Hammond business owner's Covid pivot sparks new business venture



"Life was good. I was established. I never had that fear that I would go out of business until Covid."

Daniel Lambert is a man who takes nothing for granted.

"Life was good. I was established. I never had that fear that I would go out of business until Covid."

Lambert has owned Cate Street Pub in historic downtown Hammond, La. since 1997; but, fear set in when he was forced to close the doors in early 2020 because of the pandemic. Cate Street Pub is a longtime gathering place for college students and locals.

Many of his employees stay with him for years as they work their way through college. "I'm so lucky. I have the best employees. They stay with me a long time. But I really put an emphasis on my employees getting their education. They know that school comes first when they work here. When they have an exam and need the night off, they get the night off," Lambert said.

That kind of loyalty was another reason Lambert knew he needed to do something to get his people working during the pandemic. Days became weeks, and weeks stretched into months - no one knew when

things would get back to normal. In the meantime, Lambert knew he needed to keep his own kids busy when they weren't doing schoolwork, so he started his own garden and bought some chickens. He also gained a large following on social media from his posts of his new garden and his chickens.

"When Covid first happened, I was mad and negative at first, but I prayed about what to do. I think God told me to grow that garden and get those chickens. That was Him guiding me. And then the food trailer came along."


Call it divine intervention, kismet, or maybe serendipity - a friend was selling a food trailer, so Lambert bought it. After going through the proper channels, Lambert was allowed to put the trailer, which is equipped with a kitchen, in the parking lot behind his bar, where he could serve food. At first, his goal was to serve just cheeseburgers and fries. "All of my people were on board. My bartenders learned how to be waiters, and my

La. man connected to cattle rustling ring arrested again

Today, a Rapides Parish man was arrested for a third time on livestock theft related charges. The Special Rangers with the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association (TSCRA) arrested Justin G. Thompson, 42, on behalf of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Livestock Brand Commission which had a warrant out for his arrest. Thompson, 127 Pilgrim Road, Hineston, La., was booked into the Wood County Texas Jail in Quitman, Texas. Thompson is charged with five counts of theft over \$25,000 and one count of theft over \$5,000. Thompson has waived extradition proceedings and is pending transfer and booking into the St. Tammany Parish Jail. In March 2019, investigators with the LDAF Brand Commission received a complaint from a St. Tammany Parish livestock dealer. Following a joint investigation by the Brand Commission and the TSCRA, it was determined that Thompson allegedly created fraudulent invoices and diverted payments regarding the purchasing and selling of livestock belonging to the complainant. LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said, "This is the third time our investigators have arrested Mr. Thompson on similar charges. Our investigators will continue to pursue complaints and hold wrongdoers accountable." Currently, no bond has been set and Thompson is pending extradition to Louisiana on the charges. If convicted, Thompson faces possible fines and jail time.

bouncers learned how to cook. The food turned out really well!"

Through his social media posts, word spread about the food trailer, and people started showing up for lunch at the once-shuttered bar. Lambert tried new dishes, using vegetables from his own garden and fresh eggs from his chickens for his potato salad. He added smoked pork, barbecue brisket and ribs to the menu. He even used his homemade meat rub recipe at the food trailer.

"To keep (the rub) consistent, I went to a company in Harvey, La. called Blend Mark. They blend lots of seasonings for restaurants. I sent them my recipe."

As the food trailer business was just starting, an existing restaurant next door to the pub closed. That's when Lambert decided to open a restaurant - Mr. Mule's Kitchen - and moved his operations from a food trailer in the parking lot to a fully equipped kitchen next door. It was a bold move, risking everything on a new venture in the middle of a pandemic.

The community response was overwhelming. Lambert could hardly keep up as people packed Mr. Mule's Kitchen, standing in line just to get a seat at the counter. His "pivot" (a word that became very popular during the

pandemic) paid off in a new local business, and his people were working again.

"Almost everything I used in the food trailer and now my restaurant is locally sourced out." Whether it's the tomatoes, cucumbers, parsley, peppers and onions from his own garden, beef from Loranger, seafood from Ponchatoula or wine and cheese from local businesses, supporting other local businesses and agriculture producers is a must for Lambert.

That local connection extends inside the restaurant, where the décor evokes a sense of nostalgia. Photos of Hammond's past line the walls. Lambert collected old photos from the building's previous owner, and his nephew Zachary Tompkins, the University Archivist at LSU.

Lambert said while doing some research, he found the original owner of the building, Vito Giannobile owned mules. Lambert delights in the coincidence because his nickname is "Mule" which, of course, is the name of the restaurant. With a little help from his sister-in-law Connie, a decorator and antiques dealer, Lambert filled the restaurant with memorabilia that gives customers a glimpse into the building's past - a pharmacy, an ice cream parlor,

and other types of businesses.

And that homemade rub - it became so popular, Lambert now sells it online and at his restaurant.

"It's just crazy how things happen. I asked my brother, Mark (a marketing and communications expert who owns Lambert Media in Baton Rouge), to design the label for me. And there you have it - Mr. Mule's Cajun BBQ Rub."

It's been a long journey from owning a shuttered business to opening Mr. Mule's Kitchen on May 30, 2021. Along the way, Lambert has worked hard and stayed grateful.

