Strain responds to Bloomberg Businessweek criticism of domestic catfish production

As Louisiana's Commissioner of Agriculture and Forestry, I take great exception to the Oct. 12, 2010, Bloomberg Businessweek article by Bruce Einhorn.

Einhorn cites Norbert Sporns, Chief Executive Officer of HQ Sustainable Maritime Industries. HQ Sustainable is an aquaculture and aquatic product processing company based in Hainan, China. Mr. Sporns compares Chinese tilapia farms favorably to catfish farms in Louisiana. Mr. Sporns describes the conditions of our Louisiana catfish production facilities as "despicable."

"Our standards," Mr. Sporns says, "are way, way better."

Several reputable sources refute Mr. Sporns' claims.

According to USACatfish.com, "United States farm-raised catfish is not given any added hormones. Under normal growing conditions, U.S. farm-raised catfish is antibiotic-free..."

In addition, a Nov. 8, 2010, Delta Farm Press article entitled "U.S. Catfish Farmers Push for United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Inspections" recaps the diet that U.S. farm-raised catfish consume.

"According to (the) Catfish Famers of America (CFA), U.S. farm-raised catfish are some of the healthiest and safest fish in the world, raised in ponds filled with pure, fresh water, and fed a diet of high-protein food pellets, made from a mixture of soybeans, corn, wheat, vitamins and minerals."

National Public Radio's May 11, 2007, report by Melanie Peoples stated, "tests on some frozen catfish fillets from China have found two antibiotics banned by the Food and Drug Administration. Alabama has banned catfish from China, after it determined that the fillets contained the antibiotics. Mississippi has halted store sales of the imported fish; Louisiana and

Arkansas plan to test all catfish imported from China."

Peoples' article, entitled "States Ban Catfish Imports from China over Tests," cited the use of antibiotics in Chinese catfish production that are banned by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Peoples wrote, "Repeated tests by Mississippi and Alabama show the presence of fluoroquinolone antibiotics, which the FDA has banned for use, saying they lead to the emergence of antibiotic-resistant bacteria."

The New York Times June 29, 2007, "FDA Issues Alert on Chinese Seafood" article by Andrew Martin reported "the Food and Drug Administration today issued an alert challenging imports of five major types of farm-raised seafood from China, including shrimp and catfish, because testing found recurrent contamination from carcinogens and antibiotics."

The FDA inspects the two catfish processors in Louisiana, Haring's Pride in Wisner and Guidry's Catfish in Breaux Bridge.

Dr. Lucina Lampila, Associate Professor of Seafood Technology at Louisiana State University's Department of Food Science, says FDA inspections normally occur at any point from annually to once each four to seven years depending upon the risk level of the food product. FDA has the option to contract with the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH) to have more frequent inspections and often do so if the product in question is ready to eat or high risk.

FDA inspections include the Seafood Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP) regulations which requires processors of fish and fishery products to understand the food safety hazards associated with their process and product and, through a system of preventive controls, to keep those hazards from

occurring.

FDA rules also include the Current Good Manufacturing Practice regulations, which provide the basis for determining whether the products have been processed under sanitary conditions. In addition, Louisiana catfish processors are subject to the Thermally Processed Low-Acid Foods Packaged in Hermetically Sealed Containers and Acidified Food regulations, which specifically address the hazard of Clostridium botulinum in these products.

Statistics compiled by Patricia Schafer, Compliance Branch Director and Director of Import Operations for the FDA's New Orleans District, indicated Haring's Pride's two processing plants were inspected in 2009 and had no violations. Guidry's Catfish passed with only minimal problems that were insufficient to warrant even a warning letter.

Catfish inspection by USDA's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) is required by the 2008 Farm Bill, but final regulations are not yet in place. The law will transfer the inspection and regulation of catfish from the FDA to the USDA, which has a tighter inspection and safety programs in regards to catfish.

When the USDA takes over inspections, Office of Catfish Inspection Programs (OCIP) activities will take place throughout all aspects of catfish production.

According to USDA National Agricultural Statistics Service, the most current number of catfish farming operations in Louisiana is 17 (as of January 1, 2008). In 2010 the water surface acres for the industry totaled 1,800. Louisiana growers had \$8,395,000 in sales during 2009.

Louisiana's catfish are raised under the healthiest conditions anywhere in the world and are by far the safest and best tasting fish you can buy.

While 2010 has been a good year for state agricultural interests, the Louisiana Agriculture Finance Authority (LAFA) is still processing federal aid money for producers that were affected by the 2008 storms and the wet weather of 2009.

"LAFA is busy administering \$92 million of federal funds to assist our farmers, ranchers and fishers and agribusinesses," Strain said. "The Farm and Agribusiness Recovery Grant and Loan Program was the first and only one of its kind in the United States and is helping our state producers recover and rebuild."

Strain said that LAFA has reduced its bonded indebtedness by more than \$28.5 million (31.24 percent) during the last three years.

The LDAF also awarded more than \$310,000 of USDA grant funds for research, education and promotion to enhance the competitiveness of specialty crops in Louisiana in 2010 and disbursed \$380,000 worth of food coupons to 16,000 senior citizens participating in the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program.

The coupons are redeemed at approved farmers markets and roadside stands for fresh fruits, vegetables, herbs and honey, Strain said.

LDAF was affected by a budget cut that removed more than \$8.4 million to its funding.

"During the past three years, we reduced our budget by more than \$24.7 million (22.9 percent)," Strain said. "Since 2008, we streamlined and downsized the department by more than 300 employees (30 percent), eliminated 383 vehicles (37 percent of the fleet) and decreased the aviation fleet by seven aircraft (31.5 percent)."

Other highlights of the 2010 LDAF agricultural year:

- ◆ The boll weevil has been functionally eradicated from the cotton fields of Louisiana. The Boll Weevil Eradication Commission, Technical Advisory Committee, LDAF personnel, cotton farmers, agricultural consultants, pesticide applicators and state, local and federal partners are to be commended.
- ◆ The LDAF is working with the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals, Louisiana Economic Development and other groups to promote and assure the quality and safety of Louisiana seafood in response to the Deep Water Horizon oil spill.
- ◆ Louisiana experienced a record number of wildland fires during a drought that was most severe from August through October. In that period, 936 fires burned nearly 10,000 acres of wildland.
- ◆ The LDAF received a favorable decision in ongoing litigation to establish the authority of the LDAF to rule on the closing of rural railroad crossings. The Federal Court for the Middle District of Louisiana remanded the case back to the 19th Judicial District Court, thus reaffirming our position that this is an issue under state jurisdiction.
- ◆ The LDAF helped secure a \$500,000 grant to establish the National Food Animal Veterinary Institute Pilot Program to address the national shortage of large-animal veterinarians and technicians. Strain worked closely with Missouri Secretary of Agriculture Jon Hagler and USDA Deputy Undersecretary for Rural Development, Cheryl Cook to establish the program.
- ◆ The LDAF continues to represent state agricultural interests as they pertain to the 2012 Farm Bill, Cap and Trade, Estate Tax, Capital Gains Tax, Food Safety Modernization Act, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits, immigration reform, Chesapeake Clean Water and Ecosystem Restoration Act and as well as other related issues.
- ◆ Strain accepted positions as vice-chair of the Southern United Trade Association, treasurer of the Southern Association of the State Departments of Agriculture and treasurer of the National Interstate Pest Control Compact.
