

At 88 years YOUNG...

FARMING NEVER GETS OLD

Among the rolling hills of West Feliciana Parish lives a man who still gets up with the roosters and climbs on his tractor when his arthritis is not acting up too badly.

“Farming is what I did before I went into the Navy and farming is what I did when I came out. It’s a way of life. It’s all I knew,” said Joe Daniel, Jr.

At 88-years-old, Daniel loves to grow vegetables in his garden – squash, cucumbers, tomatoes, bell peppers, you name it. He also has 20 acres of corn.

Daniel checks his cattle every day and feeds his goats three times a week. They even run to the fence when he calls them. “I feed them the corn I grow. They love it,” he added. But his favorite chore is working with his cows. “We used to have a lot of wild cattle out here. When someone needed assistance getting them into pens, I was ready to rope,” said Daniel. But those days of roping are gone. Arthritis came on strong in his early 80s. “I’m crippled from my years of walking behind that mule.” He pauses and then with a twinkle in his eye adds, “...and from dancing with women!” At that point Daniel bursts into laughter.

He said it’s hard accepting that he can’t do what he used to. “I miss riding horses. I used to ride every day.” But even the arthritis doesn’t seem to slow him down. “I still drive my tractor but my kids sold my bulldozer. They were afraid I’d fall off,” he added.

Daniel’s father was a farmer and now his son, West Feliciana Parish Sheriff J. Austin Daniel farms, as does

his son, David, and David’s son Derek. “That’s five generations of farmers,” he said.

Over the many decades, Daniel says he has seen a lot of changes in the agricultural industry including the use of herbicides, different varieties of corn and even plowing fields using a mule before tractors came along.

When asked what kind of advice he gives his son, the sheriff, Daniel said, “We give each other advice.” But the advice usually has a bit of comedy behind it. Sheriff J.

Austin Daniel said his dad told him, “You have to feed those cows every day. You eat every day, don’t you?” The elder Daniel said his son tells him to stay off the tractor. Sheriff Daniel quickly chimes back in, “Add the bulldozer to that!”

But farming isn’t the only thing Daniel is proud of. He spent 31 years on the West Feliciana Parish School Board. “You don’t get everything

you want, but our biggest achievement was building the West Feliciana Parish School Complex.”

While the Daniel family is full of public servants, including Joe Daniel, Sr. who was on the police jury and J. Austin Daniel, the sheriff, Joe Daniel excitedly spoke about the new calf that was born on the day of the interview. He even pointed it out in the field. “You’ve got to make sure they’re okay when they’re having their calves. I make sure I check on them.”

Farming is work he’s never backed down from and by the looks of it, when Daniel climbs on that tractor, it is work even his arthritis won’t keep him from doing.

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

LDAF works to deter spread of virus in horses

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is monitoring all horses entering Louisiana from Illinois after reports of at least 68 horses that tested positive in recent months for Equine Herpes Virus Type 1 (EHV-1) at the Hawthorne Race Course located in Illinois. Horse owners must provide health certificates to the Louisiana State Veterinarian's Office prior to

entry. "This is a precautionary measure to prevent exposure to horses in Louisiana. The Louisiana Office of the State Veterinarian is monitoring the outbreak at Hawthorne Race Course. This is a highly contagious disease and we will prohibit all horses from Illinois from entering the state unless they are cleared by a veterinarian," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain,

D.V.M. According to Stanley Seeling, president of the Louisiana Horseman's Benevolent and Protective Association, horses typically travel from Hawthorne Race Course to Louisiana for the winter races. EHV-1 is a DNA virus that can cause fever, lethargy, abortion, respiratory and neurological issues and can cause death. It can be spread directly from horse-to-

horse or indirectly through coughing or contact with physical objects contaminated with the virus. Those objects include: tack, wipe rags or other grooming equipment, feed and water buckets and people's hands or clothing. The health certificate must disclose that the horse has not been on Hawthorne's grounds in the preceding 30 days. EHV-1 is not contagious to humans.



State livestock show Feb. 9-16

Hundreds of youth from across Louisiana will gather in Gonzales next month for the 78th annual LSU AgCenter Livestock Show at the Lamar-Dixon Expo Center.

LSU AgCenter officials say they expect more than 2,000 4-H and FFA exhibitors to bring about 1,500 breeding animals, 1,600 market animals, 180 pens of broilers and 700 exhibition birds to the competition on Feb. 9-16.

By the time those 4-H and FFA members reach the state show, they already will have competed in parish and district competitions across Louisiana during the first few weeks of 2013. All will arrive in Gonzales aiming to be state champions – or at least to earn rewards for their hard work and dedication.

Judges at the show determine the winners in various breeds of beef and dairy cattle, goats, hogs, poultry and sheep.

A highlight of the show is the Premier Exhibitor Program, which places emphasis and recognition on exhibitors' knowledge and skills in the 4-H and FFA livestock projects. Supported by an endowment from Gerry Lane Enterprises in Baton Rouge, the program is available to participants exhibiting beef, dairy, swine, sheep, poultry and goats. Testing all facets of the youths' ability in their livestock projects, the contest comprises an interview, a resume, a test, a skill-a-thon and showing abilities.

