## Strain reelected to serve a second term



Mike Strain won reelection as Louisiana's Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner by a wide margin, according to returns provided by the Secretary of State's office. Unofficial, but complete returns, showed that Strain garnered more than 66 percent of the votes cast in the Oct. 22 election.

"I am honored that Louisiana voters have shown confidence in me and my organization and returned me to office," Strain said. "I thank my family, the thousands of people who supported me with their votes and my staff who helped me implement the changes the Department of Agriculture and Forestry needed.

Among the changes, was a reduction of operating expenses over the last three years. "I ended the department's construction program, which was a drain on financial resources and not an efficient allocation of manpower," Strain said.

Strain also trimmed the LDAF work force by 35 percent, and the debt load to the department and Louisiana Agricultural Finance Authority was reduced by 36 percent. The vehicle fleet was also cut by 410 vehicles while the aviation fleet was condensed by 36 percent. Strain also cut spending for gasoline. In 2011, fuel costs

were lessened by more than \$603,000 from 2008 spending levels despite higher unit costs.

Strain pledged to work hard for the farmer, rancher and aquaculture producers of the state.

"I will continue to promote Louisiana agriculture, forestry and aquaculture, find efficiencies in our organization and reduce costs expediently.

"The future is bright for Louisiana and American agriculture, forestry, aquaculture, energy and all other resource based industries. There are tremendous opportunities ahead for export and trade, which will revitalize our state and national economy.

"The bottom line is this: each year the world will grow by more than 75 million persons, reaching over nine billion by the year 2050.

"We must feed, clothe, house and provide energy worldwide to meet this growing demand and this will result in a tremendous economic impact to all of America.

"It's a tremendous challenge, but with the support of the agricultural community, I will provide the leadership for the future and bring good things to Louisiana. Thank you for allowing me to serve another four years."

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## LDAF "rolling billboard" promotes fresh La. produce

In Louisiana, you can't have a parade without throwing Mardi Gras beads, doubloons or other trinkets to the crowd from your float, but the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) broke with tradition at the Washington Parish Free Fair parade Oct. 19

Instead of beads, riders on the LDAF Specialty Crop Program float handed out fresh Louisiana satsumas.

The float is a "rolling billboard" advertising Louisiana's fresh produce and the Louisiana Grown website ([www.LouisianaGrown.com](http://www.LouisianaGrown.com)) where viewers can find producer information, farmers markets,



recipes and more.

The rolling billboard will travel to local fairs and festivals throughout the state and reach consumers with the message to buy Louisiana grown produce and to add more fresh fruits and vegetables to their diet.

Funding came from a United States Department of Agriculture

(USDA) Specialty Crop Block Grant Program (SCBGP) that awarded 55 grants to fund 740 initiatives across the United States and its territories. The grants will help strengthen the market for specialty crops like fruits, vegetables, tree nuts, dried fruits, horticulture and nursery crops, including floriculture.

## St. Landry Parish juveniles arrested in horse thefts

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said Livestock Brand Commission Inspectors and the St. Landry Parish Sheriff's Office arrested two Opelousas juveniles Oct. 10-11 for livestock theft. Strain said seven horses were stolen from the St. Landry Parish

Animal Control Shelter during a series of five break-ins from Aug. 8 through Oct. 1. One juvenile suspect was charged with seven counts of livestock theft, four counts of criminal trespass and one count of cruelty to animals. The second juvenile suspect was

charged with one count of livestock theft and once count of criminal trespassing. Six of the horses have been recovered. Investigators are still searching for the unrecovered horse. Livestock Brand Commission personnel investigate all agricul-

tural crime in Louisiana including theft of livestock (cattle, equines, hogs, emus, ostriches, turtles, sheep, and exotics) and farm machinery and equipment. All enforcement personnel are commissioned by Louisiana State Police and have full police powers in the performance of their duties.

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

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

## Ashland fire ruled arson, reward offered for arrest

A \$10,000 reward is being offered for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for the Sept. 2 Natchitoches Parish wildfire, Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.

Strain said the Louisiana Forestry Association, Hancock Forestry, Roy O. Martin Co., Weyerhaeuser and the Natchitoches Chamber of Commerce put up the reward.

Strain made the announcement at a press conference held Oct. 18, at the address of Natchitoches Parish Sheriff Deputy Ronnie Quick. Quick's home, 3048 Hwy. 153, Saline, was destroyed in the fire.

The fire, dubbed the "TD13 Fire," burned nearly 5,000 acres of timberland and destroyed 10 homes and 35 outbuildings. Timber losses were estimated at \$5 million in addition to \$2 to \$3 million in lost homes and other items.

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) investigators determined the cause of the fire was arson.

"It is important that we find whoever is responsible for this fire and hold them accountable," Strain said. "We are asking anyone with information to come forward."

The fire was first reported to the LDAF Natchitoches office as being near the Ashland and Creston communities around 1:45 p.m., Sept. 2. LDAF firefighting crews were immediately dispatched.

Sixteen crews, 11 from the LDAF and five from the U.S. Forest Service (USFS), worked through the night installing firelines.

In addition to the 16 bulldozer and engine crews, three LDAF aircraft, a USFS Type 3 helicopter and two single engine air tankers (SEATS) assisted in the operation.

Strain said local fire departments, local area officials, Louisiana National Guard, Natchitoches and Winn parish offices of emergency preparedness, Natchitoches Parish Sheriff's Office and Red Cross all gave assistance.

State Forester Wade Dubea said 2,695 fires have burned more than 35,753 acres of wildland and timber so far in 2011. In 2010, 2,335 wildfires burned 23,138 acres.

"Nearly half the state is under burn ban orders," Dubea said. "Conditions are very dry and wildfires can get out of hand very quickly. We will investigate the cause of every wildfire and take appropriate action."
