Not everyone has the will and determination to grow a giant cabbage, but Meghan Comeaux from Iota Elementary in Iota, Louisiana did just that. Her cabbage weighed in at a whopping 13 pounds and Comeaux now reigns as the 2012 winner of the Bonnie Plants 3rd grade cabbage program.

When asked what technique she used to grow the jumbo cabbage, Comeaux said, "Miracle Grow and horse poop!" Well, it worked. Comeaux says she and her family have a garden in their yard so she's accustomed to the TLC needed to grow vegetables such as carrots, corn and okra, but even she was surprised by how big it got. "I told my parents we need to measure it every day," she said. And it grew, and grew and grew.

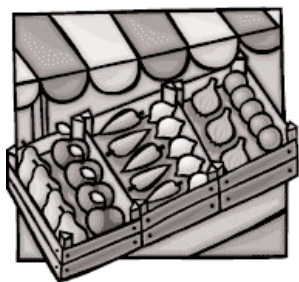
Comeaux says she had a feeling it could be an award winning cabbage but she was up against thousands of other students across Louisiana. Bonnie Plants representative Charlie Trussell said, "She did a great job. In my years of being involved in this program, it was one of the best cabbages I've ever seen. You can tell she enjoyed it."

Comeaux's third grade teacher, Gena Daigle, said she was at a Farmers Market when she learned of the program. "A lot of kids have never planted before, so it was exciting because they could get their hands

dirty," said Daigle. But the program is more than getting your hands dirty. "They learned what causes the plants to grow better, whether it's the amount of water or the quality of the soil, so it was a great learning experience," added the teacher. "They also learned how to measure and we did cooking experiments. We cooked cabbage jambalaya and cabbage soup. They ate it up," said Daigle. Would you believe that their teacher even gave them writing assignments in which they were required to "bring their cabbages to life."

Trussell says the program is a huge success and the folks at Bonnie Plants hope children will continue to grow gardens and eat fresh veggies. The program also helps them understand where food comes from. As for Comeaux, she says she always plans to have a garden. While she admits she's not the biggest fan of cabbage, she says she did try it when her proud parents cooked it up! Now in the 4th grade, and a year older and wiser, Comeaux says her \$1,000 scholarship award from Bonnie Plants is in the bank to go toward her college education.

Louisiana schools have participated in the Bonnie Plants Cabbage Program for the past 10 years. In 2012, 14,880 Louisiana third graders received cabbage plants to take home and grow.

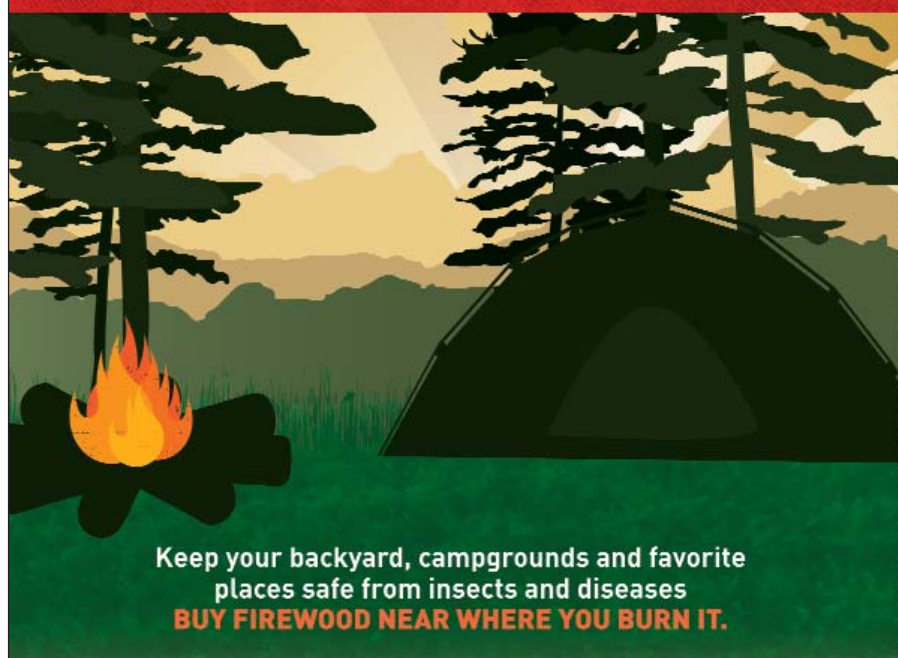
