

## Seeing the Light at Lighthouse Ranch for Boys *A ministry to youth*

It started as a ranch for troubled boys in South Dakota. Thirty-four years ago, affordable land a few miles south of Loranger brought the program to Louisiana. Lighthouse Ranch for Boys now sits on 40 acres in Tangipahoa Parish.

The young men in need of disciplinary help come from around Louisiana and all over the country – Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Massachusetts, Michigan and Texas to name a few states. They range in age from 12 to 18 years old. “We hope this is a step before they get to jail. We want to do whatever we can to ensure these boys have a chance in life,” said Dave Barley, facilities manager for Lighthouse Ranch.

Barley describes Lighthouse’s education program as accredited and an accelerated Christian program. “We’ve had success stories. A recent graduate is now home in Boston where he’s enrolled in college and hopes to become a civil engineer. Another graduate is home in Michigan and working,” said Barley. Lighthouse Ranch is also a place where they teach these young men life skills.

“Most of these boys come to the ranch and only know how to sit on the sofa and push buttons. Our goal is to

teach them how to grow or build something so they can get some practical skills,” said Barley.

With food being the highest expense at the ranch, after insurance, the ranch’s organizers developed an agricultural program to teach the boys how to grow their own food. “There are so many people who need help from the food bank that we decided to grow our own,” added Barley.

They plant seeds during suggested planting times and anyone in the program learns how to plant, till and monitor the progress of their fruits and vegetables. Currently, they’re growing lettuce, radishes, onions, tomatoes, squash, egg plant, melons, green beans, okra and cucumbers.

“We teach them practical things such as how to make salsa out of tomatoes. They really like that. They learn how to can green beans and clean, process and store vegetables,” said Barley.

Fifteen-year-old Mitchell Miller has been at the school for just over a month. A resident of Lake Charles, he said he was having trouble with showing respect to the people he interacts with and had a really negative *See Ranch, continued on page 20*

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Strain urges horse owners to prepare for WNV, EEE

As summertime approaches and mosquitoes become more prevalent, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is urging horse owners to vaccinate their animals for both Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) and the West Nile Virus (WNV).

Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "While many horses have been tested throughout the

state, we have not found any animals that are positive for either disease. However, recent tests by the Louisiana Office of Public Health have indicated that a mosquito pool has tested positive in West Baton Rouge Parish so it is important for horse owners to be proactive to prevent the virus from spreading. Horses are infected the same way humans are

infected – by being bitten by infected mosquitoes - so everyone needs to take extra precautionary measures at this time."

If a mosquito bites an infected bird, EEE or WNV can be spread to horses, dogs, cats and humans. These mosquito-transmitted diseases can cause inflammation or swelling of the brain and spinal cord.

Prevention includes avoiding mosquitoes, removing standing water and using mosquito repellants that are safe for horses and humans. Horses can also be vaccinated. So far, there is no vaccination approved for people. Horse owners should contact their local veterinarian regarding proper vaccination protocols during this time of increased risk.





#### Cool 'n' Crunchy Egg Salad

4 oz. cream cheese, softened	1/2 cup finely chopped carrots
2 tbsps. mayonnaise	2 tbsps. chopped pimiento
1 tbsp. sweet pickle relish	stuffed green olives
4 hard-cooked eggs, chopped	lettuce leaves, and/or tomato slices, optional

In a medium sized bowl, stir together first 3 ingredients. Stir in remaining ingredients until evenly coated with dressing. Cover and chill to blend flavors. Serve on lettuce leaves and garnish with tomato slices, if desired.

#### Baked Eggs with Creamy Spinach Hash Browns

2 cups frozen Southern-style hash brown potatoes (12 oz.)	1/2 cup sour cream
1 cup sliced mushrooms	1/2 cup shredded Cheddar cheese, divided
1/4 cup water	1 tsp. dried dill weed
2 cups baby spinach	4 eggs

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Coat large nonstick skillet with cooking spray; heat over medium-high heat until hot. Add potatoes, mushrooms and water; mix and spread in even layer. Cook, covered, 8 minutes. Turn vegetables over; cook, uncovered, until soft, about 6 minutes. Remove from heat. Add spinach, sour cream, 1/4 cup cheese and dill weed; mix well. Divide mixture evenly among four greased 10-oz. ramekins or custard cups. Press an indentation (about 2-inch diameter) into center of mixture with back of spoon. Place on baking sheet. Break and slip an egg into each indentation. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake in 350-degree oven until whites are completely set and yolks begin to thicken but are not hard, 25 to 30 minutes.

