Margot Babin and her eight siblings grew up in the crawfish business. Their parents, Marin and Joanna Durand, started their crawfish and rice farm in the 1970s. To this day, it truly is a family business.

"All of us are in the crawfish and rice farming business; although, we have one brother who also works in construction," said Babin. While the brothers handle the farming, the sisters -Margot, Joanna Durand and Connie Bergeron -

run the operations over at Teche Valley Seafood, the processing facility. Margot's daughter, Gena, also helps out at Teche Valley. "My Granny worked the operational side. When she passed away, my mom and her sisters stepped up," said Gena.

Located in the heart of St. Martinville, La., Teche Valley prides itself on delivering the highest quality crawfish. They're full service – from the pond to the table. But while they are a smaller processing facility, the sisters say it is the quality that keeps customers coming back.

So what makes Teche Valley crawfish so special? Bergeron reiterated that it is simply the quality of these farm raised, rice fed crawfish. "We know what our crawfish are eating. They're eating rice. We know if they have an issue. We know all of their

cycles."

They also wash their crawfish. There are no surprises when the consumer opens the sack. If people are paying for crawfish - they're getting crawfish.

Teche also specializes in large, select crawfish. "We know our customers. We know what they want," said Margot. "People ask me, 'Why are you at the grader?' That's why I'm at the grader. I want to make sure my people are getting what they are paying me for." The grader separates the large, medium and small crawfish.

The brothers farm the crawfish in Coteau Holmes which is about eight miles northeast of St. Martinville. "Because we know where our crawfish come from and who is farming them, they let us know when we need to process the crawfish and how fast we need to process them," said Margot. "It's very rare you'll get a dead crawfish in a sack from us."

Teche Valley sells to the public, caterers and restaurants – anyone who wants "clean" crawfish. Besides grading, they boil the mudbugs and use the small crawfish for the puree. They sell frozen three pound bags of boiled crawfish and also send their live crawfish all over the south.

The sisters agree that they have had their fair share of challenges throughout the years. "The **See Teche Valley, continued on page 22**



crawfish industry changes every year. It's farming. It's agriculture," added Margot.

In 2020, the Covid-19 pandemic shut down the restaurants. They adjusted by setting up a drive through and selling to the public. Earlier this year, a freeze slowed things down, as well, impacting the size and price of the crawfish.

On any given day, you'll see the sisters and Margot's daughter, Gena, grading and hauling sacks of crawfish. They're not afraid to do the hard work.

"This is what I know. Watching these women work. They are my role models. It's where I get my work ethic," said Gena. During peak season and for big events such as Easter weekend and Mother's Day, the entire family chips in.

But while the industry has changed over the years with fewer processing plants in the state and only the larger ones still in business, Teche Valley has held its own. They credit that to the consistency of their product.

"We don't try to compete with anybody. We just take one day at the time. We're going to work to maintain our consistency, our brothers will continue to bring us great crawfish and we want our consumers to be happy. That's how we keep those repeat customers," added Margot.


