

Arrests made in Morehouse Parish cattle theft case

Five people are charged in connection with the theft of cattle in Morehouse Parish.

"Authorities received a tip from a concerned citizen who saw a trailer with a flat tire and loaded with cattle in the middle of the night. Thanks to the awareness and quick thinking on the part of this citizen, the cattle have been recovered," said Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

The break in the case came shortly before midnight on Saturday, June 8, when a citizen reported to the Morehouse Parish Sheriff's office that three trailer loads of cattle were stopped on Old Bonita Road. One of the trailers had a flat tire. The trailers contained 37 head of cattle belonging to Jeff Simmons Farms of Bastrop.

The individuals arrested are: 30-year-old Robert McKinney of Albany, La., 33-year-old Brandy Fralick of Albany, La., 24-year-old Rowdy Ray of Independence, La., 33-year-old Carey Hutchinson of Albany, La. and 24-year-old Kayla Stevenson of Amite, La. A 15-year-old juvenile was also taken into custody and later released to his family.

An investigation by the Morehouse Parish Sheriff's Office and LDAF Brand Inspectors revealed that Robert McKinney and Rowdy Ray were allegedly involved in the theft of 14 head of cattle from Dreher Farms of Bastrop which was reported on May 28, 2013.

Officials said the Dreher Ranch ear tags that were

removed from these cattle were found in McKinney's truck. Twelve head of these cattle were sold through the Amite sale barn in McKinney's name. Two others have been returned to Dreher Farms.

"These cases should serve as a reminder to farmers and ranchers that the branding of livestock with a registered brand is one of the best theft deterrents available to cattle producers. While ear tags can be removed, thieves are less likely to steal cattle that are branded," said Strain.

Upon further investigation, LDAF Brand Inspectors and deputies from the Livingston Parish Sheriff's Office recovered a new 2006 aluminum Featherlite living quarters horse trailer that was recently reported stolen from a dealership in Mississippi. This trailer was returned to the dealership on June 11. The Mississippi Ag/Theft Bureau is investigating. Authorities also recovered a Bayliner boat that was reported stolen from Union Parish.

McKinney and Ray are charged with two counts of felony theft of livestock. McKinney is also charged with possession of stolen property for the trailer, contributing to the delinquency of a juvenile and criminal conspiracy. The other suspects are charged with one count each of felony theft of livestock. If convicted, they face up to 10 years in prison for each of the theft charges.

McKinney remains in jail on \$130,000 bond. The other suspects have reportedly bonded out of jail.

2013 LDAF Legislative update

House Bill 166 (Act 185) by Rep. Anders - authorizes, rather than requires, the La. Tax Commission to assist the La. Forestry Commission in determining the annual value of trees, timber, and pulpwood for purposes of levying severance taxes.

House Bill 182 (sent to governor) by Rep. Anders-changes the requirement that the Dept. of Agriculture and Forestry promulgate guidelines regarding the exemption from the sales and use tax for raw agricultural commodities used in preparing crops or animals for market from a mandatory requirement to a permissive one.

House Bill 200 (Act 103) by Rep. Anders - makes appropriate changes to the licensing requirements for persons engaged in the landscape archi-

tect profession in order to reflect the changes in the administration of the national Landscape Architect Registration Examination.

House Bill 202 (Act 104) by Rep. Anders - requires the Department of Agriculture & Forestry to collect social security numbers on applications for licenses, permits and certificates in order to allow the Attorney General's office to collect on debts owed to the department.

House Bill 473 (Act 113) by Rep. Hugh-allows the Louisiana Agricultural Commodities Commission to meet four times per calendar year instead of at least once during each quarter of the year.

House Bill 510 (Act 200) by Rep. Chaney-removes the requirement

that the state veterinarian have three of five years of veterinary experience in the regulatory control of livestock disease. The bill additionally gives the state veterinarian the powers to establish, maintain and enforce quarantine lines; place movement restrictions on intrastate and interstate travel of animals; place livestock in quarantine; appoint inspectors to enter property to inspect and disinfect livestock; give written or oral instructions to a person to comply with the entry requirements; and make decisions based on the study of the causes of current disease risks and how to prevent the introduction of the spread of disease.

House Bill 633 (Act 115) by Rep. Lebas - This bill is purely a clean-up

bill which re-designates the definition section of law for the unlawful transportation of diseased animals or livestock or adulterated meat.

House Bill 664 (sent to governor) Rep. Terry Landry- updates various provisions related to sweet potato dealer's permits to reflect current practices in the industry. It additionally authorizes LDAF to refuse to renew a sweet potato dealer's permit to any person or business applying for a sweet potato dealer's permit if the person or business owes unpaid sweet potato fees, taxes, or civil penalties.

Senate Bill 168 (Act No. 26) by Sen. Thompson - Effective May 23, 2013, merges the La. Feed, Fertilizer, and Agricultural Liming Commission

with the Seed Commission to create the La. Agricultural Chemistry and Seed Commission. Accordingly, all powers, duties, and functions of the commissions are transferred to the new commission.

Attention: Bull sellers and buyers. All non-virgin bulls and bulls older than 24 months for sale in Louisiana must have a current negative trichomoniasis test from an accredited veterinarian before they may be sold. Virgin bulls must have a breeder's certification of virgin status signed by the breeder, the breeder's agent or an accredited veterinarian. Rice plants short for their age this year

The short height of this year's rice crop doesn't mean it is necessarily late in development, LSU AgCenter rice experts advised at the Acadia Parish Rice Field Day on June 14.

