## Strain, USDA officials meet with producers and others in Vidalia

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., met with farmers and ranchers atop the levee in Vidalia May 20 and urged them to remain in close contact with their local Farm Service Agency (FSA) office, financial advisors, crop insurance representatives and local government leaders as Mississippi River floodwaters rise and recede.

“Contact your local FSA office. Contact your insurers. Keep good records, and when you need us, you call us,” Strain said. “We are going to be here to help.”

The meeting was held on the levee behind the Vidalia Riverfront, a district that includes a hospital, medical center, hotel and conference center. The structures, built on the batture between the levee and the river, are being temporarily protected from the Mississippi River by dams of Hesco baskets, electric and diesel pumps and manpower. The human element was need to keep pumps working and to monitor seepage, leaks and backwater problems.

Ted Glaser, a 63-year-old farmer has been

planting his leased Morganza Spillway fields for more than a decade. This spring, he had a thousand acres in corn and soybeans planted in the spillway. The corn was just about to start tasseling. soybeans were greening.

Glaser said he has always known it's a risk to plant in the Morganza Spillway but he defended his routine.

“It hadn't flooded there in 38 years. That's some of the richest soil in the United States and it produces,” Glaser said. “Yes, it's a risk, but people ought to be glad we

are farming it because the cost of food is going up. People don't realize you have to grow it and that food doesn't just come off the grocery shelf.”

The financial burden is enormous for a single farmer, Glaser said. He had \$320,000 invested in his Morganza crop.

“I was worried to death to lose all the inputs,” Glaser said. “All your money is up front in the corn crops. It's a risk that most people just don't understand.”

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Strain advises horse owners to protect against disease

In light of recent equine herpesvirus (EHV-1) cases in mostly western states, Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding Louisiana horse owners to continue practicing biosecurity measures in day-to-day activities.

Recent cases of EHV-1 were traced to horses that attended the National Cutting Horse Association's (NCHA) Western National Championship in Ogden, Utah from April 29 to May 8.

Strain said no known Louisiana horses that attended the Utah event re-entered the state.

Louisiana Department of

Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Animal Health and Food Safety officials, through information provided by Utah event officials, identified a Louisiana owner who had three horses at the show Strain said.

"The horses are currently in quarantine at a Nebraska training facility and to date have not exhibited any clinical symptoms of the disease," Strain said. "These three horses did not enter Louisiana following the Utah event; in fact they have been stabled and trained in Nebraska for several months."

Strain said although EHV-1 is highly contagious among horses,

the disease does not affect humans.

Strain said EHV-1 is a DNA virus, which can result in myeloencephalitis, causing severe neurological symptoms.

Physical symptoms of the EHV-1 virus may include respiratory symptoms, fever, lethargy and loss of appetite.

In severe cases, EHV-1 may also cause abortion and neurological symptoms exhibited as a loss of coordination, inability to stand, urine dribbling and diminished tail tone.

The illness can be fatal.

The most common means of

transmission of EHV-1 is by direct horse-to-horse contact often through aerosol transmission, inhalation of droplets from coughing and snorting. Animal handlers through contaminated hands, clothing, equipment, feed and water buckets, and tack may also spread the disease indirectly.

Area Veterinarian in Charge for the United States Department of Agriculture's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Richard Cambre, D.V.M., said the agency is working in conjunction with state veterinarians to monitor exposed horses in the respective states.



## Strain accepts NOLA locavore challenge

Ag and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain will be eating local this month. He is participating in the first annual New Orleans Eat Local Challenge.

The challenge is for participants to eat food that is grown or caught within a 200-mile radius of New Orleans.

“The best chefs of New Orleans use only the freshest ingredients in their recipes. That’s why their restaurants are so good,” Strain said. “When you use fresh, local ingredients, you can taste the difference.”

The challenge was issued by the NOLA Locavores, a group founded

by Leslie Brown, the founder of NOLA Veggie Fest, Linda Michurski of Hollygrove Market and Farm and Lee Stafford, the founder of Euterpre Recycling Center. The goal of the Challenge is connect residents of the Crescent City with



their food’s origins.

Contestants of the New Orleans Eat Local Challenge will pay a \$20 registration fee that entitles them to a 2011 Eat Local Challenge t-shirt and a 10 percent discount on produce purchased at the Hollygrove Market and Farm. They’ll also

receive a New Orleans Foods Buyer Guide, access to daily postings of recipes and tips, free admission to the Food Justice Film Series at Zeitgeist Multi-Disciplinary Arts Center and an invitation to the finale party July 1.

There will be five recipe contests throughout the Challenge in which contestants can win prizes like cookbooks, a three-course catered locavore meal and a case of wine.

“When you eat locally you are supporting the local farmer and small business owners in your town,” Strain said.

## Strain: Fresh produce coupons for senior citizens are on the way

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said that Farmers Market Nutrition Program coupons were mailed to Louisiana senior citizens recently.

Strain said the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's Agro-Consumer Services office distributed more than \$370,000 worth of coupons to qualifying senior citizens for 2011. Each qualifying senior citizen will receive \$24 worth of coupons.

More than 14,000 senior citizens have currently qualified for the program.

"The Farmers Market Nutrition Program helps our older residents purchase locally-grown fresh fruits and vegetables at farmers markets and roadside stands," Strain said. "Not only does the program give

them the ability to buy good, healthy, fresh food, it also supports our local farmers. The harvest is coming in now and there are plenty of tomatoes, blueberries, squash, beans and melons available."

Currently, 41 farmers markets and 90 roadside stands located throughout the state accept the coupons.

Farmers cannot give change for coupons; therefore, each purchase must be at least \$4. Coupons are not accepted at grocery stores or by non-participating farmers. Only farmers who have signed "Farmer Participation Agreements" with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry will accept the coupons. Seniors have the opportunity to redeem the coupons during the summer and fall growing seasons or until the

coupons expire November 30, 2011.

