



# LDAF joins multi-state effort to battle farmer, a stress



(October 29, 2021) -Farm and ranch closures, land forfeitures, labor issues and more, are contributing factors to the high level of stress in rural communities. According to a 2015 report from the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention - a full five years before the COVID-19 pandemic hit - rates of suicide in rural communities measured twice that of urban areas.

To address this problem, the U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) is funding four regional farm and ranch stress assistance networks. The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is among more than 50 partners participating in the effort for the Southern region. LDAF

has been awarded a \$500,000 grant for this project.

The three-year, \$7.2 million southern region project will span 13 states and two U.S. territories, and is being coordinated by the University of Tennessee Institute of Agriculture. Partner organizations, in addition to the LDAF, represent land-grant institutions to government agencies, commodity and lending groups, and non-profit organizations.

Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., praised the initiative saying, "This funding and partnership will bring much needed support to our Louisiana farmers and ranchers who have been tremendously affected by major hurricanes and the continued impacts See Stress, continued on page 2



# DID YOU KNOW?

LDAF's Food Distribution team stores and distributes millions of pounds of USDA commodities to Louisiana citizens each year.



LDAF Food Distribution program staff stores and distributes USDA commodities for the school lunch program and other donated food programs administered by USDA.

The Food Distribution program also serves a critical role during disaster response through the administration of the Emergency Food Assistance Program. In the immediate aftermath

of a declared disaster, Food Distribution may, for example, distribute USDA food to disaster relief agencies such as the American Red Cross and the Salvation Army for congregate feeding sites. Under certain conditions, Food Distribution may provide household food packages of nutritious food to hungry families.

Following Hurricane Ida,

the USDA authorized Food Distribution to distribute household food packages in 19 parishes. The packages consisted of about 25 pounds of shelf stable canned goods, protein items and staples such as rice, flour and pastas. In total, 1,161,785 pounds of food valued at \$1,116,587 was distributed to people located in parishes impacted by Hurricane Ida.
