Nursery industry picking up the pieces following ice storm

It happened again. This time it was an ice storm with below freezing temperatures for five consecutive days. The previous two catastrophic events, hurricanes Laura and

Delta, happened just a few months prior. And let us not forget the ongoing pandemic which caused businesses to struggle because of employee shortages and shuttered doors.

"The day we got to the property during the ice storm, we were sick. My daughter, Sam, and I couldn't get on the roads the first day; but the next day, we drove all the nurseries. We were just sick," said Marcia Young, Doug Young Nursery owner since 1976. Young's family has actually been in the business since 1942. The first nursery in the family was started by Doug Young's father, Robert Young.

Young is all too familiar with dealing with the impacts of an angry Mother Nature. But this time, her plant nurseries were not even put back together from the previous hurricanes when they got hit, again.

"We weren't even cleaned up from the wind damage from Hurricane Laura," said Young.

To say the Central Louisiana nursery industry was hit hard is an understatement. However, they have faced these hurdles

before and recovered. This type of loss is what agricultural producers can unpredictably experience at any time.

"Three weeks after Laura, Hurricane Delta dropped 18 inches of rain on us. It covered the entire parking lot and washed plants down to the creek. We had to rescue those plants and then we had to get rid of the fungus from all the rain," she added.

The economic impact of the nursery industry in Central Louisiana alone is tens of millions of dollars. The heart of the state's nursery industry is in Forest Hill, La. but extends to Glenmora and LeCompte. There are approximately 200 plant nurseries in the area. "Originally, plant nurseries came to be because the soil was very workable to grow the ball and burlap plants. And there was a man by the name of Sam Stokes, a naturalist, who propagated plants. Now, plants are grown in a can or container. But that is what made this area so conducive to growing plants," added Young.

On a stormy day in early March, Louisiana Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M., paid a visit to Young's nursery to take a look at the damage.

"It is hard to comprehend the amount of damage. We're looking at millions of dollars in damage from plants and structures," said Strain. "Not only are there losses, but it will **See Nursery, continued on page 22**

Four accused in Iberville Parish of possession of stolen livestock

Investigators with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's (LDAF's) Livestock Brand Commission say four individuals are accused of possessing stolen cattle from the Maringouin area.

The Iberville Parish Sheriff's Office contacted the Livestock Brand Commission on March 1, 2021 to request assistance in locating four head of cattle reported stolen from an Iberville Parish cattle producer.

Following an investigation, the cattle were located and recovered in St. Landry Parish.

The cattle were returned to their owner.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "The timely reporting of this crime to local law enforcement and the successful networking within law enforcement agencies resulted in the recovery of the livestock producer's cattle and bringing the alleged perpetrators to justice."

DORADA BATTERED FISH TACOS

Submitted by Port Orleans Brewery

Ingredients:

For the fish:

- 1 can Dorada Mexican lager
- 2 pounds tilapia
- ¾ cup cornstarch
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ cup all-purpose flour

For the chipotle crema:

- ⅔ cup Mexican crema
- ⅓ cup mayonnaise
- 3 chipotle chiles in adobo sauce
- 2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lime
- ½ teaspoon salt

For the tacos:

- Vegetable, canola, or peanut oil
- Corn tortillas, warmed
- 2 cups shredded cabbage
- Lime wedges
- Cilantro leaves

Instructions:

Cut each tilapia fillet in half lengthwise. Cut the longer half again. In a large bowl, add ¼ teaspoon cornstarch, ½ teaspoon baking powder, and 2 teaspoons salt. Whisk together to combine. Add strips and toss until evenly coated. Transfer the fish to a wire rack set over a rimmed baking sheet and refrigerate uncovered for 30 minutes. Meanwhile, make the crema. Combine Mexican crema, mayo, chipotles, lime juice, and salt into a small food processor and process until smooth. The crema should be fairly thin. When ready to fry, whisk together ½ cup cornstarch, ½ teaspoon baking powder, ½ cup flour, and 2 teaspoons salt in a large bowl. Add Dorada and whisk until it is a steady, thin stream coming off of the whisk. Fill a large cast-iron pot with 2 inches of oil. Heat oil to 350 degrees F. Dip the fillets in the beer batter one at a time until fully coated. Carefully lower the fish into the oil and fry until golden brown. Transfer to a wire rack and sprinkle with salt. To make the tacos, place 1 or 2 pieces of fish in a warm tortilla with shredded cabbage. Squeeze lime over the taco and drizzle with chipotle crema. Top with cilantro leaves.

take a lot of time to rebuild and replant. These nurseries are the economy in this area.”

Jim Clinton, CEO of Louisiana Central, who also visited the nursery said, “The nurseries represent a major segment of the economy, mostly in Rapides and Allen parishes, and people do not realize that there are so many nurseries, the number of people involved or how it is such an expanding industry.”

Hurricane Laura blew down about nine greenhouses at one of Young’s nurseries and about 15 greenhouses at another, blowing off the plastic and exposing them to rain. Trees fell down on warehouses and other structures on the property. Meanwhile, Hurricane Delta was more of a flood event.

And then the ice storm happened in February.

“This was the icing on the cake. We still had damaged buildings from the hurricanes but our big greenhouse was completely fixed because we had our poinsettia crop in it along with some tropical plants,” said Young.

It took just three short hours for the one acre greenhouse to fall and then other structures to collapse. Young believes

ice collected in the gutters and took the structure to the ground. She also estimated losing at least 200,000 plants in the big greenhouse alone. The economic impact: \$350,000. In all, she estimates having lost about 70% of her inventory – a minimum of \$2.5 million.

