Prepare for wildfire season

Wildfire season starts in December and lasts through April. Something as simple as a grass or brush fire can get out of control so now is the time to prepare your property to prevent damage from wildfires.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) helps protect nearly 19 million acres of land. The leading causes of wildfires in Louisiana are debris burning and arson. An estimated 40 homes and 75 outbuildings are either damaged or destroyed each year in Louisiana as a result of wildfires.

“Remember, safety comes first. Listen to the warnings of officials as we head into the often dry winter months. Follow the guidelines of the prescribed burning protocol. Don’t burn during high winds and extremely dry conditions and

monitor fires until they burn out,” said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

For the past 10 years, records indicate an annual average of 2,087 wildfires burning 22,305 acres of forestland in Louisiana. In addition to the destruction of valuable forestland and the impact on the economy through the loss of this important natural resource, wildfires seriously threaten countless rural structures, equipment and people on a daily basis. Millions of dollars worth of property is severely threatened but damage can be minimized by timely and effective wildfire suppression.

The website, www.firewise.org provides tips on how to reduce your risk of damage from wildfires:

-Clear leaves and other debris from gutters, eaves, porches and decks. This prevents

embers from igniting your home.

-Keep lawns hydrated and maintained. Dry grass and shrubs are fuel for wildfire.

-Remove flammable materials (firewood stacks, propane canisters, dry vegetation) within 5 feet of the home’s foundation and outbuildings, including garages and sheds. If it can catch fire, don’t let it touch the house, deck or porch.

-Limit vegetation surrounding the home’s perimeter to at least 30-100 feet, depending on the area’s wildfire risk.

-Create a “fire-free” area within five feet of the home, using non-flammable landscaping materials such as rocks, pavers and/or high-moisture content annuals and perennials.

-If you have trees on your property, prune so the lowest branches are 6 to 10 feet from the ground.

-Don’t let debris and lawn cuttings linger. Dispose of these items quickly to reduce fuel for fire.

-When planting, choose slow-growing, carefully placed shrubs and trees so the area can be more easily maintained.

-Landscape with native and less-flammable plants.

The LDAF is the only State agency with statewide wildland fire-fighting capabilities. LDAF fire crews work in conjunction with local fire departments. Fires are detected by aircraft or are reported by public citizens, and are then suppressed by trained forestry crews.

The Office of Forestry administers the Certified Prescribed Burn Manager Program, which is designed to promote the safe and effective use of prescribed fire in the management of natural resources. Pay attention to your local fire officials when burn bans are in effect. The LDAF website (www.ldaf.state.la.us) also gives notice when there is a burn ban in effect in certain areas. 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LDAF launches new public awareness campaign

Louisiana is one of several states participating in a new public awareness campaign promoting the benefits of prescribed burning. The One Message, Many Voices (OMMV) campaign goal is to encourage citizens to enjoy outdoor activities, and to increase public awareness of wildfire prevention and maintenance of healthy forests

through the website visitmyforest.org.

Prescribed burning is a controlled burn conducted to decrease the likelihood of an out of control fire.

Public Service Announcements are currently airing across the state and radio, print and billboard ads will soon feature the OMMV message.

LDAF implements structural pest control online reporting

Baton Rouge, La. (November 5, 2012) - The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is utilizing a new tool to help protect consumers. The licensee or permittee for structural pest control companies must report monthly to LDAF all contracts for post construction and pre-treatment termite work performed. The benefits of the new reporting system are two fold. It is an added convenience for pest control compa-

nies and the LDAF because the new online system will make this reporting more timely and efficient in that payment can be made electronically. LDAF will then use the online eradication, wood destroying insect and termite perimeter application reports to monitor the work conducted by the pest control agents.

"While most pest control companies do an excellent job and are professional, it is our job to ensure that consumers who hire

pest control companies to conduct wood destroying insect and termite control inspections are getting what they pay for and that the work is done properly," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. "This new tool will allow the LDAF easier access to monitor the work that is being performed."

The LDAF is responsible for administering many of the programs and enforcing the laws, rules and regulations that impact

every aspect of the state's agriculture and forestry industries, including structural pest control.

Strain added, "As always, when you are having any kind of pesticide applied in or around your home or business, be sure you hire a licensed or certified pest control operator. You may call the LDAF at 225-925-4578 to verify the person you want to hire is licensed or certified. This protects you, your family and pets, your home and your business."





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Rice board approves funding 17 research projects

The Louisiana Rice Research Board met Oct. 29 to decide how funds from checkoff money should be spent on research projects to benefit fellow farmers.

The board approved \$1.3 million in funding for 17 projects, after hearing several hours of presentations from LSU AgCenter scientists.

The checkoff funds are derived from a 5-cent self-assessed fee collected on every 100 pounds of rice produced and sold in Louisiana. Farmers approved renewal of the checkoff program in January.

