## Fighting fire with fire

**F**or those who live in a city, more than likely, you're not starting a fire anywhere near your home unless it's in a fireplace or on the stove. However, in rural areas, controlled burns are an inexpensive management tool to keep brush contained.

On a recent trip to the Alexander State Forest in Rapides Parish, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) firefighters were doing what they often do: conducting a prescribed burn. Prescribed burning is a controlled burn conducted to decrease the likelihood of an out of control fire. A wildfire is less likely to burn out of control if straw, leaves and debris are periodically removed. The goal of a prescribed, or controlled, fire is to use it as an ecological and economical tool to clear land.

"It's a way to restore the habitat," said LDAF's Bret Lane. "When there's fresh growth, that's what animals want to eat because it consists of better nutrients as opposed to the old stuff."

Here's how it works: LDAF forestry officials identify smoke sensitive areas and when the conditions are right,

they burn. Springtime is burning season which is driven by weather and wind direction.

Each year the foresters use prescribed fire on thousands of acres of land in the state forests. On this particular day, five firefighters were burning 80 acres. In all, there are 114 state firefighters protecting and maintaining 18.9 million acres of land. They also oversee 600,000 acres of land that is burned in the state— at the private, state and federal levels.

While the fires are controlled, the flames vary with wind direction. "This fire will outrun you in the woods," said Lane. Firefighter Jeffery Rachal with LDAF added, "Fire lanes burn themselves out but every once in awhile there is a spot fire that can become a wildfire."

Sometimes they're one foot in height, other times they build up the intensity to 30-40 feet in height. The fire-

fighters remain on the scene until the fire is completely out. "Everything we do is safety first. From our equipment, identifying objectives for the burn, identifying smoke sensitive areas where there are nursing homes and *See fire, continued on page 20*

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## 2013 fiscal legislative session is well underway

We are well underway in the 2013 fiscal legislative session and the budget will certainly be a hot topic. With cutbacks and streamlining always a focus, I'm working to ensure that our farmers and their tax exemptions are protected.

Why is this important? Simply put- agriculture is big business in Louisiana and it is imperative that we protect our farmers who provide us with food and fiber.

Think about it: what would happen if our farmers gave up on us? The demand on food production is increasing with the growing popu-

lation. While research and technology allow us to improve farming techniques which, in turn, help with the production of more commodities, tax exemptions on equipment and inputs are needed to keep up with production demands. Some farming equipment can cost up to \$750,000. Tax exemptions only cover the first \$50,000. Having those tax exemptions keeps those dollars in Louisiana as opposed to competitive neighboring states and the international market that desperately want Louisiana's business.

Agriculture contributes billions

of dollars to the economy and employs thousands of people in Louisiana. In 2012, agriculture had a nearly \$11.5 billion economic impact.

There are more than 30 thousand farms in our state. A majority of them are considered family farms. Also, with approximately 28 million acres of land in the state, approximately 14 million is land in forests and 8 million is land in farms. That means the majority of our state is rooted in agriculture.

A final note- we continue to work with the Louisiana Department of

Environmental Quality and the Environmental Protection Agency to develop a reasonable approach to reduce run-off into fields and forests from industry. Industry brings jobs and other advancements to an area, but we must also protect our natural resources. It truly is a balancing act and an effort in teamwork.

The agriculture, forestry and aquaculture sectors will lead the state's economy as we move forward because of our production capabilities and the increase of worldwide demand.

## LDAF sees increase in seed analysis requests

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry's Seed Testing Laboratory is receiving a record number of seed samples this spring, Seed Programs Director Kevin Wofford said.

Since July 1, 2012, the lab has received about 6,100 samples. During February 2013, the lab analyzed 1,500 samples, which is an increase of 500 to 700 samples for the month of February. Historically, February is the month with the largest number of samples due to spring planting across the state.

"We have seen the largest increase in soybeans and corn," Wofford said. "This is mainly due to the higher grain prices for these two commodities."

The USDA National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) reported Louisiana farmers expect to plant 600,000 acres of corn and more than 1.1 million acres of soybeans this year.


Wofford said since Louisiana is a seed importing state, we rely on other states for our agricultural seed. "This is why it is so critical to test seed to ensure that Louisiana producers are plant-

ing the highest quality seed on the market. There were approximately 3.5 million acres of seed planted last year, 2.8 million acres of that planted seed was tested by the State Seed Testing Laboratory."