One exhibitor will receive the Price LeBlanc Champion Livestock Award, which is presented to one grand champion market animal each year from among five species – steers, swine, sheep, chickens and goats. The award is funded by an endowment from

Price LeBlanc, a Baton Rouge automobile dealer.

The livestock show also includes a quality assurance and ethics certification program that educates youth on proper and ethical use of animal health products ensuring a high-quality, wholesome product.

Organizers say youth livestock projects provide a means for families to come together to participate in quality educational activities. Young people say participating in the program gives them opportunities to make new friends, see old friends and gain valuable experience. And everyone agrees it helps youngsters develop character and hone skills that will benefit them, their families and their communities throughout their lives.

While the annual event may be called a livestock show, it's more about the young people than their animals, said LSU AgCenter Chancellor Bill Richardson.

"This event provides an opportunity for some of the most outstanding youth in the state to receive recognition for their hard work in learning not only the scientific principles that must be mastered but also the responsibility required to raise this wide array of animals," Richardson said. "This show also is about the dedication of the many parents, teachers, volunteer leaders, 4-H agents and FFA advisers who have worked with the young people to help them grow as people and responsible citizens."

As a result of what they learn, generations of young people who have participated in LSU AgCenter livestock projects go on to become leaders – whether in the livestock industry or a variety of other fields ranging

from medicine to government, Richardson said.

"Livestock shows and livestock projects give a glimpse of some of the best young people in the state and some of the brightest outcomes of our youth development programs," said LSU AgCenter Vice Chancellor Paul Coreil.

"Every one of those animals is accompanied by a champion young person," Coreil said. "In this show, all the participants are winners – whether their animals are named champions or not – because what they've learned will benefit them throughout their lives."

Youth participating in livestock projects gain knowledge of animal husbandry – including selection, genetics, nutrition, health, showing, economics and marketing of livestock, said livestock show manager

Dwayne Nunez. "But they also develop skills such as communication, leadership and cooperation."

Competition in various phases of the show will begin almost as soon as the first animals are checked in on Saturday, Feb. 9, and will continue daily through Feb. 16.

An awards ceremony will conclude the activities at 4 p.m. on Feb. 16. It will recognize champion market animal exhibitors, champion showmanship winners and Premier Exhibitors as well as recipients of the annual Superintendent of Education Award, Attorney General Award and Governor Awards.

Young ag producers program now accepting applications for '13-'14

What does it take to get started in production agriculture? The LSU AgCenter's Louisiana Young Ag Producers Program will provide some answers for high school students who apply and are accepted into the 2013-2014 class.

Louisiana Young Ag Producers is a one-year, intensive classroom and hands-on, mentor-based experience that introduces high school juniors and seniors to the options available to them in the areas of food and fiber production and encourages them to enter an agriculture career, said program coordinator Bobby Soileau.

"This program provides students an opportunity to learn more about becoming an agricultural producer," Soileau said. "Candidates must demonstrate a sincere interest in entering the profession, agree to attend the summer institutes held in 2013 and 2014, and complete 50 internship hours with a qualified mentor during the 2013-2014 school term."

Paul Coreil, LSU AgCenter vice chancellor and director of the Louisiana Cooperative Extension Service, sees the program as an opportunity to get young people interested in careers in agriculture.

"The face of agriculture is changing," Coreil said. "The number of producers is decreasing, and their

average age is increasing, so it is important that we present students with information about careers in production agriculture."

Coreil also pointed out the importance of agriculture and forestry to rural economic development and the increased food and fiber demands required to sustain a growing world population.

"The demand for food is expected to steadily increase over the next 40 years, which means careers in agriculture and forestry are essential to our future," he said.

The 2013 summer session will be held July 22-26 on the LSU-Baton Rouge campus, Soileau said. In addition to the AgCenter, major sponsors of the program include the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry.

The 2012-2013 class has 13 members currently engaged in internships with their mentors, Soileau said. This group of students has a wide range of production interests, which include beef, rice, sugar, crawfish, goats and specialty crops.

LDAF forestry grant program underway

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is accepting applications for the 2012 Urban and Community Forestry Grant (U&CF) program.

For the 2012 program year, \$78,000 in federal funds is available. These funds will be distributed through a competitive grants allocation process in which LDAF will award seven grants for \$10,000, one grant for \$5,000 and one grant for \$3,000.

"It is so important that we protect our natural resources such as our forests. One of Louisiana's major commodities is forestry which at last report was valued at \$3 billion," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

In order to meet objectives outlined in the National Urban Forestry Guidelines and the Louisiana Urban Forestry Council's Strategic Plan for Louisiana Community Forestry, this program is geared toward establishing and/or strengthening existing community forestry programs in Louisiana.

National direction has become

more focused during the past years. Specific community forestry building activities being promoted includes the following:

- Employment of professional urban forestry staff at the community level;

- Development of community forestry management plans based on resource assessments/inventories;

- Development or strengthening of community forestry ordinances and policy; and

- Development or enhancement of local advocacy/advisory organizations.

The LDAF must report specific activities to the USFS each year. Future funding is based upon the number of communities participating in the activities. These matching fund grants are for activities not currently being funded and are not intended to substitute for existing programs already funded.
