Hay restrictions waived to help Texas ranchers

An executive order has been issued waiving size restrictions and permit fees on oversized loads of hay enroute to Texas.

The Departments of Transportation and Development, Public Safety and Revenue will allow vehicles transporting round hay bales to be loaded side by side across trailers up to twelve feet in width and fourteen feet in height.

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. said, "With this executive order, Louisiana hay producers may be able to help out Texas ranchers and suspending the restrictions and waiving the permit fee will allow

them to transport more hay at the lowest possible cost."

Carriers, owners and drivers are responsible for verifying in advance that the actual dimension and weight of the vehicles and loads are acceptable for all routes traveled. The oversize vehicles may only travel during daylight hours, must have required signage and flags properly placed to indicate they bear oversize loads, not exceed weight limits for bridges and similar structures, be equipped with proper mirrors, the loads must be securely bound and must carry a copy of the executive order in the vehicle.

The executive order is in effect through October 25, 2012.

Low river levels impacting La. ports

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) continues to monitor the low Mississippi River levels particularly at the Port of Lake Providence in East Carroll Parish

which is preventing shipments of grain from leaving the area.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is working with local and state officials on enlisting the help of the U.S. Corps of Engineers to dredge the area.

Strain said, "This issue could become disastrous and we need the Corps to focus on this problem. While Louisiana is not experiencing a drought, the rest of the country is. This is

a problem for our farmers in the area and the economy. We're in harvest season and if our farmers

can't get their grain to market, it will impact their livelihood."

Grain travels from the Port of Lake Providence to the Port of Greater Baton Rouge where it is shipped to the rest of the world. A

Louisiana agricultural exports totaled \$14.25 billion in the first quarter of 2012, according to the U.S. Census Bureau, Foreign Trade Division. "This is why dredging all Louisiana ports is necessary. Louisiana is a major exporter of corn and soybeans among other commodities," added Strain.

Strain met with Lake Providence Port Director Wyly Gilfoil and emergency managers to discuss possible solutions to this problem. Strain is also meeting and working with state legislators from the area, Senator Francis Thompson, Representative Bubba

Chaney, Representative Andy Anders, as well as U.S. Congressman Rodney Alexander.

She also spearheaded the "Get a Game Plan" campaign for emergency preparedness and the "Educate to Mitigate" campaign for the disaster recovery side. She updated the agency and emergency websites, improved the hurricane preparedness guides to be more user-friendly

and published them in different languages, produced television and radio public service announcements and helped produce a children's activity book for them to learn how to be prepared for emergencies.

"Veronica has built strong relationships with the media over the years – especially having walked in their shoes. She also brings to the table another skill set having worked in crisis communications. She knows the importance of getting out essential information to the public in a timely manner," said Strain. "I know she

is looking forward to learning about the agriculture and forestry industries and sharing with the public all of the important things we do for the people of our great state."

Veronica has a degree in communication and a minor in psychology from Loyola University of Chicago.

She is currently working on her meteorology degree. Veronica resides in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.





Have You Sold Cattle on the Farm? If so, be sure you paid the \$1.50 check-off. It's The Law -- No One is Exempt!

The beef check-off law goes into effect every time cattle are sold. This includes purebred sales and private treaty sales on the farm. The law requires that you must collect the national, plus the 50 cents state check-off money during your sale. The 50 cents state check-off is now a Mandatory Collection as a result of Act 298 passed in the 1995 Louisiana legislature, but producers may request a refund of this amount only, by written request to the Louisiana Beef Industry Council.

The seller is also responsible under the law. The seller may collect and remit the \$1.50 per head in a private treaty transaction. This is the best way to handle purebred sales. To avoid a late payment charge, money must be remitted by the 15th of the month following the sale. Penalties of up to \$5,000 per transaction applies to violators. All sale transactions are subject to audit to insure compliance with the check-off law.

Pine Grove man arrested for failure to remit payment for forest products

A Pine Grove man was arrested on July 30 following an investigation by Forestry Enforcement Agents with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry.

Lloyd R. Triche IV, 31, of Pine Grove, La. was booked into the Tangipahoa Parish Jail in Amite and charged with one count of failure to remit pay-

ment for forest products. Triche is accused of harvesting 18 acres of timber for a Tangipahoa Parish landowner and failing to pay the landowner \$14,000 which occurred between Oct. and Dec. of 2011.

