Topping most farmers' list of expenses is seed. Just ask veteran farmer Ray Young of Franklin Parish and he will tell you he doles out big-time cash for seed. "Seed cost is our biggest single cost nowadays," Young said. "Cottonseed is \$600 for a 50-pound bag. Depending on your seeding rate, it will cost anywhere from \$70-\$120 an acre." By Young's calculations, a cotton farmer who plants 1,000 acres in cotton will spend somewhere between \$70,000 and \$120,000 alone on seed. When producers spend that kind of cash on seed, farmers like Young are not willing to gamble on quality. Young said information provided by seed companies has proven to be pretty reliable. But Young double checks his seed quality with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's (LDAF) State Seed-Testing Laboratory. These extra tests provided by the agency are added insurance for the farmer, ensuring that he is planting high quality seed. "The seed companies do provide their own test results but often we'll have a state Department of Agriculture inspector collect samples to have third-

party test run," Young said. "Most years the quality is pretty good. Once in a great while the seed quality will deteriorate and you have make adjustments to your original plan and plant more seed or delay planting until the weather warms up."

Seed Commission Director Kevin Wofford said the Seed Programs Division and the seed-testing lab, located in a separate building behind LDAF's Baton Rouge headquarters, provide valuable services to agricultural producers and others who purchase seed for planting. The lab strives to ensure that consumers get high quality agricultural, vegetable, flower and tree seed through the enforcement of all laws, rules and regulations governing seed quality.

"Inspectors collect samples from large ag co-ops to local garden centers to verify what is listed on the manufacturer's label is accurate," Wofford said.

In addition to sampling in the marketplace, inspectors check the "test date" on seed packages. A germination "test date" is required for all seed including cotton, vegetable and grass seed packages. Seed germination will

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



Poor Man's Caviar

1 (15 oz) can black-eyed peas, rinsed & drained	1/3 cup frozen or canned corn
1/4 cup finely chopped green bell pepper	1 tbsp. finely chopped jalapenos
1/3 cup finely chopped tomatoes	3 tbsps. red wine vinegar or seasoned red wine vinegar.
1/3 cup finely chopped red onion	2 tsp. olive oil
1/3 cup finely chopped green onion	

In a bowl, combine all ingredients, cover and let sit at room temperature for 2-3 hrs., stirring occasionally. Refrigerate after serving.

Speedy Spinach Dip

2 (10 oz.) pkg. frozen, chopped spinach	1 (5 oz.) can evaporated skim milk
1 cup salsa	1 cup shredded, reduced-fat Swiss or Alpine lace cheese
4 oz. reduced-fat cream cheese	

Cook spinach according to pkg. directions and drain well. In a medium nonstick pot, combine spinach with remaining ingredients. Cook over medium heat, stirring until cheese is melted.

Marinated Shrimp Edamame Salad

1 lb. medium peeled shrimp, seasoned, cooked & coarsely chopped	2 tbsps. lime juice
1 cup shelled edamame, cooked according to directions	1 tbsp. olive oil
1 cup halved cherry tomatoes	1 tsp. wasabi paste
1 bunch green onions, chopped	1 tsp. grated fresh ginger or 1/2 tsp. ground ginger

In a medium bowl, combine shrimp, edamame, tomatoes and green onions. In a small bowl, whisk together remaining ingredients & toss with shrimp mixture. Refrigerate until serving.

Marinated Shrimp

2 lbs. medium peeled shrimp, seasoned and cooked	2 tbsps. chopped parsley
2 (14 oz.) cans quartered artichoke hearts, drained	1/4 cup red wine vinegar
1 (15 oz.) can hearts of palm, drained	2 tbsps. lemon juice
3 tbsps. capers, drained	1/4 cup olive oil
1 bunch green onions, chopped	2 tbsps. canola oil
	3 tbsps. dry mustard
	1 tsp. minced garlic
	Salt & pepper to taste

In bowl, combine shrimp, artichoke hearts, heart of palm, capers and green onions. In a small bowl, combine remaining ingredients and toss with shrimp mixture. Refrigerate until serving.

Crunchy Fruity Coleslaw

4 cups shredded green cabbage	1/4 cup slivered almonds, toasted
4 cups shredded red cabbage	2 tbsps. sesame seeds, toasted
1 red bell pepper, cored and thinly sliced into 1-inch pieces	1/4 cup balsamic vinegar
2/3 cup chopped dried apricots	1 tbsp. honey
1 1/2 cups frozen corn, thawed	2 tbsps. canola oil
1 bunch green onions, chopped	1 tps. minced garlic

In a large bowl, combine green & red cabbages, red pepper, apricots, corn, green onions, almonds & sesame seeds. In a small bowl, whisk together remaining ingredients. Toss with salad and mix well.

