Mexico continues wildcard play in U.S. sugar market

A USDA economist and an international sugar broker told Louisiana sugarcane growers that Mexico will continue to play a wild card role in the United States sugar market.

Barbara Fesco, an economist with the USDA Sweetener Analysis Division, and Craig Ruffolo of the McKeaney-Flavell said Mexico's free trade agreement with the U.S. gives them a unique ability to enter the American market at will when economic conditions are favorable.

The North American Free Trade Agreement phased out U.S. sugar tariffs from 1994-2008 that protected the U.S. from imported Mexican sugar and now Mexico has no barriers to stop them from exporting their sugar into the U.S.

"Mexico is more inclined to send us refined sugar because they make more money," Fesco said.

Ruffolo said obesity issues, the economy and Mexico continue to play significant roles in the domestic sugar market.

"Mexican buyers don't offer long term contracts and they're always pressed for cash," Ruffolo said.

Fesco and Ruffolo made their comments at the sugarcane meeting of the 2012 Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation convention in New Orleans June 30.

"The question is how do we manage a controlled American supply when we can't control Mexico?" Fesco said. "The fear is that Mexico will flood the market. That hasn't happened...yet."

Fesco said crop projections from Mexico can be somewhat unreliable because not all of Mexico's mills and refiners report accurate estimations.

Fesco said the estimations are compiled in a report known as the World Agricultural Supply Demand Estimate (WASDE).

"We want to control and protect US sugar markets, but it's a real balancing act," Fesco said.

Fesco's next comment elicited laughter from the group.

"We're managing this process for your own good," she said explaining the unfortunate reality that lower sugar prices paid to U.S. producers also made the U.S. market less attractive to Mexican sugar exports.

Ruffolo said attacks on sugar on health grounds will continue and has affected the bakery and cereal sugar market.

"The bakery and cereal market is reducing sugar in their cereal products ...so their portion of the sugar market will drop," Ruffolo said.

On the other hand, Ruffolo said the sports and energy market is using sugar as the sweetener in their products as an energy booster so demand will increase in that niche.

Confections and ice cream markets will also see increased demand for sugar.

Ruffolo concluded that sugar prices will remain static for the next couple of years and hold at the .38 to .42 cents per pound for refined product.

"Buyers are not motivated to buy forward at this time," he said. "Therefore the price will remain flat."

In 2010, 489 sugarcane growers harvested 2.8 billion pounds with a gross farm value of \$638 million according to the LSU AgCenter Agricultural Summary.

Strain wants fair treatment for La. farmers

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said he supports efforts to improve federal farm programs but must be assured that any new legislation is fair to all Louisiana farmers.

“The Farm Bill, in its current form, is inequitable to Louisiana farmers as well as most farmers throughout the South,” Strain said. “It is not designed to act as a safety net for our main industries or types of farms.

“Rice is especially not treated well and our larger farmers are required to pay higher premiums for crop insurance compared to the

rest of the country.

“Other commodities are being asked to take a 30 percent average reduction in program cuts. Louisiana rice growers will have to take a 65 percent reduction. This is unfair to rice growers, and under the bill as it is currently written, if rice farmers have a bad year, I’m afraid they won’t be able to recover and farm the following year.”

In 2011, 1058 Louisiana rice growers harvested nearly 2.8 billion pounds of rice on 417,000 acres. The gross farm value of the crop was \$366 million, according to the LSU AgCenter agricultural summary.

Overall, Louisiana’s farming industry is worth more than \$10.7 billion.

The current version of the Farm Bill reforms, eliminates and streamlines numerous programs, and will reduce the federal deficit by \$23 billion. The proposed legislation creates a risk-based coverage program for farmers that complements crop insurance to protect against both price and yield losses.

The bill also includes an extension of the U.S. Sugar Program, which is vital to Louisiana sugarcane growers, and it creates a new risk management program called the Stacked Income Protection Plan

or STAX, for cotton producers.

Strain said he is meeting with the state’s Congressional delegation and House Agriculture Committee and staff members in Washington, D.C. next week and is hopeful better protective measures for our farmers and ranchers will be incorporated into the bill when it is debated in the House of Representatives.

“The United States is embarking on a golden age of agriculture,” Strain said. “It is imperative that we do everything we can to create a market that gives American farmers a fair chance to compete.”