If found guilty, Triche could be fined up to \$5,000 and/or imprisoned for up to 10 years with or without hard labor.

12 hard-boiled eggs	1/2 cup mayonnaise
2 tbsps. of chopped pickled jalapeno	1/2 cup sour cream
2 tbsps. black olives, chopped	2 tbsps. of taco seasoning
3/4 cup Mexican blend cheese, shredded	3 tbsps. green onions
	1/4 finely chopped cilantro

Boil eggs and cool. Peel them and then cut in half lengthwise carefully to remove the yolks. Put yolks in a mixing bowl, add sour cream, mayonnaise and taco seasoning. Deviled eggs

1 dozen large eggs	Zest of 1 lemon, finely minced
1 tbsp. finely chopped flat-leaf parsley, plus more for garnish	Juice of 1/2 lemon
1 tbsp. finely chopped, rinsed capers	3 tbsps. mayonnaise
1/4 tsp. anchovy paste, or more to taste	1 tbsp. Dijon mustard
	Ground black pepper to taste

Arrange large eggs in a pot that is wide enough to allow for a single layer. Cover eggs by 1 inch with cool water. Over medium-high heat, bring water just to a boil. Remove pot from the heat, cover with a snug lid and set aside for 12 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer eggs to a bowl of ice water, stirring gently to cool them down. Once cooled, pat eggs dry and then peel. Slice eggs lengthwise. Remove yolks and place them in a medium bowl. Arrange egg white halves on a serving plate. To prepare the filling, add parsley, capers, anchovy paste, lemon zest and juice, mayonnaise, mustard and 2 tablespoons water to yolks and mash. Taste and add pepper. The filling will be salty from the capers and anchovy, so additional salt will not be needed. Scoop filling into egg white halves. Sprinkle with chopped parsley and serve. I leave out the anchovy paste and add a tsp salt. I serve anchovies on the side or in the center of my deviled egg platter.

6 boiled eggs	1/2 cup fresh chives
3 tbsps. mayonnaise	1/2 cup fresh parsley
2 tps. of sweet pickle relish	Garlic powder to taste
1 cup of Louisiana Gulf Shrimp	Salt to taste
4 strips bacon	Pepper to taste

Slice eggs lengthwise remove yolks and set aside. In a small bowl, mash yolks with a fork. Add mayonnaise, pickle relish, garlic powder, salt, pepper and fresh parsley. In a separate pan, fry bacon until crisp and remove. In those drippings, sauté shrimp until pink adding salt and pepper to taste. Chop bacon and shrimp and fold into the egg yolk mixture. NOCS expansion boosts agriculture industry

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., participated in the opening of the newly expanded 142,000 square foot cold storage warehouse at the Port of New Orleans Thursday, July 19.

Strain said, "With Louisiana being a major poultry producer, the expansion of New Orleans Cold Storage (NOCS) will ensure Louisiana products stay fresher and ready for market." Strain added, "From an economic standpoint, this facility provides jobs to residents, keeps our poultry industry valued at more than \$1.6 billion and it benefits our ports. Agriculture is one of the biggest industries in our state. We will continue to support our farmers and the industry that feeds our people."

NOCS operates four facilities with more than 12 million square feet of refrigerated space in New Orleans, Houston and Charleston, S.C.

After Hurricane Katrina, more than 30 million pounds of chicken rotted in the Jourdan Road warehouse on the Industrial Canal. When the Mississippi River Gulf Outlet closed, the ability to operate at their current capacity diminished, and the future of NOCS in New Orleans was uncertain.

Strain was instrumental in securing \$10 million in disaster funding from the Community Development Block Grant program for the NOCS expansion. The total cost of the expansion was \$40 million.

"This is now the largest cold storage facility in America. It can store and freeze millions of pounds of perishable commodities and it's a major exporter of meat prod-

ucts," Strain said. "Maintaining this business in Louisiana supports our efforts to bring back communities after devastating circumstances such as Katrina." NOCS will bring approximately 125 new jobs to the New Orleans area.

Agriculture is a nearly 10.7 billion dollar a year industry in the State of Louisiana.

