The majority of the cattle producers who advertise in the Louisiana Market Bulletin have been polled and the results are in.

The message? If you want to sell your cattle quickly, advertise in the Louisiana Market Bulletin.

"It's a good tool for the cattleman," said Roy Marcantel of Kinder in Allen Parish. "Most of the time I have more interest generated from my ad than I have cows."

Marcantel rated the Market Bulletin's effectiveness as an advertising medium with a five, the highest possible rating allowed by the informal survey.

Marcantel and other cattle advertisers were surveyed by telephone on Aug. 9 and asked six questions. The polling questions were:

"Did your cattle sell since your July 29 ad?"

"How long does it usually take for your cattle to sell after the ad has been placed in the Market Bulletin?"

"Was the sale a result of the Market Bulletin ad?"

"Have you advertised in the Market Bulletin before and how often?"

"Will you continue to advertise in the Louisiana Market Bulletin?"

"On a scale of one to five, with five being the highest and one the lowest, how do you rate your Louisiana Market Bulletin cattle advertising experience?"

Nearly 100 percent of the 21 cattlemen polled rated

the Market Bulletin's cattle advertising service with a score of five.

The most cited reason for the high rating was the fact that the classified advertisement is free to subscribers.

"You can't beat free," said one cattleman.

The poll also revealed that top quality pure bred will sell very quickly. All of those polled said top quality will go fast.

"If you've got something good to sell it will sell," Marcantel said.

Philip Watts of Livingston agrees that good quality sells. He operates his cattle business by the rules his father, V. Watts, taught him. "My daddy always said that it costs just as much to raise good quality cattle as it does the cheaper ones so that's why we raise F-1s," Watts said.

Comments on how long it takes to sell cattle after the ad has appeared in the Louisiana Market Bulletin ranged from "two or three weeks," "three or four weeks," "two months," to "it varies."

Cross-breds and other cattle will sell slower, said Matt Westmoreland of Franklinton, Washington Parish.

Westmoreland advertised a herd of registered Texas longhorns for nearly a year before he sold the cattle.

"I try to keep my ad in the Market Bulletin all year," Westmoreland said. "If cattle buyers are looking

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Loggers accused of stealing timber valued at \$336,000

Two brothers who run logging operations in northwestern Louisiana were arrested on felony timber theft charges after a two-month investigation by Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) investigators, Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.

Ricky Whitaker, 42, 6214 Quinlen Dr., Shreveport, and Jerry Whitaker, 52, 1409 Sample St., Mansfield, were arrested Aug. 25 and 26 after allegedly harvesting 200 acres of timber valued at \$336,000 and failing to pay the majority of rightful owners.

Absentee landowners who own the 200 acres of timberland at the Caroline and Rafe Travis Estates

off Friendship Road near Frierson filed complaints with the LDAF Forestry Enforcement division when their timber was cut without authorization.

Forestry Enforcement Manager Jim Baldwin said the Whitakers, operating as Whitaker Timber and Whitaker Logging, allegedly bought the timber rights from a landowner who only held a five percent interest in the property and another who held no ownership of the property. The land in question is owned collectively by 55 members of a family estate.

The Whitakers logged the timber between January and October of 2009.

Baldwin said the Whitakers

allegedly failed to verify the ownership of the timber and did not secure signed contracts from 80 percent of the landowners as required by law.

Once the Whitakers sold the timber, they allegedly failed to pay the legitimate owners for the cut timber and did not set up an escrow account for the landowners who could not be located, Baldwin said.

"The Whitakers are veteran loggers and failed to secure the basic ownership information of the property," Baldwin said. "A simple check with the DeSoto Parish Assessor's Office and Clerk of Court would have revealed that the persons selling the timber

were not the sole owners. In addition, an adjoining landowner warned the Whitakers that the person selling the timber probably didn't have the authority to do so."

"Timber theft is a very serious crime and will be investigated fully by my office," Strain said. "I urge all absentee landowners to devise a system to check their timber holdings regularly. Landowners who are selling their timber should deal with loggers only after thoroughly checking their credentials."

Strain urged the public to report any suspected timber theft to the LDAF's Baton Rouge headquarters at 225-925-4500.



Spinach and Gorgonzola Stuffed Bell Peppers

4 large red bell peppers	1/2 tsp. ground black pepper
1 tablespoon butter	3 cups coarsely chopped fresh spinach leaves
4 cloves garlic, minced	3/4 cup crumbled Gorgonzola cheese, divided
1 cup uncooked rice	
2 cups water	
3/4 tsp. salt	

Remove tops of bell peppers and reserve. Coarsely chop tops of peppers, discarding stems; set aside. Remove seeds from peppers and place in microwave proof baking dish, cover loosely and cook in microwave on high 2 to 3 minutes or until tender crisp. Drain well; set aside. Meanwhile, melt butter in large saucepan over medium heat. Add chopped bell pepper and garlic; cook 2 to 3 minutes or until tender crisp. Add rice; cook and stir 1 minute. Add water, salt and black pepper. Heat to boiling; stir once or twice. Reduce heat; cover and simmer 15 minutes or until liquid is absorbed. Remove from heat. Add spinach; stir until spinach is wilted, 3 to 5 minutes. Stir in 1/2 cup cheese. Place equal amounts of rice mixture into peppers; top with remaining cheese. Bake at 375 degrees for 15 minutes.

