## Businesses support 4-H, FFA; donate to area food bank

For some, it's a food staple that's part of the diet on any given day; but for others, having a piece of meat as part of a meal is considered a luxury. In early March, the Covington Food Bank was the recipient of approximately 1,500 pounds of pork and lamb (eight pigs and two lambs) courtesy of several Louisiana business owners who support 4-H and Future Farmers of America (FFA) members.

"We thought this would be a benefit for the young people who participate in 4-H and FFA competitions as well as the food bank," said Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M. "We asked these businesses if they would purchase the livestock and donate the meat to the food bank and they were all willing. I say this is a win win because the 4-H and FFA participants earn money off the purchase which they often put toward their education and the food bank is getting the meat donations," added Strain.

While the money earned by these young folks often goes toward education or future 4-H or FFA projects, the meat donated to the food bank helps families in other ways. "I don't make a lot of money so I can't buy a lot of meat. There are no words to describe what I've received today. This will last awhile for me and my grandson," said Joe Ann Brown as she picked up a basket of food from the food bank.

Each family receives a box of food that is nutritionally balanced. "This makes for a healthier community. This is also a great asset for our community to help those who are in need and the fact that we have fresh meat to add to the staples they get is a real bonus," said Covington Mayor Mike Cooper.

For contributor David Huval II, he says it's not hard to give back to programs such as 4-H and FFA. "Showing animals with 4-H helped make me the person I am today. I grew up

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# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## LDAF accepting Specialty Crop Block Program applications

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture & Forestry (LDAF) is accepting applications for the 2013 Specialty Crop Block Grant Program (SCBGP), Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., announced today.

Applications must be received no later than close of business (4:30 p.m.) May 6, 2013.

The LDAF will administer the grant program through the United States Department of Agriculture - Agriculture Marketing Service (USDA-AMS). Currently, exact funding levels for the 2013 SCBGP are not known due to Sequestration; however, the LDAF anticipates about \$300,000 will be available to fund Louisiana projects.

The grants designated for the state

are to be used for projects that solely enhance the competitiveness of Louisiana specialty crops like fruits, vegetables, tree nuts, dried fruits, horticulture, Christmas trees, turf grass/sod, nursery and greenhouse crops.

Some of the groups eligible for the grants include non-profit organizations and corporations, commodity associations, state and local government entities, colleges, and universities. Applicants must reside in or their business or educational affiliation must be in Louisiana. One requirement of applicants is that each applicant must obtain a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number and include that number on their application.

Grant funds will not be awarded for projects that directly benefit a particular commercial product or provide a profit to a single organization, institution, or individual. Projects should focus on issues to help improve specialty crop industries as a whole such as: distribution, production, research, market development, food safety, promotion and education.

LDAF will accept grant applications with a yearly budget value of up to \$100,000 and a minimum of \$5,000. Grants can be awarded for projects lasting up to three years. Once the deadline has past all applications submitted to LDAF will be carefully evaluated to determine if the projects are qualified based on

the criteria listed in the guidelines.

All submitted project applications deemed qualified will be reviewed and scored by a panel consisting of industry stakeholders, and the panel will make funding recommendations to LDAF. All LDAF approved projects will be incorporated into one state grant request which will be submitted to USDA.

LDAF has prepared a Request for Applications (RFP) document detailing application instructions, scoring criteria, federal forms, project format examples and other helpful information from the USDA. with nothing and this program taught me responsibility and how to show respect." Huval added, "When I was growing up, I always said I would support the program if I had the means to. I feel blessed to be able to give back to the kids and to the Covington Food Bank."

For other contributors, participating was a no-brainer. "When Commissioner Strain and Deputy Commissioner Brent Robbins said they wanted to expand the opportunity to help 4-H, FFA and the food bank, we jumped at the chance to be involved even though we've supported 4-H in the past," said Manda Fine Meats CEO Bobby Yarborough. "It's a privilege to be here because it is unbelievable when you learn of the number of 'food insecure' people who are out there. They may have their next few meals,

but they don't know if they will have enough for the rest of the month nor do they have the nutritional value," said Yarborough.

Because meat is considered a "luxury item", it's safe to bet that the people who come to the food bank cannot afford it. Another contributor, Huey Miller of ServiceMaster said, "It feels good to be involved because you're helping the kids and the food bank," said Miller.

St. Tammany Parish Assessor Louis Fitzmorris bought a hog and donated it. "I showed my animals in livestock shows and have a great appreciation for these programs," he said.

But no one is more appreciative than those who received the meat donation. "This is my first time here," said Cathy Brown. "I have a disability and need assistance. Sometimes my son gives me some

money to buy meat, but this is so helpful. Meat prices are outrageous," she said.

Covington Food Bank Marketing Director Paula Souhlas says the meat donations are "a blessing." "In the past, there were days the shelves were bare and then the food would just come. We mostly rely on our wonderful community for donations," she added.