When asked what she tells people who say, “Why don’t you just grow more plants?” Young replied, “I try to talk to people reasonably and explain to them that many of these plants are 3-5 year crops so we cannot recoup them overnight.”

“At the end of the day, this will be a tremendous loss,” said Strain. “There hasn’t been a freeze like this in 30-40 years.”

In an effort to help rebuild the economy, Strain is seeking assistance from the federal government to help recover some of the losses. He said the rush is on to have product, some of which are long term crops that take years before they are ready to be sold, in order to supply big box stores so they do not take their business elsewhere.

“What people may not realize is that crop insurance, which is regulated by the USDA, is insufficient, particularly in catastrophic events,” said Strain.

“Many of our producers were hit by multiple hurricanes last year and now their crops have been wiped out by the ice storm. Even with the insurance they may have, it is not enough to help make them even close to being whole again,” added Strain.

“I’d rather be allowed to get some insurance and have that security. When it’s a grant, you have all kinds of hoops you jump through,” said Young. “We are in a panic whether or not they come up with some sort of relief.”

“This is such a significant component of our economy and we are very proud of the nursery industry. It is very diversified with more and more Asian and Hispanic owners over the decades,” said Clinton. He added that in all of the years that he has worked in economic development, he has never seen an industry hit this hard in such a compressed period of time.

“Without a doubt, this is the worst we’ve seen it – pandemic, windy hurricane, wet hurricane and a devastating ice storm,” said Clinton.

LDAF Now Accepting SCBGP Applications

Baton Rouge, La. (March 12, 2021) -The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is now accepting applications for the 2021 Specialty Crop Block Grant Program (SCBGP), Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., announced today.

Applications must be received no later than the close of business (4:30 p.m.) April 22, 2021.

The LDAF will administer the grant program funded through the United States Department of Agriculture - Agricultural Marketing Service (USDA-AMS). The LDAF anticipates at least \$400,000 to be allocated to fund Louisiana projects.

The grants are to be used for projects that enhance the

competitiveness of Louisiana-grown specialty crops like fruits, vegetables, tree nuts, dried fruits and nursery crops including floriculture and horticulture in either domestic or foreign markets.

Applicants must reside in or their organization or educational affiliation must be in Louisiana. All applicants are required to obtain a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number and include that number on their application.

Grant funds will not be awarded for projects that directly benefit a particular commercial product or provide a profit to a single organization, institution or individual. Projects should focus on issues to help improve specialty

crop industries as a whole such as: distribution, production, research, market development, food safety, promotion and education. Individual farms are not eligible to apply; however, producer associations, state and/or local organization, state or local governments, qualified educational institutions, non-profits and other specialty crop stakeholders are eligible recipients.

Once the deadline has passed, all applications submitted to the LDAF will be carefully evaluated to determine if the projects are qualified based on the criteria listed in the guidelines. All submitted project applications deemed qualified will be reviewed

and scored by a panel consisting of industry stakeholders, and the panel will make funding recommendations to LDAF. All LDAF approved projects will be incorporated into one state grant request, which will be submitted to the USDA.

LDAF has prepared a Request for Applications (RFA) document detailing application instructions, scoring criteria, federal forms, project format examples and other helpful information from the USDA. The document may be found at www.LDAF.la.gov. Click on the 2021 Specialty Crop alert.

Commissioner Strain Urges Safe Debris burning

As the mercury rises and folks work to clean up downed trees and debris caused by hurricanes and ice storms, Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner, Mike Strain, D.V.M., is urging citizens to use caution when burning storm debris.

"Every corner of the state has experienced its fair share of severe weather which resulted in massive amounts of downed trees and debris," Strain said. "With the recent mild weather, a lot of citizens are out working to remove storm debris from property." Debris fires can quickly get out of hand. Strain said, "Should you decide to burn debris, be sure to take the necessary safety precautions to prevent a debris fire from escaping and threatening life and property."

Strain has some safety tips for debris burning:

Always check your local city/parish ordinances and fire authorities to be sure outdoor burning is permissible.



Check the weather forecast. Also, check your local fire danger rating. Postpone the burn on dry, windy days or if changes in weather are predicted.

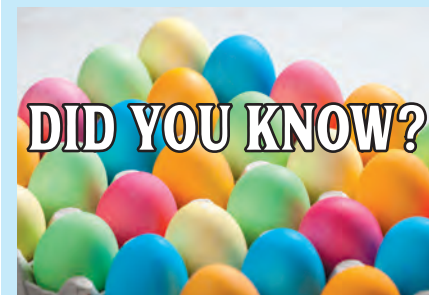
Before burning, establish a perimeter around the burn barrel or debris pile. The perimeter should be at least five feet wide around burn barrels, wider around brush piles and cleared of any flammable material down to bare soil.

Don't leave burn piles unattended. Monitor with the fire until it is completely extinguished.

Keep water and hand tools like shovels, rakes on hand to extinguish any embers or sparks that escape the perimeter. Should the fire escape, call 9-1-1 immediately.

"Debris fires can quickly get out of hand," Strain said. "Remember you are ultimately responsible for the fire and consequences."

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has a role in making sure those eggs are high quality and safe to eat before you take them home.

The LDAF employs inspectors who routinely examine eggs at grocery stores, schools and nursing homes, just to name a few, to ensure the eggs are free of cracks, clean, and within a specific temperature and date.

Whether you are dying, decorating or devilling eggs, boiled eggs that remain in the shell should be stored in the refrigerator and consumed within one week.
