La. celebrates 200 years

Commissioner Mike Strain and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry celebrated Louisiana's statehood bicentennial by planting a live oak tree April 30.

Assisted by Lieutenant Governor Jay Dardenne, the Bicentennial Committee, his staff of assistant commissioners and Westminster Elementary students, Strain shoveled soil over the four-year-old live oak tree that was donated by Bracy's Nursery of Amite.

Strain joked with the schoolchildren and said, "We're planting this tree and you can come and watch it grow, and when we come 200 years from now, it will be a full-grown tree."

The tree was planted in A.Z. Young Park behind the State Welcome Center on River Road.

But the commemorative planting was only the first official recognition of the bicentennial.

A special joint session of the State Legislature featured addresses from a Shreveport-born Academy Award winner, a celebrity chef from Opelousas, well-

know actresses from Pineville and Zachary, musicians from Acadiana and New Orleans, and a national political consultant from Carville.

Dardenne presided over the ceremony, which included the unveiling of a U.S. Postal Service Forever Stamp featuring an Atchafalaya Basin nature scene from Baton Rouge photographer C.C. Lockwood.

Lockwood commented on his Facebook page that he had known that his photograph had been chosen for the stamp but had to keep it quiet for three years.

"The U.S. Congress was somewhat reluctant to embrace its 18th state," Dardenne said. "We were different... It's that difference that makes us special."

Louisiana was admitted to the union of the United States of American on April 30, 1812.

Federal court delays H-2B labor wage increase

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said U.S. Florida District Court Judge M. Casey Rogers' decision blocking a radical wage increase for H-2B labor should be allowed to stand.

Strain said Rogers' ruling delayed a recent decree by the U.S. Department of Labor mandating an across the board wage increase for all H-2B guest workers.

An LSU AgCenter economic impact study predicted that the increase in Louisiana could have ranged from 32 to 100 percent, Strain said.

The Florida court injunction delays implementation of the H-2B Program and Final Wage Rule for

60 days.

"If these wage increases are allowed to stand it will probably put Louisiana's last few remaining crawfish tail meat processors out of business," Strain said. "And that's a shame because Louisiana created the crawfish business.

"These jobs are seasonal. Americans workers aren't willing to take a seasonal job peeling crawfish or shrimp or picking crab meat for four or five months. Consequently, employers cannot fill vacancies for temporary jobs in their peeling plants, sugar mills, forests and packing factories so they have to advertise for guest workers who are willing to do those jobs."

The H-2B Visa Program is a default United States worker program that permits American employers to fill seasonal job vacancies with H-2B foreign visa workers so businesses can avoid closures due to lack of workers.

Louisiana shrimp, crab and other food service industries as well as candy manufacturers, sugarcane, forestry, equine, construction and hotel businesses employ seasonal workers through the H-2B program. These seasonal employees are typically paid the prevailing wage for the type of job performed in the geographical area in which they are hired.

"I don't know any business that could absorb a 32 percent wage

increase and stay solvent," Strain said. "If we cannot find a solution that is fair to employers who use the H-2B Visa Program, many agricultural industries will be adversely affected.

"This injunction is a step in the right direction and I applaud the decision of Judge Rogers who clearly recognized the economic harm to small business caused by the Department of Labor's H-2B rules.

"However, I know employers need more than a 60 day reprieve from the detrimental effects of these H-2B rules and the H-2B changes should be permanently withdrawn or legislatively removed by Congress."



Alligator nutrition center of LSU AgCenter research project

Alligator farmers could grow bigger alligators faster and with less cost based on feeding studies conducted at the LSU AgCenter Aquaculture Research Station.

Until about three years ago, crawfish, catfish and several other fish were the main research projects at the station, said station director Robert Reigh.

"We agreed to do some studies with small alligators through a grant from wildlife and fisheries to look at different feed mixtures as a way to help the farmers to keep their costs down," he said.

The feed the growers use is expensive, so the different mixtures being tested will explain what adjustments can be made to decrease their operating costs, he said.

The station can deal with smaller gators and conduct studies until they grew to about three feet. At that time they are returned to the wild, Reigh said.

