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## “LOCALLY GROWN” PROGRAM SUPPORTS LOUISIANA PRODUCERS

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., joined Louisiana farmers and Walmart associates in early December in encouraging shoppers to include locally grown products – from strawberries to sweet potatoes – to their regular shopping lists.

Strain praised Walmart’s plan to use local growers wherever possible to stock their produce shelves as good for Louisiana.

“Walmart’s ‘Locally Grown’ program is a great opportunity for Louisiana producers to market their products on a large scale,” Strain said. “It’s good to know your food is coming from your area and not trucked in from hundreds of miles away.”

“While the economic climate remains a concern for local farmers, Walmart continues to help Louisiana’s agriculture business through partnerships with small farms and by stocking its shelves with locally grown items. Walmart gives customers an opportunity to buy local at a price they can afford to help local economies at a time when they need it most.

Strain is a supporter of Walmart’s program because it gives local producers

another avenue to market their products.

Walmart’s Distribution Center in Hammond currently delivers the following items from Louisiana farms to produce shelves in 41 Walmart Supercenters and five Walmart Neighborhood Markets in Louisiana and three Walmart Supercenters in Mississippi:

## Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

### Strain to ask for \$50 million to pay down debt

Agriculture Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., will ask the Legislature for \$50 million of the state’s surplus dollars to pay off past debt.

Strain’s administration inherited more than \$97 million in debt from the Odom tenure.

\$12 million was paid on the debt in 2008, reducing the total owed to \$84 million.

Included in the past debt are bonds sold for the Lacassine sugar syrup mill.

“The Louisiana Department of

Agriculture and Forestry uses about \$15 million each year to pay off about \$100 million in bonds,” Strain said. “There’s \$15 million a year that we could utilize differently.

“We can use one-time surplus dollars to pay down state debt. That will free up the monies and the cash flow the department could utilize for the agricultural programs they were designed for.

“Don’t forget that we are working with a budget that was already cut by \$4.7 million this

year.

About \$2 million of the cuts were in supplies. The department sold heavy equipment to make up that cut, Strain said. The remaining cuts were made in salaries.

Strain also reduced the number of LDAF employees. When Strain took office in January 2008, the number of department employees was at 1,006. The employee count now stands at 917.

Of the 89 positions cut, about 10 people were laid off, but most

were people who had left or retired.

Strain estimated that 20 percent to 25 percent of the remaining employees could retire in the next few years.

“We’ve done our part to control spending and reduce expenditures,” Strain said. “Agriculture is such a vital necessity for the state. I’m hoping the Legislature sees it that way and helps us with this request so we may see to it that food, fiber and fuel remain affordable.”

## Sign-up deadline is January 15

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said \$16 million in USDA Emergency Conservation Program (ECP) funds are available through USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA) to eligible Louisiana farmers and ranchers to repair farmland damaged by hurricanes Gustav and Ike.

The deadline to sign-up for the disaster aid in applicable ECP parishes is Jan. 15, 2009.

Strain said the program is available to eligible producers on a 75-25 cost-share basis for debris removal, repair conservation structures and fences that were damaged by the hurricanes.

For land to be eligible, under USDA rules, the disaster must have created new

conservation problems that:

- ♦ if left untreated, will impair or endanger the land;

- ♦ materially affect the land's productive capacity;

- ♦ represent unusual damage that, except for wind erosion, is not likely to recur frequently in the same area; and

- ♦ would be so costly to repair that federal assistance is or will be required to return the land to productive agricultural use.

Conservation problems that were present before the storms are not eligible for the cost-share assistance.

Anthony Liuzza, a Tangipahoa Parish strawberry and tomato farmer has been working with Walmart for more than 12 years.
