rently has an agricultural program that teaches them how to garden and grow their own fruits and vegetables.

Barley says the donors requested to remain anonymous. Barley adds that they are extremely grateful for the generosity of the people who contributed to their effort. He says he knows the young men will continue to learn life skills and develop a strong work ethic with this new cattle program.

## La. donates food to tornado victims

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry was instrumental in securing food and other donations for victims of the recent tornadoes in Oklahoma.

"It is a humbling experience when you need help. What makes this country great is the generosity that comes from our citizens and local businesses," said Strain.

"Louisiana has been the recipient of much assistance in the past from other parts of the country because of catastrophic events such as hurricanes. This is a chance for us to give back to those who are in need," added Strain. "Once again, our Louisiana citizens and companies are proving to be extremely generous. This is definitely a community effort."

Luis Ramos, Vice-President of Manufacturing at Blue Runner, said Blue Runner CEO Ricky Thomas read an article about the tornadoes' destruction and the relief efforts. That's when Thomas instructed his folks to get involved. "The support is amazing. I got involved when this was a pebble. Now it's a snowball," said Ramos.

Contributions included:

Farmers Rice Milling Company out of Lake Charles, La. is donating one ton of rice.

Blue Runner Foods out of Gonzales is donating 1,200

cases of beans to feed up to 65,000 people.

Silgan Containers donated the cans for the beans.

Clarion Inn and Turner Industries each donated \$1,000 toward the food products.

Robert's Distributors is donating \$600 toward the purchase of fuel for the delivery of the food.

Zapp's Potato Chips also donated several pallets of potato chips.

Gonzales and East Ascension Rotary Clubs donated four pallets of water, paper towels, Gatorade and liquid soap.

Truck owner Lester Duplessis delivered the food and supplies to Moore, Ok.

"When I was affected by Hurricane Katrina, people came out of the woodwork to help. I remember looking outside and seeing people with chainsaws cutting up trees on my property," added Strain.

Gonzales Mayor Barney Arceneaux said, "You never know when something like this could happen in your community. This is an example of a bunch of people and companies that came together to do the right thing."

The EF-5 tornado struck the Oklahoma City suburb on May 20, 2013. At least 24 people were reported killed and nearly 400 injured.

Ascension Parish President Tommy Martinez and Sheriff Jeff Wiley also supported this relief effort.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Strain: Hire only licensed horticulture professionals

Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., is urging Louisiana homeowners to hire only licensed landscape horticulturists, arborists and landscape irrigation contractors when doing major landscaping work at their homes or businesses.

“Every spring and summer, ‘yard specialists’ claiming to be landscaping professionals begin making rounds in neighborhoods offering bargain basement deals for yard work,” Strain said. “Many have little or no training and their work is often substandard.

“All arborists, landscape horticulturists and landscape irrigation contractors must be licensed by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry,” Strain said.

Oversight of these professionals is through the LDAF’s Horticulture and Quarantine Programs division.

Strain advised that homeowners ask to see a license issued by LDAF before allowing any work to be done on their property. Homeowners should also ask arborists, landscape horticulturists and landscape irrigation contractors for references before engaging their services and should follow up by checking those references.

Licensed arborists and landscape irrigation contractors must also have current liability insurance before a license is issued, Strain said. “Homeowners should ask for copies of the arborist and landscape irrigation contractor’s liability insurance,” Strain said. “They can then call the contractor’s insurance company to verify that the policy is current or they can contact our office.” “These are basic steps homeowners should take to be sure that they are hiring a licensed professional,” Strain said.

Strain said horticulture professionals must pass an exam to ensure that they have the training necessary to do the work. Arborists and landscape irrigation contractors are required to attend continuing education training to renew their licenses.

In addition, licensed horticultural professionals are required to display their LDAF license number on their vehicles.

## Have You Sold Cattle on the Farm? If so, be sure you paid the \$1.50 check-off. It`s The Law -- No One is Exempt!

The beef check-off law goes into effect every time cattle are sold. This includes purebred sales and private treaty sales on the farm. The law requires that you must collect the national, plus the 50 cents state check-off money during your sale. The 50 cents state check-off is now a Mandatory Collection as a result of Act 298 passed in the 1995 Louisiana legislature, but producers may request a refund of this amount only, by written request to the Louisiana Beef Industry Council.

The seller is also responsible under the law. The seller may collect and remit the \$1.50 per head in a private treaty transaction. This is the best way to handle purebred sales. To avoid a late payment charge, money must be remitted by the 15th of the month following the sale. Penalties of up to \$5,000 per transaction applies to violators. All sale transactions are subject to audit to insure compliance with the check-off law.

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# Stink bugs arrive in soybeans earlier than expected

Jeff Davis, LSU AgCenter entomologist, is finding stink bugs in agricultural fields earlier this year than expected.

“We found them active in clover all winter. We even found them reproducing in the winter, and they are not supposed to be,” he said.

More alarming, though, is his finding of redbanded stink bug nymphs on June 3 on soybeans only 8 inches tall, and adult redbanded stink bugs in 12-inch-high soybean plots. Both discoveries were at the South Farm of the Rice Research Station in Crowley, where he rarely finds any stink bugs.

If left unchecked, the redbanded stink bug can cause damage so extensive that farmers may lose an entire field of beans, Davis said. The redbanded stink bug is the No. 1 pest of Louisiana soybeans.

“We are not supposed to be finding stink bugs in Louisiana this early in the vegetative stage. All the literature says we won’t find them until pods have developed,” Davis said.

He is working this year with a new sampling device that uses a leaf blower on a backpack to suck insects from soybean plants. He said the vacuum finds insects often missed with sweep nets, which can also damage small plants.

Davis has two studies funded by the Louisiana Soybean and Grain Research and Promotion Board. The first study will examine possible traits that make some varieties of soybeans undesirable to soybean pests, while integrating natural enemies of the pest and insecticides.

The second study is aimed at determining when stink bugs move into a soybean field and how they

survive winters.

Clover appears to be a bridge species that harbors stink bugs until soybeans are growing. Farmers who use clover as a cover crop should be aware that killing the clover could cause stink bugs to move into a soybean field, he said.

Two other insect pests are also problematic for Louisiana soybean growers, Davis said. The kudzu bug was found near Vicksburg, Miss., and the brown marmorated stinkbug has been found in Texas.

To detect possible movements of those two insects into Louisiana, small plots of 10 high-yielding soybean varieties were planted at several research stations, and they are sampled weekly.

“We use them as our early warning system,” Davis said.

Yield and quality will be examined after harvest, he said. Half of the research plots will be sprayed, and half will be left unsprayed for comparison.

The brown marmorated stink bug is not in Louisiana yet, he said, but discovery of the kudzu bug just across the Mississippi River from Louisiana means the pest could be found in soybeans soon.

Alabama and Georgia soybean farmers have found the kudzu in their crops. Yield losses in untreated fields could be as high as 40 percent, Davis said, but several insecticides are available that are effective against the insect.

Davis also will be monitoring insect pests for insecticide resistance. He said some populations of stink bugs were showing resistance last year.