Covington Food Bank Executive Director Terri Turner-Marse added, "It's astounding the number of elderly people on fixed incomes who are barely scraping by. The food bank becomes a requirement for the elderly to survive. Your hope is that you help people and they are able to move up, but the elderly regularly need us."

Regional Director for the LSU AgCenter Dr. Bobby Fletcher has

been instrumental in helping sell livestock at the St. Tammany Junior Livestock show for the past few years. "We all need to give back and support our communities and youth development programs. ## Bird repellent approved for rice fields

### -LSU AgCenter Report-

LSU AgCenter research funded by Louisiana rice farmers' checkoff funds led to federal approval of a bird repellent, AV-1011, that prevents birds from eating rice seed once it is planted.

Without this research, the AV-1011 would not have gotten approval by the Environmental Protection Agency, according to Steve Linscombe, director of the LSU AgCenter Rice Research Station.


Linscombe said birds quickly learn not to use planted rice fields for a quick meal.

"It doesn't taste good, so they don't eat the rice," Linscombe said, adding that the chemical doesn't hurt the birds.

Linscombe said EPA approval was given for 40,000 acres of seed planted in dry fields and 15,000 acres of water-planted rice.

The biggest need for the repellent is in the areas of Vermilion, Jefferson Davis and Cameron parishes, which are near the marshy blackbird roosting areas.

Swarms of blackbirds can devastate a rice field, causing farmers to have to use valuable time to go back into a field that had already been planted and spend money on more seed and fuel. Economic loss in 2008 was estimated at \$38.1 million based on the 2008 value of the crop in the rice-growing states of Louisiana, Arkansas, Texas, Mississippi, Missouri and



approved by rice farmers again last year. They pay a total of 8 cents for every 100 pounds of rice they sell, and 5 cents goes to research and 3 cents for promotion.

Saichuk said a number of materials have been tested to prevent birds from eating rice seed, without affecting the birds. "This is the only thing that showed any promise."

The bird repellent is authorized for use on seed of other crops, such as corn.

"AgCenter scientists provided quite a bit of research and assistance in the justification for approval of the AV1011," Linscombe said.

Don Reed, AgCenter wildlife extension agent, did much of the work, Linscombe said.

Linscombe said use of the material was granted by EPA under a Section 18 permit that has been obtained annually through application by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry. Efforts are under way to obtain permanent EPA approval, Linscombe said.

Johnny Saichuk, AgCenter rice specialist, said he spoke at an EPA hearing in 2012 in North Carolina to help obtain the Section 18 permit this year. The trip was funded by the Louisiana Rice Research Board with checkoff funds, Saichuk said.

The checkoff program was

Paul Johnson, who farms in Cameron Parish, said he estimated his war against blackbirds, using propane-powered pop guns and shotguns, cost him an average of \$70 an acre.

"It was a big, big eye-opener for me when I started adding all that up," he recalled. "Even with all that, I still had damage to areas of fields. The one thing that wasn't figured in there was peace of mind."

He said after planting a 70-acre field last year, hordes of blackbirds descended on the seed. "For three days, we could not leave the field. All we were doing was shooting."

He said he eventually abandoned the field and let the blackbirds have the seed, but he followed up by planting seed treated with AV-1011. "Within three hours, there was not a blackbird in the field."

## NRCS accepting applications through April 19 for pilot program

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service Oil Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (SPCC) Pilot program is being offered to help agricultural producers comply with revised regulations by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The SPCC program is intended to prevent and mitigate fuel and oil spills on agricultural operations.

In order to be considered in the first SPCC Pilot application evaluation period for fiscal year 2013, interested agricultural producers are encouraged to visit their local Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) office as soon as possible. The first application evaluation period for fiscal year 2013 SPCC funding ends April 19, 2013.

"Farmers and ranchers who need assistance to comply with EPA's Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure regulation should consider NRCS's SPCC Pilot," said Acting State Conservationist Britt Paul. "I encourage any producer who may be interested to visit their local NRCS office and submit an application for funding."

NRCS has developed a SPCC Conservation Activity Plan to assist farming operations that exceed 10,000 gallons of above-ground storage capacity. Those facilities with less than 10,000

gallons but more than 1,320 gallons of above-ground storage capacity should take advantage of the "self-certification template provided by EPA. NRCS has also developed practice standards to assist producers who wish to implement elements of an approved SPCC plan and comply with the SPCC rule.

The pilot program is funded through the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP).

EQIP is authorized by the Farm Bill to assist eligible landowners plan and implement conservation practices that address natural resource concerns and for opportunities to improve soil, water, plant, animal, air, and related resources on agricultural land and non-industrial private forestland. In addition, EQIP also helps producers meet Federal, State, Tribal and local environmental regulations.
