



What looks like any other home in the Goodwood area of Baton Rouge is anything but ordinary. It's a modest home that sits on an acre and a half of land in the middle of the city. And on that acre and a half is what is called an urban farm.

"When we bought this property 15 years ago, we didn't say, 'Ooh, a farm. We simply wanted the land,'" said Chris Frink, a former newspaper journalist and current state employee. Frink says he and his wife, veterinarian Emily Taylor, intended to create an oasis of exotic flowers in the yard, but it did not work out as planned.

"I can't tell you how much money we spent on native azaleas and how many we killed. So we built a raised bed garden and when the economy started going down in 2007-2008, we bought our first chickens."

The chickens, or "the girls," as Frink refers to them have been raised on the Frink property since they were chicks. He's even named a few of them. "Joan" is named after a character played by actress Christina Hendricks on the AMC series "Mad Men" whom Frink describes as a "flashy red head." Joan and 12 other hens live in an 8x8 foot hen house which took Frink about three months to build.

Of the 13 chickens, only five still lay eggs. He acknowledges that he'd rather spend his money and time on chickens that produce. However, when asked what he plans to do with them, without missing a beat, Frink said he can't bring himself to eat "the girls." "I know they're not pets. We don't cuddle with



them or take them for walks like you would do with a dog, but I can't slaughter them."

Chickens aren't the only thing he is raising at his place. He's got 17 citrus trees on the property and a fig tree that he makes fig preserves and fig ice cream from. "It's the fig that got me to appreciate the seasons. Fig season is short so there's a limited amount of time to enjoy the fruit. There's nothing like picking fresh figs off the tree."

Frink also has tomatoes he planted from seed but lost most of his crop because of the delay caused by Hurricane Isaac. However, there's much more than just tomatoes. He says he can make an entire, well balanced meal right from his backyard. He's got broccoli, cauliflower, spinach, lettuce, mustard greens, collards and basil.

Frink said he and his wife, Emily, have always appreciated the fresh fruits and vegetables from the Baton Rouge Farmer's Market but one day a chance meeting with a shop owner who sells honey at the market gave Frink an idea.

"Emily was speaking with Liz Holloway who owns Bocage Bee and Honey Company in Baton Rouge and she was telling Liz about our citrus trees – satsuma, lemon, lime, orange and grapefruit – and Liz said, 'You could make the greatest honey!' Well, the light went off."

So now, Frink and his wife are in the bee business. As Frink fearlessly stands next to his bee colony *See Urban farming, continued on page 20*

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Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Commissioner supports clean cities effort

Baton Rouge, LA (October 18, 2012) – Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., was the keynote speaker for the Greater Baton Rouge Clean Cities Coalition and National Alternative Fuel Vehicle Day.

“Since taking office nearly five years ago, one of many goals has been to run our office more efficiently and look for ways to cut

costs in an effort to be good stewards of taxpayer money. Right now, the average gallon of gas costs us \$3.30. We anticipate spending approximately 80 cents per gallon using the compressed natural gas vehicles,” said Strain. “In addition to that, we are always looking for opportunities to advance quality of life and we support those efforts that are not only cost effective but environ-

mentally sound,” Strain added.

Greater Baton Rouge Clean Cities Coalition is promoting the use of alternative fuel and advanced technology vehicles during its National Alternative Fuel Vehicle Day Odyssey event. It’s one of 160 events being held nationwide.

“So far, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry has purchased one com-

pressed natural gas (CNG) vehicle. As of now, we plan to purchase a few more to test the product in our effort to save money, improve air quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions,” added Strain.

The effort is supported in part by the U.S. Department of Energy through a grant for the Advanced Electric Drive Vehicle Education Program.

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

I'd like to acknowledge a honor recently bestowed on Deputy Commissioner Brent Robbins' late father, who was posthumously inducted in the National 4-H Hall of Fame on Oct. 12 in Chevy Chase, Md. Robbins also hatched chicks for 4-H members to participate in poultry projects and helped students raise championship-quality animals. Robbins served as an original 4-H board member and later as president for the foundation.

Robbins believed in community service and took part in 4-H projects such as making toys and repairing bicycles for special-needs children.

Robbins and his wife raised nine children, including our very own Dr. Brent Robbins, whom we are grateful to have on board here at the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. Leroy Robbins' hard work and commitment to family and community is an inspiration to us all.

with bees swarming all around, he explains the bee business is a real learning curve. He's even a member of the Capitol Area Beekeepers' Association which he says gave him an outlet to learn what he needed to learn to get started.

"This was harder than chickens. You've got to manage bees. You have to look at the colonies and know what you're seeing. You need to look for how many babies the queen is producing and if the apiary isn't overcrowded because if it's overcrowded, they will swarm and leave."

Frink says what makes his honey so special is the number of citrus trees he has on the property. The bees take the nectar from the citrus blossoms and transfer it to the honey giving it a citrus flavor. "I have sold so much honey this year that we'll have to include it on our tax return."

So, you may be wondering how Frink became so interested in urban farming? He grew up in a city and remains a city dweller. "My interest came from having the land and feeling called to do something. For us, it's knowing where our food comes from. We eat a lot less processed foods than we used to. Just planting your own tomatoes is rewarding. Oh my gosh, the BLTs! We have them at least once a week for dinner because our tomatoes are so good."

Frink claims anyone can do this. "You can plant vegetables in pots. You can even have chickens. We have some of the best chicken laws in Baton Rouge."

While Frink says he's gotten in touch with the seasons because of the planting and he does have fun with what he produces, he acknowledges that it is a lot of work. He says he has a greater appreciation for farmers who make a living out of what they produce. "I have a tremendous amount of respect for farmers. I have a bumper sticker - No Farmers, No Food." Isn't that the truth.

So you may be wondering why Frink named his farm "Urban Insanity". It's simple. He says he wanted to reference the fact they live in a city and he says his two daughters, Helen and Camille, think their parents are "crazy". What is

absolutely clear - Frink is he is extremely passionate about his farm. He loves the work although it can be challenging and he takes a lot of pride in the fact it is homegrown and everything he sells is a product of the great state of Louisiana.

Frink will share his experiences as an urban farmer when he participates in a workshop Saturday, November 17, 2012 at the LSU AgCenter's Burden Center. The workshop is called "Backyard Chickens are Easy." It starts at 10 a.m.

Food Access Summit set for Nov. 7 in Baton Rouge

Several Louisiana organizations concerned with food production and distribution have planned a Food Access Summit Nov. 7 at the Pennington Biomedical Research Center. The purpose is to promote communication among these various groups.

The summit is from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will include sessions on developing local food policy councils, initiating farm-to-school programs, and implementing a hunger-free Louisiana plan, according to Annrose Guarino, LSU AgCenter nutritionist and one of the summit organizers.

"We hope to strengthen connections between agriculture and communities and make fresh and nutritious foods available to more people," Guarino said.

Guest speakers will include Mike Strain, commissioner of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry; Bill Ludwig, a U.S. Department of Agriculture regional administrator from Dallas, Texas; Rep. Scott Simon, the Louisiana legislator who sponsored the legislation establishing a state Sustainable Local Food Policy Council; and Paul Coreil, LSU AgCenter vice chancellor.

Guarino said about 300 people across the state are expected to attend, including farmers, non-profit organizations, policy mak-

ers and school officials.

Other topics to be covered include establishing school and community gardens, food stamps and farmers markets, and utilization of local foods in school lunch programs.