Saddle microchips available

The Louisiana Livestock Brand Commission, a division of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's (LDAF) Animal Health and Food Safety office, re-launched its saddle microchip program at the Louisiana Equine Council's Saddle Symposium that was held Saturday, June 23 at the Ranch Outlet store in Lafayette.

Livestock Brand Commission Inspector John Steib discussed saddle theft, saddle marking and identification methods.

Following the discussion, Steib microchipped saddles of participants who requested to have their saddle made identifiable. The permanent microchip, about the size of a grain of rice, is inserted into the "tree" of the saddle. Registration documentation corresponding to the microchip is provided to the saddle owner and a copy is kept on file in the department.

"The microchip we use for saddles is the same commonly used for household pets and horses," Steib said. "When scanned with a scanner designed for such a purpose the microchip number appears on the scanner."

There is a nominal fee charged to the saddle owner to reimburse the state for the cost of the chip.

Brand Commission Director Carl Bennett said saddle theft is an all too common problem in rural communities.

"Saddles can cost a few hundred dollars, on the lower end, to six or seven thousand dollars on the upper end," Bennett said. "Each year the Livestock Brand Commission investigates many saddle and tack thefts. Marking a saddle with a unique mark in a discreet place such as under the skirt is a big help to investigators in recovering stolen saddles."

Strain said farm-related crime is a real problem and stressed the importance of prevention.

"Once stolen, saddles are difficult to recover due to a lack of identifying marks," Strain said. "This is why we are encouraging folks to take measures to prevent theft and aid our Livestock Brand Commission in recovery if theft occurs."

Bennett said he hopes to partner with equine organizations like the Louisiana Equine Council on a regular basis to offer this saddle microchip service to the public.

Upcoming dates and sites brand inspectors will be available to microchip saddles will be announced through equine industry publications and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's website.

"This program is not new, we are just reviving and enhancing it," Bennett said.

Why won't my crape myrtle trees bloom?

What's the most popular summer-blooming tree in Louisiana? Crape myrtles. Pretty easy question. Louisianans plant many crape myrtles in their landscapes every year. The lovely, long-lasting blooms make them attractive.

Most years, crape myrtles start blooming between mid-May and early June. Flowering continues for 90-120 days depending on the variety.

You may sometimes see crape myrtles not blooming well. "Why?" you might ask. Here are some factors to consider:

- New growth. How much new growth did your crape myrtles have this spring? Crape myrtles need to have new growth each spring in order to produce summer flowers. These flowers come on current-season growth, so late winter/early spring fertilization can aid crape myrtle flowering in the summer. It is not too late to fertilize this year if you haven't yet.

- Shade. Crape myrtles require eight hours of direct sun daily to bloom well. Crape myrtles planted in areas that receive less than six hours of direct sun do not get enough sunlight for adequate bloom development.

- Variety. Some varieties don't flower as vigorously as others. Hybrid crape myrtles usually flower first. Natchez, Tuscarora, Basham's Party Pink and Muskogee are the easiest-flowering varieties. The semi-dwarf varieties such as Tonto, Acoma and Sioux follow a week or two later.

- Insects. Heavy infestations of aphids decrease flowering. This is the most common insect problem

on crape myrtles. Ever feel like you're being "rained" on under the canopy of a crape myrtle? That "rain" is actually bodily fluid being excreted from aphids. White flies and other

insect also can cause problems for crape myrtles.

- Improper pruning. Drastic pruning or pruning after new spring growth can delay summer flowering. Drastic pruning, in fact, may promote excessive growth and less flowering. Sometimes the "crape murder" method of pruning can initiate too much growth at the expense of flowering.

- Too much fertilizer. Excessive fertilization, especially high amounts of nitrogen, in conjunction with other factors, primarily improper pruning, can eliminate or delay flowering.

- Leaf spot. Foliar diseases decrease plant vigor and flowering, especially in the absence of new growth in spring. The main cause of leaf spot in crape myrtles is the fungus *Cercospora*, and it's bad this year. Long term, this disease is not detrimental to the plant. Using fungicides for control has not been very effective because they would have to be applied repeatedly throughout the growing season, and getting adequate coverage on larger trees is difficult.

- Wet soil. Crape myrtles need well-drained areas to grow well. Lichens growing on bark is common on crape myrtles growing in shady areas accompanied by poorly drained soils and low levels of native soil fertility.

So, that's the list. Consider these reasons if your crape myrtles are not performing to their potential. Hopefully, your crape myrtles will bloom and bloom some more for you this summer.
