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Mosquito outbreak in hurricane-damaged areas causes concern for livestock

LSU AgCenter veterinarian Dr. Christine Navarre is concerned for livestock following mosquito outbreaks in the wake of Hurricane Ida.

Hurricane Laura caused a similar issue last year, which resulted in death for some cattle in southwest Louisiana. Navarre said livestock owners should take precautions to protect their animals.

She suggested spraying the premises or animals with an insecticide approved by the Environmental Protection Agency. Animals should only be sprayed with products labeled for use with that particular animal species. She warned owners not to use a premise spray directly on animals unless the label specifies that use.

Owners can contact their veterinarian for information on products that can be applied on livestock. She said Brahman cattle are more sensitive to organophosphate insecticides. Information on premise sprays is available at <https://bit.ly/>

“There are many products approved. The best thing is to contact your local farm supply store to see what they have available,” Navarre said. “Follow all label directions for use, including proper dilution. Also, follow all meat and milk withdrawal times for products used in food animals.”

Navarre said livestock owners should also consider:

Moving animals away from trees.

Clipping vegetation.

Finding areas without vegetation or ploughing up some ground for resting spots.

Moving individual or small groups of animals into stalls or a barn with fans.

She said blanketing horses can cause heat stress, and fly sheets don't work well against mosquitoes. She also recommended that horse owners have their horses vaccinated against mosquito-borne diseases such as encephalitis and West Nile virus.

Strain: Hire only licensed arborists to work on storm-damaged trees

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding residents to hire only professional-licensed arborists to perform work on storm-damaged trees.

“Anyone doing tree work in Louisiana is required to obtain a license through the LDAF,” Strain said. “Hiring only licensed-professional arborists protects you, the homeowner, since licensed arborists are not only trained to properly execute tree work, but they must also maintain liability

insurance. I also urge you to get a written estimate and, while you may be required to pay a reasonable deposit, you should never pay for the job in full up front.”

“Following hurricanes, we see an increased number of people going door-to-door offering tree services,” Strain said. “When hiring an arborist to remove storm-damaged trees, always ask to see their license and a current copy of the arborist’s liability insurance certificate.”

According to the Louisiana horticulture law,

no person shall receive fees, advertise or solicit business in a regulated profession or occupation unless this person holds the appropriate license or permit, or has a regular employee who holds the appropriate license or permit, or is employed by a person who holds the appropriate license or permit. In addition, all licensees are required to place their license numbers on all business-related vehicles that have advertisements on them.

Out of state arborists

may apply for a temporary arborist license if they are certified by the International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) or if they are currently licensed in another state by the result of passing an examination. A temporary arborist license is good for 90 days from the date of issuance.

No license is required for someone doing tree debris removal like cutting up and hauling away fallen trees.

Strain added that any work on a tree or portion of a tree still standing will require an arborist license.

PRESCRIBED BURN WORKSHOP WITH LDAF CERTIFICATION SET FOR NOV. 10-12 IN HAMMOND

A prescribed burning workshop with burner certification is scheduled for Nov. 10, 11 and 12, 2021 at the Hammond Research Station, 21549 Old Covington Hwy in Hammond, La. The workshop is from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day and ends at 1:30 p.m. on Nov. 12.

The workshop will provide essential information for conducting prescribed burns safely and legally in your timberlands.

Topics on the first two days will include fuels, fire

behavior, fire weather, fire ecology, burning techniques, smoke management, fire lane establishment, burn planning and more. 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USDA extends Pandemic Livestock Indemnity Program application deadline

WASHINGTON, Sept. 16, 2021— The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) is providing additional time for livestock and poultry producers to apply for the Pandemic Livestock Indemnity Program (PLIP). Producers who suffered losses during the pandemic due to insufficient access to processing may now apply for assistance for those losses and the cost of depopulation and disposal of the animals through Oct. 12, 2021.

PLIP provides payments to producers for losses of livestock or poultry depopulated from March 1, 2020 through Dec. 26, 2020, due to insufficient processing access as a result of the pandemic. Payments are based on 80% of the fair market value of the livestock and poultry and for the cost of depopulation and disposal of the animal. Eligible livestock and poultry include swine, chickens and turkeys.

Eligible livestock and poultry producers can apply for PLIP through the Oct. 12, 2021 deadline by completing the FSA-620, Pandemic Livestock Indemnity Program application, and submitting it to any FSA county office. Visit farmers.gov/plip for more information on how to apply.

