FROM POLI SCI to FARM LIFE

For 26-year-old Galen Iverstine, farming hasn't always been a way of life. In fact, the Central, La. native was studying political science at LSU when he found his calling. "I was doing research for a

project when I stumbled upon the politics of food which focused on food, fertilizer and feed. I found it interesting and started researching alternative methods of farming."

Iverstine's maternal and paternal

grandparents were strawberry farmers in Independence but that's where the farming background ended until two and a half years ago. Questioning what he was going to do with a political science degree since he did not want to go to law school, Iverstine was on the verge of joining the military when he told his parents he planned to become a farmer. Iverstine's mom, Brenda, says she asked him a simple question, "Don't you realize you'll be married to farming?" But she warmed up to the idea and is now very proud of her son.

Iverstine left home and spent seven months on a farm in New Hampshire. "I wanted to figure out if I had the fortitude to do this." When he got home, he says he was ready to move forward with his plans.

"As a mom, I almost thought he'd have enough after a year, but he didn't," says Brenda Iverstine. After talking things over with his parents, Iverstine's father, Jack, helped him secure 65 acres of land in Kentwood, La. "It was an old dairy farm. It had the greenest pasture with a high output of hay and minimal infrastructure cost," said Jack Iverstine.

Iverstine says he started small. "I started with two pigs which I bought from a lady in Folsom," said Iverstine. Now he raises 6,000 meat chickens each year, 150 turkeys, approximately 100 pigs and 36 cattle.

"Poultry was going to be my way in but then I needed to cut my grass. That's when I bought my cattle. Cows and hogs are the direction I'm moving toward now," says Iverstine.

Iverstine explained there is a symbiotic approach to the way he operates his farm in which everything serves a purpose. "The cattle eat the grass, I move the cattle and the chickens shorten it some more and then fertilize the land. We could be using tractors but instead we use cattle. We just keep moving our animals around." He adds, "There's another purpose to moving the animals

around. Parasites can't grasp onto a host. It builds resistance on the farm and our veterinarian bills stay very low. It's a very traditional way of farming."

While Brenda and Jack Iverstine still live in Central, they have completely embraced their son's farming profession. "It's been contagious. We love the farm. Plus, see *Farming, cont. on page 20*

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

Strain reminds producers to respond to ag census

Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is reminding Louisiana producers to respond to the Census of Agriculture.

“Ag Census is an important tool local and national leaders use to make decisions that directly impact your business, your community and your industry,” Strain said.

Conducted every five years by the U.S. Department of

Agriculture’s National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS), the Census provides a snapshot of U.S. farms and ranches and the people who operate them. It is the only source of uniform, comprehensive agricultural data for every state and county in the country.

NASS will mail out the forms in late Dec. and farmers and ranchers are asked to respond by mail or online by Feb. 4, 2013. Participation by every farmer and

rancher, regardless of the size or type of operation, is vitally important. By responding to the Census, producers are benefiting themselves, their communities and all of American agriculture.

The 2012 Census of Agriculture will collect information concerning all areas of farming and ranching operations, including production expenses, market value of products, and operator characteristics. This information is used by

everyone who provides services to farmers and rural communities - including federal, state and local governments, agribusinesses, and many others.

Participation in the Census is required by law, and that same law protects the confidentiality of all individual responses.



Louisiana farmers harvest record soybean crop

Louisiana farmers produced a record soybean crop this year, yielding 44 bushels on 1.11 million acres, according to U.S. Department of Agriculture statistics. The previous high was 43 bushels in 2007.

Ron Levy, LSU AgCenter soybean specialist, said generally favorable weather, well-adapted varieties and grower willingness to invest in the crop were factors that pushed state soybean production to a record level.

"People were not afraid to manage the crop for high yield potential," Levy said. "They could justify the higher costs of crop protection because of the higher value of the crop."

For example, he said, farmers able to irrigate their crop were willing to spend money to pump water, knowing the expense would be offset by excellent prices.

During much of the growing season, prices topped \$15 a bushel and reached \$17 in September. They have recently slipped to the \$14 range.