Quick Lemon Basil Shrimp

2 tbsps. olive oil	2 tbsps. fresh chopped basil
2 tps. minced garlic	leaves 2 tbsps. chopped parsley
1 1/2 lbs. medium to large peeled shrimp	2 tbsps. lemon juice
	Salt & pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. In an oblong, shallow baking dish, combine oil and garlic. Heat in oven 2-3 minutes, watching carefully that garlic does not brown. Add shrimp to oil mixture and return to oven. Bake for 4 minutes, stir shrimp, and continue cooking 4-6 minutes until shrimp are done. Remove from oven and sprinkle with basil, parsley and lemon juice. Season to taste.

vary depending on seed kind and storage conditions; therefore it is important that the seed is re-tested prior to expiration to ensure seed germination remains high, Wofford said.

Wofford said a strong regulatory seed program is essential in Louisiana.

“Although Louisiana produces several thousand acres of seed rice, sugarcane, sweet potatoes and small grains each year, Louisiana is predominately a seed importing state” Wofford said.

Seed Commission Assistant Director Lester Cannon said seed offered for planting, from tiny packets of tomato seed to pricey 50-pound bags of cottonseed, must pass at least two tests.

State and federal law require seed producers to affix a label on their products listing the percentages of pure seed and non-seed material contained in the bag, Cannon said. A purity test determines if the listed percentages of seed and non-seed materials in a sample are accurate.

“For a purity test, analysts separate pure seed from other material to verify that the pure seed percentage listed on the label is accurate,” Cannon said. “In particular, we look for noxious weed seed because it is very important that we prevent the introduction or the spread of noxious weeds in Louisiana via seed.”

The second test performed is a germination test, Cannon said.

“The germination test tells us if the seed sample is viable and will emerge and develop into a normal seedling,” Cannon said.

Seeds are planted in soil or positioned onto moistened towels and placed in a seed germinator, a device resembling a large side-by-side refrigerator. Cannon said the germinator replicates ideal germinating conditions. If less than 60 percent of an agricultural seed sample germinates, the seed lot can't be sold here.

If a sample does not fall within the tolerances established by law, the agency has authority to force a seed owner to re-label the product, Cannon said. In addition, if a sample contains too great a percentage of a noxious weed seed, of poor

quality or there is other major labeling problems, LDAF can issue a “stop sale” order.

Cannon said sometimes seed owners request additional tests, usually vigor tests like the Texas Cool test for cotton, and the Accelerated Aging test for soybeans. These tests determine seed performance under less than ideal conditions, which farmers are often faced with in Louisiana.

LDAF also provides services for seed certification.

Louisiana seed producers seeking certification for their seed must meet standards set by the Association of Official Seed Certifying Agencies. The designation is given only to superior seed after passing a rigorous inspection, sampling, testing and documentation process.

“Certified seed must meet more stringent field inspections and lab tests,” Cannon said. “It is a step better than non-certified seed. It is kind of a value added product, if you will.”

As part of the process, certified samples are taken from seed batches that have passed seed certification field inspection standards specific to the crop kind and variety.

Cannon estimated that around 13,000 acres of cropland is dedicated to growing certified seed in Louisiana. The program currently

certifies seven different commodities: sweet potatoes, rice, soybeans, turf grass, oats, wheat and sugarcane. Currently, the LDAF is in the process of developing certification standards for several native plant

species to be used in the coastal restoration efforts, Cannon said.

Wofford said the seed-testing lab analyzes seed for a number of purposes but it has seen a steady increase in requests from game hunters, hunting clubs and farmers who want to make sure their wildlife mixes, a blend of two or more seed kinds like wheat, oats and Austrian winter peas, will attract wildlife.

“Hunting is such a big business these days and more and more people have begun selling wildlife seed mixtures,” Wofford said. “Farmers and hunters will plant hundreds and

even thousands of acres of food plots.”

Wofford explained that seed analysts take special care when examining wildlife mixtures.

“There are a lot of exotic seeds in these mixtures and some of them run afoul of our noxious weed seed law,” Wofford said. “Some things that are allowed in other states are prohibited in Louisiana because they could create a major problem if they are introduced here.”

