Attention: Baled hay producers, sellers, buyers, shippers



The United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) regulates the movement of hay out of areas under quarantine for the imported fire ant. The quarantine zone includes most of the southeastern U.S. including Louisiana.

In quarantine areas like Louisiana, USDA only regulates baled hay and baled straw that are stored in direct contact with the ground since it poses a risk for harboring imported fire ants. This hay can move anywhere within the quarantine area but can only move outside of the quarantine area when certain conditions are met.

Baled hay that meets any of the requirements below is not regulated and has no movement restrictions:

- For baled hay that is stacked, all bales except the bottom layer that is in direct contact with the ground.

- Hay that is cut, baled, loaded, and shipped without storage.

- Baled hay that is stored on an impervious surface such as hardpan (highly compressed soil), asphalt, concrete, etc.

- Baled hay that is stored elevated above the soil on pallets or tires or stored on landscaping cloth placed over the soil.

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) officials recommend anyone shipping hay outside of Louisiana contact agriculture officials in the destination state before transporting hay.

As Louisiana's harvest season ramps into high gear, the 2012 agricultural outlook is bright despite a few bumps in the road.

"Despite the production difficulties the Louisiana agricultural industry has faced in 2012, there is still an expectation that the total farm gate value in 2012 will reach and exceed 2011 levels. First, prices for many of our commodities are currently at historical levels. And, second, even with our production difficulties, many of our commodities are projected to have near record yields," said LSU AgCenter Economist Kurt Guidry.

Louisiana agriculture contributed \$6.1 billion in direct gross farm sales to the state's economy in 2011 and that number could be even higher in 2012.

Each year, the LSU AgCenter summarizes agriculture commodity values and the 2011 figures are up more than 10 percent from \$5.5 billion in 2010.

Here is a breakdown of the \$6.1 billion:

- ♦\$3.8 billion from plant enterprises: forestry, row crops, fruits, vegetables and horticulture.

- ♦\$569 million from fisheries enterprises/aquaculture: crawfish, catfish, alligator; marine fisheries: shrimp, crabs, commercial fin fish.

- ♦\$1.7 billion from animal enterprises: beef cattle, dairy, horses, poultry, sheep, goats, hogs.

These numbers do not include other service industries that impact the agriculture industry and state. According to a report by Dr. Matt Fannin of the LSU AgCenter, 238,000 people were employed in full or part-time agricultural jobs in 2009 and generated \$5 billion in employee wages and benefits in Louisiana. What could change this year's expectations? A hurricane that could damage crops still in the field or leave farmers unable to harvest. This is where Isaac comes in.

"For some commodities like sugarcane, Isaac may reduce harvest efficiency when having to harvest cane that is blown over. Also, if wet conditions per-

sist through harvest, we could see additional mud and trash when they harvest the cane. Historically, we know that when we harvest under wet conditions, we see an increase in the amount of mud and trash we have with the harvested cane and we typically see a reduction in the amount of sugar that can be recovered from each ton of sugarcane," said Guidry.

There are several commodities that are projected to have near-record to record yields but that is certainly not the case for all commodities. For commodities like citrus and pecans, Hurricane Isaac has had enough impact that they will not have record yields.

The USDA is projecting yields in 2012 that would be the highest in the 1980 to 2012 time frame for several commodities. Corn, grain sorghum, and rice are projected to have the highest yields during that time frame. For the others, 2012 yields are all above average and are approaching the highest yields in that time frame. For many of these commodities, yield expectations may be reduced in future USDA projections, but it appears, at this time, that yields for most of our major row crop commodities will certainly be significantly above their 5 year average.

Normally, a hurricane or major weather event could cause delays in the growing and harvest season. "Disasters are costly and the economic impact on agriculture can be devastating, ranging from several hundred million to billions in losses.

"When there's no profit, there's no ability to reinvest in operations and when farmers can't do that, it impacts the amount of money spent in their communities, the number of people they hire and whether they expand their operations," said Guidry.

For many rural communities, agriculture is what drives its economic engine. When business is good and profits are up more money is pumped into the local economy. Profitable producers spend more money which in turn increases the tax base for the local government and school board.

Grant awarded to LDAF for feed safety program

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is the recipient of a three year, \$300,000 federal grant to enhance its food safety program.

The grant, awarded to food and feed regulatory agencies to build their inspection program capacity, stems from the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) which became law in January 2011. The key focus of FSMA is to update the

way feed and food are regulated.