Shrimp And Creamy Spinach-feta Rice

2 tbsps. vegetable oil	1/2 tsp. pepper
1/2 cup golden raisins	1 lb. cooked, peeled, deveined medium shrimp
1/2 cup julienne strips red bell pepper	3 cups hot cooked white rice
1 (6-oz.) pkg. fresh baby spinach	1 cup crumbled feta cheese with basil & tomato (or plain)
1/2 tsp. salt	Toasted pecans or pine nuts

Heat oil in large nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add raisins and bell pepper; saute 1 minute. Add spinach, salt and pepper; toss until spinach is just wilted. Add shrimp; saute 30 seconds. Add hot rice and feta cheese. Toss all ingredients until heated through and cheese is soft and creamy. Top with toasted nuts, if desired.

Chicken and Broccoli Rice Casserole

1/2 cup chopped onion	2 cups chopped fresh broccoli, steamed*
1/2 cup sliced fresh mushrooms	1 (10 3/4 oz.) can condensed cream of mushroom soup
1 tbsp. butter or margarine	1/2 cup (2 oz.) shredded Cheddar cheese
2 cups hot cooked rice	
2 cups cooked chicken breast cubes	

Cook onion and mushrooms in butter in large skillet until tender. Stir in rice, chicken, broccoli and condensed soup. Pour into buttered shallow 1-1/2-quart baking dish; top with cheese. Bake at 350 degrees 20 to 25 minutes.

**Note: One 10-ounce package frozen chopped broccoli may be substituted*

Cranberry Pecan Rice Pilaf

2 tbsps. butter or margarine	1/2 cup dried cranberries
1 cup uncooked rice	1/2 cup chopped pecans, toasted*
1 (14 1/2 oz.) can chicken broth	1/4 cup sliced green onions
1 cup grated Parmesan cheese	Salt and ground black pepper

Melt butter in 2-quart saucepan over medium heat. Add rice; cook and stir 2 to 3 minutes. Add broth and heat to boiling; stir once or twice. Reduce heat; cover and simmer 15 minutes or until liquid is absorbed. Remove from heat. Stir in cheese, cranberries, pecans and onions. Season to taste with salt and pepper.

**Note: To toast pecans, spread nuts on small baking sheet. Bake at 325 degrees 5 to 8 minutes, or until golden brown, stirring frequently. Nuts burn easily so check them often.*

Chicken Tomato Basil Rice Soup

1 tsp. vegetable oil	1 (14 1/2 oz.) can low-sodium chicken broth
1 medium onion, chopped	1 (6-oz.) can tomato paste
1 medium carrot, thinly sliced	2 tbsps. chopped fresh basil
2 celery ribs, thinly sliced	2 tbsps. chopped fresh parsley
3 cloves garlic, minced	Salt and pepper to taste
1 1/2 lbs. boneless, skinless chicken breast halves, cut into bite-size pieces	3 cups hot cooked rice
2 (14 1/2 oz.) cans stewed tomatoes, undrained*	Fresh basil for garnish

Heat oil in Dutch oven over medium-high heat until hot; add onion, carrot, celery and garlic. Cook and stir 3 to 5 minutes or until onion is tender. Add chicken; cook and stir 2 to 3 minutes or until pieces are light brown on all sides. Add tomatoes and juice, broth, tomato paste, basil, parsley, pepper and salt. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat to low; simmer 30 minutes. Just before serving place 1/2 cup hot rice into individual serving bowls. Ladle soup over rice. Garnish with basil.

**Note: Canned whole tomatoes may be substituted.*

Bananas Foster Rice Pudding

2 medium bananas, peeled and chopped	1 cup heavy cream, divided
1 1/2 tbsp. light rum	1/4 cup butter
1/2 cup plus 2 tps. packed brown sugar	1/3 cup chopped pecans
	3 cups cooked rice

In small bowl, combine bananas and rum. Combine 1/2 cup brown sugar, 1/2 cup cream and butter in 2-quart saucepan. Cook over medium-high heat until boiling 2 to 3 minutes, stirring constantly. Add pecans. Cook until slightly thickened 1 to 2 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and stir in banana mixture. Add rice; mix well. Beat remaining 1/2 cup cream until soft peaks form. Add remaining brown sugar; beat until stiff peaks form. Serve pudding topped with whipped cream.

through the Market Bulletin, they're going to see my name and for the price, you can't beat it. Free is free. If the cows sell, great. If they didn't sell this time, well, the ad didn't cost me anything."

Interestingly enough, Westmoreland sold his longhorn herd from his July 29 advertisement. "The Market Bulletin is an excellent tool," Westmoreland said.

Every one of the 21 cattlemen and women polled said they had used the Louisiana Market Bulletin to advertise their cattle and will continue to do so.

Larry Duhon of Kaplan, Vermilion Parish, uses the Louisiana Market Bulletin to find other items to purchase for use in his business operation.

"Anything you want you can find in the

Market Bulletin," Duhon said. "It really helps out in this economy. You can buy good stuff with good people."
