Istrouma Brewing

Baton Rouge natives John and Joanna Haynes are story tellers. Whether they are telling stories through art, film making or through their collection of antiques of which they have repurposed, the Haynes' are visionaries.

"We always said, one day, we want to live on

a farm," said John Haynes. Growing up, Haynes spent lots of time in the country and on a farm. Haynes' father grew up on a cattle farm in Clinton, La. and his mother's extended families were dairy farmers in Osyka, Miss. So going back to Haynes' agricultural roots wasn't a farfetched idea when he and his wife, Joanna, bought a home and a barn on 14 acres in St. Gabriel, La.

"We just always knew we wanted our kids to know what it was like to drive down a gravel road and to appreciate the beauty of and the hard work that goes into living on a farm."

Growing up in Louisiana, Haynes said it's hard not be passionate about food. So after years of working as an artist and a film maker, the self-proclaimed home brewer with a passion for culinary along with his equally talented and creative wife, decided to convert the old red barn on their property into a restaurant and brewery. That's when Istrouma Brewing and Feed & Seed Restaurant at Sugar Farms were established.

"There just aren't a lot of

restaurants where we live," said Haynes. After three years of planning and unexpected delays caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, Istrouma Brewing opened in October 2020. "We didn't market ourselves in the beginning because we wanted to ease into it. However, the support has been overwhelming. It keeps growing through word of mouth."

Currently on the menu are pizza and tacos. But don't expect just cheese and pepperoni. The pizzas and tacos are made with fresh ingredients mostly from Sugar Farms. "We make our own seasonings and cheeses, even our own ice cream. We hope to be fully sustainable and farm to table one day."

Here's where they get even more creative. They make their own sodas such as root beer and cherry cola, fresh squeezed lemonade (regular and frozen) which is a seasonal item and Haynes is pushing the limits on brewing flavored beers. "In Europe they use syrups. We are creating our own syrups using fruits and seasonings. We've used cucumber, fresh mint, pineapple and habanero peppers - all farm ingredients."

Haynes typically has eight to 10 beers on tap - barrel aged, light, dark, and sour.

Everything in the restaurant tells a story. The tables are made from a tree that fell. The tasting room has an old cab of a pick-up truck

Additional Coronavirus Assistance for Ag Producers

Baton Rouge, La. (January 15, 2021) - Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is providing additional assistance for agricultural producers through the Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP).


Now eligible for assistance are contract producers of swine, broilers, laying hens, chicken eggs and turkeys. Producers could receive up to 80% of their revenue loss subject to the availability of funds. Producers of pullets and turfgrass sod are also eligible for CFAP payments.

Updates to the program include expanding eligibility for some agricultural producers and commodities. The USDA is also updating payments to accurately compensate some producers who already applied for the program. Producers who are now eligible and those who need to modify existing applications due to these updates can contact USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA) between Jan. 19 and Feb. 26.

"This program provides payments to farmers who suffered losses during the pandemic. I am hopeful this can help our ag producers who need assistance to stay afloat," said Strain.

In May, the USDA announced up to \$16 billion in direct payments to America's farmers and ranchers who suffered losses. In September, another \$14 billion was added to the program.

- ½ cup celery

LDAF’S Poultry Diagnostic Lab Receives Another Perfect Score!

For the fifth year in a row, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Poultry Diagnostic Laboratory located in Homer, La. passed the Avian Influenza proficiency test with a 100% score. For the past three years, the lab has also received a 100% score on the Mycoplasma proficiency test.

The LDAF operates one of only two National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) authorized laboratories in Louisiana.

On an annual basis, the Poultry Diagnostic Lab must pass proficiency tests in order to maintain its NPIP authorized lab certification as well as pass state and NPIP audits.

Commercial poultry are routinely tested for various avian diseases to ensure the chickens are healthy and free of disease.

The poultry lab receives samples five days a week and performs a variety of serology tests to screen all of the commercial poultry farms for diseases such as avian influenza, Mycoplasma, and other respiratory diseases.

The NPIP is a federal program set up under the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) that establishes testing procedures and requirements to ensure diseases affecting poultry are monitored and controlled.

The lab is run by a director and two laboratory technicians.

that now serves as a booth, some of the chairs are old barber shop relics. Haynes also has a display of LSU memorabilia and much of the art is his very own.

“My artwork is typically whimsical. I think art is not something you’re just born with. It’s a discipline. I learned how to use my strengths and weaknesses. You can get better. You have to use it and not be afraid to tell that story. Sometimes people are afraid to tell a story,” said Haynes. He further explained, “I never thought I could draw well but I think overcoming fear in whatever we do is the answer. If you don’t plant the crops in fear of the rain or the pests, you will never reap the

rewards of that harvest.”

Haynes added that part of telling a story with food and beverage is the visual aspect of it. “I love to see it, smell it, and touch it. I love the creative sensitivities. As for our beer, I’m going to start naming them, as well. That will also help tell a story.”

Sugar Farms is also home to horses, goats, and Haynes’ “beautiful and majestic” longhorn cattle. “I just love them -the color of their hide, the spots, no spots, the horns. They truly bring down my blood pressure and they’re also great at mowing grass.”

Haynes said the



brewery is named “Istrouma” which is the native name for the “red pole” which was a red cypress tree stripped of its bark that marked the boundary between Houma and Bayou Goula hunting grounds when explorers discovered what is now Baton Rouge. Sugar Farms was named after the old saying “give me some sugar” which is what he and his wife say to their two sons.

As of now, Istrouma Brewery is open Thursday’s from 4:00-9:00 p.m. and Friday’s and Saturdays from 11:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. It is located at 5590 Bayou Paul Road in St. Gabriel, La.

Haynes is also the owner of WISH Picture Shows in which he has produced documentaries and worked on various productions for corporations.
