## Farewell Miss Mildred

### Mildred Patton Fish

February 22, 1921 - November 1, 2010



Mildred Patton Fish was an employee with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) for more than 37 years. She died at 1:20 a.m. Monday, Nov. 1, 2010. She was 89, a resident of Baton Rouge and a native of Clarks.

Miss Mildred Fish started her tenure at the LDAF in Aug. of 1973 as a clerk for the Louisiana Market Bulletin until June of 1996 when she transferred to the Office of Management and

Finance. She is survived by a brother, Roy Patton; and numerous nieces, nephews and friends. Fish was preceded in death by her husband, Jack Fish; three sisters and five brothers. She was a member of the First Baptist Church.

An annual LDAF Employees Remember Miss Mildred Day has been setup in Miss Mildred's memory. A collection will be held every Nov. 1 and the proceeds donated to the Greater Baton Food Bank. Four-hundred and fifty dollars was collected and donated this year.

## Group explores ways to increase awareness of locally grown food

When the Louisiana Sustainable Local Food Policy Council met in Avoyelles Parish to discuss how to increase awareness of locally grown food, some of the members had no idea how good goat milk tasted.

"Goat milk is delicious," said Marguerite Constantine, co-owner of WesMar Farms, a goat dairy in Moreauville.

The group, chaired by Rep. Scott Simon of Abita Springs, met in Mansura Nov. 16 at the Louisiana 4-H Museum and heard from experts in the agricultural and restaurant fields. Side field trips included stops at the Brown Bag Gourmet in Marksville and WesMar Farms where the group had the opportunity to sample the goat milk.

The council is holding a series of meetings over the next two years to gather information to incorporate in a future sustainable food policy that can be applied to school lunch systems, government assistance programs and other public services.

Constantine, Trent Bonnette of Brown Bag Gourmet and Ponchatoula High School agriscience teacher Alice Dubois also made presentations.

Dubois, who is also the school's Future Farmers of America (FFA) advisor, brought along FFA member Michelle Laterrade who explained to the council how the Ponchatoula High FFA interacts with the community at large.

"We learn about the urban and rural diversity in agriculture," Laterrade said. "We've also worked with agriscience professionals."

Laterrade's presentation illustrated the work the Ponchatoula FFA has done in growing vegetation for wetlands restoration and planting cypress trees in critical habitat. The Ponchatoula High chapter also grows produce in square foot garden plots and contributes their produce to local food banks.

"The food bank was overwhelmed by our contribution. See Local food, continued on page 20

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## LDAF and LCA partner to combat farm theft

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., and Louisiana Cattlemen's Association (LCA) President Jack Cutshall announced a new plan called the Livestock Producer Protection Program that will help fight theft on the farm.

"Livestock and equipment theft is a serious issue in rural Louisiana," Strain said. "The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is committed to protecting our producers' investments, and by partnering with LCA, we hope to prevent theft instead of just investigating it."

Livestock producers will complete a farm inventory and a LDAF premises identification registration form available from either LCA or

LDAF's Louisiana Brand Commission. The producer will retain the inventory form for reference in case of a theft. Once participants complete the enrollment process, "Livestock Producer Protection Program" signs will be provided by the LCA and/or the LDAF to warn would-be thieves that the farm is enrolled in the program.

Louisiana livestock producers are eligible to sign up with the LDAF and membership is free. Enrollment with LCA is for members only and requires a nominal fee.

Cutshall said warning signs that read, "Member Louisiana Cattlemen's Association Protected" are available exclusively for LCA members.

"The best defense against theft is a good offense," Cutshall said. "We are making a concerted effort to make it hard to sell stolen livestock and agricultural equipment."

Strain said LDAF Brand Commission inspectors investigated 267 complaints and recovered or accounted for property valued at \$1,570,540 in 2009.

LDAF Livestock Brand Commission Director Carl Bennett said having information provided through the program will help law enforcement quickly identify the stolen property.

"Time is not on your side when investigating a crime," Bennett said. "One problem investigators commonly face is getting an accurate description of the stolen equip-

ment. Victims frequently haven't kept their records up to date so key information is not available."

Strain said the program is patterned after a Texas model that has been very successful.

The Texas program has been in place since the 1940s.

The Livestock Producer Protection Program is fully funded through a LDAF animal disease traceability grant funded by the United States Department of Agriculture.

"We believe the signs alone will be a deterrent," Strain said. "When participants do experience theft, LDAF investigators will now be armed with vital information that will aid in the recovery of stolen items."

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





tion of fresh produce," Dubois said. "They said they hardly ever receive fresh food."

Dubois said the lack of access of locally produced food in institutional food networks is a problem.

"We grow strawberries at the school, but when the cafeteria served strawberries at school at the height of the season, the berries were from California," Dubois said.

Bonnette told the council that he is constantly looking for ways to incorporate Louisiana food items, like Louisiana beef, sweet potatoes and cane syrup, into his menu.

Bonnette wasn't just giving lip service to the local food movement. He backed up his rhetoric when the council made a field trip to his Brown Bag Gourmet restaurant on Marksville's Acton Road.

Bonnette's choice for the set lunch was a hamburger or a shrimp, tasso and grits combo plate. A hamburger? Yes, a hamburger, but not just any hamburger. The Brown Bag Gourmet's hamburger is made from

beef grown at the Eagle Ranch in the nearby Goudeau community. The cattle from which the beef comes is processed at Babineaux's Slaughterhouse in Breaux Bridge. Of course, the shrimp and tasso on the grits entrée were Louisiana-grown as well.

"You can get the beef products easily from a food distributor," Bonnette said. "That's the easiest and quickest way, but I've made a commitment to buy as much local product as possible to serve in my restaurant."

Bonnette also uses goat cheese from WestMar Farms.

After the lunch, members of the council, including Simon and Dickie Brennan of Commander's Palace and Stephen Santillo of Blue Dog Café in Lafayette reconvened at WesMar Farms to tour Constantine's goat dairy.

Constantine said potential buyers for goat products are more familiar with conventional supply businesses and she finds it difficult to break into institutional markets.

Constantine said she welcomes the mar-

keting challenge and has adopted a "whatever it takes" attitude.

"We wanted to open our farm to the public as an agritourism venture and because we have goats, we found we had to be classified as a zoo to get the proper permits," Constantine said. "So I thought whatever it takes. We kind of like the idea that we are one of only two zoos in Avoyelles parish."

Constantine also told the council there are obstacles she will have to overcome to get her food products in the local public school cafeterias.

"We learned we have to be classified as a USDA-approved commodity," Constantine said.

Brennan and Santillo were impressed with WesMar Farms' goat milk and bought all of the farm's milk on hand and several varieties of the cheese for use in their restaurants.

"My sous chef at the Blue Dog is going to try the goat milk in some new recipes," Santillo said. "We're already using goat cheese locally produced in St. Martinville

from Belle Ecorce Farms at Jolie's Louisiana Bistro."

Simon said the presentations made an impact on him.

"We have a need for local food producers but fewer are getting into agricultural professions," Simon said. "We're experiencing a shrinking set of farmers but it looks like new ways of family farming have the potential to emerge."

The Louisiana Sustainable Local Food Policy Council is comprised of agricultural producers, representatives from the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, LSU and Southern AgCenters, the Louisiana Cooperative Extension Service, Louisiana Dietetics Association, Louisiana Meat Processors Association, restaurateurs, commercial fishermen, farmers markets representatives and other government representatives.