“The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) realized there was a need to enhance food safety procedures. This financial assistance will help the Department of Agriculture and Forestry make the necessary changes to boost inspection capabilities and help ensure food safety,” said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

The grant will fund:

- 1) A temporary “Feed Inspection Coordinator” position through the grant funding period
- 2) Feed safety training for the LDAF Office of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences inspection staff
- 3) Various meetings and training events hosted by LDAF for the Louisiana feed industry
- 4) Creation of a Louisiana Feed

Manufacturing Facility Inventory

5) Publishing of educational materials for both the Louisiana feed industry and consumers.

“This grant is a step toward achieving the goal of an integrated food safety system between state and federal regulatory agencies to help ensure a safe livestock feed supply for the Louisiana farmer and safe pet foods for the Louisiana pet owner,” added Strain.







Sweet Potato Chicken Burger

1 lb. ground chicken, white meat only	1/2 tsp. paprika
1 cup finely shredded sweet potato	1/4 tsp. ground cumin
2 tbsps. chopped cilantro	1 tbsp. vegetable oil
1/2 tsp. salt	4 hamburger buns
1/2 tsp. garlic powder	1 cup fresh spinach
1/2 tsp. ground cinnamon	Cilantro leaves
1/2 tsp. ground coriander	1 medium tomato, sliced

In a medium bowl, combine chicken, sweet potato, cilantro, salt, garlic powder, cinnamon, coriander, paprika, and cumin. Form mixture into 4 (3/4-inch thick) patties. In a large nonstick skillet, heat oil over medium heat. Add patties, and cook 5 to 6 minutes per side or until an instant-read thermometer inserted into center reads 165 degrees. Serve patties on buns topped with spinach, cilantro, tomato slices, and Apricot Ketchup (recipe below).

Apricot Ketchup

1/4 cup ketchup	1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon
2 tbsps. apricot preserves	1/4 tsp. ground cumin
1/2 tsp. paprika	1/4 tsp. ground coriander

In a small bowl, combine all ingredients.

Sweet Potato Praline Brownies

1 large sweet potato	1/2 tsp. baking powder
5 large egg whites	2 tps. vanilla extract, divided
1 cup softened unsalted butter, divided	1 cup brown sugar
1 cup sugar	1/4 tsp. salt
1 1/2 cup chopped pecans, divided	1/2 cup evaporated milk
1/2 cup unsweetened cocoa powder	1/2 cup confectioners' sugar

Prick sweet potato all over with a fork. Wrap in a wet paper towel and microwave on high for 5 minutes and continue in 2-minute intervals until soft. Set aside to cool then peel, mash, and reserve pulp. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Lightly grease an 8-inch square baking pan. In a large bowl, beat egg whites at high speed with an electric mixer until stiff peaks form. In another bowl, combine 1/2 cup butter and sugar. Add cocoa powder, baking powder, and 1 teaspoon vanilla. Gently fold in egg whites to combine. Stir in 1/2 cup pecans and sweet potato. Transfer to prepared pan, and bake 25 to 30 minutes or until center is firm. In a heavy saucepan, melt 1/2 cup butter over medium heat. Add brown sugar and salt, and bring to a boil. Cook for 2 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat, and slowly whisk in evaporated milk. Return saucepan to stove and bring mixture to a boil again. Boil, stirring constantly, until mixture reaches 230 degrees on a candy thermometer. Remove from heat, and stir for 2 minutes; let cool to lukewarm. Add remaining 1 teaspoon vanilla and confectioners' sugar. Pour mixture over warm brownies and top with remaining 1 cup pecans. Let cool to room temperature before cutting.

Cheesy Sweet Potato Mac

8 oz. macaroni (about 2 cups)	1 cup whole milk
1 (15 oz.) can sweet potatoes	1 cup shredded fontina cheese
2 tbsps. butter	1/2 cup soft bread crumbs
2 tbsps. all-purpose flour	1/2 cup grated Parmesan
1/2 tsp. salt	1/3 cup chopped pecans
1/2 tsp. ground black pepper	1 tbsp. pecan oil
1 cup heavy whipping cream	

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Cook pasta according to package directions, and drain. Return to pot, and add sweet potatoes. In a large saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Whisk in flour, salt, and pepper, and cook for 2 minutes. Whisk in cream and milk; cook, stirring frequently, until thickened, about 3 minutes. Stir in fontina 1/4 cup at a time. Stir cheese sauce into pasta. Transfer macaroni and cheese to a 2-quart baking dish. In a small bowl, combine bread crumbs, Parmesan, pecans, and oil; sprinkle over pasta. Bake for 30 minutes or until bubbly and golden. Let stand 10 minutes before serving.

