While Louisiana is purported to have four seasons (spring, summer, autumn and winter), some Pelican State residents believe the state is divided into the hot and not-so-hot seasons.

Depending on whom you ask, you're likely to get several responses.

Sports fans believe the only seasons that matter are football, basketball, baseball and Mother's Day. Farmers parcel out their days into planting season and harvesting season.

For outdoorsmen, there is only hunting season and fishing season.

Covey Rise, a Tangipahoa Parish hunting lodge near Husser that specializes in upland game hunting, found they were plenty busy providing quality pheasant hunts for the sportsmen who lodge there in the cooler months.

Now, gamekeepers cast off their hunting boots after the hunt is over and don farming overalls. They park the ATVs and crank up the tractors and get to the task of planting a ten-acre garden of fresh produce. The produce is grown exclusively for the *haute-cuisine* restaurants of New Orleans.

"We're getting the stuff that was picked the night before or that morning, so we're getting this beautiful product," said Chef Michael Stoltzfus, owner of Coquette, one of the hottest new restaurants in New Orleans. "If produce has been on a truck for more than a day the quality has been compromised."

Grady Seale, Covey Rise farm manager, said he's trying to accommodate the eclectic tastes of New Orleans' chefs and instead of planting a large tract of one type of produce, he's planting several different varieties.

"We may plant ten different things and 20 or 30 varieties of it," Seale said. "The chefs challenge us. They want different items that add color to the plate."

There's a caveat, however.

"Anything that's colorful and that chefs love, it's not easy to grow in Louisiana," Seale said.

To provide Seale with the necessary agrarian knowledge, Covey Rise enlisted the services of retired LSU AgCenter horticulturist Jimmy Boudreaux. Boudreaux

advises Seale and Covey Rise co-owner Jimbo Geisler about what will make the produce grow best.

After the lodge had been established, Geisler recognized early on that he was sitting on an agricultural gold mine with enormous potential.

"Not everybody hunts, but everybody eats," Geisler said. "With the economy the way it's been the last couple of years, we had to diversify. Hunting is limited to five or six months, so we were looking to do something else. We have friendships with John Besh and Dickie Brennan and they were looking for local farmers to grow produce for their restaurants. It seemed like it was the thing to do."

Geisler said trucks from Covey Rise trek over Lake Ponchartrain four days a week to the New Orleans restaurants. Chefs climb right onto the trucks to pick the fruits and vegetables they'll use on the *menu du jour*.

But sometimes the push and shove of the Crescent City wears on a body and chefs visit Covey Rise farm to pick produce straight from the fields and enjoy the great outdoors.

"We invite all the chefs to come to see the farm," Geisler said. "We want them to come see what we're doing and see what it's like. The chefs are really into farming. They probably have a little garden at home and they are into it from the time that a seed is planted to the time that it's on the plate."

And it's satisfying to the farm manager, Seale.

"It all pays off when that fruit starts to come up and it's growing well, then it's selling well. And the chefs say we want more, we need more," Seale said. "It's really satisfying to have the little seed, get the dirt ready and start to sell the produce and actually taste it as well."

Covey Rise usually features a communal meal once a month in the lodge. Diners can call the lodge and make reservations and an evening gourmet meal is served for a fixed price. Upcoming dates for the meal are June 23 and July 21.

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Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Alternative livestock license renewals due June 30

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said all alternative livestock producers must apply or renew their 2012-13 licenses by June 30.

“Alternative livestock is a viable and growing agricultural business, but we must ensure that our domestic deer are protected,” Strain said. “Part of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry’s (LDAF) function is to make sure that alternative livestock in the state are healthy and well-cared for. We anticipate no problems with this program because alternative livestock producers take great care of their ani-

mals.”

Alternative livestock are defined as any imported exotic deer and imported exotic antelope, elk and farm-raised white-tailed deer.

Strain said those that raise exotic deer and other alternative livestock for commercial purposes must maintain their farm-rating license administered by the LDAF’s Office of Animal Health.

Prior to entering Louisiana, all alternative livestock must have an entry permit number issued by the State Veterinarian’s Office. Farm-raised alternative livestock must be contained at all times.