When the alligators hatch each fall, wildlife and fisheries agents collect them and provide enough for the nutrition studies.

"When we get them, they are about a month old," Reigh said. "At that point, they are almost identical in size, weighing within about a gram of each other."

At this early age, they are easy to handle and space is not as much an issue as when they get to 3-4 feet.

Hatchlings are fed different mixtures and amounts of feed to see if it causes any difference in their growth rates. The feed mixtures contains varying amounts of fish meal and grains, with some including cellulose to determine if it has any effect on digestibility.

"We are interested in the digestibility of the

various feeds, which have a 57 percent protein content," Reigh said.

With little nutrition information available for alligator feeds, he's looking to provide energy, digestibility and nutrient information from the various mixtures.

Feeding alligators is quite a bit different than other animals. "If you're feeding a cow, or horse or dog, you're feeding them a lot of energy, relative to the amount of protein you're giving them," Reigh said. "It's different with aquatic animals because they have very low energy requirements."

In cool temperatures alligator grow slowly because they are not requiring much energy, but as the temperature increases, they will grow at a faster rate, he said.

When temperatures reach the mid-to upper 90s, the heat stress causes negative effects.

At the research station, the temperature is kept at a constant 90 degrees, and the alligators are fed every day.

While alligator meat continues to be in high demand, producers are mostly interested in the skin quality. With that in mind, the growers are extremely interested in nutrition and disease because both have an effect, Reigh said.

Since the alligators are grown in controlled conditions, the scientists have the ability to look at nutrition, water quality and temperature as determinants of growth.

"If you took two alligators from the same clutch of identical size and allowed one to remain in the wild and brought the other into a controlled environment, after a year their growth would be dramatically different," Reigh said. "First, the one in the wild doesn't

eat as much, and second, it's subjected to whatever the outside temperature is, which will be unfavorable at some time of the year."

With the downturn in the economy, the alligator industry has suffered in Louisiana over the past few years, but it is on the upswing now, according to LSU AgCenter vice chancellor for research Phil Elzer.

"I would say that the number of growers is somewhere between six and eight now, which is down from about 25," Elzer said.

According to the Louisiana Agriculture Summary, in 2011 there was a nearly 55 percent reduction in the number of animals harvested, but estimated value of the harvest was approximately 34 percent higher than the previous year. This was due in part to the increased prices for hides that resulted from decreased supplies in the market.

The farm-gate value for farm-raised alligators was estimated at \$38.5 million in 2011, up from \$28.7 million in 2010.

Pickled Eggs

1 jar (16 oz) beets	1-1/2 tbsp. whole allspice
1-3/4 cups white vinegar	1 stick cinnamon, halved
1 cup sugar	8 hard-boiled eggs, peeled

Drain beets, reserving juice. Set beets aside for another use. Combine beet juice, vinegar, sugar and spices in medium saucepan. Bring to a boil; stir until sugar is dissolved. Reduce heat and simmer 5 minutes. Arrange eggs in 1-quart jar with tight fitting lid. Pour hot mixture over eggs. Cover tightly. Allow to cool to room temperature 1 hour. Refrigerate to blend flavors, at least several hours or up to one week.

Mini Cheddar Quiche Bites

1/4 to 1/2 cup panko or regular bread crumbs	1/4 tsp. salt
Custard:	1/8 tsp. pepper
4 eggs	1-1/4 cups shredded Cheddar cheese (5 oz.)
1/3 cup half-and-half	

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Generously spray 24 mini-muffin cups with cooking spray. Pat 1/2 to 1 teaspoon crumbs in the bottom of each muffin cup. Tap muffin pan to lightly coat sides of each muffin cup. Beat eggs, half-and-half, salt and pepper in medium bowl until blended. Add cheese; mix well. Spoon evenly into mini-muffin cups, about 1 tablespoon each. Bake in 350 degree oven until just set, 12 to 15 minutes. Cool on rack 5 minutes. Loosen quiches from sides of muffin cups with a thin knife. Remove from cups; serve warm.