Seniors who receive coupons also receive a directory of participating farmers markets and roadside stands where the coupons may be spent.

A person must be at least 60 years old and earn less than 185 percent of the poverty level to qualify for the program. In a one-person household, the annual income level can be no more than \$20,147. The annual income in a two-person household cannot exceed \$27,214.



Fortunately, the United States Department of Agriculture, Federal Emergency Management Agency and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced on May 7 that the opening of the Morganza Spillway would be considered a natural disaster and not a man-made event. Strain pushed hard for the ruling.

"We wanted to make sure our farmers got the same deal as the Missouri farmers who lost their crops when the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers artificially breached the levee to save lives," Strain said.

The ruling meant that farmers like Glaser who had crop insurance would be able to file a claim against their policies.

"I'm fortunate I had crop insurance and bought a buy up," Glaser said. "I'll get my costs covered."

Strain and USDA undersecretaries Dallas Tonsager and Mike Scuse surveyed the Mississippi River flooding from the air above Butte La Rose, the Morganza Spillway and Vicksburg before landing in Natchez and driving across the Mississippi River to meet with farmers who were waiting there to talk with them.

Clarence Hawkins, state director for the USDA Rural Development office conducted the meeting. Willie Cooper, state director of the USDA Farm Service Agency, also

addressed the group.

Strain reiterated to the anxious crowd that agricultural producers in the Morganza Spillway would be eligible for payments for their losses provided they had purchased crop insurance.

"Colonel Ed Fleming of the Corps of Engineers told us that the flooding in the spillway would be inevitable. We asked him to put that in writing and he did," Strain said. "The USDA needed that distinction to be able to say that the flooding of the Morganza Spillway was a natural disaster."

Scuse advised cattle owners who had to move their livestock from flooded areas to meet with their local Farm Service Agency office.

"We're advising you to go to your local FSA office with your records as soon as you can," Scuse said. "Procedures have changed since the 2000 Farm Bill because we have new programs like the Livestock Indemnity Program and the Emergency Livestock Assistance Program. These programs did not exist before."

Scuse, a former state secretary of agriculture and farmer, said he had faced similar problems when he was farming.

"I've had to sit across from a banker before and tell him I could not meet my obligations," Scuse said. "I know what

you're facing."

Strain said not all agricultural contingencies will be covered by USDA programs.

"We're going to try to cover as many things as we can," Strain said. "Then we'll try to develop some mechanism to help with those uninsured losses."

Cooper said the Emergency Watershed Protection Program administered through the Natural Resources Conservation Service can help farmers remove debris and rehabilitate their fields after flood waters recede.


"Take photographs of damage to your fields," Cooper said. "Try to include an easily recognizable landmark in your photos so anyone will be able to verify that your field was damaged."

Strain also said there were some provisions in crop insurance policies dealing with feral hog damage to cropland but stressed it is required that producers use reasonable methods to prevent hog encroachment.

Strain assured the producers that the LDAF is working closely with the governor's office, the congressional delegation and the USDA to find ways to mitigate disaster expenses and losses.

"I'm grateful that these top USDA officials have come down here to visit with us and assure us that they are here to help," Strain said.

## LSU AgCenter says economic impact of flood, drought to La. farmers huge

La. farmers face huge losses from flood, drought damage

Earlier in May, corn and soybeans planted in the Morganza floodway sat parched. Farmers were anxious for a rain. Today, water covers these same crops, drowned by the opening of the spillway.

Miles Brashier, LSU AgCenter county agent in Point Coupee Parish, said about 10 percent of the parish's crops were located within the flood zone.

"That's a lot of money," Brashier said, standing near a field of corn and soybeans. "We're talking about three-quarters of a million dollars in crop loss just in this 1,000-acre field."

Water rushing through the spillway gates will make its way across the Morganza floodway into the Atchafalaya Basin.

Estimates before the floodgates opened were that about 18,000 acres would be damaged. But flooding isn't restricted to the basin. Water from flooding or seepage is affecting many acres from East Carroll Parish down to the coast, according to LSU AgCenter economist Kurt Guidry.

"I think when it's all said and done, we're probably going to see, at least in our first estimate, nearly 300,000 acres impacted," Guidry said, adding that this could translate into \$200 million in damages.

LSU AgCenter economists looked at crop damage from the 1973 opening of the Morganza Spillway. In current dollars, the costs of the 1973 flood would equal \$300 million.

Guidry said damage will largely depend on how long water stays in some areas and whether farmers can replant some acres. But Brashier says the water will likely linger on the land long enough to keep farmers from replanting.

"It wouldn't be an automatic that we'll be able to plant beans in July," Brashier said. "That probably wouldn't

question is, is that going to be a 30 percent, 40 percent or 50 percent loss, and we just don't know at this time," Guidry said.

Crops affected by flooding are mainly corn, cotton, soybeans and sugarcane. Cattle producers were able to move their herds out of the way of water, but many are crowded on pastures.

Brashier said this means farmers will likely need to feed their cattle hay earlier in the year than normal, but because the levees were closed for hay production, farmers may see hay shortages.

"That's about 8,000 acres of pastureland alone that beef cattle producers have lost, which is going to set them back for hay in the winter," Brashier said.

While flooding is a concern in areas along the basin, drought is a problem in many other areas of the state. According to Brashier crops outside of the spillway in Pointe Coupee Parish are already starting to experience drought stress.

"The first thing they do is they don't actually want to perform for you," Brashier said. "The bean pods will fall off. The corn will be shrunken. So, we have some situation where you won't have the yield potential that we should have."

If the drought continues, farmers across the state would see yield losses from either too much water or not enough.