#### Monte Cristo Sandwiches

4 slices loaf bread	2 slices Swiss or mozzarella cheese
2 tbsps. honey mustard	2 eggs, beaten
2 thin slices ham	1/4 cup fat free half and half
2 thin slices turkey	1-2 tbsps. butter

Spread one side of 2 bread slices with mustard. Top remaining 2 slices with ham, cheese slice and turkey slice. Close sandwiches with mustard side down. Combine eggs and half and half in a small bowl and using wire whisk beat to combine. Place sandwiches in a shallow casserole dish and pour batter over sandwiches, pressing to absorb liquid. Turn sandwiches and press. Refrigerate sandwiches for 15 minutes. Heat a large skillet over medium heat and melt butter. Cook sandwiches in skillet on each side until golden brown and cheese has melted. May turn sandwiches again to make sure batter is cooked and bread is crispy. Cut each sandwich into 4 triangles.

#### Stuffed French Toast

30 to 36 thin French bread or baguette slices, 1/2" slices	1 can (8 oz) crushed pineapple, undrained
4 oz. cream cheese, softened	1/4 cup orange juice
1 cup strawberry preserves	2 tsp. freshly grated orange peel
8 eggs	1 tsp. vanilla
1-1/2 cups milk	1/2 tsp. salt

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Spread 1/2 of the bread slices with cream cheese and strawberry preserves and top with remaining bread slices to make little sandwiches. Arrange sandwiches in greased 13 x 9-inch glass baking dish. Whisk eggs in medium bowl until foamy. Stir in milk, pineapple, orange juice, orange peel, vanilla and salt. Slowly pour egg mixture over bread; press bread into egg mixture. Cover and refrigerate at least 1 hour or overnight. Bake in center of oven until puffed, golden and knife inserted near centers comes out clean, about 45 to 50 minutes.

#### Texas-Style Egg & Potato Skillet

4 thick slices turkey bacon, chopped	1/2 cup pico de gallo or salsa
1 medium baking potato, diced	1/2 cup shredded smoked Cheddar cheese
8 eggs, beaten	6 (8-inch) flour tortilla, warmed

Cook bacon in large nonstick skillet over medium heat until edges begin to brown. Pour off drippings. Add potato; cook and stir until potato is tender and browned and bacon is crisp, 6 to 8 minutes. Pour eggs over mixture in skillet. As eggs begin to set, gently pull the eggs across the pan with an inverted turner, forming large soft curds. Continue cooking - pulling, lifting and folding eggs - until thickened and no visible liquid egg remains. Do not stir constantly. Stir in pico de gallo; heat through. Sprinkle with cheese. Serve with tortillas.

#### Bacon, Egg & Mushroom Burritos

6 thick slices applewood-smoked turkey bacon
4 oz. fresh shiitake or button mushrooms, stemmed, sliced
4 oz. fresh baby arugula or spinach (4 cups)
12 eggs, beaten

Cook bacon in 12-inch nonstick skillet over medium heat until crisp. Remove bacon; pour off all but 1 tablespoon of drippings. Add mushrooms; sauté over medium heat 2 minutes. Add arugula; cook until wilted, about 1 minute. Pour eggs over mixture in skillet. As eggs begin to set, gently pull the eggs across the pan with an inverted turner, forming large soft curds. Continue cooking - pulling, lifting and folding eggs - until thickened and no visible liquid egg remains. Do not stir constantly. Season with salt and pepper. Spoon egg mixture into center of each tortilla, dividing evenly; top each with 1 bacon slice. Fold in sides of tortillas, then roll up burrito-style.

attitude until now. He's been participating in the agricultural program.

"I work in the garden on Fridays and help with the tilling. I love it. I planted the first two rows of corn, cherry tomatoes, squash and okra. I also clean the weeds out of the garden," said Miller. But the program is doing other things for him too. He says his parents found the program over the internet and he was reluctant to go at first. "I feel so much closer to God now and I haven't been getting into trouble."

Barley said they don't push a specific religion on the boys since they come from different backgrounds. "We mostly encourage positive thinking, respect, how to be grateful and hope they develop spiritually."

Miller is also improving in school. "I started at a fifth grade level. Now, in a very short period of time, I'm reading at a seventh grade level. My reading and math skills are really improving."

