LDAF received requests for roughly 351,000 gallons of fuel for first responders, hospitals, nursing homes and state partners for life saving, life supporting and life sustaining emergency response, in addition to relief and recovery missions as requested.

“I’d like to thank the Louisiana Cattlemen’s Association, Hill’s Pet Food Company, LSU AgCenter, the Louisiana National Guard, Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, the Louisiana State Animal Response Team (LSART), American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA), National Animal Rescue and Sheltering Coalition (NARSC), and everyone else who stepped up during the response efforts,” Strain said. “You can never predict how challenging a storm may become. We have very dedicated teams of people who continue to work hard during the response and recovery efforts.”