"These funds are investments in our future as rice farmers," said Board Chairman Jackie Loewer, a farmer from Branch. "The board's money is being well spent by scientists working on such programs as breeding new varieties, disease resistance, salt tolerance in new rice lines, hybrid rice, testing of new herbicides and insecticides, fertilizer applications and fungicide work."

Loewer said the projects are practical and aimed at solving problems encountered by all rice farmers.

"As farmers, we individually don't have the resources to have our own research and development department," Loewer said. "So as farmers, we pool our money together and help provide funding for our research team."

Steve Linscombe, director of the LSU AgCenter Rice Research Station, said the board's funds represent a large portion of the money required to conduct research. "With budget cuts in the past several years, the board's contribution toward our mission to help farmers is appreciated even more," he said. "We could not maintain the current level of research without the checkoff funds."

Also at the board meeting, outgoing board member Linda Zaunbrecher, of Gueydan, was recognized for her six years of service. New board member Ronnie Sonnier, of Kinder, attended his first meeting.

Projects to be conducted with the board funds are:

–Economic analysis of rice production and farm management in Louisiana, Mike Salassi, economist.

–Integrated management strategies for insect pests of rice in Louisiana, Mike Stout, entomologist.

–Characterization and use of genetic traits for resistance to multiple diseases of rice, Jong Hyun Ham, plant pathologist.

–Study of the biology and management of *Cercospora* disease in rice, Clayton Hollier, plant pathologist.

–Weed management in rice, Eric Webster, weed scientist.

–Breeding rice varieties with tolerance to salt and other stresses, Prasanta Subudhi, plant breeder.

Rice Research Station overall support, Linscombe.

–Development of disease control in rice, Don Groth, plant pathologist.

–Rice management strategies for efficient use of agronomic inputs and natural resources, Dustin Harrell, agronomist.

–Multiple generation rice breeding nursery, Linscombe.

–Enhancement of rice research and extension communications, Linscombe.

–Development of superior rice varieties for Louisiana, Linscombe.

–Marker-assisted breeding and development of molecular markers for important traits in Louisiana rice production, Herry Utomo, molecular biologist.

–Characterization of high-protein rice lines and development of herbicide-resistant rice, Ida Wenefrida, rice researcher.

–Development of hybrid rice and sheath blight-resistant germplasm for Louisiana, James Oard, geneticist.

–Rice research verification program, Johnny Saichuk, rice specialist.

–Rapid, on-site evaluation of soil salinity and zinc deficiency, David Weindorf, soil scientist.

Hispanic and women farmer and rancher claims period

Hispanic and women farmers and ranchers who allege discrimination by the USDA in past decades may file claims until March 25, 2013.

The process offers a voluntary alternative to litigation for each Hispanic or female farmer and rancher who can prove that USDA denied their applications for loan or loan servicing assistance for discriminatory reasons for certain time periods between 1981 and 2000.

As announced in February 2011, the voluntary claims process will make available at least \$1.33 billion for cash awards and tax relief payments, plus up to \$160 million in farm debt relief, to eligible Hispanic and women farmers and ranchers. There are no filing fees to participate in the program.

The Department will continue reaching out to potential Hispanic and female claimants, around the country to get the word out to individuals who may be eligible for this program so they have the opportunity to participate.

Claimants must register for a claims package (by calling the number or visiting the website) and the claims package will be mailed to claimants. Independent legal services companies will administer the claims process and adjudicate the claims. Although there are no filing fees to participate and a lawyer is not required to participate in the claims process, persons seeking legal advice may contact a lawyer or other legal services provider.

Cattle ranchers learn basics of marsh burning

Cattle owners and ranch managers in Cameron Parish learned the basics of smoke management in prescribed burns used to control coastal marsh vegetation.

Niels De Hoop, LSU AgCenter forestry specialist, said prescribed burning is a tool used by foresters and sugarcane farmers and in marshland for cattle at a meeting here on Oct. 30. But the smoke resulting from intentional fires can become a problem if guidelines are not followed, he said.

Louisiana state law has established a certification for prescribed burns. "It all came out of concerns for liability," De Hoop said.

Certification means a burn manager cannot be held liable unless negligence can be shown, De Hoop explained, but the law has never been tested in court.

After the class, participants were tested in order to receive their certifications. A burn management class also was held earlier in the month in Lafayette.

De Hoop said currently separate trainings and certifications are used for sugarcane, forestry and marshland burning, but an effort under way may consolidate training and certification for all three uses of prescribed burns.

Andy Nyman, AgCenter coastal marshland specialist, said burning

marshland reduces the fuel from dead plant material and improves marsh grass quality. He said marshes need to be burned every five years. Naturally occurring fires from lightning are not as effective now because roads and canals have limited the size of fires.

Nyman discussed the best times to burn, with consideration to wind speed and direction, humidity and water levels.

Nyman said plant roots hold soils, making them essential for maintaining marsh and minimizing land subsidence. Burning enhances the volume of organic material, he said.

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