The USDA statistics show Louisiana's soybean yield equaled the Iowa soybean harvest and was higher than other Midwestern states such as Illinois (43 bushels) and Missouri (31 bushels), where a severe drought took its toll. Only Ohio, Pennsylvania, Maryland and New York had better average yields than Louisiana.

Even with the state's record high yields, some farmers left their crop in the field if it

wasn't worth harvesting, Levy said, and that happened in cases of not enough rain or too much at the wrong time.

He said some of the highest yields in Louisiana exceeded 90 bushels per acre.

Levy said the 2013 growing season is likely to result in more soybean acreage.

"It appears we will continue to see an increase in soybean acreage as demand appears to be strong into the 2013 growing season," Levy said. "A lot of growers have already booked seed for next year."

Kurt Guidry, LSU AgCenter economist, said the expectation of higher acreage and the possibility of normal weather could push prices lower but demand is not expected to decline.

"Prices have been strong this year primarily because we had a smaller crop in South America this spring, due to adverse weather conditions. This was followed by drought conditions here in the United States," Guidry said.

"While the higher prices would be expected to weaken demand somewhat, both export demand and domestic crush thus far in the 2012/13 marketing year have been above the previous year's pace. Through November 1, 2012, China purchases were up 43 percent from the previous year," he said.

Weather in South America has been more favorable for the bean crop there, and Brazil is expecting a yield of 21-22 percent higher than the previous crop, while Argentina is

expecting a 34 percent increase, once they start harvesting their crop in February and March, Guidry said.

The national average yield estimate has gone from 36.1 to 39.3, more than 3 bushels per acre, from the August 2012 USDA estimate to its November 2012 estimate. This larger production has eased some of the supply concerns and has likely helped to soften prices, Guidry said.

Guidry said the competition for acreage with strong corn and soybean prices is expected to result in fewer rice acres in Arkansas and north Louisiana, with early projections for 2013 U.S. rice acreage falling as much as 100,000 acres. That decrease, combined with a new trade deal with Colombia and the possibility of selling long-grain rice to China, could boost rice prices for next year, he said.

our way of eating has changed. We eat fresh and we support our local farms. If we don't have eggs, we buy them from another farmer. We keep our dollars close," said Brenda Iverstine.

Iverstine acknowledges the work is not easy and he does most of it himself. "I'm up between 4:30 and 5:00 every morning and normally work until dark. I'm also at the Baton Rouge Farmer's Market every Saturday selling pork, chicken, eggs and beef."

Iverstine says the best advice he ever got was to not be afraid of making a mistake. He says since he started small, it allowed him to make his mistakes and learn from them without too much loss.

"I want my business to grow as the market demands it. I sell what I raise and sometimes run out of

inventory. That's a good thing. I don't want to be sitting on a lot of inventory," he said. Iverstine wears many hats. He is the farmer, he does the marketing, packaging and even serves as the delivery man. "I sell a lot to chefs in Baton Rouge who want to cook with local food."

Iverstine needs nine credit hours to get his political science degree from LSU which he plans to do. He is also trying to organize a young farmer's cooperative so his counterparts can bounce ideas off of one another. "Universities are great but they don't graduate farmers. There's no farm training if you haven't grown up on a farm."

At the end of the day, Iverstine says he knows his hard work will pay off. "I just want to leave behind a better place."

"While much of the country suffered through drought, our farmers were able to help fill in the gap by producing exceptional crops including a record yield for soybeans," said LSU AgCenter Chancellor Bill Richardson. "Louisiana agriculture continues to play an essential economic role in the state and local economies."

Other sponsors of the competition include the Louisiana Radio Network, Louisiana Farm Bureau

Federation and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. Producers from all areas of agriculture are eligible to enter.

Three finalists will be recognized at White Oak Plantation in Baton Rouge on Feb. 28, 2013, with the winner receiving a cash award and other prizes.

This is the 16th year of presenting the Louisiana Farmer of the Year award. Last year's winner was Hank Rabb, a cotton and corn farmer from St. Joseph in Tensas Parish.
