Updated pesticide mobile licenses & business app

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) has updated its mobile application. Now, users can look up private and commercial pesticide applicators, aerial and ground owner operators, agricultural consultants, structural pest control businesses, licensees, and technicians; and restricted use pesticide (RUP) dealers and salespersons, said Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

“The original goal of having this mobile app was to make it easier to verify landscaping and horticulture professionals. Now we have expanded that list to include pest control professionals which should be helpful to both the public and our inspectors out in the field,” added Strain. Users can verify a license, a certification, business permit, or even file a complaint.

Insect activity increases as the days and nights become warmer during the spring and summer months. This is the time of year when termites swarm. Homeowners who experience pests (termites or other insects) in and around their home should contact a licensed pest control professional to identify and control the pest. “The mobile app is a convenient tool to easily check the

credentials of persons representing themselves as a pest management professional,” added Strain.

Farmer cooperatives and businesses must have a RUP dealer license to purchase and sell these pesticides. These licensed dealers must verify that a person has the required certification to purchase a RUP. The app makes it quick and easy to verify certifications of pesticide applicators purchasing these restricted use pesticides.

In addition, the mobile app includes a form for filing a complaint against a pesticide applicator or business. The form can be completed and submitted electronically. The department receives these complaints immediately providing a quicker response to your complaint and/or concerns related to a pest control issue or pesticide application.

The app, called LDAF Business App, may be downloaded free at the iTunes and Google Play stores. It was first introduced in January 2018.

Unwanted pesticide pick-up program nets 60 tons of pesticides

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's (LDAF's) most recent unwanted pesticide pick-up events have resulted in the disposal of 60 tons of unwanted pesticides. The unwanted pesticides were collected from agricultural producers, pesticide applicators or homeowners who need assistance disposing of them properly. "As we get ready to celebrate Earth Day on April 22, let this be another example how we can all work responsibly to get rid

of waste and other products that may be harmful to the environment and the health of our citizens if not disposed of properly," said Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M. "Sixty tons is a significant amount of pesticide products. Thank you to everyone who participated." The most recent events were held in Monroe and Natchitoches, La. Just over 49 tons of pesticides were collected in Monroe and more than nine tons were

collected in Natchitoches. The program began in 2019 and is conducted at various locations in the state on an annual basis. There is no cost to the farmer, and it is completely anonymous for those who wish to participate. Currently in Louisiana, an individual wishing to dispose of pesticide products must contact a licensed contractor for disposal, which results in a costly fee based on pounds of product(s) submitted for disposal. The LDAF program