Sweet Potato Vietnamese Soup

1 tbsp. canola oil	2 tps. ground cumin
1 pound ground pork	1 1/2 tps. ground cardamom
1 small onion, finely chopped	1/4 tsp. ground nutmeg
1/4 cup chopped fresh basil, divided	2 sweet potatoes, peeled and cut into 1/2-inch cubes (about 2 cups)
1 (3-inch) piece lemongrass	1 quart chicken stock
3 cloves garlic, minced	1 (13.5 oz.) can light coconut milk
1 jalapeño pepper, chopped	Garnish: chopped fresh cilantro, jalapeño pepper slices
2 tps. grated fresh ginger	

In large stockpot, heat oil over medium heat. Add pork, onion, 2 tablespoons basil, lemongrass, garlic, jalapeño, ginger, cumin, cardamom, and nutmeg. Cook until pork is browned and onion is soft, about 10 minutes. Add sweet potatoes, chicken stock, and coconut milk. Bring to a simmer; cover and cook until sweet potatoes are tender, about 20 minutes. Uncover, remove lemongrass, and add salt and pepper to taste. Garnish with remaining basil, cilantro, and jalapeño.

Sweet Potato Corn Spoonbread

1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese, softened	1 cup frozen corn, thawed
1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened	1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
1 (15 oz.) can cut sweet potatoes in syrup, drained and coarsely mashed	2 large eggs
1 (15 oz.) can creamed corn	3/4 medium yellow onion, finely chopped (about 1 cup)
1 (8.5 oz.) box cornbread mix	1/2 cup chopped pecan pralines

Preheat oven 375 degrees. In a large bowl, combine cream cheese and butter; beat at medium speed with an electric mixer until well combined. Stir in sweet potatoes, creamed corn, cornbread mix, corn kernels, parsley, eggs, and onion. Pour into an 8-inch square baking dish, and top with chopped pralines. Bake about 45 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean.

Labor Department adds electronic filing for H-2A and H-2B visa programs

The United States Department of Labor recently announced the implementation of electronic filing in the H-2A and H-2B visa programs through the iCERT Visa Portal System.

The new electronic filing capability will enhance the accessibility and quality of labor certification services, reduce the data collection and reporting burden on small employers, facilitate more streamlined business processes, and establish greater transparency in the labor department's decisions.

Electronic filing in the H-2B program begins

October 15, 2012. Electronic filing in the H-2A program begins December 10, 2012.



In advance of these implementation dates, the federal labor department will publish a *Federal Register* notice formally announcing implementation of electronic filing, and conduct four webinar training sessions to orient the public to electronic filing in the H-2A and H-2B programs. Strain to lead NASDA task force group

The National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) selected Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., to lead a task force focused on creating proactive messaging for stakeholders.

At a meeting with NASDA last week, Strain suggested NASDA members become more effective in communicating the importance of the nation's agricultural industry by speaking with one voice instead of individual voices. That messaging can come in many forms including social media.

Agriculture industries and agribusinesses, commodity and trade organizations, and universities and learning institutions are the targeted audiences.

Strain said, "The goal is to show the benefits agriculture brings to the country. For example, the agricultural industry provides people with the safest and highest quality food and fiber supply. This messaging model also supports the One Health concept which incorporates principles of the environment, plants and animals."



Protect property from termites post Isaac

Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is urging builders and homeowners to take steps to prevent the spread of termites as they rebuild and remodel after Hurricane Isaac.

"Since Isaac, we have received several calls from people who are concerned about termites. If your community flooded and treated soil was washed away by the hurricane, most likely the pesticide barrier no longer exists around your home or business and the area may need to be retreated," Strain said. "Bait stations need to be evaluated for replacement as well.

"Termite colonies are constantly

looking for new food sources. Now is the time to take proactive measures to prevent termites from destroying your investments," added Strain.

Structures in south Louisiana are typically treated with a preventative barrier either pre-construction, during construction or post-construction. Some owners also choose to build with termite-treated or termite-resistant products. After construction, baiting stations and liquid treatments are used as tools for detecting and destroying termite colonies.

"Consumers should contact the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry at 225-925-4578 to make sure the pesticide

company you hire is fully certified and licensed. This protects you, your family, your home or your business," said Strain.

Treatments and annual inspections by a licensed, insured and bonded pest control company are a good termite preventative. Between professional inspections, owners should periodically inspect their home or business for evidence of termites. Look for mud tubes on the slabs, piers or walls and pinholes in wallboards, softness in flooring or blisters in paint or wallpaper.