Barley said the agricultural program is something the students can see results from their hard work and it's very rewarding. They also have a goal of starting a beef program. "We have a barn. We'd love for someone to donate a couple of heifers and a bull. As I've said, food is our second highest expense." They also want to start a small engine repair business. Barley says that's another skill they can learn and use when they leave or graduate from the program.

Currently, there are seven boys enrolled in the school. They are graded on their schoolwork and the skills they develop. A typical day is regimented. They get up at the same time, go to school and eat their meals at the same time. After school, they perform certain chores

such as emptying trash, mowing grass, sweeping and mopping unless they're involved in the agricultural program in which those boys work in the garden.

But it's not all about discipline. The program's directors also make time for fun. If a student has been well behaved, they are allowed to ride horses, play sports or electronic games and are frequently treated to a special outing such as going out to dinner or a movie.

Barley said the biggest challenge is making sure there is balance with the boys. He said you have to understand their backgrounds, where they come from and most importantly, you have to be available to them. "Sometimes they just need someone to talk to. We've noticed that they respond better and respect you when there is a balance of being stern but also loving. You can't be super strict. You need to show them kindness and understanding."

Lighthouse Ranch officials say it's sometimes difficult to keep these troubled teens in the program because funding is often an issue. "There is a cost to enroll the student. It can cost per family up to \$1,500 or more per month. Because we're a non-profit, we mostly rely on donations," he added.

At the end of the day, Barley said he hopes the kids learn to be disciplined, how to clean up after themselves and respect others. "We also hope they leave here with a better outlook on life as a Christian and become productive citizens in life with a career goal in mind."

## Forage featured at research station field day

BOSSIER CITY, La. – Growing grass efficiently was the focus of the LSU AgCenter Red River Research Station Beef and Forage Field Day held April 16.

Farmers and ranchers have several herbicide options available for pastures said LSU AgCenter weed scientist Ron Strahan. He showed a plot where several different chemicals were used to treat the broadleaf weed curly dock.

2,4-D is the cheapest option at roughly \$3 an acre, Strahan said. A quart of 2,4-D per acre caused damage to clover, but using only a pint per acre would still be effective and cause less clover injury.

Other chemicals, such as Weedmaster, Grazon P+D, Grazon Next and Surmount are options, but they also can injure clover, he said.

Grazon P+D contains 2,4-D plus the chemical picloram and performed best on curly dock. It costs \$8-\$10 per acre, but it can damage or kill desirable trees nearby, he said.

The herbicide Pasturegard is effective on woody plants, but it also damages clover, Strahan said.

He demonstrated the "hack-and-squirt" method of killing Chinese tallow trees, using an axe or machete to cut a slash into the tree, followed by an application of

Grazon P+D. "It has been 100 percent effective on Chinese tallow."

Legumes such as cowpeas are difficult to establish in a pasture, but they offer good forage, said LSU AgCenter forage researcher Buddy Pitman. Management is required to get the growth started. "You can't just scatter the seed out there and expect it to be a workable product," Pitman said.

Keeping past soil test results will show any nutrient trends in a pasture's soil, said LSU AgCenter agronomist Wink Alison.

Urea has become a popular form of nitrogen fertilizer, but it tends to decompose if the application is not followed by rain three to four days later, Alison said.

A nitrogen loss of 20-25 percent is possible, but once the material is in the soil, volatilization is reduced. Urease inhibitors such as Agrotain offer protection against volatilization for several days, he said. Urea also increases soil acidity, requiring more frequent application of lime.

LSU AgCenter beef researcher Ryon Walker gave an overview of research projects at the Hill Farm and Red River research stations. Projects include a study of parasites that have become resistant to deworming treatments such as Ivomec.

Research is showing a treatment using different combinations of dewormers several times a year provides improved results, Walker said.

Another study is looking at calf performance based on cow size. He said larger cows may not result in larger calves at weaning, and larger cows may require more feed than predicted.

Ryegrass can be substituted for alfalfa to make baleage, said Mike McCormick, director of the LSU AgCenter Southeast Research Station at Franklinton. Special wrapping equipment is used to sheath round bales in several layers of plastic sheeting, protecting the hay from the elements.

Ryegrass has the potential for 18-20 percent protein, he said, which is comparable to alfalfa.

Ryegrass intended for baleage should be fertilized between Feb. 15 and March 15 and harvested at the boot stage with a drydown of 40-50 percent moisture, McCormick said.

Producers also heard details from Mike Barrington, of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry about the new federal animal identification regulations that will allow traceability of livestock moved across state lines.