“We’re just ensuring the overall animal health of the deer herd,

both domestic and exotic,” Strain said. “The program requires inspection, blood sampling and record keeping by the LDAF so it’s vitally important that everyone involved in this type of livestock operation registers with the LDAF and pay their fees.”

Anyone considering starting an alternative livestock business should contact the Office of Animal Health for an application. Once the application is approved, an inspection of the facility is arranged before alternative livestock are allowed on the premises, Strain said.

There are two types of alternative livestock operations, Strain

said.

A breeder pen allows alternative livestock to be raised for buying and selling. No hunting is allowed.

A hunt pen requires a minimum of 300-acres. Hunting is allowed during the regular deer season of Oct. 1-Jan. 31. Harvest tags are required and can be purchased through the LDAF. A harvest pen license is required.

Currently, the LDAF licenses 260 breeder pens and 70 hunt pens throughout the state.

Strain said applications and regulations are available by calling the Office of Animal Health at 225-925-3980.





Buchart was involved in every aspect of Louisiana's forest industries and served in numerous administrative and program man-


agement roles. He retired from the LDAF in 2011 after 30 years

Eggceptional Egg Recipes

Protein Packed Pancakes

6 eggs	3/4 tsp. baking powder
1 cup ricotta cheese	1/2 tsp. salt
1/2 cup all-purpose flour	1/2 tsp. vanilla
2 Tbsp. melted butter or vegetable oil	

Beat eggs, cheese, flour, oil, baking powder, salt and vanilla in large bowl until blended. Heat lightly greased large nonstick skillet or griddle over medium heat until hot. Spoon 1/4 cup portion of batter (1 Tbsp. for silver dollar size) into skillet; Cook until golden brown, turning once. Serve with your favorite syrup or preserves, or raspberries, or sliced bananas and chopped pecans.

Make your own freezer pancakes, ready to pop in the toaster on those hurried weekday mornings. To freeze: Cool pancakes on wire racks. Return to baking sheets; freeze in single layer 1 to 2 hours. Wrap well, individually or stacked; freeze up to 1 month.

Muffin Frittatas

6 eggs	1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1/2 cup milk	3/4 cup chopped zucchini
1/4 tsp. salt	1/4 cup chopped red bell pepper
1/8 tsp. pepper	2 Tbsp. chopped red onion

Heat oven to 350-degrees. Beat eggs, milk, salt and pepper in medium bowl until blended. Add cheese, zucchini, bell pepper and onion; mix well. Spoon evenly into 12 greased muffin cups, about 1/4 cup each. Bake in 350-degree oven until just set, 20 to 22 minutes. Cool on rack 5 minutes. Remove from cups; serve warm.

Migas (Tex-Mex Scrambled Eggs & Tortillas)

1 cup green (tomatillo) salsa	12 eggs, beaten
2 plum tomatoes, diced	1/2 cup queso fresco, crumbled
6 corn tortillas (6-inch), halved, cut into thin strips	

Coat a 12-inch nonstick skillet with ovenproof handle with cooking spray; heat over medium heat until hot. Add salsa and tomatoes; cook and stir 2 minutes. Add tortilla strips; stir to coat. Cook 1 minute. Pour eggs over mixture in skillet. As eggs begin to set, gently pull the eggs across the pan with an inverted turner, forming large soft curds. Continue cooking - pulling, lifting and folding eggs - until thickened and no visible liquid egg remains. Do not stir constantly. Sprinkle cheese over eggs. Broil 6 inches from heat until cheese softens, 2 to 3 minutes.

PB&J Crunchy French Toast

2 eggs	4 slices day-old bread
3 Tbsp. milk	1/2 cup finely chopped peanuts

Beat eggs and milk in shallow dish until blended. Soak 1 bread slice at a time in egg mixture, turning once; dip each slice into peanuts to coat both sides. Coat large nonstick skillet with cooking spray; heat over medium heat until hot. Place 2 bread slices in skillet. Cook over medium to medium-low heat until golden brown and no visible liquid egg remains, 2 to 3 minutes per side. Adjust heat as necessary so that peanuts do not burn. Clean skillet. Repeat to cook remaining bread.

