It could be considered a “camp” for cows. More than 200 heifers from cattle ranchers across the state are spending approximately four months at a feed lot in Kinder, La. and participating in the McNeese State University Heifer Development Program.

“Our three acre feed lot is not that large. It’s not like what you would see out west with 50 thousand head of cattle. This

is small scale for the university and for research purposes,” said Dr. Bill Storer who works for the Department of Agriculture over at McNeese State University.

Feed lots are where the sole source of nutrition is feed as opposed to pasture. Six years ago, the facility added a Heifer Development Program. “This is for farmers who want to keep

heifers that are considered exceptional in the herd and are selected to be bred,” added Storer.

Cattle rancher Tom Ardoin has put 75 of his cattle through the program over the past five years. “The most beneficial thing is the condition of the cattle when they return and how well they are able to maintain that

condition because of the feed,” said Ardoin.

Once the heifers are entered into the program, they are monitored for about four months and reports are kept on them. “We look at the different breeds and how they compare. We monitor their conception rates, their daily weight gain and

we even use ultrasound on the cattle to check on the quality of the meat. Temperament is also important. The calmer the animal, the better,” said Storer.

Ardoin has noticed the change in his heifers. “I appreciate the low stress handling techniques of the staff. When the cattle get back to me, they’re not so wild. They’re also used to people handling them,” he added.

All this was made possible a few years back when cattle rancher, Bill Fuller, who’s also in the timber business, developed his own heifer program and eventually opened it up to the public. Fuller donated a portion of his property to McNeese to use for the program. “I never attended McNeese, but my father, Parrish Fuller, helped select the first president of the university back in the 1940s,” said Fuller.

“Over the years, I figured there must be a better way to get better quality cattle. That really became my focus, so I started dis-

cussing the idea with McNeese officials and here we are today. I told them, ‘I’ll give you the feed lot if here we give me someone who can operate it and handle the research. I’ll even foot the bill for the first two years until we make sure it’s profitable,’” said Fuller.

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Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

NASDA Members Press Congress to Enact Long-Term Farm Bill

At an early Feb. meeting of the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA) in Washington D.C., Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., along with top state agriculture officials from around the country, called on Congress to quickly enact a long-term Farm Bill. A five-year Farm Bill will give America's farmers and ranchers more certainty for the future of their operations.

"This morning I met with farmers in Jeff Davis Parish and one of their

main concerns is the lack of a long-term Farm Bill. While the Farm Bill has been extended for several months, there's too much uncertainty when it comes to disaster provisions and other challenges such as proposed state tax reform issues that may impact our Louisiana farmers," said Strain. "I urge you to reach out to your congressional leaders to take action on this sooner rather than later," he added.

NASDA members also pressed Congress to pass a Farm Bill that includes a Specialty Crop Block

Grant Program and continues support of the Market Access Program (MAP) and other trade development programs. The association also focused on fully funding invasive species programs with enhanced federal-state coordination, providing conservation programs, advancing agricultural research activities, and ensuring a viable safety net for our nation's dairy producers.

In addition to the urgent need for a long-term Farm Bill, NASDA members also discussed other issues affecting American agriculture. The

role of states in leveraging federal program dollars to deliver state-federal cooperative programs, especially those regarding significant responsibilities resulting from the implementation of the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA).

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

Fuller added, "Typically, when calves are weaned from their mothers, they're sold. We feel that with higher cattle prices, more money can be made by the farmer if they raise the calf and eventually sell it at a higher price." Fuller says when you wean a calf and sell it, you don't know its quality or what really happens to it. "We're just looking at all avenues for producers. We want our farmers to make more money," added Fuller.

Today, the feed lot makes enough money that with all of the state cutbacks at universities, the money generated covers the research.

On average, the program gets about 10 heifers per farmer but the farmer normally sends however many heifers they want to replace.

The cost to have a heifer in the program also fluctuates. "This year it has averaged about \$2.20 per day. It fluctuates with corn and bean prices," said Storer. Corn is also grown on the property which is then turned into silage. Any extra costs are incurred for supplemental feed.

"Feed lots are more prevalent out west because of climate and feed availability. Louisiana weather makes it hard to maintain a feed lot so we use special bags to keep the silage in good condition," said Storer.

