## Honoring Fallen Heroes

"The people of Arizona are hurting tremendously," said Louisiana State Fire Marshal Butch Browning. Browning and state officials, including Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., memorialized 19 firefighters who were killed June 30, 2013 battling a 13 square mile blaze in Yarnell, a tiny mountain town in a remote area northwest of Phoenix, Arizona. The inferno got the best of them when the winds shifted.

"When firefighters head to work, every day they worry about the calls they have to respond to. They train to do their best. And while they train to save property, they know lives can be lost," said Browning.

At the memorial service held at the Louisiana State Firefighter's Memorial, located on the grounds of the State Fire Marshal's Office, Strain said he is proud to represent the 104 wildland firefighters who work to save timber, property and, most importantly, lives. "I've been out there watching them attack those walls of flames. They have great courage."

Louisiana officials all agree that a shock wave went across America and fire services when it was learned that this hotshot crew, an elite group of firefighters, lost their lives. Strain said it's been 80 years since the last major loss of life happened as a result of wildland fires. This time around, only one out of the 20 members of the Granite Mountain Hotshots survived because he

was moving the unit's truck at the time.

Louisiana wildland firefighters protect more than 19 million acres of land. They average just over 2000 fires per year. "Our condolences go out to the families, friends and fellow firefighters of these men who lived every day making a difference," said Strain.

It is reported that the crew and its commanders were following safety protocols, but it appears the fire's erratic nature overwhelmed them. The hotshot team spent recent weeks fighting fires in New Mexico and other areas of Arizona before they were called to Yarnell. The temperature was in the triple digits as they carried backpacks, chainsaws and other heavy gear to remove brush and trees.

A moment of silence and a ceremonial bell rang as the names of the 19 firefighters were read. The bell ringing signaled the start of duty and the sounding of the bell at the end of the day, last call, represented the end of the alarm. "Louisiana has a rich tradition of supporting firefighters and being there when in need," said Browning. Strain added, "Let us be mindful of the men and women in uniform and in special services who risk their lives and sacrifice so we may live safe and free."

To all of our first responders out there -- it takes a special person to put themselves in harms way and they do so every day.

## USDA detects citrus canker in Louisiana

A bacterial disease that only affects citrus plants was confirmed on leaf samples collected from sweet orange trees growing in City Park in New Orleans. The laboratory test confirming the disease was conducted by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS).

The disease, called citrus

canker, poses no health risks to humans or animals. The disease is spread by wind-driven rain and by movement of infected plant material or contaminated tools and equipment.

Transport of infected plant material is the primary means of spreading the citrus canker pathogen over long distances.

"This is the first report of citrus canker found in Louisiana. The

disease has been present in Florida since 1995. The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry is conducting an ongoing survey with the USDA to detect any additional positive sites," said Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M.

Three citrus trees in City Park have tested positive for the disease. The disease causes lesions

on leaves, stems and fruit. Citrus canker causes leaves and fruit to drop prematurely. Eventually, trees will produce no fruit at all.

"We certainly want to protect our citrus industry. Citrus is valued at between \$5-6 million in the state. This is why it is imperative we determine where the disease is present and consider precautionary measures to keep it from spreading," added Strain.

## Have You Sold Cattle on the Farm? If so, be sure you paid the \$1.50 check-off. It's The Law -- No One is Exempt!

The beef check-off law goes into effect every time cattle are sold. This includes purebred sales and private treaty sales on the farm. The law requires that you must collect the national, plus the 50 cents state check-off money during your sale. The 50 cents state check-off is now a Mandatory Collection as a result of Act 298 passed in the 1995 Louisiana legislature, but producers may request a refund of this amount only, by written request to the Louisiana Beef Industry Council.

The seller is also responsible under the law. The seller may collect and remit the \$1.50 per head in a private treaty transaction. This is the best way to handle purebred sales. To avoid a late payment charge, money must be remitted by the 15th of the month following the sale. Penalties of up to \$5,000 per transaction applies to violators. All sale transactions are subject to audit to insure compliance with the check-off law.

In a small bowl, stir together yogurt, salad dressing, honey and salt until well blended. Place chicken, blueberries, apples and walnuts in separate small serving bowls with spoons. Arrange lettuce leaves on a serving plate. To assemble a taco, place a spoonful of each ingredient and a drizzle of the dressing onto a lettuce leaf and roll up. Secure with a toothpick if desired.

***Blueberry Cobbler***

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spread blueberries in ungreased 8 or 9-inch square baking dish or pan. Sprinkle with cornstarch. Drizzle with lemon juice, set aside. In medium bowl combine flour, 1/2 cup sugar, baking powder and salt. Add milk and butter. Stir just until combined (not smooth). Drop mounds of dough onto blueberries. Pour boiling water over dough and fruit. Sprinkle with remaining 1/4-cup sugar. Bake until biscuits are golden brown and blueberries are bubbly, 45 to 50 minutes. Serve warm or at room temperature.

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In a 9-inch pie plate, toss blueberries with 1/4 cup of the sugar and 1 tablespoon of the flour. Spread evenly in pie plate. In a medium bowl, combine remaining 8 tablespoons (1/2 cup) flour, the oats, walnuts, pumpkin pie spice and remaining 1/4 cup sugar. Using a pastry blender or two knives, cut in butter until moist crumbs form. With your fingers, press together crumbs to make large chunks. Place on top of blueberries. Bake in top third of oven until topping is browned, about 20 minutes. Cool on a rack.