Additional pandemic assistance program deadlines

Oct. 12 – Coronavirus Food Assistance Program 2, which provides critical support to agricultural producers impacted by COVID-19 market disruptions.

Oct. 15 – Pandemic Assistance for Timber Harvesters and Haulers, which provides financial relief to timber harvesting and timber hauling businesses that experienced losses in 2020 due to COVID-19.

Repairing landscapes after storms

Loss of trees is a common catastrophe during hurricanes, tornadoes and other weather events. Water-saturated soils also can contribute to trees uprooting during heavy winds. In addition, ice storms, although rare, can cause structural damage.

We have had our share of winter ice, flooding and heavy winds from both hurricanes and tornadoes recently in Louisiana. As climate change continues and we experience more weather challenges, there are some things you can do in your yards to prepare.

One dilemma people face during heavy winds and saturated soils is losing mature shade trees. Unfortunately, many of those trees may have taken 20 to 30 years to reach a mature size, and now those landscapes have a large void. Many homeowners are looking to replace those gaps but don't have the time for new trees to reach full maturity. To help get landscapes restored back to its once full look, many homeowners are looking for fast-growing trees and shrubs.

One of the tradeoffs for fast-growing trees can be weak wood. Avoid selecting trees with weak wood or structural problems that you may lose in coming storms. Some examples of fast-growing trees that have weak wood are boxelder, Bradford pear, cottonwood, Leyland cypress, pines, river birch, silver maple, tulip poplar, white poplar and water oak.

Some examples of sturdy trees that exhibit fast growth are bald cypress, Drake elm, lacebark elm, red maples, swamp tupelo, sweet bay magnolia, sycamore, live oak, nuttall oak, overcup oak, pin oak, sawtooth oak and willow oak.

In cleaning up your landscape,

any limbs on trees or shrubs that were bent or broken should be removed. Trees or shrubs that are leaning and without significant damage or limb loss can be straightened out.

Start by removing broken limbs and prune broken branches. Next, clean torn areas with a sharp, clean knife or ax, leaving as much bark as possible to help the wound repair process.

If trees are uprooted or leaning, straighten and stake the tree to reset and help reestablish roots. Your chances of survival are best when one third to one half of the roots are still in the soil and the remaining exposed roots are relatively undisturbed.

Pull the tree upright and fill in soil as needed. Water the tree and gently step on the soil area surrounding the trunk of the tree to help firm the soil and remove air pockets.

Next, attach three guy lines to the trunk at about two-thirds of the height of the tree. Anchor in place with stakes at an angle, placing them 12 to 15 feet from the base of the tree, and secure the lines. Be sure to wrap ropes or cables with cloth or a rubber hose.

Remove straps within a year and do not fertilize. Water to encourage new root growth. Irrigate deeply for the next one to two weeks after resetting.

Reset trees stand a 50-50 chance of surviving long-term due to root damage that will take years to reestablish. Shrubs, perennials, tropical and annuals are much more likely to recover more quickly than trees after a storm.

Plants with large leaves typically shred during high winds but will put on new growth and recover in a short time. As for other woody

shrubs that were damaged during the storm, they too can recover and reach full maturity within a few years.

Flooding is another concern with hurricane weather. Roots that are in standing water for extended periods can die due to no oxygen, toxins in the soil and fungal disease. Most plant casualties from temporary flooding are vegetables and seedlings.

Signs of water stress are yellow and wilted leaves. Improve drainage by trenching to allow water to flow away from the area. Before replanting, correct and prevent flooding from happening again.

Install French drains to help water move into the soil and away from low-lying areas, or add rain gardens or swales that redirect the water to an area.

Rain gardens use moisture-loving plants that help absorb water and that will not die from standing water. You have many options, such as bald cypress, river birch, live oaks, swamp red maple, pond cypress, rushes, sweetbay magnolia, southern magnolia, ironwood, parsley hawthorn, Virginia willow, American beautyberry, yaupon holly, Florida anise, dwarf palmetto, southern wax myrtle, Louisiana iris, buttonbush, river oats, muhly grass, ironweed, golden rod, cardinal flower, cinnamon fern, Texas star, swamp mallow, swamp milkweed, rudbeckia, rain and crinum lilies.

If you have poor-draining soils due to compaction and heavy clay, you should consider adding sand to encourage drainage in addition to compost to increase the organic content of the soil. Alternatively, you can add raised beds to low-lying areas and build the soil up.

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