Part of the research is conducted by graduate students. Allison Vail wants to be a veterinarian and says she's always been interested in cattle. "We use what's called heat watch patches to monitor when

they are 'in heat.' That information is transmitted to the patch and we record it in the computer system," said Vail. The process helps determine the best times to breed the cattle.

"It's nice to see further production. I grew up on a farm and it's good to see what can be done to help farmers," added Vail.

According to Fuller and Storer, the nearest heifer development programs are in Texas Mississippi. "I grew up looking for better and more efficient ways of doing things. McNeese's agriculture program has truly come a long way," added Fuller.

Have you sold cattle on the farm?

The beef check-off law goes into effect every time cattle are sold. This includes purebred sales and private treaty sales on the farm. The law requires that you must collect the national, plus the 50 cents state check-off money during your sale. The 50 cents state check-off is now a Mandatory Collection as a result of Act 298 passed in the 1995 Louisiana legislature, but producers may request a refund of this amount only, by written request to the Louisiana Beef Industry Council.

The seller is also responsible under the law. The seller may collect and remit the \$1.50 per head in a private treaty transaction. This is the best way to handle purebred sales. To avoid a late payment charge, money must be remitted by the 15th of the month following the sale. Penalties of up to \$5,000 per transaction applies to violators. All sale transactions are subject to audit to insure compliance with the check-off law.

LDAF assistant commissioner to receive the Governor's Award - Conservationist of the Year

John Walther of Thibodaux, a long-time volunteer with CCA Louisiana who has been the guiding force behind 11 unique artificial reef deployments across Louisiana's coast, has been chosen to receive the Governor's Award - Conservationist of the Year for 2012.

"I am humbled to join the ranks of other great conservationists and sportsmen honored by the Louisiana Wildlife Federation this year," Walther said. "Just as these individuals commitment to conservation drives the process, cooperation and guidance of government allow the projects to become reality. No one can accomplish these projects alone; it takes the teamwork of individuals, government and industry."

In addition to volunteering with CCA, Walther serves as the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's Office of Animal Health and Food Safety Assistant Commissioner and Emergency Programs Director.

The award, a handsome statuette of a bald eagle, will be presented the evening of Saturday, February 23 at a banquet held in conjunction with the Louisiana Wildlife Federation's 74th convention February 22 - 24 at the Embassy Suites Hotel in Baton Rouge. The banquet master of ceremonies will be Dr. Rex Caffey, Director of the Center for Natural Resource Economics and Policy at Louisiana Sea Grant and LSU AgCenter.

The Governor's Award is presented annually to the person or organization deemed to have made the most outstanding contribution toward the protection and wise use of the state's natural resources among nominees submitted by the public. The selection for this and five other awards was made by a panel of independent judges with expertise in a wide range of conservation fields. The 49th Annual Governor's State Conservation Achievement Awards program is hosted by the Louisiana Wildlife Federation and the awards are presented jointly with the National Wildlife Federation.

Walther pioneered the use of recycled concrete materials in recent artificial reef projects in Louisiana, including the "Brad Vincent

Reef" in Calcasieu Lake and the "Buras High School Reef" in Breton Sound completed in 2012. He also has been a driving force behind the annual Derelict Crab Trap Removal Program.

One other individual, three organizations and one business will also be recognized by the Louisiana Wildlife Federation for their outstanding conservation achievements last year. They are:

Michael Balboni of Alexandria, Forest Supervisor of Kisatchie National Forest, for managing successful conservation improvements, including the recent preservation of natural prairies in Winn Parish and a highly successful banding and protection program for endangered red-cockaded woodpeckers.

The website kidslovethegulf.org, created by youths Rory McCracken and Maeve McCracken to raise money for wildlife recovery efforts in the aftermath of the Deepwater Horizon oil spill, who also published "G is for the Gulf," a wildlife education book for children;

St. Mary Parish 4-H - Black Bear Awareness project for creating a collaborative multi-year educational and outreach initiative to youth and citizens in St. Mary Parish about the recovery efforts of the endangered black bear population;

Bayou Grace Community Services of Chauvin for mobilizing citizens both locally and nationally in volunteer projects, advocacy and education efforts to support restoration of the Barataria and Terrebonne estuaries;

Marsh Dog, LLC of Baton Rouge for establishing a business that produces high-quality dog treats made from nutria meat, which is creating a stronger demand for nutria to help reduce the negative impact of nutria on coastal marsh vegetation.