Johnny Saichuk, LSU AgCenter rice specialist, said many rice fields are already at the green ring stage, even though they don't look tall enough to be that developed.

Rice water weevils are also showing up later than usual, he said.

Because weather prevented herbicide applications, late-season weeds are already being found, he said. Insects, including redbanded stink bugs, are showing up, and fungicides will need to be applied soon.

"This may be the year you can actually

combine an insecticide and a fungicide," Saichuk said.

But, Saichuk said, experience has shown him that applying an insecticide before rice heads emerge is a waste of money.

Don Groth, LSU AgCenter plant pathologist, said most rice is more mature than it appears. He said so far he has received reports of sheath blight becoming widespread. "But, so far, we've had a light blast year," he said.

He said the next two to three weeks will be the prime time for fungicides.

The rate for Sercadis fungicide aimed at sheath blight resistant to most other fungicides has been increased to provide better protection, Groth said.

Mike Stout, LSU AgCenter entomologist, said the emergence of rice water weevils was delayed, but he said he has found substantial numbers of larvae.

Stout also said large numbers of Mexican rice borers have shown up in Jefferson Davis Parish, and he said it's only a matter of time before they are found in Acadia Parish.

"If it's not this year, then next year," he said, adding that it's not known what kind of problem the pest will be for Louisiana rice.

Steve Linscombe, LSU AgCenter rice breeder, said a medium-grain Clearfield line of rice is showing promise, and he wants to make it available to Kellogg's for testing. He said a Clearfield Jazzman variety also is

being grown in Puerto Rico, and it will be planted at the Rice Research Station this year.

Ron Levy, LSU AgCenter soybean specialist, said Louisiana farmers have planted as much as 1.3 million acres in soybeans.

"We probably replanted more than I can ever remember," Levy said. "We had a lot of fields replanted three and four times."

In north Louisiana, many fields had to be replanted because seedlings could not break through a dry crust that covered the soil.

Levy recommended farmers who are still planning to plant soybeans should use Group V varieties at a high plant population.

Dustin Harrell, LSU AgCenter agronomist, is conducting a study to find the optimum time for planting soybeans in southwest Louisiana. He is also conducting a study with Jeff Davis, LSU AgCenter entomologist, on how potassium fertilizer affects insects.

Eric Webster, LSU AgCenter weed scientist, showed farmers numerous rice plots of herbicide demonstrations with more than two dozen products for grasses, broadleaf weeds and aquatic plants.

Daniel Stephenson, LSU AgCenter weed scientist, talked about his work on the benefits of using pre-emergent soybean herbicides. He said the products can result in higher soybean yields, but rice farmers have to be careful to follow restrictions on when rice can be planted after the applications of some of the products.

Mayhaws in short supply this year

Charles and Nelda Hutchins have been making mayhaw jelly in their Grant Fruit Processing facility for 12 years. The couple buys mayhaw berries from growers in Louisiana and neighboring states, but they have never seen a mayhaw season this bad.

"Normally we buy 30,000 to 50,000 pounds. From this year's crop we got almost 2,500 pounds," Nelda Hutchins said.

In East Feliciana Parish, Don Lord has several mayhaw orchards. He sells his crop to the Hutchinses and says a late freeze wiped out his berries.

"The cold snaps are probably the biggest enemy we have, and the farther south you are, the more advantage you have," Lord said.

Lord also is a distributor of the Hutchinses' products and estimates he has "sold more

mayhaw jelly than anyone in the universe."

Despite the down year, there is still jelly to be had. Recently, the Hutchinses were making a batch of mayhaw jelly from the few berries they were able to get from Texas and Georgia.

They typically sell more jelly at Christmas than any other time of the year, but with the short supply of mayhaws, they don't expect to have any mayhaw jelly around by the end of the year.

Their Springhill Jelly brand also has muscadine, blueberry and other flavors, but mayhaw jelly is their best seller.

"Well probably the No. 1 thing in the South is nostalgia," Nelda Hutchins said. "They remember going into the woods and picking up mayhaws, and grandma or mama made

them some jelly. And it was the best jelly in the world."

Lord said he often is asked what mayhaw jelly tastes like. "I tell them, that is the thing about the mayhaw, it's unique and you can't tell anybody what it tastes like."

The mayhaw has a loyal following. Lord is one of about 100 growers. He and the Hutchinses are members of the Louisiana Mayhaw Association, a group dedicated to educating the public about mayhaws and helping mayhaw growers.

Lord said he is seeing interest in mayhaws rise.

"Every year the demand for mayhaws increases, and it looks like next year will be a big year," Lord said.

This year could have been a big year. The

Hutchinses said they received a record number of calls from people looking for mayhaw products.

"We also sell a lot of juice to the jelly makers that don't have the facilities that we have," Charles Hutchins said.

LSU AgCenter family and consumer science agent Quincy Cheek also gets a lot of calls from people looking for mayhaws and mayhaw products.

She says there is more to the berry than just jelly.

"There are different things you can do with it. Some of the people do ice cream. They make syrup with it. They do mayhaw vinaigrette," Cheek said.

The tart, red berry also can be used in baked goods.
