## It's time to prepare for hurricane season

Hurricane season is here and the 2021 hurricane season is expected to be an active one. Now is the time to prepare.

"I'm urging everyone to have a plan in place for you, your family, your property and your pets/

livestock in the event you are in the path of a storm," said Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Louisiana residents should have a plan in place for their property, pets and/or livestock in the event a

storm threatens.

"This is the time to prepare your property so if you need trees cut, it is recommended you use a licensed arborist. This protects you because they are trained and must maintain liability insurance," said Strain.

Refer to the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) website or LDAF Business App for mobile devices to verify the current license status of an arborist.

As for animals, livestock owners should identify an area on their property that is least likely to flood and where the animals can be moved, if necessary. During an evacuation, it is important to leave early and have a place to go that allows livestock and or family pets.

### **Tips on preparing livestock trailers:**

- Check tire pressure and rubber for wear
- Test brake and running lights
- Inspect the overall condition of the trailer
- Proper identification for livestock that are evacuated is crucial during a natural disaster.

### **Important livestock items to take during an evacuation:**

- Health records (especially proof of EIA testing for horses)
- Food
- Special medications
- Bridles or leads

### **Important pet items to take during an evacuation:**

- Health records
- Food and food bowls
- Special medications
- Pet carriers
- Collars/leashes

By law, the LDAF is designated by the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act to assist in

evacuating and sheltering household pets for evacuated citizens going to shelters during declared emergencies. The LDAF has two mobile pet shelters to assist in keeping family pets in close proximity to their owners when an evacuation is necessary. Those pet trailers and LDAF employees are ready to be mobilized, if necessary.

The LDAF also provides fuel for emergency vehicles, hospitals, nursing homes, shelters and other emergency operations that require fuel. The LDAF is prepared to move forward on this, if necessary.

Hurricane season starts June 1 and ends November 30. East Feliciana Parish man arrested in Tangipahoa Parish for stolen livestock

Baton Rouge, La. (May 21, 2021) – An East Feliciana Parish man is behind bars accused of stealing 11 head of cattle from a livestock market in Tangipahoa Parish.

Thirty-three year old Eric D. Banford, 3768 Richmond Drive, Ethel, La., turned himself in to the

Tangipahoa Parish Sheriff's Office Friday morning following an investigation by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's (LDAF's) Brand Commission. During the investigation, it was determined that Banford received livestock but failed to pay for them in a

timely manner which is a violation of R.S.14:67.1 theft of livestock. The alleged theft happened in October and November of 2020.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "The law is specific when dealing with the purchase of livestock. The failure or refusal to pay for livestock

acquired is a crime and a violation of the theft of livestock statute."

The value of the cattle is estimated at \$3,100. Bond is set at \$25,000. If convicted, the suspect faces possible fines and jail time.

At this time, the cattle have not been recovered.

## CHICKEN AND SAUSAGE PASTA

Submitted by Frey's Smoked Sausage, LLC

**Ingredients:**

- 1 pound sausage
- 4-6 chicken breasts (boneless/skinless)
- 1 cup onion, chopped
- 1 cup bell pepper, chopped
- ¾ cup onion tops, chopped
- 1 cup fresh mushroom, chopped
- 1 quart half & half
- 1 heaping teaspoon corn starch
- Pasta of choice

**Instructions:**

Remove visible fat from chicken. Season lightly with salt, red pepper, and black pepper. Cut sausage into bite-sized pieces. Brown chicken and sausage in pan sprayed with non-stick cooking spray. After browning add enough water to cover bottom of pan. Cover and cook chicken and sausage, on medium to lower heat, for 15-20 minutes, adding just enough water to keep from sticking. Remove chicken from pan. Cut or break apart into smaller pieces and return to pan. Add onion, bell pepper, onion tops, and mushrooms to chicken and sausage. Again if needed, add just enough water to keep from sticking. Cover and cook until vegetables are tender and liquid has reduced to bottom of pan. Dilute 1 heaping teaspoon corn starch in half and half. Pour over cooked chicken and sausage. Heat until half and half starts to thicken. If a thicker cream sauce is desired, dilute a little more corn starch in the half and half. Follow cooking directions on package for pasta. Serve over cooked pasta of choice.

# Rapides Parish designated natural disaster area

Baton Rouge, La. (May 24, 2021) – Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) designated Rapides Parish as a primary natural disaster area. Producers who suffered losses caused by the winter storm and ice that occurred from Feb. 15-21, 2021, may be eligible for USDA Farm

Service Agency (FSA) emergency loans.

Producers in the contiguous Louisiana parishes of Allen, Avoyelles, Evangeline, Grant, LaSalle, Natchitoches and Vernon are also eligible to apply for emergency loans.

“Many producers in this area were hit by multiple hurricanes last year only to have further losses from the winter storm in

February,” Strain said. “Emergency assistance is essential to help producers recover and stay in business.”

## Lumber prices to remain high for a while

If you have started construction on a new home or want to update a room in your house, you probably have experienced sticker shock when it comes to the price of building materials, especially lumber.

Last year, the price was \$354 per thousand foot of lumber. By the first week of May, the price had risen to an all-time high of \$1686, an increase of nearly 475%. By May 18, the price had cooled some, down to \$1,264.

This explosion in price is being fueled by high demand and an extremely tight supply of lumber. New housing construction and remodeling projects of existing homes is driving the demand. Some of this is driven by the pandemic and many people working from home.

“They would like to have some extra spaces,” said Joseph Chang, a forestry economist for the LSU AgCenter. “And consequently, many of the stay-at-home people are actually now spending money to build new houses or adding additions to houses.”

The seeds for the lumber shortage can be traced back to the financial crisis of 2008, when housing markets collapsed, which caused demand for lumber to crater.

“Lots of mills closed,” said Buck Vandersteen, executive director of the Louisiana Forestry Association. “They could not maintain operations. They closed, and they really haven’t opened.”

Chang estimates that more than 100 mills closed in the Southeast between 2006 and 2021, which represents a nearly 40% reduction. Even with the closures, production was not reduced.

“The total production did not decrease at all,” Chang said. “The mills that are remaining are bigger

and more efficient, while the older, less efficient mills just dropped out.”

Louisiana has about 14 million acres of forestland, and Vandersteen is adamant the spike in lumber prices is not because of a severe shortage of trees.

“That’s completely false,” he said. “We have more wood in our forests now than 50 to 100 years ago. The problem that we have is we don’t have enough facilities to utilize all that is growing.”

While the price of the finished lumber product is high, landowners have not seen any increases on the price they receive for their timber.

“The high price and the low stumpage price are probably going to be here for a while until someone breaks that status quo and brings a new mill in,” Chang said.

Another factor hurting landowners is the numerous tropical systems during 2020 destroyed a large inventory of trees.

“Last year’s storms knocked down in a few hours about what we would cut in Louisiana during a normal year,” Vandersteen said.

While some of the downed timber from the storms was salvaged, the price landowners received for it was lower than they would have received under a normal harvest.

Vandersteen believes that landowners can still benefit from growing trees.

“Wood is a great building product,” he said. “It’s renewable. It’s sustainable. It sequesters carbon. It does all the good things that we are interested in a climate change environment.”

Both Chang and Vandersteen believe this is a good time for lumber producers to invest in Louisiana because of the state’s abundance of timber.