***Blueberry Basmati Rice Pudding with Blueberry Cassis Sorbet***

To prepare blueberry cassis sorbet: In a blender, puree 2 cups of the blueberries, 1/4 cup sugar, lemon juice and creme de cassis. Transfer puree to an ice cream maker. Freeze according to directions. Pack sorbet into a freezer container until ready to use. To prepare rice pudding: In a large saucepan, bring milk to a boil. Add rice. Reduce heat and simmer for 10 minutes. Add 1/2 cup sugar to the rice mixture. Cook, stirring frequently, until the pudding is a thin consistency, 20 to 30 minutes. Remove from heat. Stir in the vanilla. Divide rice pudding, about a 1/2-cup each, to 6 serving dishes. Cool to room temperature. Chill until ready to serve. To prepare crisp rice paper round: Preheat oven to 300 degrees. With scissors, cut six 2-1/2 inch rounds from spring roll wrapper. Lightly brush rounds with honey. Place on parchment-lined baking sheet. Bake for 10 minutes, cool to room temperature. In a medium bowl, whip cream with 1/2 teaspoon sugar until soft peaks form. To serve, spoon cream onto rice pudding. Place a 1/4-cup oval ice cream scoop of sorbet on each rice pudding. Sprinkle with remaining 1/2 cup blueberries. Garnish with a crisp rice paper round.

***Blueberry Upside Down Cake***

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray an 8-inch round baking pan with vegetable cooking spray, set aside. Rinse blueberries with cold water and pat dry with paper towels. In a medium bowl, stir sugar with cornstarch. Add blueberries, toss to coat well. Spread blueberries in the prepared pan. In a medium bowl, blend muffin mix, egg and milk until batter is slightly lumpy (do not over mix). Gently spread batter over berries. Bake until center springs back when gently pressed, 25 to 30 minutes. Cool 5 minutes in pan. Invert onto a cake plate. Serve cake wedges with yogurt.

The largest benefit of electric power is that it is approximately one-third the cost of diesel operation and low operating cost (no oil changes, maintenance, fuel storage etc.).

Electricity is more efficient. A typical diesel engine is between 15 percent and 20 percent energy-efficient. In contrast, according to an LSU AgCenter study, an electrical equivalent is approximately 85 percent efficient.

There are lower operating and maintenance costs with electric motors because they require substantially less maintenance than a diesel motor, such as no filters and oil changes.

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

## It's a good year for crape myrtle blooms

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HAMMOND, La. – The early spring months of March and April were not kind to spring growth on crape myrtles this year. But we are seeing very nice blooms on these great summer-flowering landscape trees as we reach their peak performance time of late June through July.

Keys to success with crape myrtles include correct sunlight, ideal soil pH and drainage, proper pruning, regular fertilization, proper mulching and insect control.

Crape myrtles need full sun in order to perform their best, grow their best and bloom their best. This means eight hours or more of direct sun daily. Less than eight hours of sunlight daily is not sufficient for ideal performance.

Many of us underestimate the amount of sun our landscape receives. To get a better handle on this, check your sun patterns in the morning, during the middle of the day and again in late afternoon.

Proper soil pH is important for crape myrtles, but maybe not as important as it is for some of our other landscape plants. Crape myrtles like a soil pH of 6.0-6.5. This is considered slightly acid. Do not guess on soil pH – soil test. You can lower the pH level with sulfur products and raise it with lime products. But always do this based on the results of a soil test.

What about pruning? Although February is the time to prune crape myrtles, your particular trees may not need to be pruned. When it is needed, prune these trees to maintain a natural shape. Thin out branches. Do not top or just “hack off the top” of these trees. This is commonly referred to as “crape murder.” We don’t recommend major pruning to reduce height.

Fertilization is important for crape myrtles. This is especially true if you don’t follow some of the other practices and care considerations. To maximize spring growth and summer bloom, crape myrtles should be fertilized in early spring just prior to the start of new growth. A fertilizer like 8-8-8 or 13-13-13 will work fine and is recommended for crape myrtles.

It is best to place fertilizer in drilled holes in the ground (about 8 inches deep) rather than just throw fertilizer on top of the soil. You can fertilize later in the spring and in the summer, but they don’t benefit as much as when fertilizer is applied in late winter to early spring.

Mulching, unfortunately, is done incorrectly in many residential and commercial landscapes these days. Mulch “out” instead of “up.” Many times you may see mulch piled around the base of a tree. Do not do this. Spread mulch outward toward

the ends of the branches, and use pine straw, pine bark or wood chips to a depth of 2-3 inches. Refresh the layer of mulch as needed. Keep mulch off the stems and lower trunk.

One frequent problem on crape myrtles is insect damage. Actually, insects generally don’t do much damage to the trees, but aphids feeding on new shoots in spring can be a problem. White flies also may be occasional problems on crape myrtles. Left unchecked, these insects will release their bodily fluids onto the foliage, and the resultant honeydew leads to sooty mold on the leaves. This is the black discoloration that occurs in early summer through fall. If you control the insects, no sooty mold will develop.

Popular crape myrtle varieties in Louisiana include Natchez, Muskogee, Tonto, Acoma and Sioux. Garden centers have the best availability now.

Companies have introduced many new groups and varieties of crape myrtles over the past few years. These include the dwarf Razzle Dazzle series, the black-foliaged Black Diamond varieties, the Barnyard Collection (Purple Cow, Pink Pig and Red Rooster), the Enduring Summer series, the burgundy-foliaged Delta Jazz, the Magic series and more. The LSU AgCenter is conducting adaptability studies for south Louisiana on all these new crape myrtles.