does not require a fee for the disposal of unwanted pesticides. The cost of the program is funded through fees associated with pesticide manufacturers' product registrations in Louisiana. Future dates and locations for this program will be scheduled after the LDAF and LSU AgCenter determine which location will best serve the public. 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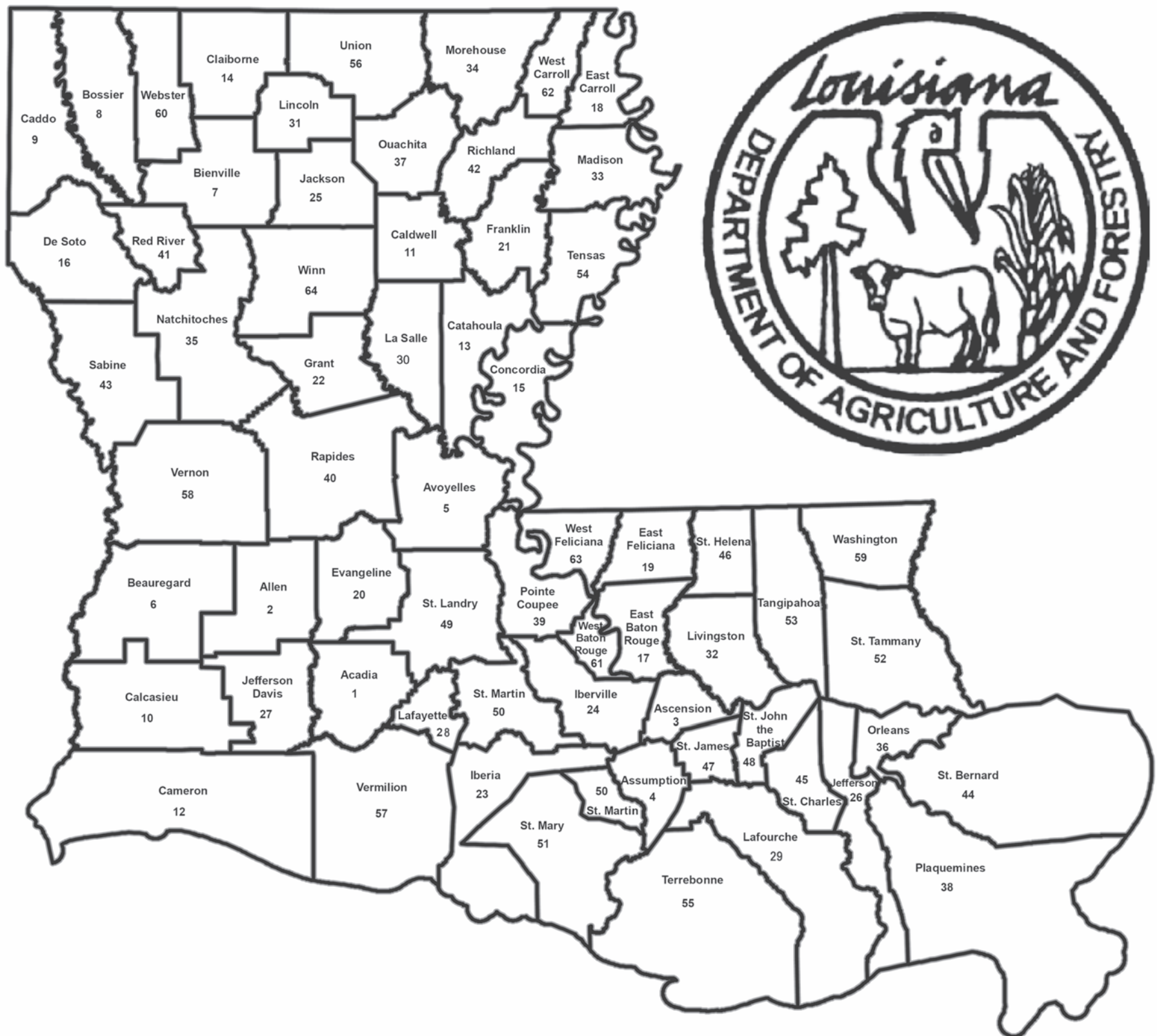

MEXICAN DEVEILED EGGS

- 2 tablespoons of pickled jalapenos, chopped
- 2 tablespoons of black olives, chopped
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup Mexican blend cheese, shredded
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup mayonnaise
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sour cream
- 2 tablespoons of taco seasoning
- 3 tablespoons green onions
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup cilantro, chopped (just a dash sprinkled over the top of each egg)

Instructions:

Boil eggs and cool. Peel them and then cut in half lengthwise carefully removing the yolks. Put yolks in a mixing bowl; add sour cream, mayonnaise and taco seasoning. Mix all other ingredients except the cilantro. Put the yolk filling in halves. For garnish, sprinkle with just a dash of finely chopped cilantro over the top of each egg.

EASY CRAWFISH DIP

to develop shells and become white, it's best to crush them.

"At that point, you're just helping them along with the maturing process if you move them to the water," Carter said.

Wilson adds that mature apple snails are not particularly adept at moving across land without the aid of natural flooding occurrences. He encourages crawfish farmers to use well water for controlled flooding of their ponds, which many do. He said so far this is the best method to prevent further spread.

"We're hoping to identify a management strategy that's compatible with crawfish," Wilson said. "Draining to low water can be effective in getting rid of the snails, but it's also detrimental to crawfish."

Carter adds that apple snails have the ability to burrow into the mud and wait out dry spells, with some surviving for more than six months doing so.

"One possible mitigation method is once crawfish

ponds are drained to till them after they have dried out," Carter said.

Chemical control options could be a future solution, Wilson believes, but those come with their own caveats.

"One shows a little promise, but finding a chemical that's detrimental to snails, yet safe for crawfish is a challenge," Wilson said. "Plus, it could be a hard sell to consumers."

Wilson sites as his biggest concern apple snails continuing to spread into new farms and affecting the entire crawfish production industry. But he said that is a worst-case scenario that can be prevented.

"Eventually, we might be able to identify a solution, but it's not going to be a silver bullet," Wilson said.

"The best method of prevention is for farmers to remain aware, use controlled flooding with well water when possible and to clean their equipment thoroughly before transferring it from pond to pond."