Ham & Eggs in Puff Pastry

2 eggs, well beaten	4 hard boiled eggs, chopped
1 tbsp. prepared mustard	1 cup chopped ham
2 tsp. lemon juice	1/2 cup shredded Swiss cheese
1 pkg. (10 oz.) frozen chopped spinach, defrosted, squeezed dry	1 sheet frozen puff pastry, defrosted

Heat oven to 425 degrees. Reserve 2 Tbsp. beaten egg for glazing. Mix remaining beaten eggs, mustard and lemon juice in large bowl. Add spinach; mix well. Add hard-cooked eggs, ham and cheese; mix gently. Roll puff pastry on lightly floured surface into 15 x 9-inch rectangle. Brush lightly with some of the reserved beaten egg. Spoon spinach mixture lengthwise down center of pastry. Fold sides of pastry over filling, pinching edges together in center to seal; pinch short ends of pastry to seal. Place, seam-side-down, on lightly greased baking sheet. Brush top and sides with remaining beaten egg. Cut five diagonal slashes across top of pastry for steam vents. Bake in 425-degree oven until pastry is golden brown and filling is heated through, about 20 minutes. Cut crosswise into 1-inch slices.

Blueberry Clafouti

2/3 cup sugar	1 tbsp. fresh lemon juice
1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, room temperature	1 tsp. vanilla
4 eggs	1/4 tsp. ground nutmeg
1 cup all-purpose flour	1/8 tsp. salt
	2 cups blueberries

Heat oven to 375 degrees. Beat sugar and butter in mixer bowl until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs until well blended. Add flour, lemon juice, vanilla, nutmeg and salt; beat until smooth. Fold blueberries into batter. Spread in lightly greased 9-inch quiche dish or cake pan. Bake in center of 375 degrees oven until top is lightly browned and knife inserted in center comes out clean, 40 to 50 minutes. Cool on wire rack.

The Louisiana wheat crop was harvested in May with varying results but one thing is certain: the 2012 crop won't come close to the \$109 million economic impact 2011's crop did.

Ray Schexnayder of West Baton Rouge Parish and his brothers Donald and Dan farm more than 3,000 acres of wheat, soybeans and corn in West Baton Rouge and Pointe Coupee parishes.

This year, the mild winter and wet March negatively affected the yield for their wheat crop.

"The wheat came up real good and looked

good until the warm weather we had in March, Ray Schexnayder said. "It just looked like the wheat tried to keep growing."

Ray said wheat harvests and prices had been good for the last couple of years so it's somewhat disappointing that the 2012 crop won't measure up.

"We had been getting yields of around 70 bushels to the acres, 50 in some of the bad ground and more than 70 in the good places," Ray said. "The price was good too, about eight dollars a bushel."

Ray said he expected his crop to average in

the 50 bushel range and the price would probably be about six dollars.

Many farmers in south Louisiana are able to plant and harvest their wheat early and then follow up with a soybean crop.

"We rotate corn, wheat and beans," Ray said. "The rotation helps build up organic matter."

Stephen Harrison, a wheat expert with the LSU AgCenter, said the 2012 crop will go down in the books as forgettable.

"We had three very good wheat growing years in a row, and then we had this year," Harrison said. "It was too warm, too wet, and

too many storms. Just about everything that could impact a wheat plant has happened."

Despite the low yield for this year's wheat, the Schexnayder are well diversified. Their sweet corn crop is just coming in and nearly all of the deer corn sold in the Baton Rouge area comes from their farm.

"People that want our sweet corn have been calling for a few weeks now," Ray said. "They're ready for some sweet corn."

Sarver's community service projects have included 4-H visits to nursing homes and collecting food, clothing, toys and school supplies for disadvantaged children. She started several programs to promote environmental responsibility. Sarver has been named Teacher of the Year and has won awards for her 4-H leadership.

– Carolyn Bordelon is president of the Avoyelles Parish 4-H Foundation and coordinator of the parish 4-H shooting sports program. An archery instructor and leader on the state level, she has obtained grants from the National Rifle Association and local agencies to buy targets, safety equipment and an enclosed trailer for shooting sports.