The Seed Testing Laboratory has seven analysts and one student worker. "Seed lab personnel are working extra hours in order to keep the turnover rate on samples down which means getting results to seed dealers across the state quicker," Wofford said.

The laboratory analyzes all agricultural crop and vegetable seed that are offered for sale in Louisiana. The lab performs various tests ranging from seed count to herbicide bioassay testing, in addition to standard germination and purity tests. This variety of testing is to ensure that the consumers of Louisiana are purchasing high quality seed. During the course of the year the lab performs about 17,000 tests on seed.

The lab analyzes seed ranging from dealers from other states to Louisiana homeowners wanting to know if their garden seed is viable.

hospitals, we write out our management plans and we stay on the scene with our bulldozers to ensure the fire is out," says Lane.

Fire officials warn that in the event you are considering doing a controlled burn, make sure open burning is allowed in the area, do not leave the fire unattended and have the proper equipment on hand to put out the fire in the event it gets out of hand.

Remember, the leading causes of wildfires are debris burning and arson.

Louisiana is also one of several states still participating in the public awareness campaign promoting the benefits of prescribed burning. The One Message, Many Voices (OMMV) campaign goal is to encourage citizens to enjoy outdoor activities, and to increase public awareness of wildfire prevention and maintenance of healthy forests through the website [goodfires.org](http://goodfires.org).

Here are some additional tips on how to prevent wildfires from damaging your property:

- Clear leaves and other debris

from gutters, eaves, porches and decks. This prevents embers from igniting your home.

- Keep lawns hydrated and maintained. Dry grass and shrubs are fuel for wildfire.

- Remove flammable materials (firewood stacks, propane canisters, dry vegetation) within 5 feet of the home's foundation and outbuildings, including garages and sheds. If it can catch fire, don't let it touch the house, deck or porch.

- Limit vegetation surrounding the home's perimeter to at least 30-100 feet, depending on the area's wildfire risk.

- Create a "fire-free" area within five feet of the home, using non-flammable landscaping materials such as rocks, pavers and/or high-moisture content annuals and perennials.

- If you have trees on your property, prune so the lowest branches are 6 to 10 feet from the ground.

- Don't let debris and lawn cuttings linger. Dispose of these items quickly to reduce fuel for fire.

- When planting, choose slow-growing, carefully placed shrubs and trees so the area can be more easily maintained.

- Landscape with native and less-flammable plants.

The LDAF is the only State agency with statewide wildland firefighting capabilities. LDAF fire crews work in conjunction with local fire departments. Fires are detected by aircraft or are reported by public citizens, and are then suppressed by trained forestry crews.

The Office of Forestry administers the Certified Prescribed Burn Manager Program, which is designed to promote the safe and effective use of prescribed fire in the management of natural resources. Pay attention to your local fire officials when burn bans are in effect. The LDAF website ([www.ldaf.state.la.us](http://www.ldaf.state.la.us)) also gives notice when there is a burn ban in effect in certain areas. The LDAF Hotline number is 1-855-4LA-LDAF (1-855-452-5323).

Wildfire season starts in December and lasts through April.

Law enforcement officials say the suspect, 48-year-old Jackie G. Murray, Jr., of the 6200 block of East Texas Street in Bossier City, La., admitted to taking the saddles from Hays Brothers' Ranch near Arcadia in Lincoln Parish. The LDAF Brand Inspector recovered the saddles.

Jackie Murray was charged with illegal possession of stolen things valued at \$1,000.

Cooperating in the investigation

were the Bossier Sheriff's Office, Lincoln Sheriff's Office and the 26th Judicial District Attorney's Office.

In another Brand Commission related incident, two propane tanks, 120 and 250-gallon tanks, were reported stolen March 22 from a farm in Whiteville, a community located in the northern part of St. Landry Parish.

On April 1, the LDAF Brand Inspector discovered the propane tanks were sold at a scrap yard in Marksville, La. in Avoyelles Parish. Arrested was Roderick Dwayne Jacobs of 204 South Ash St., Bunkie, La. for the theft. Jacobs was also charged with criminal trespassing.