"Gratitude and humility are always in the forefront. And you have to give back. I believe in using my success to help others."

Whether it's a fundraiser to help a child who has cancer or helping a homeless man who stopped by the restaurant during this interview ("I see that guy from time to time. He'll come back later. He knows I'll feed him."), Lambert believes in giving back.

Today, Lambert's businesses are thriving. The bar is back open, the food trailer is now at a local ballpark and operated by his daughter, who is learning how to run a business, and his restaurant is up and running.

"Every day I say thank you for the things I have."

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Rice researchers highlight variety development, growing methods at field day

LSU AgCenter Report

(07/06/21) CROWLEY, La. — More than 400 rice producers and industry insiders gathered for the first post-pandemic field day at the LSU AgCenter H. Rouse Caffey Rice Research Station on June 30.

Following a virtual field day in 2020, this year's in-person event featured a field tour highlighting new developments in rice varieties, pest management and growing practices.

"We have had a great turnout for our first post-pandemic LSU AgCenter rice field day," said Dustin Harrell, resident coordinator of the Rice Research Station. "We can once again give our rice growers and rice industry professionals an in-person look at our collaborative research efforts to create new varieties and best management practices for a thriving and sustainable rice crop here in Louisiana."

For more than a century, rice growers have heard from researchers on how to produce a thriving crop at this annual event.

"We saw today some fabulous research from the staff and faculty at the Rice Research Station," said Richard Fontenot, chairman of the Louisiana Rice Research Board and Evangeline Parish farmer. "We shared some of the

research that we're doing with the breeding program because we are looking at different varieties. A lot of our challenges, as we move forward today, is to offer what our customers and consumers want in Louisiana, in the United States and around the world."

Faculty and staff at the station work year-round developing new varieties and growing techniques that are used across the state and beyond to produce an abundant and sustainable crop.

Adam Famoso, AgCenter rice breeder, talked about a new rice variety called PVLO3 that has many positive characteristics, including resistance to blast disease.

"Our growers don't get paid on how resistant a line is, but they're paid on yield and quality," Famoso said. "And disease is a major factor in determining what a given field or variety is going to do in terms of yield and quality."

Harrell told participants of the field tours about growing rice using furrow irrigation, a practice that is growing in popularity.

"It's basically growing rice in upland conditions," Harrell said. "We're actually digging furrows and then we're irrigating down those

furrows with poly-pipe. Furrow-irrigated rice is really taking off in Arkansas and Mississippi, but also in northeast Louisiana."

Harrell said this new growing method — also known as row rice — helps conserve water, fuel and manpower when compared to producing a crop with traditional growing methods. To attempt to overcome some of the challenges farmers may face with row rice, Harrell and his staff have implemented field trials to further examine nitrogen fertilization practices.

Mike Strain, commissioner of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, touted strong economic numbers for the nation's agriculture sector. He said the U.S. economy regressed about 2.5% while the agricultural economy grew 4.6% within the past year.

"We are making more exports, so it's driving our numbers," Strain told the group. "We've seen over the last 18 months an increase in the value of our commodities by almost 60 percent."

To outline some of the inner workings of the international rice trade, Betsy Ward, CEO of the USA Rice Federation, addressed the crowd.

She detailed some of the challenges that her organization is working to overcome in the global rice market — including political unrest in Haiti that could lead to food shortages in that nation and a record rice crop in Colombia that is creating export losses for the U.S. rice industry.

"Whether it's trade wars, multiple hurricanes or the pandemic, we certainly are cognizant of the challenges that you are facing," Ward said. "It's been a really trying couple of years, but the fact that we are all here gives me optimism for our rice industry and for our whole country."

Though obstacles such as the tumultuous 2020 Atlantic hurricane season and the COVID-19 pandemic may have challenged the nation's agriculture sector, the AgCenter remains dedicated to continuing the vital research conducted at the Rice Research Station and other facilities, said LSU

AgCenter Vice President for Agriculture Bill Richardson.

"We continue your research in spite of some very, very difficult circumstances," Richardson said. "We try to pay close attention to the needs of the rice industry. We want to make sure we move toward the future and provide you the quality of programs that you need to have."

Richardson added that the rice farmers of Louisiana have funneled more than \$40 million into research conducted at the Rice Research Station.

Other speakers at the event included state Rep. Clay Schexnayder, speaker of the Louisiana House of Representatives; Kurt Guidry, LSU AgCenter Southwest Region director; Kevin Norton, former assistant chief of the U.S. Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service; and Mike Salassi, AgCenter associate vice president.

FSA to begin taking applications for PLIP on July 20

WASHINGTON, July 13, 2021— Livestock and poultry producers who suffered losses during the pandemic due to insufficient access to processing can apply for assistance for those losses and the cost of depopulation and disposal of the animals. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Secretary Vilsack announced the Pandemic Livestock Indemnity Program (PLIP) in [recorded] remarks at the National Pork Industry Conference in Wisconsin Dells, WI. The announcement is part of USDA's Pandemic Assistance for Producers initiative. Livestock and poultry producers can apply for assistance through USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA) July 20 through Sept. 17, 2021.