The Louisiana Seed-Testing Lab, an Association of Official Seed Analysts (AOSA) certified lab, is the only seed-testing lab in Louisiana that offers seed testing services to the public. All tests are conducted under nationally accepted procedures by AOSA certified analysts.

Seed-testing fees range from \$8 to \$24 each depending on the seed kind and type of test. Electronic lab results and monthly billing are available. Wofford said seed samples, seed sample forms and payments may be hand-delivered or mailed to the LDAF State Seed-Testing Lab at 5825 Florida Blvd., Baton Rouge, LA 70806. Forms and fee schedules are available at www.ldaf.la.gov.



Oberlin opens new farmers market

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said the grand opening of a farmers market in downtown Oberlin April 13 was the first step to ensure that residents of the Allen Parish town will have locally grown fresh fruits and vegetables available for consumption.

"When I first heard that 'food deserts' exist in Louisiana, I couldn't believe it," Strain said. "There are areas across our state where you cannot get fresh fruits, fresh vegetables or other fresh food. Food deserts exist in rural areas like Oberlin and in parts of New Orleans.

"At the turn of the century we had farmers markets everywhere and everyone had their own gardens. We have to get back to the basics and farmers markets are a

vital part of providing good nutrition."

Strain lauded the efforts of the Oberlin farmers market organizer, Brenda Byrd.

"It takes a lot of hard work to put a market together," Strain said. "There is wealth in the land of rural America and the farmers market."

Byrd said Oberlin became a food desert because parish residents' spending habits shifted over the years.

"My mom and dad had a grocery store in Oberlin and they grew a lot of the produce they sold in the store," Byrd said. "Everyone grew their own garden and sold their extra produce. At one time Oberlin supported several grocery stores but things changed."

Today, the town does not have a

single grocery store that sells fresh produce on a regular basis, Byrd said.

"You and I had something to do with that," Byrd said. "We started using our shopping dollars in other communities and it took its toll on Oberlin. The town has become a food desert. We're hoping our farmers market will start the reversal of that trend. We want to see some fresh produce coming back here and we encourage local gardening."

Byrd said the Oberlin Farmers Market accepts food stamps. The market will also redeem the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program coupons when they are issued by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry and United States Department of Agriculture.

The Oberlin Farmers Market, 228 W. 6th Avenue, Allen Parish, is open Wednesdays from 9 a.m. through 1 p.m. and features a variety of in-season fruits and vegetables from local growers. Local vendors are needed, Byrd said.

Paddling, canoeing workshop set for June 9-10 in Vidalia

The LSU AgCenter will conduct a two-day workshop at the Vidalia Conference Center June 9-10 for entrepreneurs interested in business opportunities related to paddling and canoeing.

The workshop will inform landowners, communities and entrepreneurs about the potential diversifying farming operations through using waterways and federal and state recreation areas to include paddling, said Dora Ann Hatch, LSU AgCenter agritourism coordinator.

Participants will learn how to manage land resources and about liability and legal considerations, marketing and business management related to water recreation, Hatch said.

"Communities throughout the United

States that have developed paddling trails have witnessed economic and social impacts," she said. "Economically, paddling trails help diversify the economy by offering landowners more options for their land use."

Paddlers typically spend \$27 to \$63 per day, Hatch said.

"Socially, paddling improves the quality of life issues in communities through stewardship and healthy lifestyles," she said.

The workshop will include morning classroom sessions and an afternoon trip to Monterey Delta, a diverse, 4,000-acre farm with six miles of Bayou Cocodrie running through the property. The farm produces rice, soybeans, cotton, corn and crawfish. During the trip, participants will learn about

waterfowl, native plants, crawfishing, birding and pond management.

On the second afternoon, John Ruskey, a river guide and canoe builder with the Quapaw Canoe Co. in Clarksdale, Miss., will offer an optional field trip to canoe in nearby waters. His company provides guided expeditions by kayak, canoe and stand-up paddle boards on the Lower Mississippi River and some of its tributaries.

The LSU AgCenter has received a \$115,000 grant from the Walton Family Foundation to facilitate efforts to make the northeast Louisiana Mississippi River parishes a nature tourism destination based on unexploited natural resources and has formed an ecotourism advisory group in northeast Louisiana, Hatch said.

Workshop sponsors include the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation, the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, Mississippi State University, Mississippi State University Extension Service, the U.S. EPA, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the Louisiana Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism.