"We have reached the end of a long road traveled since Hurricane Katrina, and we are poised for growth. The storm and subsequent closing of the Mississippi River-Gulf Outlet made it uncertain whether we could keep operations in New Orleans open," said NOCS President and CEO Mark Blanchard. "But with the help of the state and The Port of New Orleans, we are expanding by opening our new, state-of-the-art terminal at the Henry Clay Avenue Wharf.

The new facility can store 38 million pounds of perishable products and can freeze up to 1.25 million pounds of fresh product each day. Operations at the new terminal include blast freezing, handling, warehousing and stevedoring – the loading and unloading of vessels – of export poultry and beef products.

The building was constructed with the latest environmentally friendly technology to cut down on energy expenses and increase efficiency. It includes LED lighting, room to berth two ships, the ability to load perishable products into containers and transfer the cargo to the Port of New Orleans container terminal for ocean transport. The new Henry Clay Wharf location is so close to the Port of New Orleans Container Terminal, overall efficiency will increase because of their close proximity.

Researchers develop wheat for wet climate

Wheat growers have a saying that "wheat doesn't like wet feet." With winters often damp and dreary, Louisiana is not conducive for growing this crop, which has its origins in dry climates. But LSU AgCenter wheat breeder Steve Harrison has developed lines that can tolerate local conditions and allow farmers to grow wheat profitably.

Harrison has enlisted help of other universities to make this possible. The LSU AgCenter is a partner in SUNGRAINS, a consortium of six southeastern universities cooperating on wheat and oat research and variety development. They include the universities of Florida, Georgia, Arkansas, North Carolina State and Texas A&M.

"SUNGRAINS provides the majority of wheat and all of the oat varieties grown in the Southeast," Harrison said.

Varieties developed at the AgCenter used to be tested at just three locations within the state. Now they are tested multiple places across the Southeast, allowing for collection of better data more quickly.

"Looking at how varieties perform across the Southeast region helps make the breeding program much more efficient," Harrison said.

Through its work with SUNGRAINS, the LSU AgCenter's wheat and oat breeding program will release several varieties this year, the most significant being the wheat breeding line named LA01110D-150. This release adds another high-yielding and adapted variety for farmers to plant.

Harrison said the breeding program partnered with the Georgia Seed Development Commission in Plains, Ga., to produce 1,200 bushels of this variety this year.

"This line has done extremely well across the region for the past three years," he said.

Harrison also is planning to release another line called LA02015E-201. Although it is a good variety for the Deep South, it is not as broadly adapted as LA01110D-150, Harrison said.

The wheat breeding team focuses on developing high-yielding, disease-resistant varieties adapted to the Gulf Coast region, Harrison said.

"We're bringing in new genes for stripe rust resistance and looking at a new disease, wheat blast," he said.

Wheat blast recently showed up in the United States, and Harrison said it has a potential to be a major problem. He has been testing for blast resistance for several years through collaborative screening nurseries in Brazil.

Harrison also is looking at resistance to the Hessian fly, the major insect pest of wheat.

"Any wheat grown in this region has to have a good defensive package in addition to high yields and high test weight," Harrison said. Test weight

refers to the average weight of grain usually expressed in pounds per bushel.

The AgCenter wheat breeding team includes plant pathologists Boyd Padgett and Don Groth, entomologist Fangneng Huang, and agronomist Rick Mascagni, who focuses on characteristics such as plant height and test weight. Also on the team are research associates Kelly Arceneaux, Lucas Bissett, Katie McCarthy and Myra Purvis.

The team has had a hard time collecting data because of warm and wet weather conditions that damaged the wheat or complicated its development. Warm temperatures caused the wheat to develop early, and in many areas the crop did not receive the required chilling hours needed to head.

The wheat breeding team is working on a molecular marker project to help map genes that influence heading dates and other traits.

"We try to develop selectable markers that allow us to screen for and identify those lines that have the genes and traits we are looking for in terms of agronomic characteristics and disease resistance."

Harrison and his team also work with oats. LSU AgCenter's oat program is one of only a handful in the United States and is well-known around the world.

"We coordinate an international oat program for the exchange of breeding material. As a result we have a very broad genetic base and develop lines that work well in other parts of the world," Harrison said.

He is releasing three oat varieties this year. One will be released in cooperation with a government institution in Uruguay. Another will be used in California's dairy industry. And the third will be used in Germany for the fodder industry.

These lines are offshoots of research aimed at producing oats for the southern United States, Harrison said.

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
