## SAWMILL TOWN ENDURES

**B**link and you'll miss it. The narrow stretch of pavement off U.S. 171 North looks like it unravels to nowhere, but travel it: You'll find living history.

The town of Fisher is a survivor. It is one of the last sawmill towns from the state's golden age of lumbering.

Several of the town's white-washed, wood-frame buildings remain amid the 300-strong village north of Leesville, in Sabine Parish.

Ann Anderson, who operates a flea market in Fisher, said some locals don't even know about the place.

"It's off the beaten path," she said.

Anderson's treasures are in the building that used to be the town's commissary. The store is said to have sold everything from cribs to coffins.

Anderson grew up in Fisher. She spends a lot of

time telling her customers the history of the Louisiana Long Leaf Lumber Co., whose workers made up the town. Many of them are buried in Fisher's lone cemetery, tucked away just north of

town, down a dirt path.


"There was a hospital, a hotel, a town hall," she said. "They had everything."

The village of Fisher was founded by Capt. John Barber White and Oliver Williams Fisher, men from Missouri and partners in a lumber business.

In Kansas City, Mo., White lived next door to Arthur E. Stilwell, who promoted the construction of Kansas City Southern Railroad. He

built a rail line south from Shreveport through the piney hills of north central Louisiana and put his Gulf of Mexico terminal at Port Arthur, Texas.

## State ag chief shares letter from timber owner

It's one thing to praise your own organization. It's another when someone from outside the group takes the time to write a "pat on the back" letter. Here is one I received from Dick and Mattie Zeagler of LaSalle Parish. The Zeagler's letter relates to the Louisiana forestry industry and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's (LDAF) role in protecting our forest resources.

Valued at more than \$2.5 billion, forestry is Louisiana's largest agricultural industry. Wildfire is one of forestry's greatest threats. During Aug.-Sept. 2010, the number of wildfires in the state increased by more than 700 percent over the same period in 2009. To protect this valuable resource as well as private homes and personal property, State Fire Marshall Butch

Browning and I declared a statewide burn ban Oct. 2.

The LDAF is tasked with wildfire detection and suppression of 18.9 million acres of wildland, including valuable commercial timber resources, yet receives wildfire detection and suppression funding from landowners for only 53 percent of the protected area.

In the meantime, LDAF will continue to monitor weather conditions and protect our forests. We can't save every inch of forest from wildfire, but LDAF firefighters will continue to do "more with less" to minimize the damage.

Dear Sirs,

I am writing to you to express my sincere gratitude towards a group of men and women who have for years gone unnoticed by much of the general population of our state.

This group is the foresters and wildfire fighters employed by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry.

I understand that this select group of people is on call 24 hours a day 7 days a week to ensure our safety. This was never more apparent than on October 1, 2010. On that day, a large wildfire took place in LaSalle Parish that has made our entire region sit up and take notice. After it consumed around 1,000 acres of timberland, people became not only more aware of what fire can and will do, but of what these men can and will do to protect us from it.

I happen to own a small 40-acre tract of pines that is ready to be thinned for the first time. Your men stopped the fire less than 100 feet from my property line. Since no

crop insurances are available for small landowners such as me, the blow from losing the potential income I had hoped to gain from my timber would have been devastating. That being said, I know that my timber does not and will never hold the many values of the many homes that the men saved that day!

I understand that Mr. Clay Mayo and his men placed themselves directly in front of this large wildfire that was heading toward a neighbor's home. While I cannot imagine what these men saw coming toward them, I can, as you should, view the damage left behind in the fire's wake. Mr. Mayo, his crew, and all others who assisted on that day, are greatly appreciated.



# Sweet Potato Dishes

From the

### *Sweet Stir Fried Yams*

2 tbsps. oil	1 tbsp. honey
2 lbs. sweet potatoes, peeled & cut into 1/2 inch cubes	1 cup chicken broth
1/2 cup golden raisins	1/4 tsp. each ground nutmeg & ground cloves
1/2 cup orange juice	1/2 cup sweetened dried coconut

Heat oil in wok or fry pan over medium-high heat. Add sweet potatoes to hot oil and stir-fry until tender crisp, about 7 minutes. Stir in raisins, orange juice, honey, 1/2 cup broth, cloves and nutmeg. Cover and simmer 10 minutes. Add remaining broth and simmer covered until potatoes are tender and liquid is absorbed. Stir in coconut. Transfer to serving dish and garnish with slivered, roasted almonds if desired.

### *Baked Sweet Potato Fries*

4 sweet potatoes (yams)	Salt and pepper to taste
2 tbsps. olive oil	Chopped parsley (optional)

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Coat baking sheet with nonstick cooking spray or line with foil. Cut sweet potatoes into 1/2-inch thick lengthwise strips, toss with oil. Arrange in single layer on baking sheet, bake 15-20 minutes. Turn potatoes over, bake 15-20 minutes or until golden brown all over. Season to taste, sprinkle with parsley.

### *Juban's Sweet Potato Chips*

4 large sweet potatoes, peeled  
2 quarts Peanut oil or Canola oil for frying  
powdered sugar

Slice sweet potatoes about 1/6 inch thick, using a vegetable slicer or mandolin. In a 6-quart pot, heat oil to 300 degrees. Carefully place about 1/2 of the chips in oil, stirring to separate. They will float to the top within a short time. Cook until golden brown - be careful not to burn the chips. Remove the chips from the oil quickly and drain on paper towels. Repeat with the remaining sweet potatoes. Let cool, then dust with powdered sugar and serve.