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Lineage logistics to expand at port of New Orleans

Cold storage investment of \$42 million to support \$1.6 billion La. poultry industry

In April, Lineage Logistics announced its expansion at the Port of New Orleans. The company plans to spend \$42 million to expand its Jourdan Road cold-storage facility in New Orleans East, where Lineage expects to create 50 new direct jobs.

Lineage facilities in New Orleans partnered with the Port of New Orleans to export 380,000 tons of poultry to global markets. The expansion will support imports of fresh produce as well.

In 2020, Lineage acquired New Orleans Cold Storage as part of its acquisition of Emergent Cold. The port and New Orleans Cold Storage opened a new 140,000-square-foot, blast-freeze facility in 2012 at the Henry Clay Avenue Wharf upriver, adding 1.25 million pounds of daily blast-freeze capacity and 38 million pounds of storage capacity for frozen

goods. That capacity is in addition to the Jourdan Road site.

"The benefit of this project cannot be overstated," said Commissioner Mike Strain of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. "Between 30 percent and 40 percent of the poultry exported through this facility is produced and processed at Louisiana commercial broiler farms, and the Lineage project is critical not just for Louisiana's poultry industry, but for our soybean farmers as well. Soybeans feed our poultry industry, and our poultry industry feeds the world."

Lineage's expansion project, which will generate an estimated 150 construction jobs, is projected to be complete in the second quarter of 2022, and the company will begin hiring for its new jobs in early 2022.



Invasive snail species could threaten crawfish production

Calling them the densest he's ever seen, LSU AgCenter entomologist Blake Wilson was startled to find invasive apple snail egg masses in St. James Parish, but said preventative measures, and a little help from Mother Nature, can mitigate the spread and potential damage to the crawfish industry.

Wilson, who specializes in agriculture pest management research, had previously encountered high concentrations of apple snails, or *Pomacea maculata*, in Calcasieu, Vermillion and Lafayette parishes, with smaller concentrations in Cameron and Jefferson Davis.

Last week he received a call from a concerned crawfish farmer from St. James, who discovered the unmistakable bright, pink eggs. Wilson believes severe weather and flooding over the last year could have contributed to the spread.

"It's likely they may have shown up on new farms following the hurricanes last year," Wilson said. "Any type of flooding can create an easy way for them to get into isolated ponds."

Currently, Wilson estimates that fewer than 3,000 of Louisiana's estimated 200,000 acres of crawfish farms have been impacted, but those farms have been hit hard. According to Wilson, each apple snail egg mass can contain hundreds of eggs, with a female producing them every week to ten days in the summer months.

"They're catching half the normal crawfish due

to mature snails both clogging trap entrances and consuming the bait," Wilson said. "In some fields, there has been more than a 50% reduction in the overall crawfish catch."

Introduced to the Louisiana ecosystem around 2016, apple snails were sold in pet stores for aquariums as "Mystery Snails," "Island Snails," and "Giant Apple Snails." The first sighting in the wild in Louisiana was in a swamp near Schriever, about 12 miles north of Houma, in Terrebonne Parish. Whether careless or intentional, a pet owner was the likely cause.

Jacoby Carter, a wildlife ecologist at the U.S. Geological Survey Wetland and Aquatic Research Center in Lafayette, said in addition to crawfish ponds, apple snails present a problem in natural systems. They eat native, submerged, aquatic vegetation, eliminating food and habitat for ducks and other species, while also helping invasive aquatic plant species by removing the competition.

Carter said although young snails have a multitude of predators, humans should remain cautious when encountering the eggs, and definitely should not eat the adults.

"The snail hatchlings are a millimeter wide at most, so they are food sources for fish, turtles and have even been found in the stomachs of frogs," Carter said. "But, in the egg stage, they emit toxins that can irritate human skin, and the adults carry lung worm, which can make

people sick."

Wilson said because many farmers dump crawfish in the late spring to stock their ponds for the next cycle, this is a crucial time to make sure not to inadvertently introduce snails to the ponds during that process.

"A main point I'd like to emphasize is not to move boats and equipment from infested bodies of water to those that are not infested," Wilson said. "Anything near the surface of the water can get an egg mass on it and they can be introduced that way."

Carter said the easiest way to destroy apple snail egg masses in the early, bright-pink stage is to, while wearing gloves, carefully scrape them into the water where they will be unable to survive and hatch. Once the hatchlings start