Meringue Kisses

4 egg whites, room temperature	1-3/4 cups powdered sugar, sifted
1/2 tsp. cream of tartar	2 cups ground almonds

Heat oven to 225 degrees. Beat egg whites and cream of tartar in mixer bowl with whisk attachment on high speed until foamy. Beating constantly, add sugar, 2 tablespoons at a time, until whites are glossy and stand in stiff peaks. Fold in almonds. Drop meringue by tablespoonfuls onto baking sheets lined with parchment paper or aluminum foil. Bake in 225 degree oven until firm, about 1 hour. Turn off oven. Let dry in oven, with door closed, until cool and crisp, at least 1 hour.

Chocolate Kisses Variation: omit ground almonds. Beat in 1/2 cup unsweetened cocoa powder and 2 tsp. vanilla after stiff peaks have formed.

Easy Baked Eggs In Puff Pastry

1 pkg. (10 oz.) frozen puff pastry shells (6 shells)	1/2 cup sour cream
6 eggs	1/2 tsp. dried dill weed
	Dash salt

Heat oven to 400 degrees. Bake pastry shells on baking sheet 20 minutes; remove from oven. Reduce oven setting to 375 degrees. Remove tops from pastry shells; place on baking sheet next to shells. Carefully remove soft dough from centers of pastry shells with a fork; discard. Break and slip an egg into each shell. Bake in 375-degree oven until whites are almost set, 14 to 15 minutes. Mix sour cream, dill weed and salt; spoon evenly over eggs. Bake until hot, about 3 minutes. Serve with baked tops as lids or accompaniments.

Baked Eggs with Spinach Hash Browns

2 cups frozen Southern-style hash brown potatoes (12 oz.)	1/2 cup sour cream
1 cup sliced mushrooms (3 oz.)	1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese (2 oz.), divided
1/4 cup water	1 tsp. dried dill weed
2 cups baby spinach (2.5 oz.)	4 eggs

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Coat a large nonstick skillet with cooking spray; heat over medium-high heat until hot. Add potatoes, mushrooms and water; mix and spread in even layer. Cook, covered, eight minutes. Turn vegetables over; cook, uncovered, until soft, about 6 minutes. Remove from heat. Add spinach, sour cream, 1/4 cup cheese and dill weed; mix well. Divide mixture evenly among four greased 10-oz. ramekins or custard cups. Press an indentation (about 2-inch diameter) into center of mixture with back of spoon. Place on baking sheet. Break and slip an egg into each indentation. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake in 350 degree oven until whites are completely set and yolks begin to thicken but are not hard, 25 to 30 minutes.

Chocolate Sponge Custards

3 egg whites, room temperature	1/3 cup chocolate-flavored syrup
1/4 tsp. cream of tartar	1/4 cup all-purpose flour
3 egg yolks	3/4 tsp. vanilla
1-1/4 cups milk	

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Place six 6-oz. greased custard cups in 13 x 9 x 2 inch baking pan. Beat egg whites with cream of tartar in mixer bowl with whisk attachment on high speed until stiff but not dry, just until whites no longer slip when bowl is tilted; remove to large bowl. Beat egg yolks, milk, syrup, flour and vanilla in clean mixer bowl on high speed until smooth. Gently but thoroughly fold into beaten whites. Pour into custard cups, dividing evenly. Place pan on a rack in the center of a 350 degree oven; pour very hot water into pan (hot-water bath) to within 1/2 inch of top of cups. Bake until wooden pick inserted near center comes out clean, 30 to 35 minutes. Remove cups from water bath at once; cool on wire rack at least 10 minutes.

area. Pol, said the mission of the Advocacy Center is to educate the community in child abuse prevention.

Pol introduced Commissioner Strain who acknowledged State Forester Wade Dubea, State Forester, and Todd Parker, Assistant Commissioner of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences.

Strain thanked all those present and applauded the Advocacy Center on their work and noted that planting a tree is an appropriate way of honoring the victims and showing support to the families.

Using a ceremonial gold shovel, Strain planted the satsuma tree.

"We're glad to support the Children's Advocacy Center," Strain said. "I applaud their work."

Dubea gave the group a lesson on the proper way to plant a citrus tree and how to care for it.