### *Deep Fried Yam Puppies*

7 cups canola oil	1 tsp. cayenne pepper
2 cups self-rising cornmeal mix	1/2 tsp. cinnamon
3 tbsps. self-rising all purpose flour	1 cup whole milk
1/2 cup finely chopped onion	1 egg, beaten
1/2 tsp. black pepper	1 (29 oz.) can of Bruce's Yams cut sweet potatoes in syrup, drained
2 tps. salt	

In a deep fryer or heavy deep skillet add the canola oil to a depth of at least 2 inches. Heat to 375 degrees. In a 4 quart bowl combine dry ingredients: cornmeal mix, flour, onion, pepper, salt, cayenne, cinnamon. Combine beaten egg and milk and then add to dry ingredients. Drain sweet potatoes and then slice them into 1/2 inch sized disks. Add potatoes one at a time to the hushpuppy mixture. Cover completely with mixture. Using 2 spoons (one to hold puppy and one to push it into the hot oil, fry puppies until they pop to the top. Turn once and fry until medium brown. Remove with tongs. Drain on a paper towel lined rack. Serve hot. This makes about 25 to 30 hushpuppies. Total time 35 minutes.

### *Honey Roasted Mashed Opelousas Sweet Potatoes*

6 sweet potatoes, about 1 lb.	1/2 tsp. nutmeg
1 stick butter, diced	1 cup honey
1 tsp. ground cinnamon	Salt and pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Peel and quarter potatoes. Place neatly in a roasting pan. Place butter evenly on top of potatoes. Sprinkle cinnamon and nutmeg on top. Drizzle with honey and season with salt and pepper. Gently pour 2 cups water into pan without washing mixture off potatoes. Cover and bake for 1 1/2 hours or until very tender. Remove cover and stir. Continue to cook for 1/2 hour. Potatoes should have a nice dark brown color on top and be very tender. Remove potatoes with slotted spoon and add to mixing bowl and whip until all lumps are gone. Drizzle in liquid from pan as desired. Turn off mixer and scrape bowl. Continue to mix, I usually use all my liquid because it's needed and has a lot of flavor. When desired consistency is there, adjust seasoning.

### *Sweet Potatoes with Onions and Cranberries*

3 lbs. sweet potatoes	1/2 cup white wine
3 medium yellow onions	1/2 cup chicken broth
2 tbsps. butter or margarine	3 tbsps. fresh thyme or 1 tsp. dried
1(5 oz.) pkg. dried Cranberries	Salt and black pepper, to taste

Peel sweet potatoes and cut into 1-inch chunks. Remove onion skins and cut onions into narrow wedges. In large, 12-in. skillet with tight fitting lid, melt butter over medium heat. Add sweet potatoes and onions and cook uncovered, stirring frequently, until onions are light golden brown, about 20 minutes. Add cranberries, wine, broth and thyme. Bring to boil, cover, then reduce heat and simmer gently for 15 to 20 minutes or until potatoes are tender and liquid is almost absorbed. Season with salt and pepper. If made ahead, cool, cover and refrigerate. Reheat gently to serve. Makes 8 to 10 servings.



He reportedly fueled his neighbor's interest in Louisiana timberland so much that White and Fisher began exploring northwest Louisiana in 1897. Two years later they bought land for a mill.

According to local history, White and Fisher wanted to place a sawmill in Many, but the residents opposed the noise and dirt.

In 1899, Louisiana Long Leaf Lumber Co. was incorporated, six miles south of Many on about 10,000 acres. White and Fisher built a town near their operation to house themselves and their workers, and they named it after Fisher.

According to oral history recordings, the people of Sabine River country didn't like the idea of a corporation nearby. They shot out cabin windows and disturbed the toil of mill workers.

Still, the sawmill town thrived with a commissary, school, church, opera house, hotel, post office and a hospital, among other buildings.

Most of the buildings stand today except the hospital and

a hotel that was torn down and sold for lumber in the 1970s.

The town is still separated by Kansas City Southern railroad tracks, the original dividing line between mill managers' homes and those of the workers.

In the 1960s, Louisiana Long Leaf Lumber Co. dissolved and sold the mill and town to Boise Cascade. Most of the buildings and homes were sold.

Susan Slay is the town's mayor. Her grandfather and father came from Missouri to work at the mill in 1927; she grew up in town.

The house where she was born is next door to her current home, in a stretch of old buildings on what is known as "4-L Drive."

Fisher's original homes were those of millworkers who paid the company a minimal rent. Some of those houses still stand. "I remember Daddy telling me the rent was \$4," she said.

Slay said mill workers and their families were taken care of. If they needed more room in their homes, they would

request it and usually get it.

"They had two carpenter crews. You came in and wrote your name down and said, 'I'd like to add a bedroom or whatever,' and you were on the list," she said.

Today, many of the town's houses are listed on the National Register of Historic Places and are used by the community. The original post office is still in operation. The church also still stands, though it has been moved. The opera house, which once hosted country music greats like Hank Williams and Kitty Wells, lacks heating or cooling systems and can only be used in spring and fall.

Slay said she wants to preserve the town because it means a lot to her and has so much to do with her family history.

Slay recalls her life growing up there a simple, but happy one in a town with a lot of pride and unity, she said.

Slay said over the years, the town and its people have made efforts to preserve and restore the town.

She said turning state attention to the town a treasure, she said is an ongoing effort.

"We like it," she said. "It's a good place to live."
