

Former Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Bob Odom began his agriculture service in 1960 as an employee of the department and was elected commissioner in 1979. There is something to be said for anyone who has dedicated most of their life to public service.

"Most notably and early on in his tenure, Odom combined all aspects of the agricultural industry under one department, making it more modern and operating more efficiently, and making it a model for other states. Odom was also a past president of the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) which helped bring the Louisiana agricultural industry to the national forefront.

Still going strong

It's mid-morning on a Thursday and someone walks into the nearly 50-year-old Bear Creek Western Store in Montpelier and states that "lots of people are wondering if y'all are open. I keep telling them y'all are." Owner Melba Giardina says they've been hearing that a lot lately.

"It's been confusing to people since the restaurant and bar burned in the early morning hours of April 27th. When the Montpelier Volunteer Fire Department's pager went off, I ran to the window of my home which is located nearby and I could see the fire coming through the roof in the area of the stage," said Giardina. She added, "Contrary to some media reports, the western store is open. We were not affected at all by the fire. We get calls every day from people wondering if we're still in business or if we burned down too."

While Giardina's parents, W.B. and Ione King, sold the restaurant and bar in 1991, she says it's hard to not have the restaurant business there and fondly recalls some of the many music acts that played at the bar such as Tanya Tucker, Tammy Wynette and Randy Travis. "Back in the day, people would shop at our

store, go eat at the restaurant and make a day of it. We also had a grocery and a hardware store. They would stay in Montpelier all day long. It's disappointing that the restaurant and that part of history is gone."

The restaurant has been reduced to rubble as a result of the fire, but the western store remains a sprawling 19,000 square foot store that sells everything one can think of – from boots, clothing, hats, jewelry to saddles and tack.

"Daddy always tried to keep stuff no one else had and he tried to keep a larger selection with a variety of sizes. You've got to give people a reason to drive out here to St. Helena Parish."

Giardina says for years, Montpelier just had Bear Creek Western Store, the restaurant next door and Dykes Feed Mill.

She says the town has a few more businesses now and jokingly says, "We're uptown now!"

Bear Creek Western Store is open Monday-Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and Sundays from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. They are closed for major holidays only and one day out of the year to do inventory.

"Come see us. We are definitely still open and hopefully plan to be for a long time!"

Virgin bulls must have a breeder's certification of virgin status signed by the breeder, the breeder's agent or an accredited veterinarian. 

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Waterways bill clears Congress, heads to president

Baton Rouge, La. (May 22, 2014) - Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., recent passage of the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 ("WRRDA 2014" H.R. 3080) by both the U.S. House of Representatives and Senate as a major victory not only for Louisiana but for the entire nation.

"I commend Congress for taking swift action on this important legislation that will directly impact our agricultural industry," Strain said. "When this bill is enacted, it will enable economic growth of Louisiana and the nation's trade by strengthening and maintaining a strong water resources infrastructure allowing efficient transport of goods to market."

WRRDA legislation was developed by Louisiana's Congressional delegation to address widening and dredging of the Lower Mississippi river to ensure continued transport of the nation's commodities.

WRRDA highlights:

- ◆Provisions to exempt U.S. farms and ranches from the pending Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) rule. The

provisions will exempt aboveground oil storage tanks that have an aggregate storage capacity of less than 10,000 gallons. In addition to providing this exemption, it would allow farmers who are regulated and have less than 42,000 gallons of aboveground storage capacity to self-certify their own plans.

- ◆Reform the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers by holding them accountable on project schedules and increasing public disclosure of internal decisions
- ◆Speeds up environmental and project delivery schedules
- ◆Authorizes the "Morganza to the Gulf" project
- ◆Requires Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund expenditures to maintain Louisiana's ports and waterways
- ◆Authorizes six Louisiana Coastal Area ecosystem projects
- ◆Allows for the Acadiana Gulf of Mexico Access Channel (AGMAC) project at the Port of Iberia to continue which deepens channels for ships bound for the Gulf of Mexico from 12 feet to 20 feet

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posed and existing federal legislation including WRRDA directly with Rep. Charles Boustany during a roundtable discussion hosted by Strain.

The Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Nutrient Management Task Force studies the topics related to agricultural nutrient issues and evaluate their impact on our agricultural industries. The task force is charged with supporting the agency in multiple water-related issues.

Other topics covered during the roundtable discussion included the EPA and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Clean Water Act proposed rule to define the scope of waters protected under the Clean Water Act, Agricultural Worker Protection Standards, and the Food Safety Modernization Act.

Strain said, "I want to thank Rep. Boustany for taking the time to listen to the concerns of our agricultural producers. We are particularly pleased that the House recognized the low risk of oil spills on farms with the SPCC rule exemption for our farmers. Compliance to the rule would have been cost prohibitive."

The bill now moves to President Barack Obama, who is expected to sign it into law.



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
